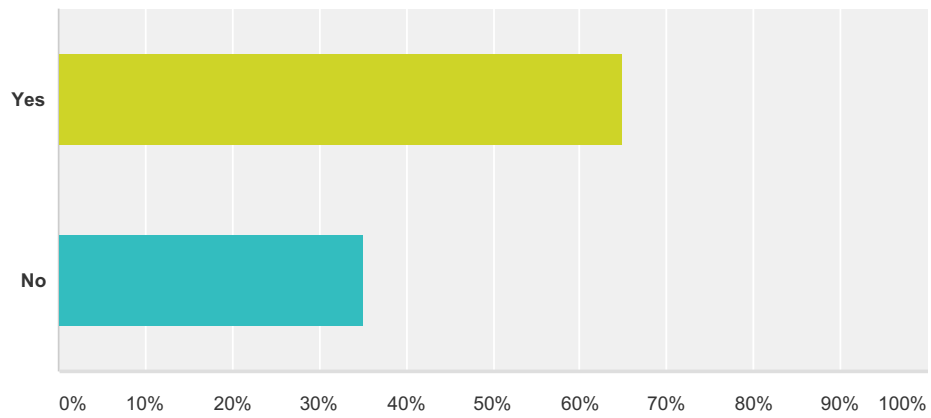


Q1 Do you give permission to your teen (16-17 years) to take this survey?

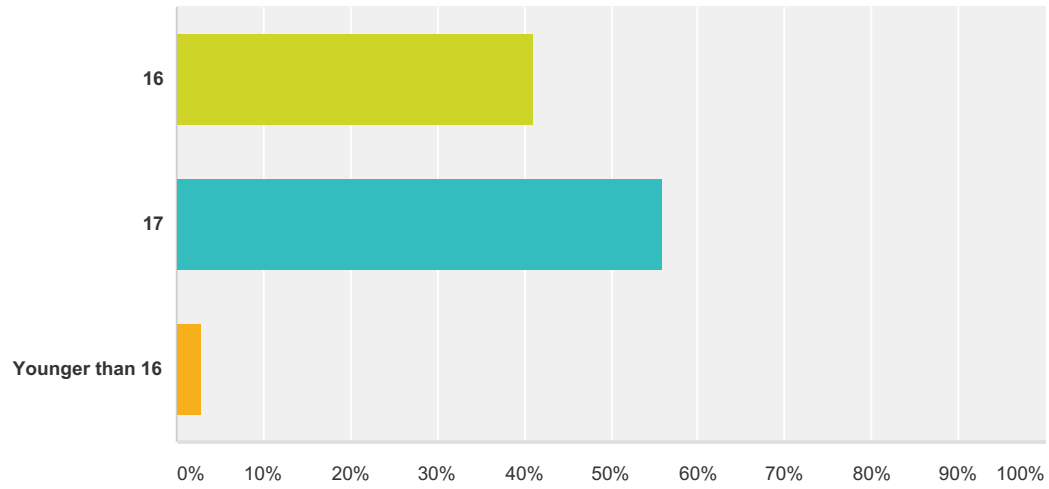

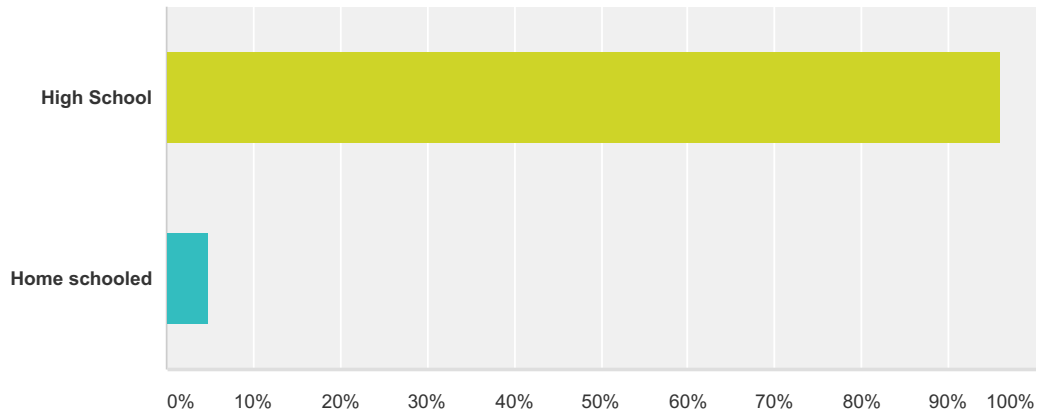

Q3 What is your education to date?

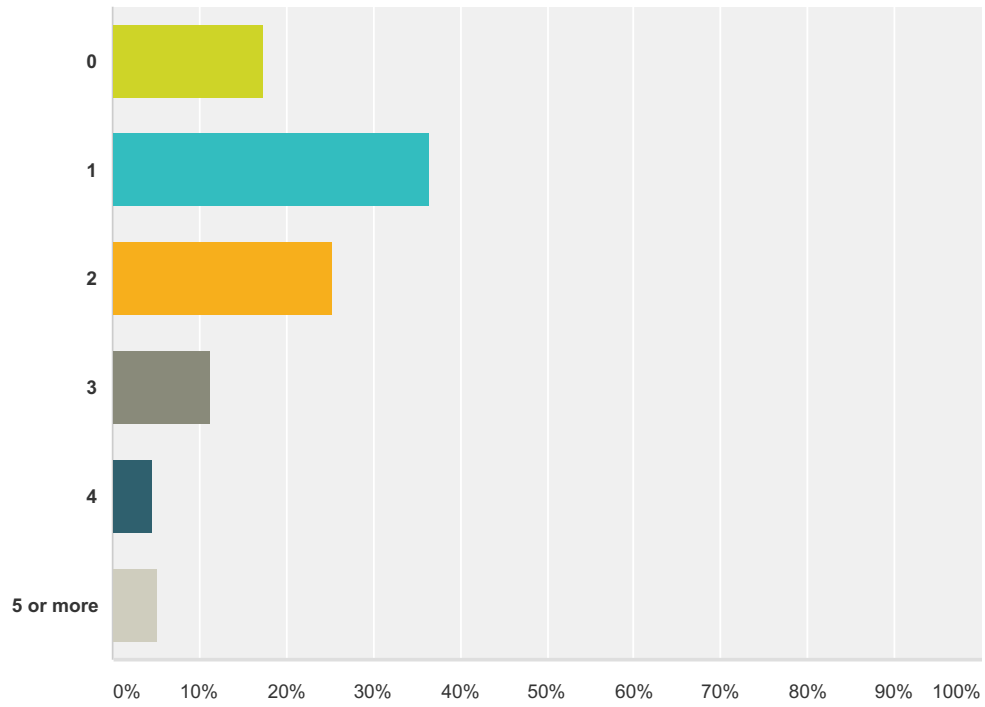

Q4 How many siblings do you have?

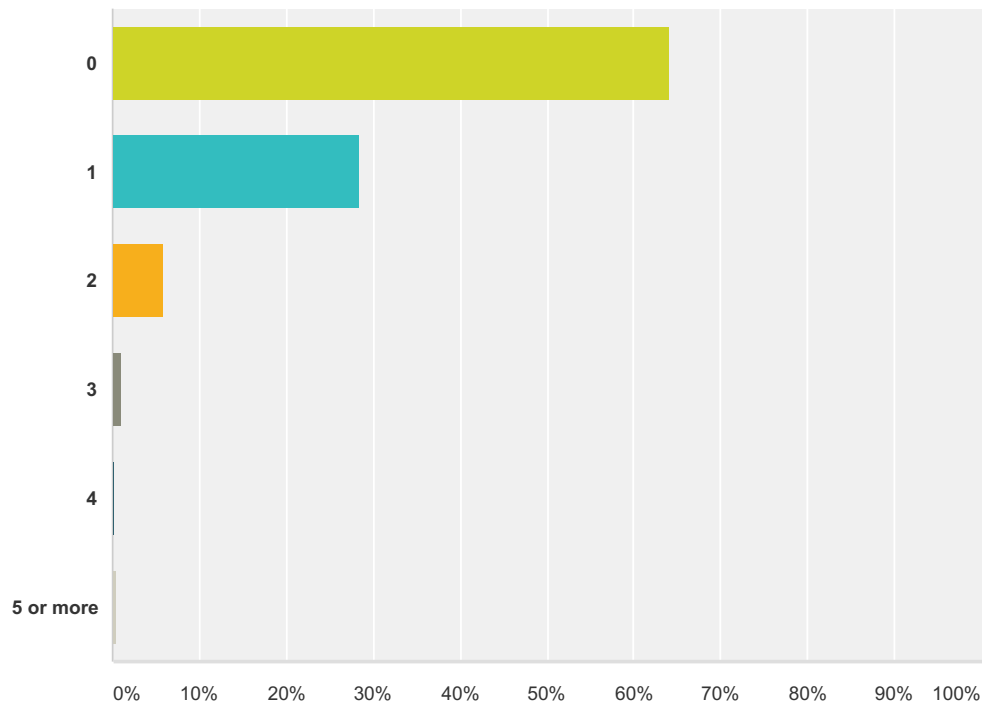

Q5 How many siblings do you have in or within one year of college or career school?

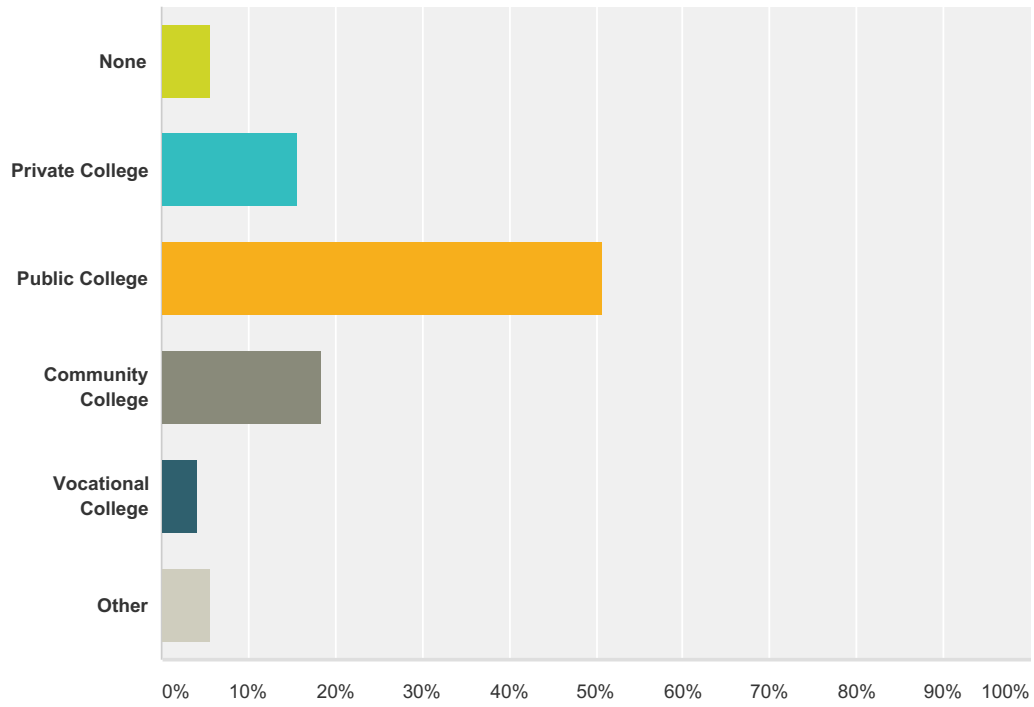

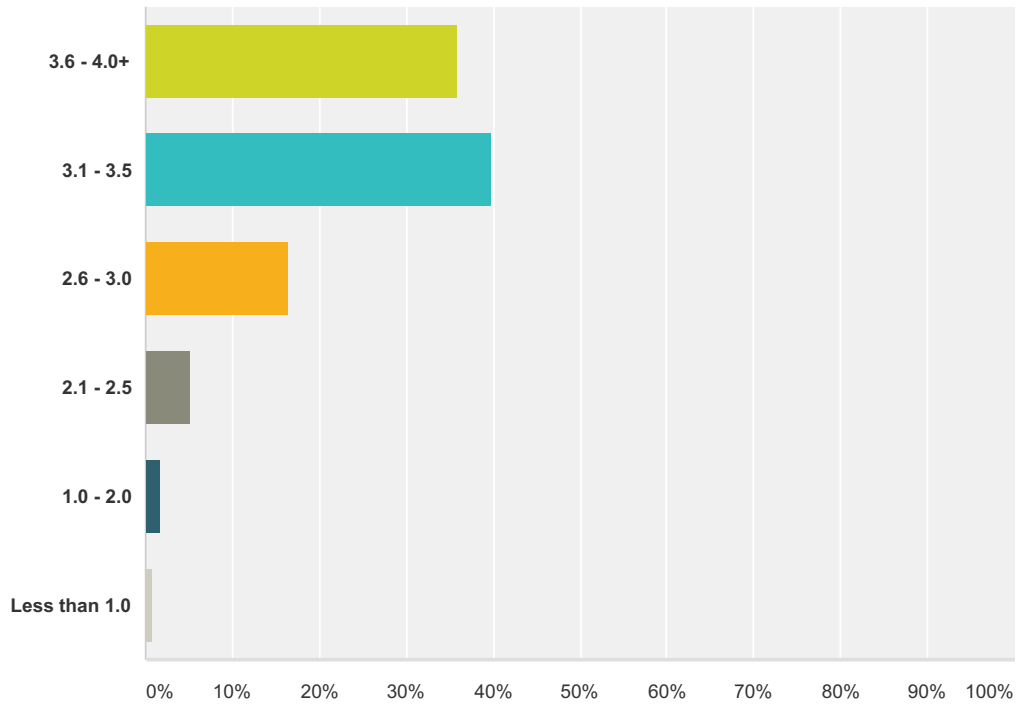

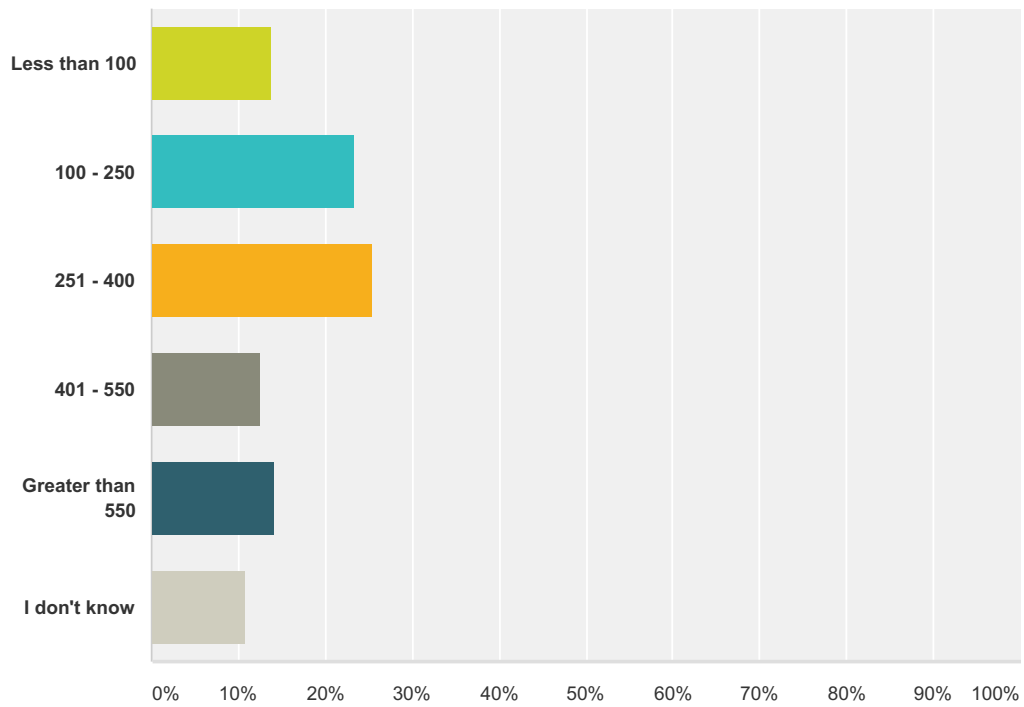

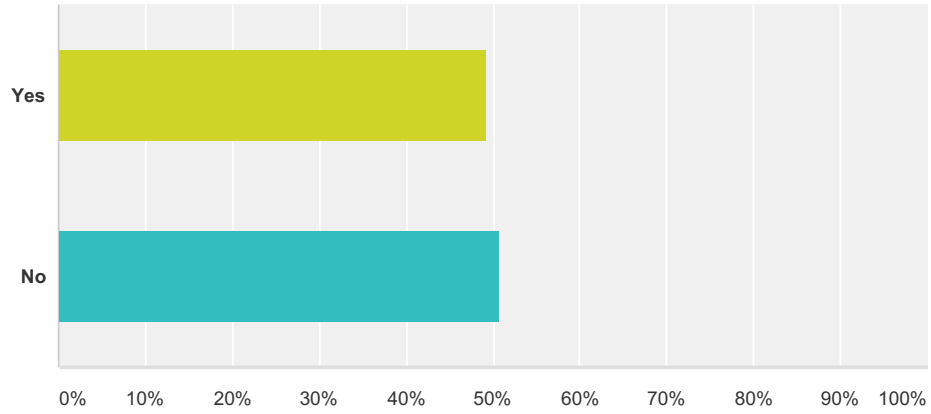

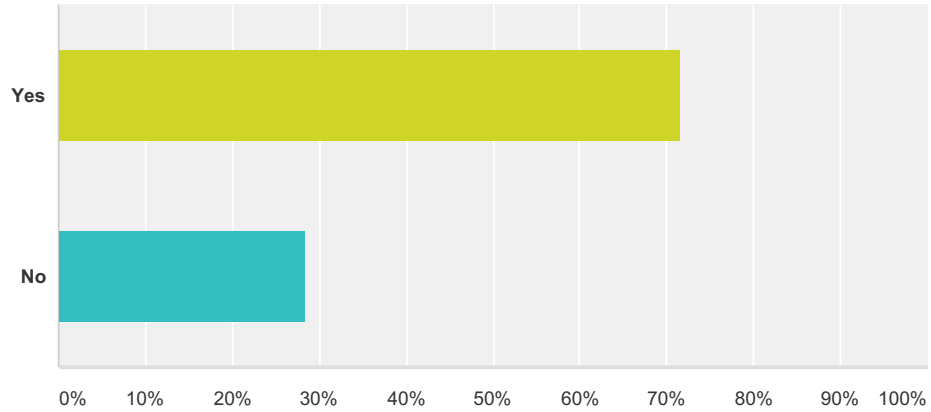

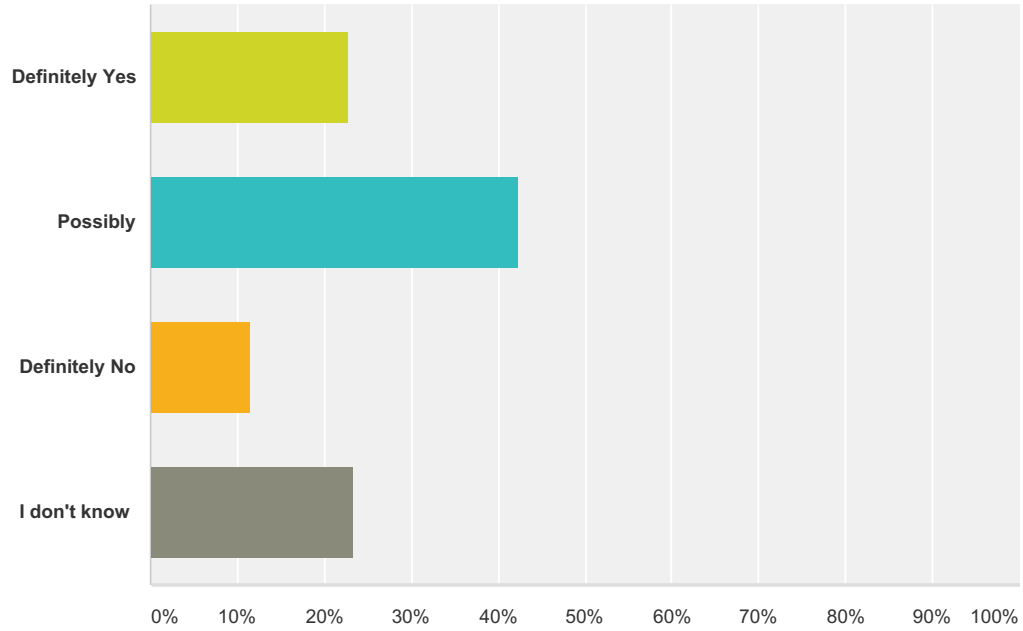

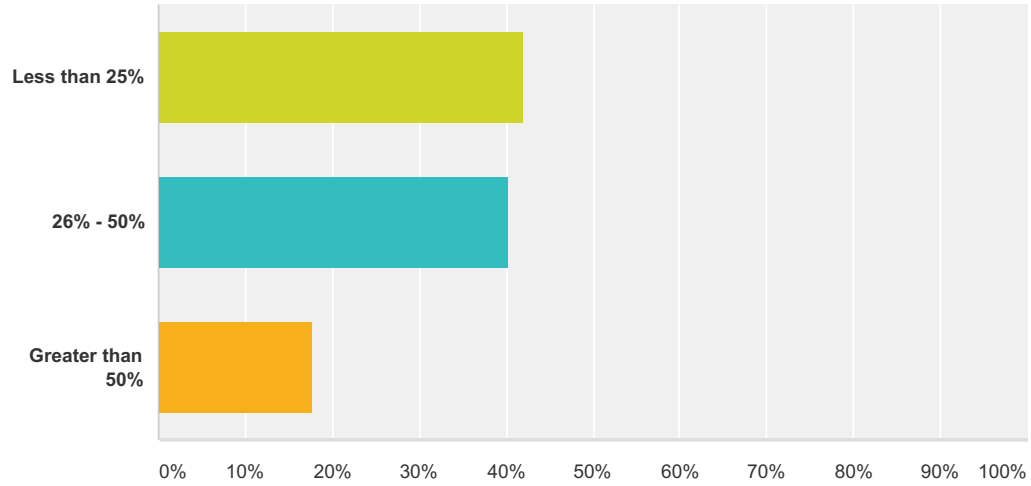

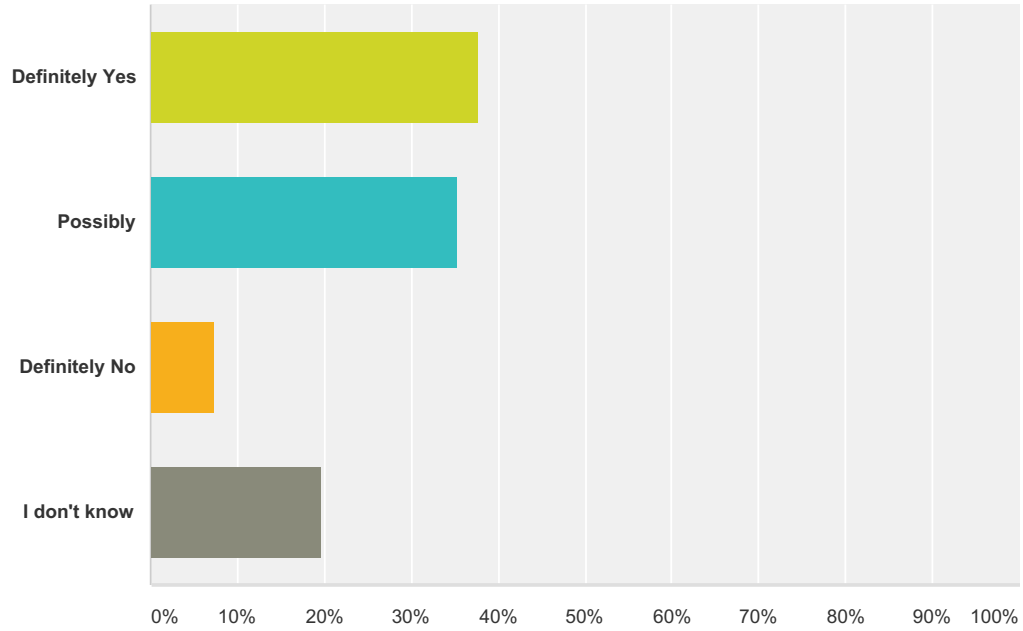

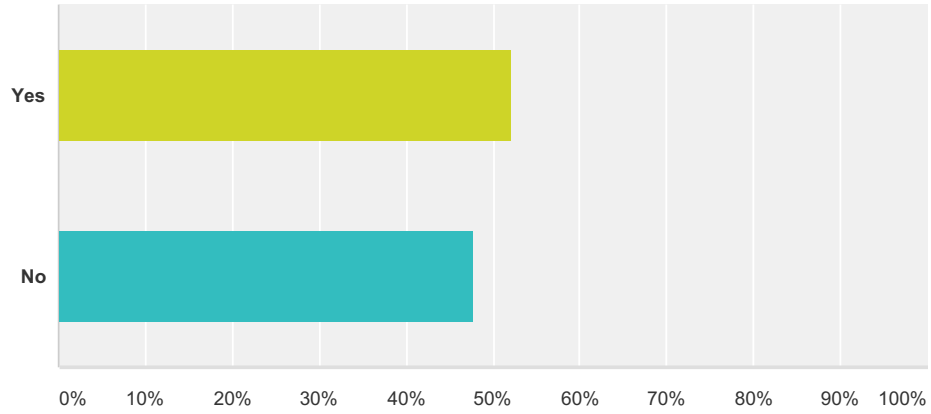

Q14 Have you gotten a job in order to earn money so you can save for college or post-secondary school?

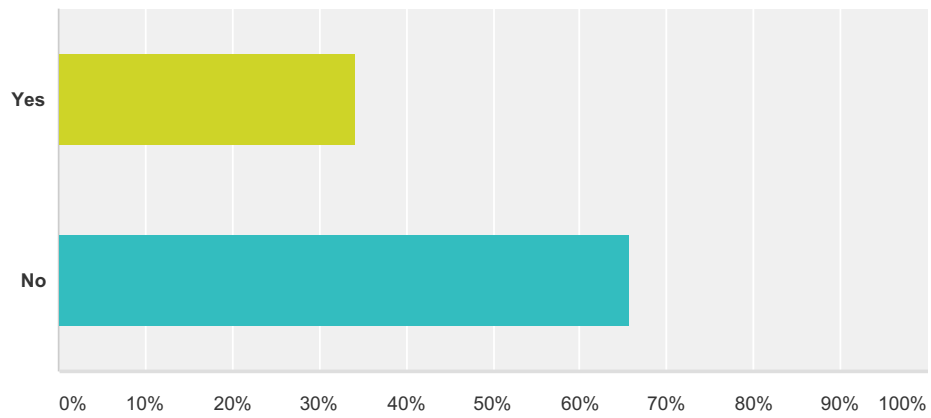

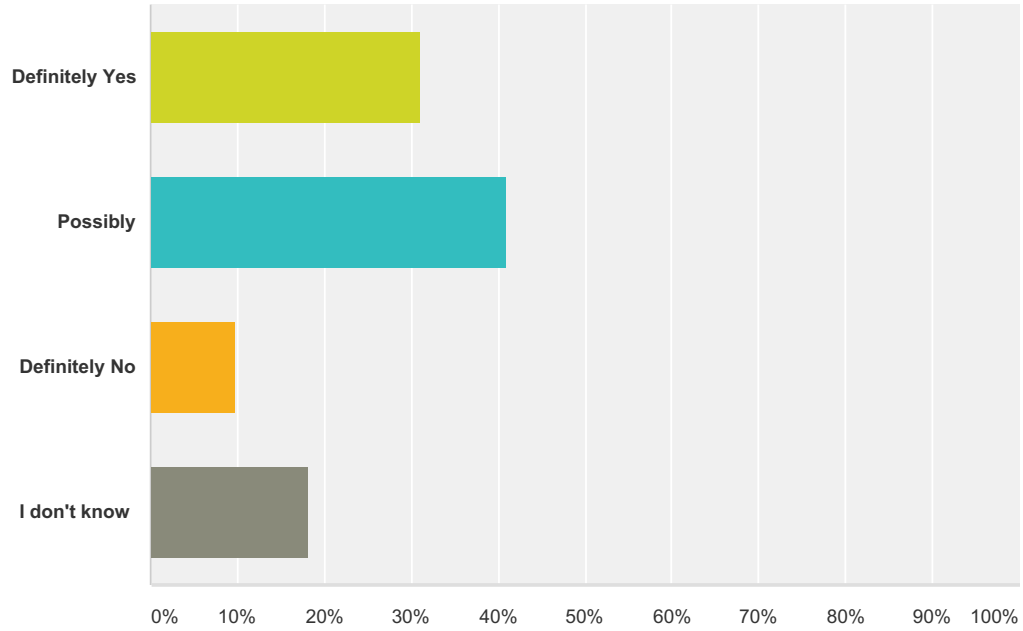

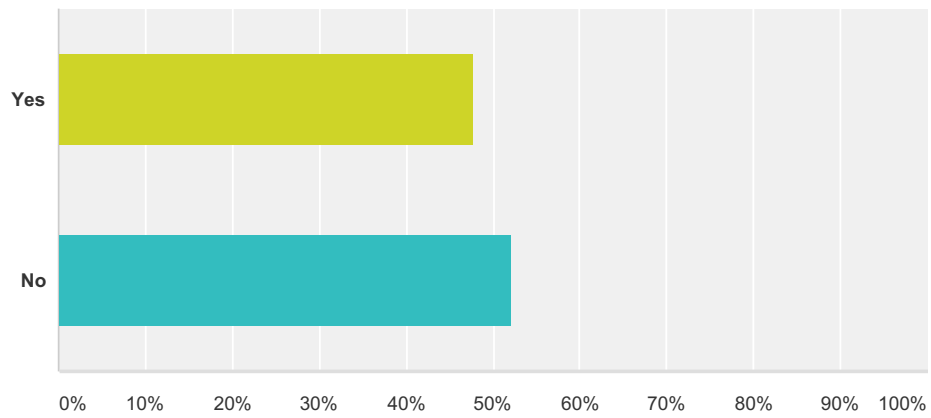

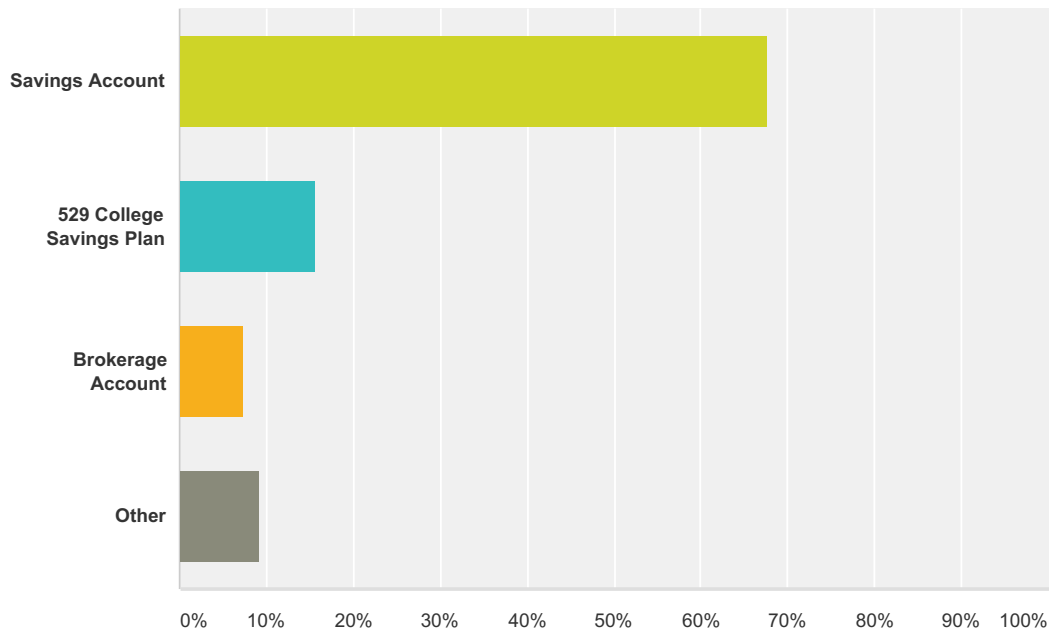

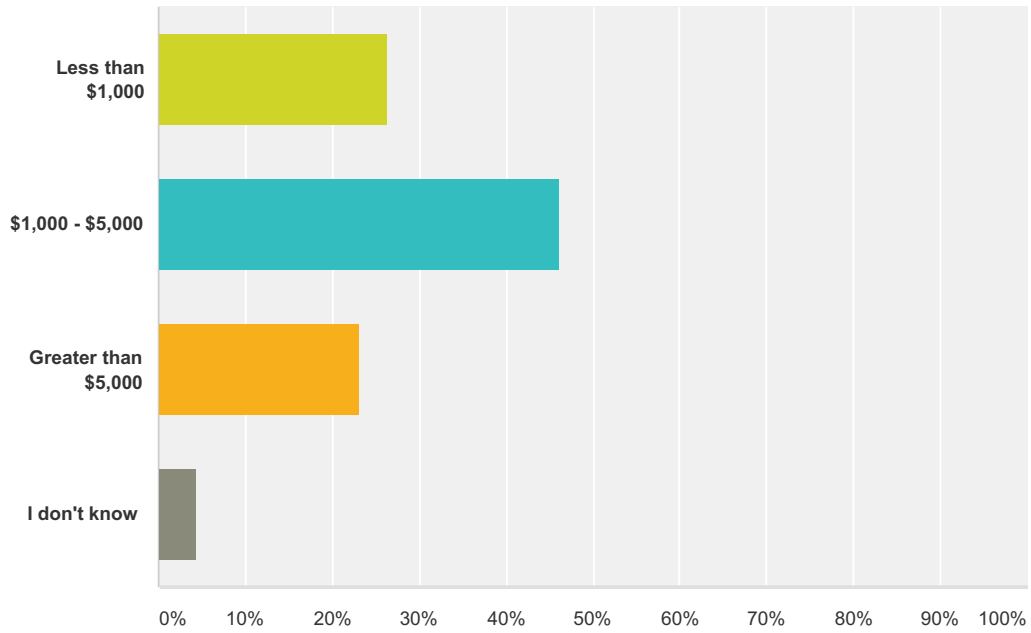

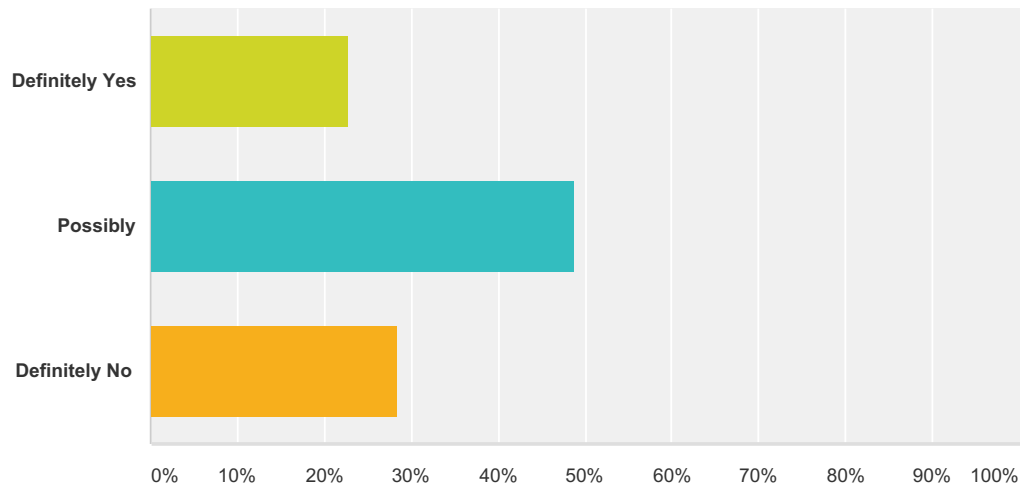

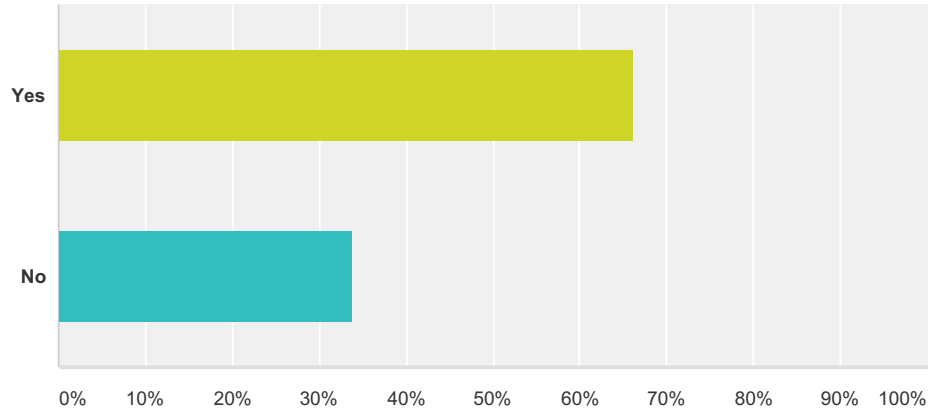

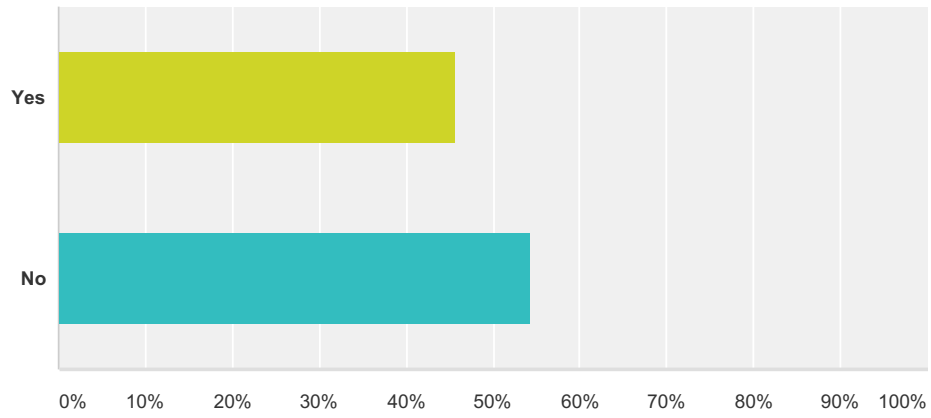

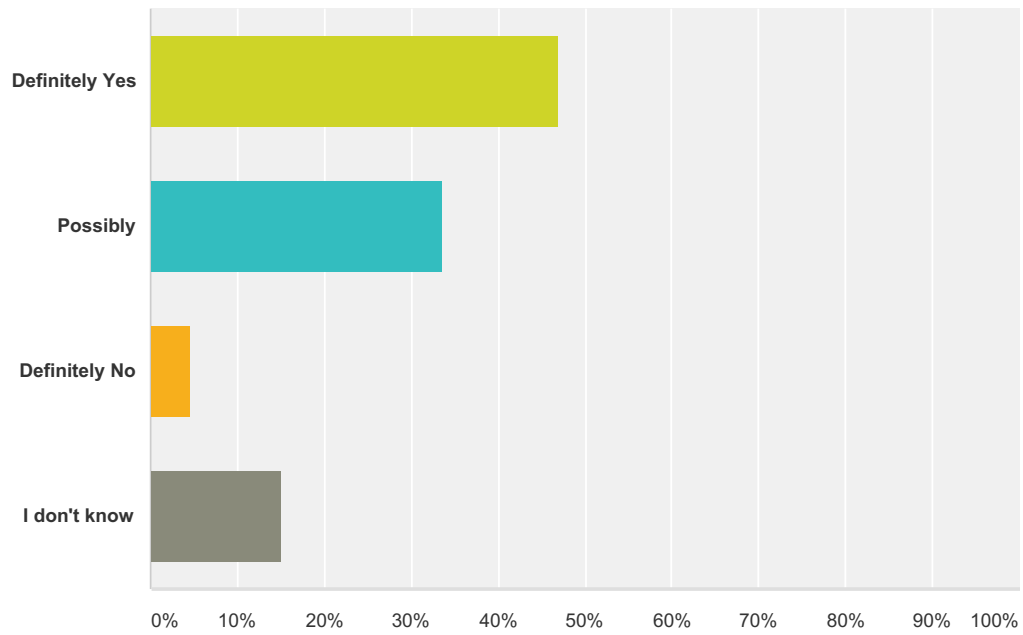

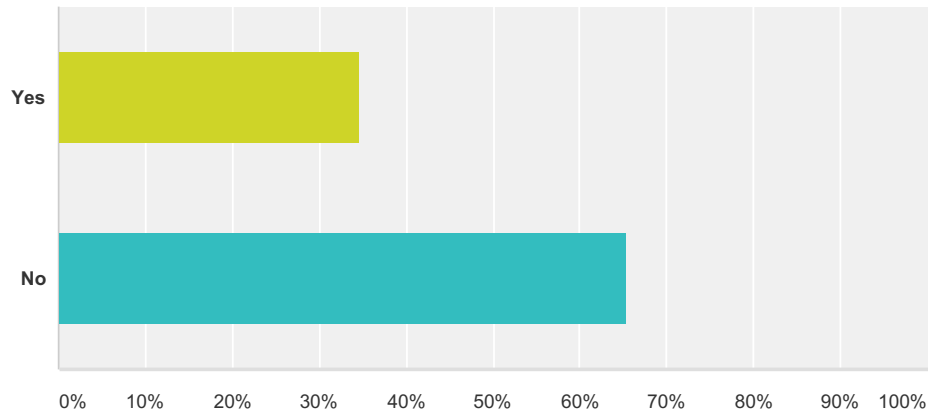

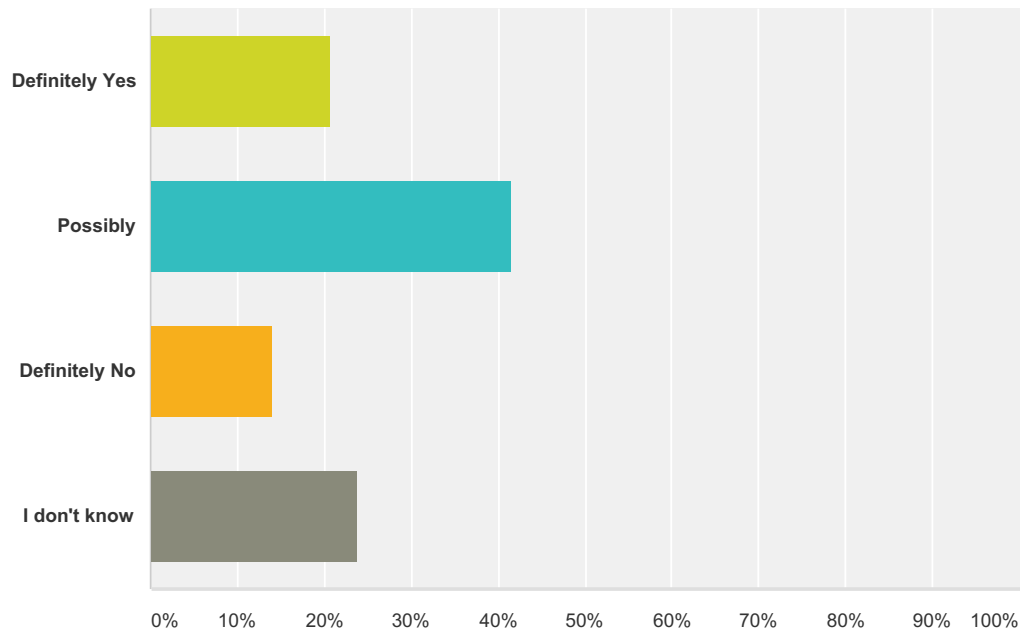

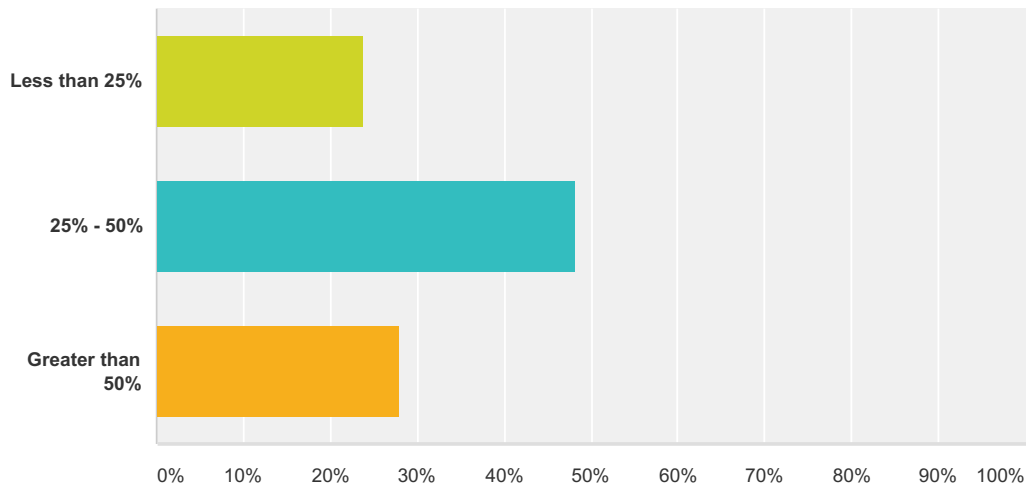

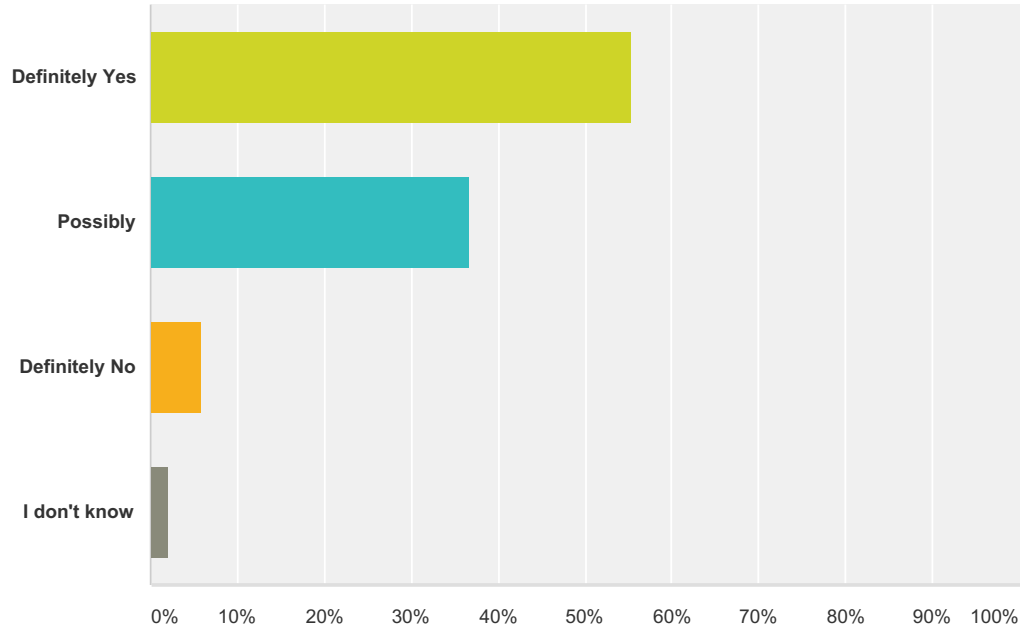

Q27 Are you concerned with the debt burden you may be faced with after college or higher education?

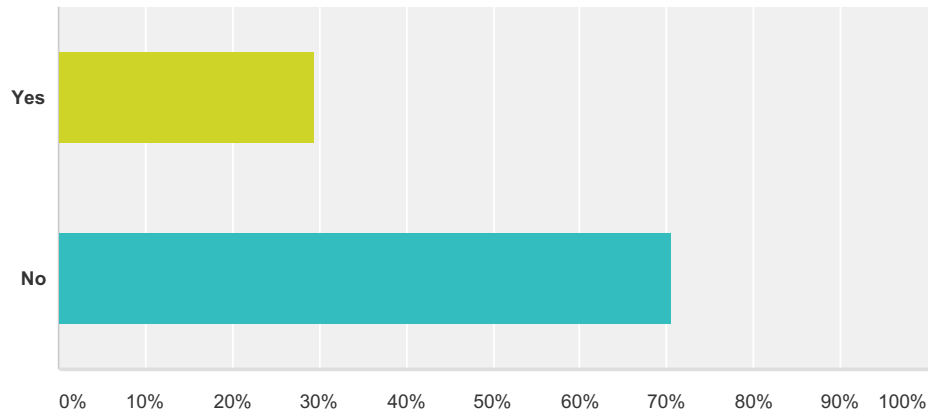

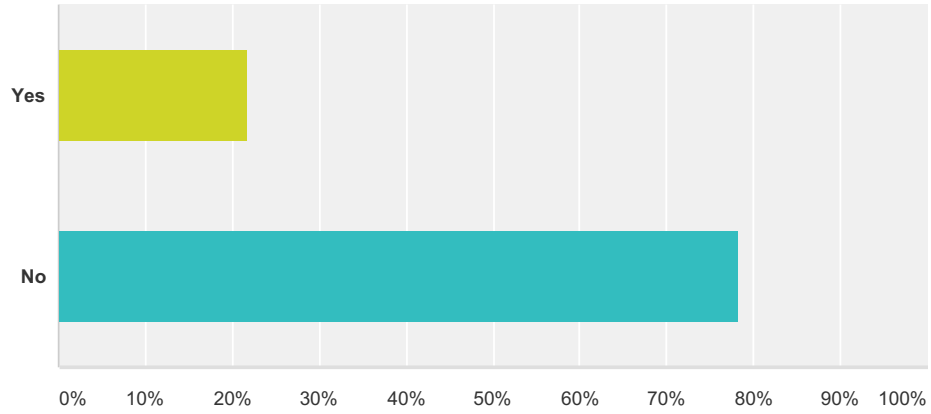

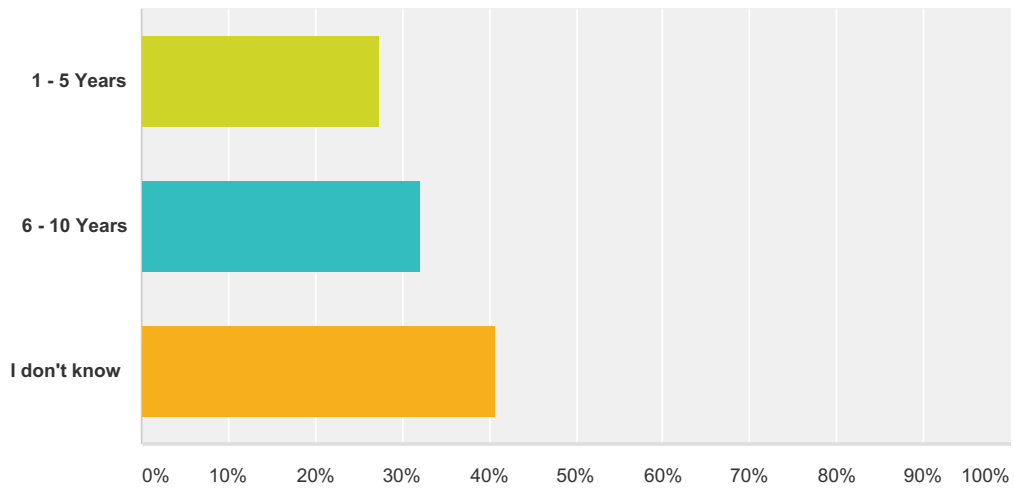

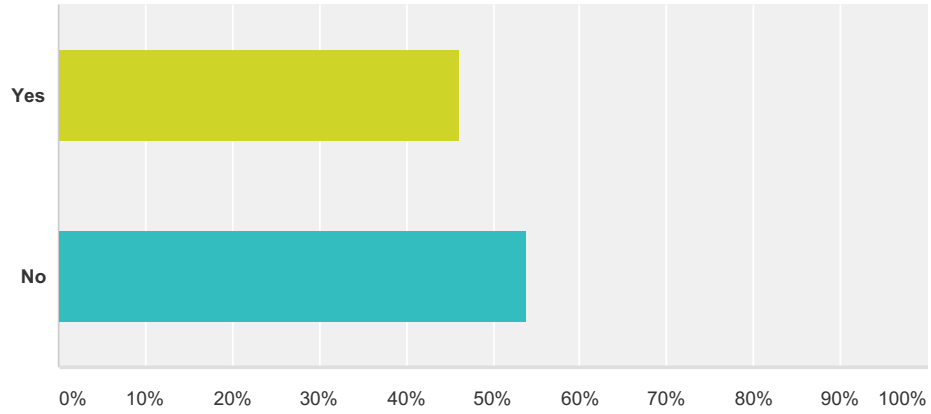

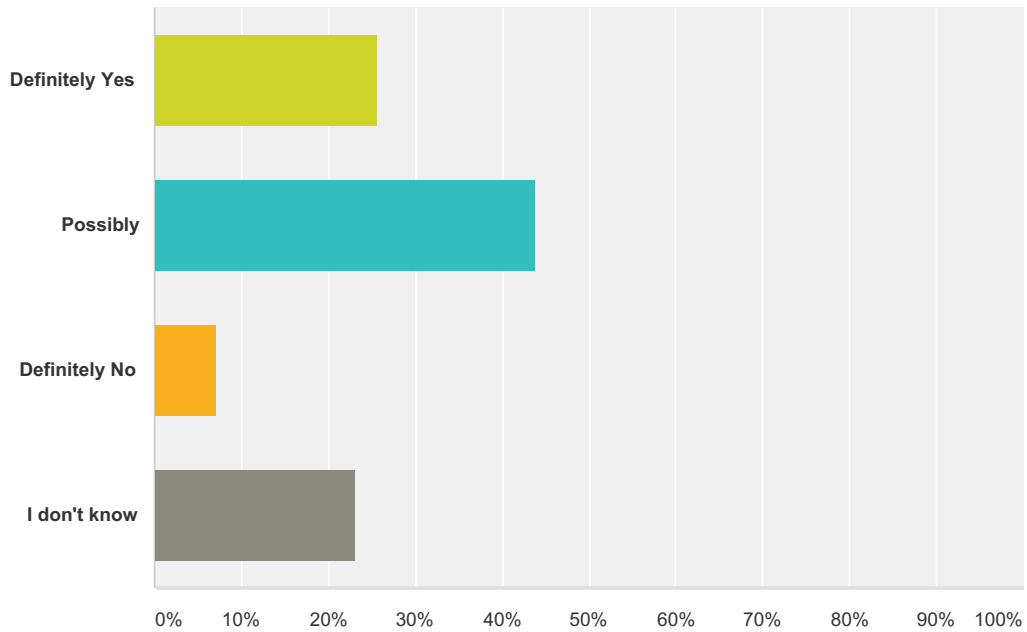

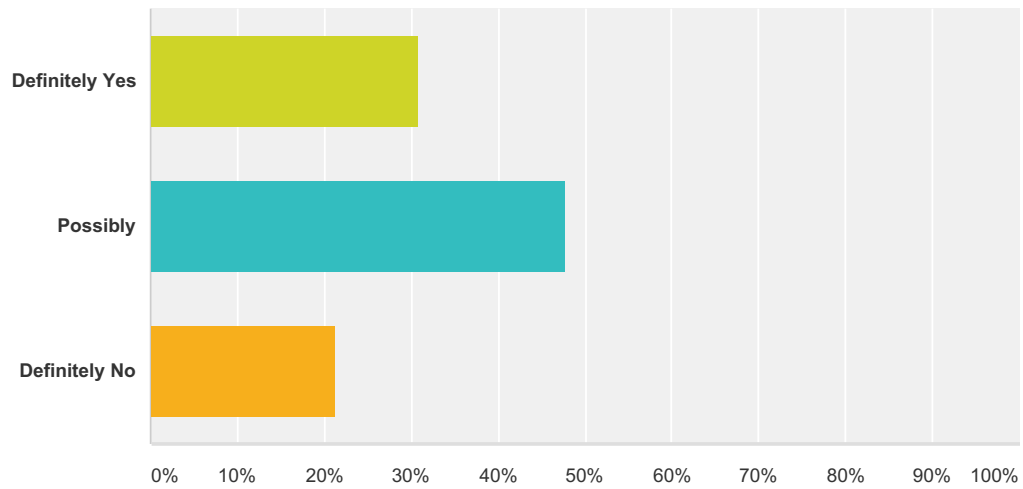

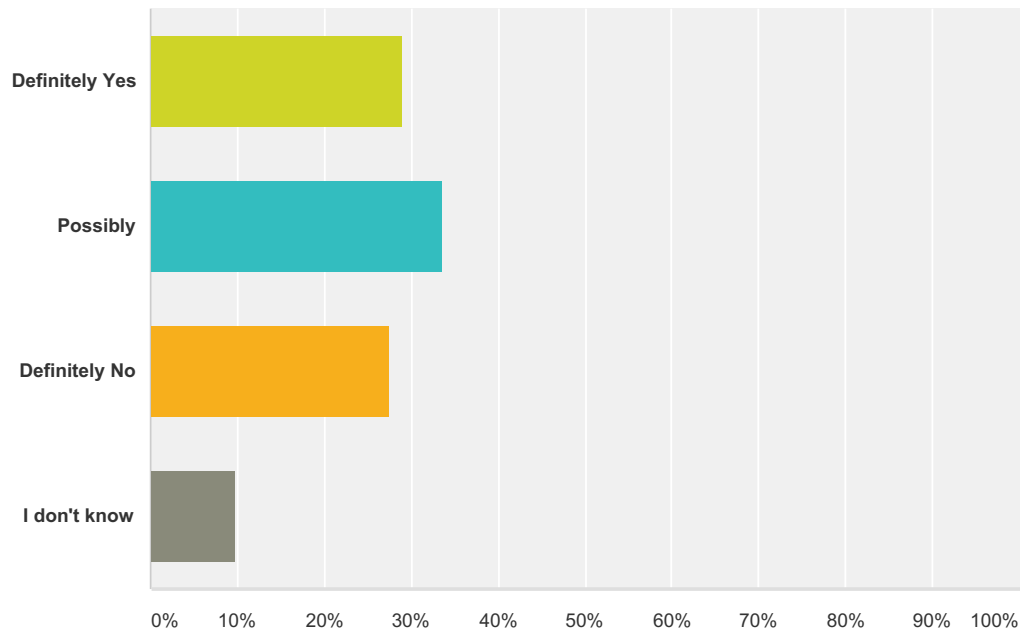

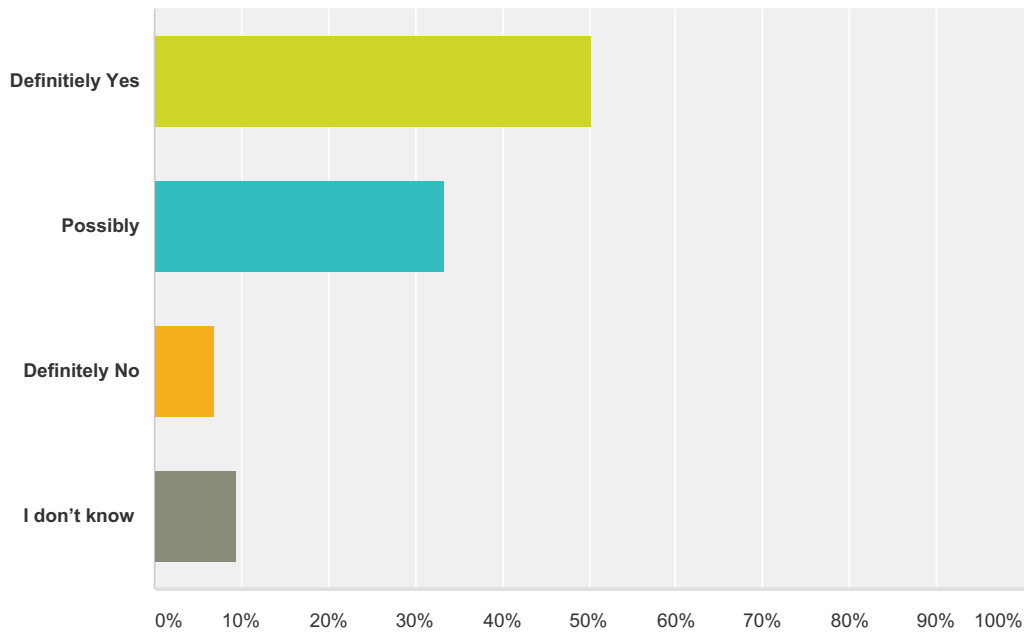

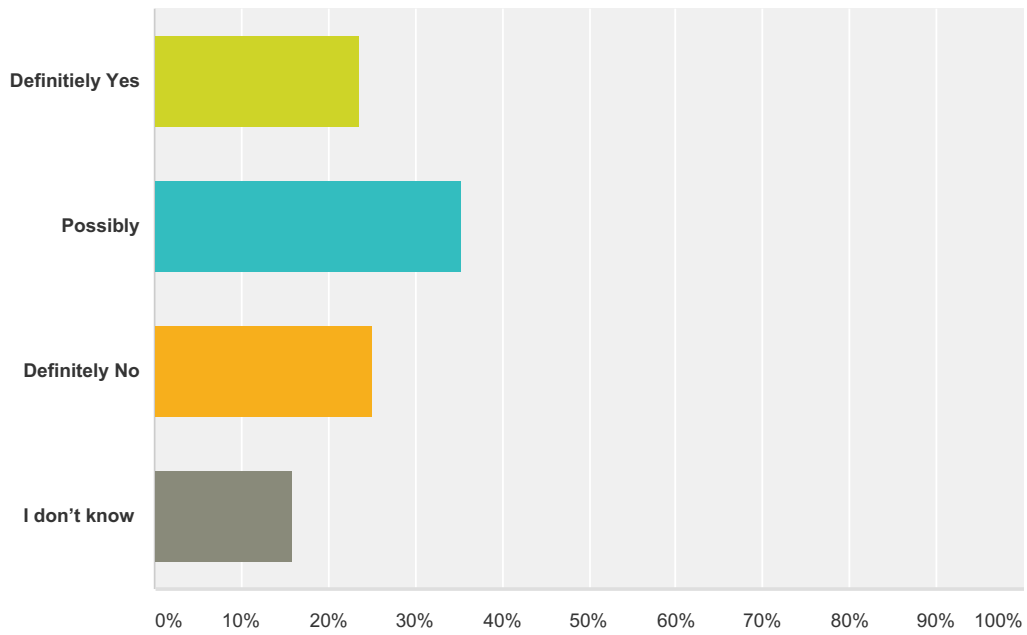

Q36 Have costs been a factor in deciding to attend college part-time versus full-time?

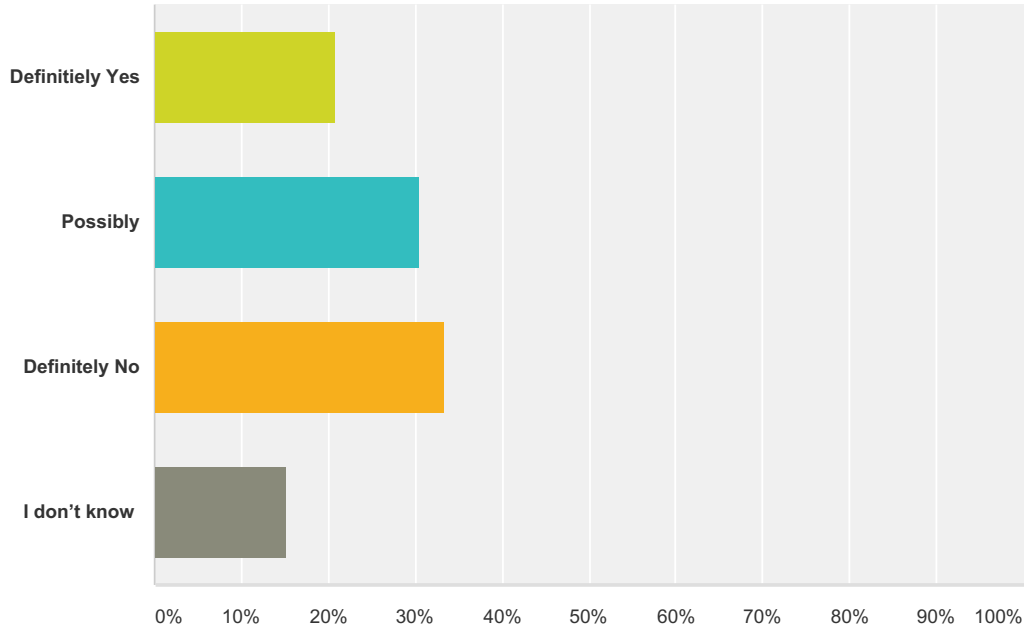

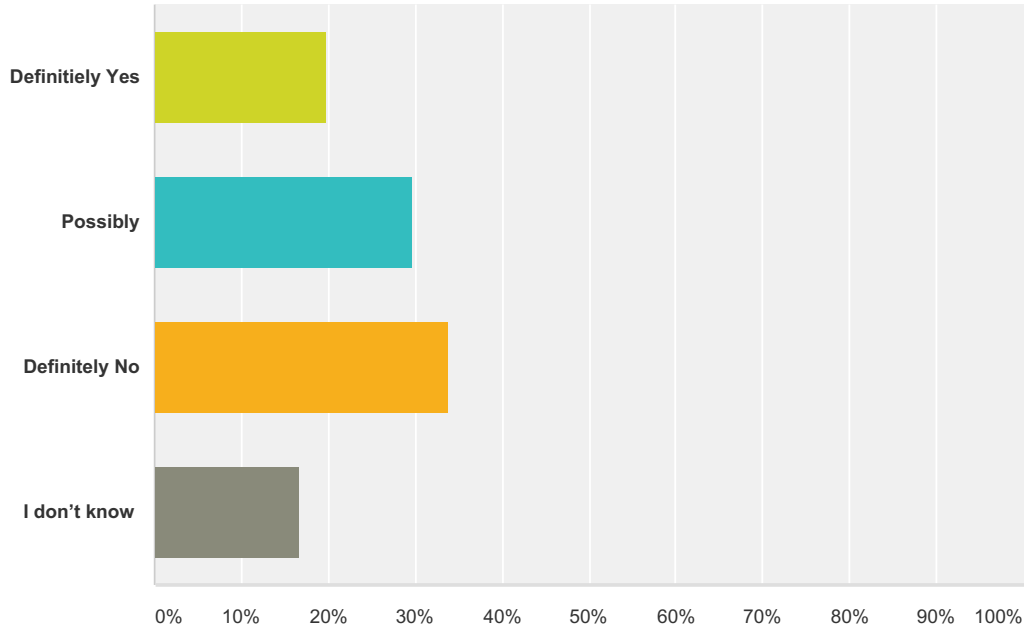

Q38 Have costs been a factor in choosing your major (i.e. picking a major because it has a higher starting salary)?

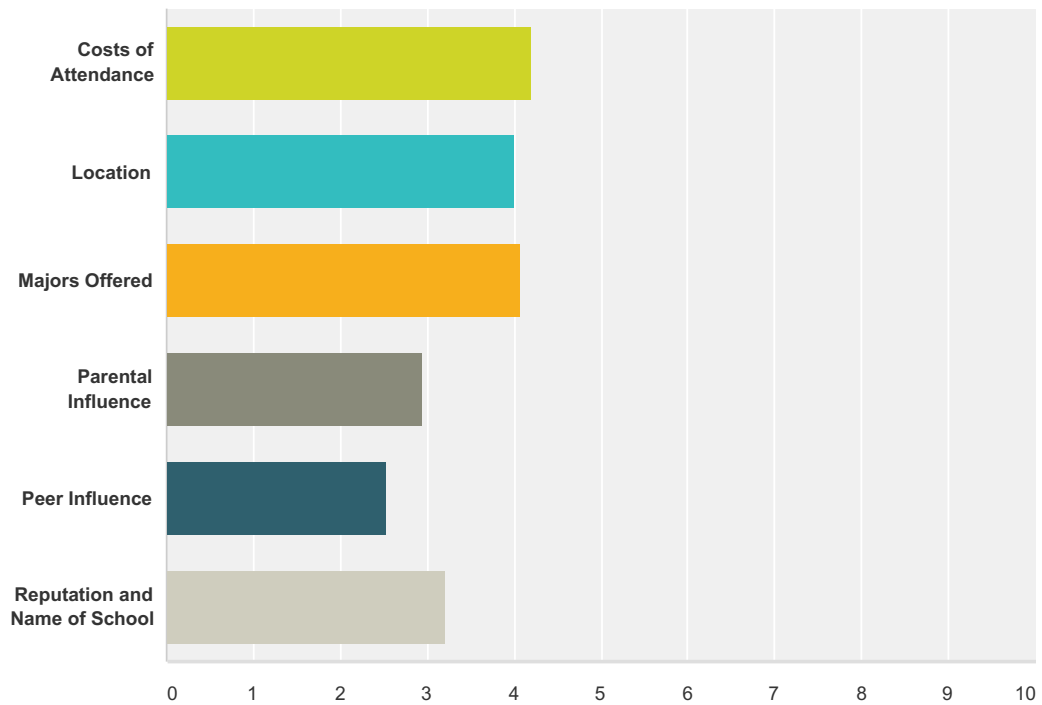

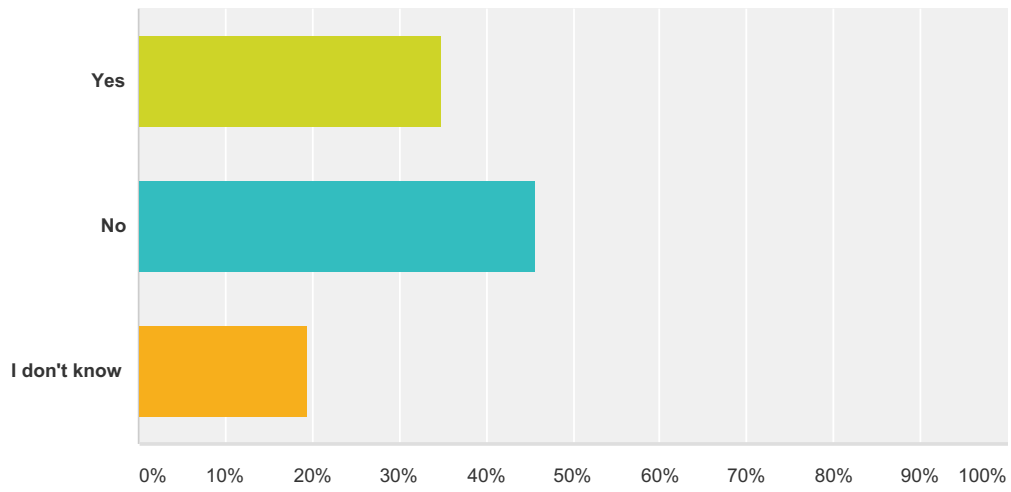

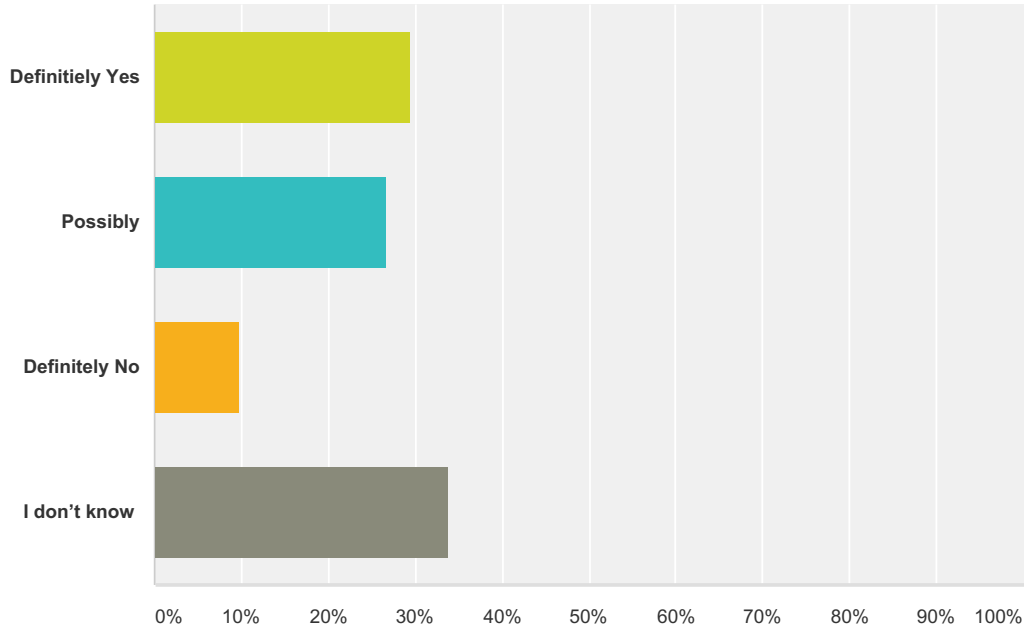

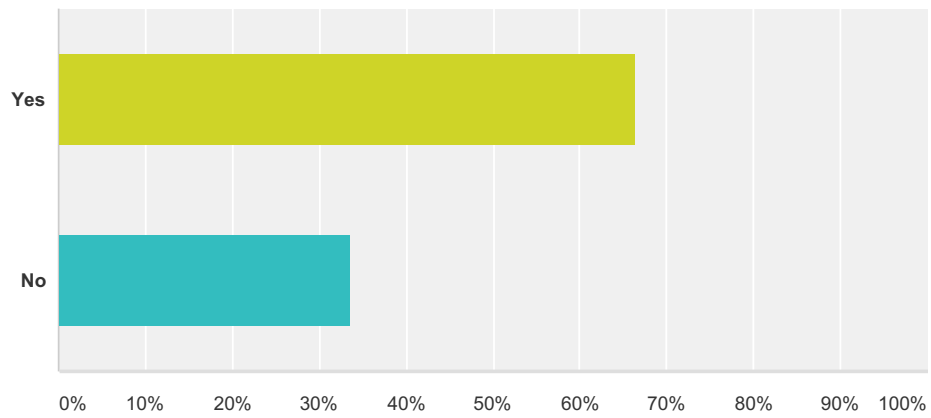

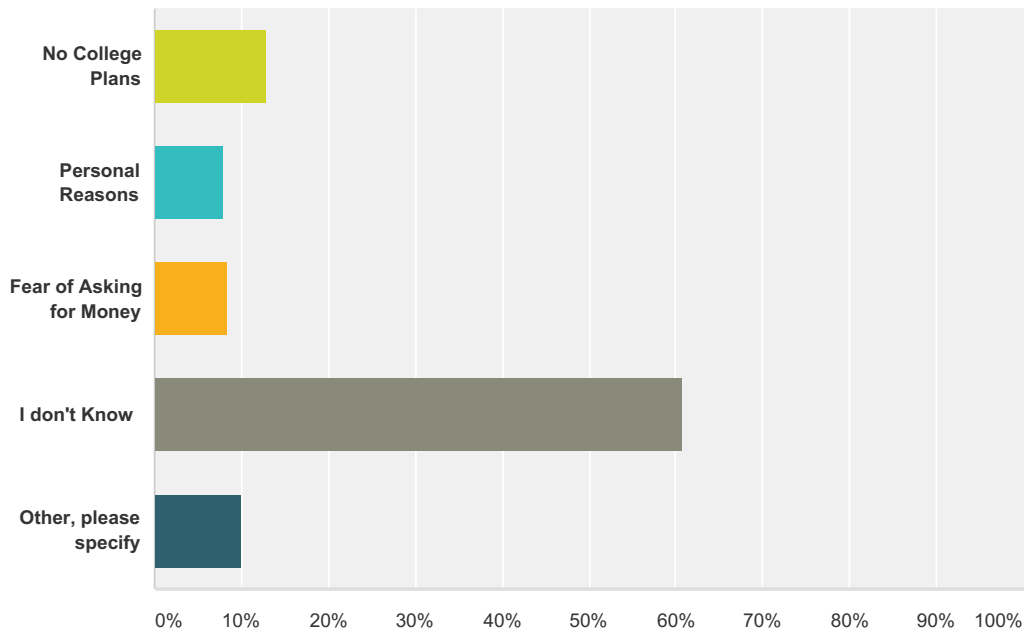

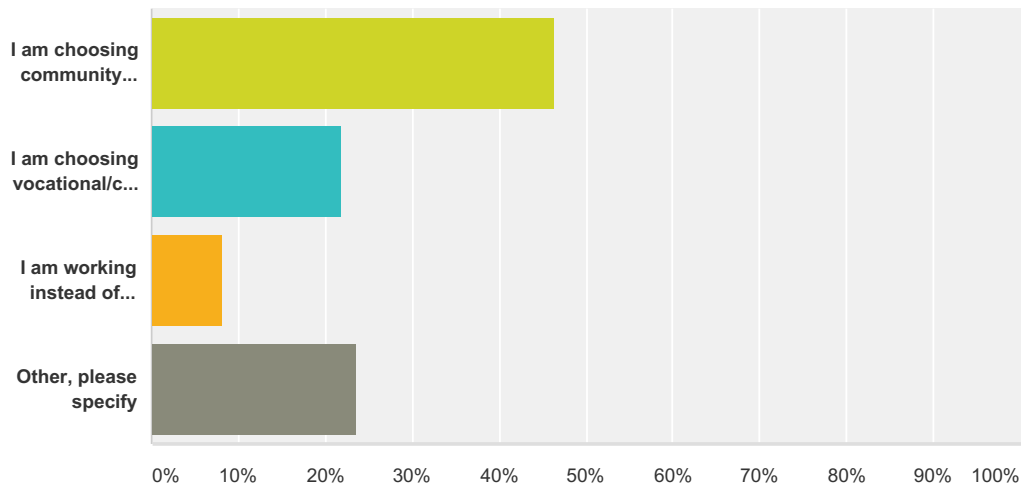

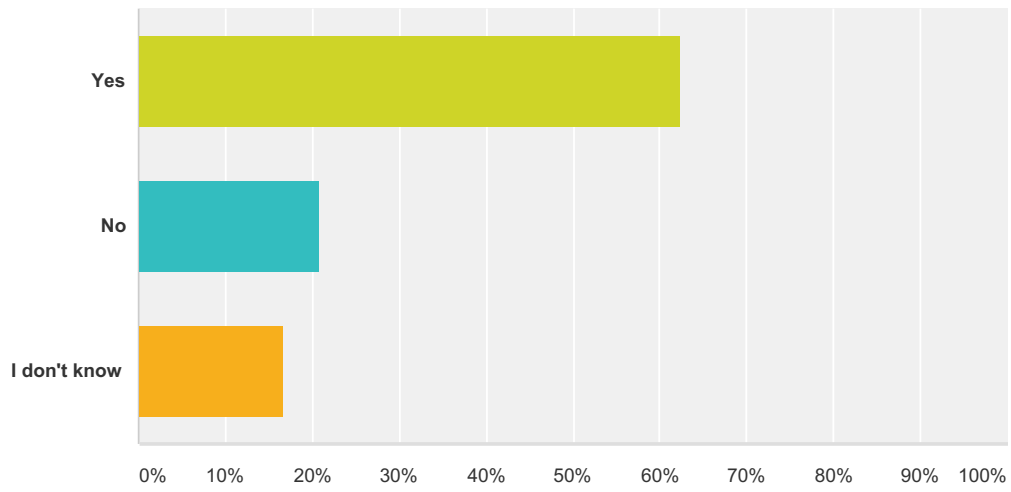

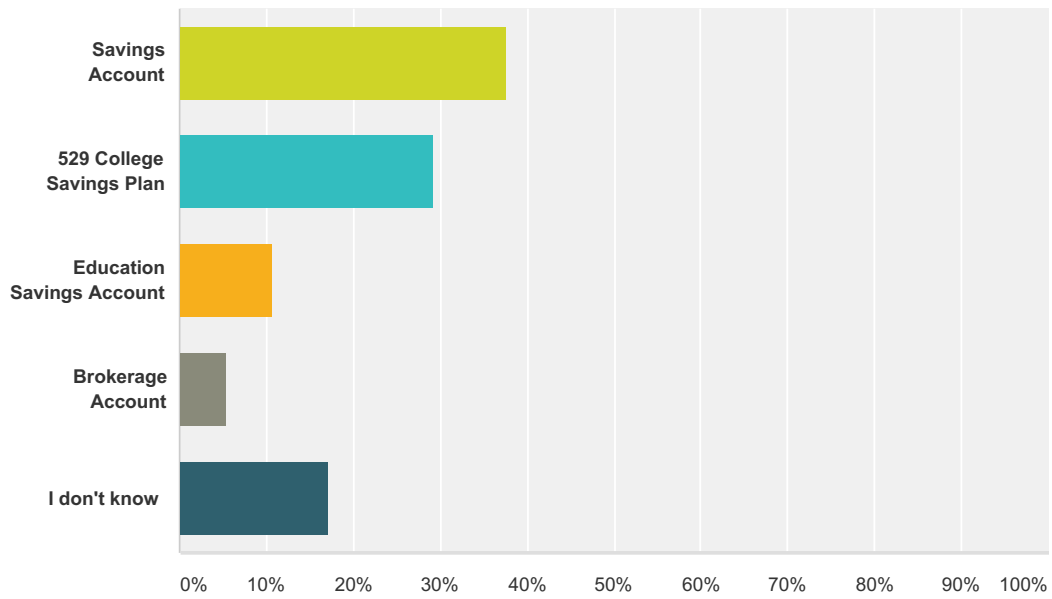

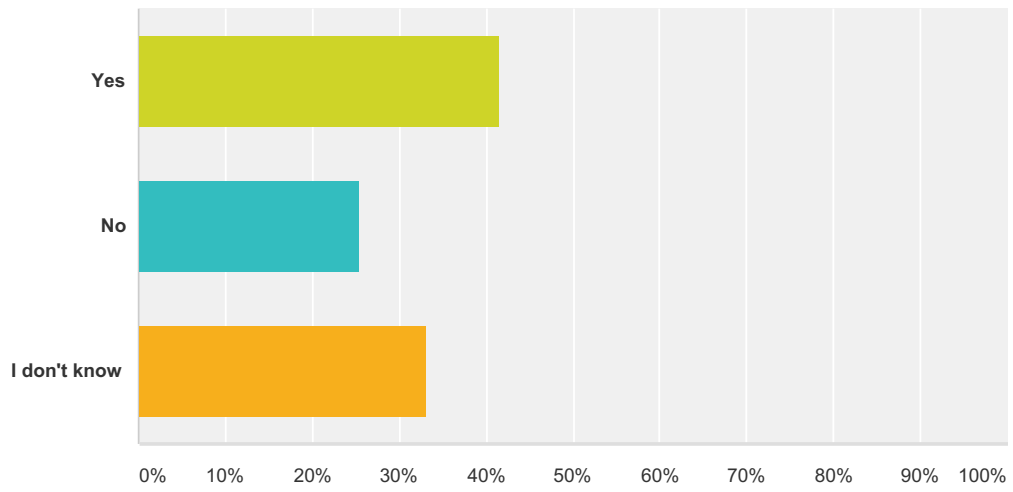

Q49 Are they saving a fixed amount per month?

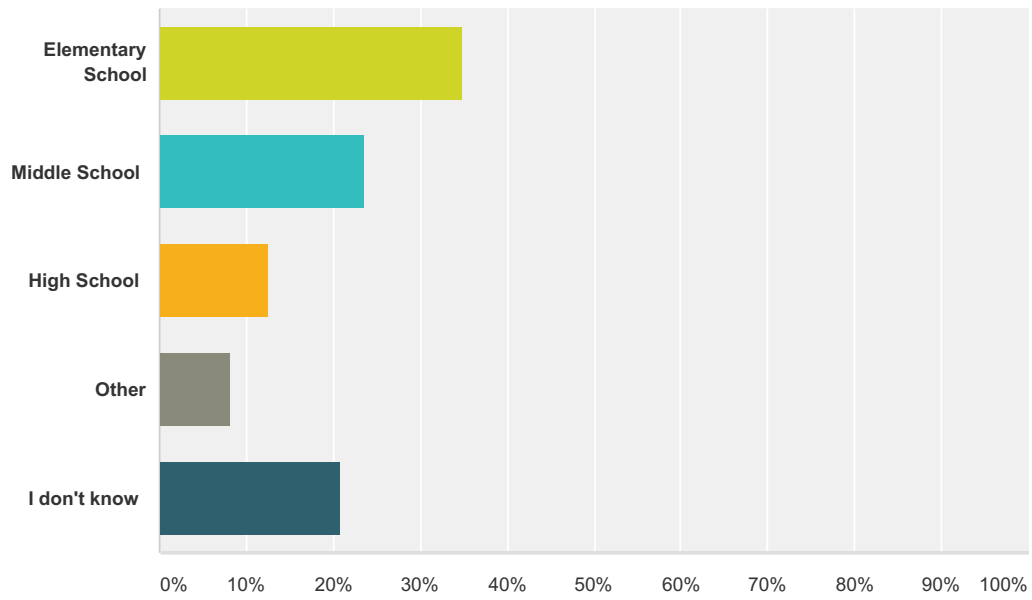

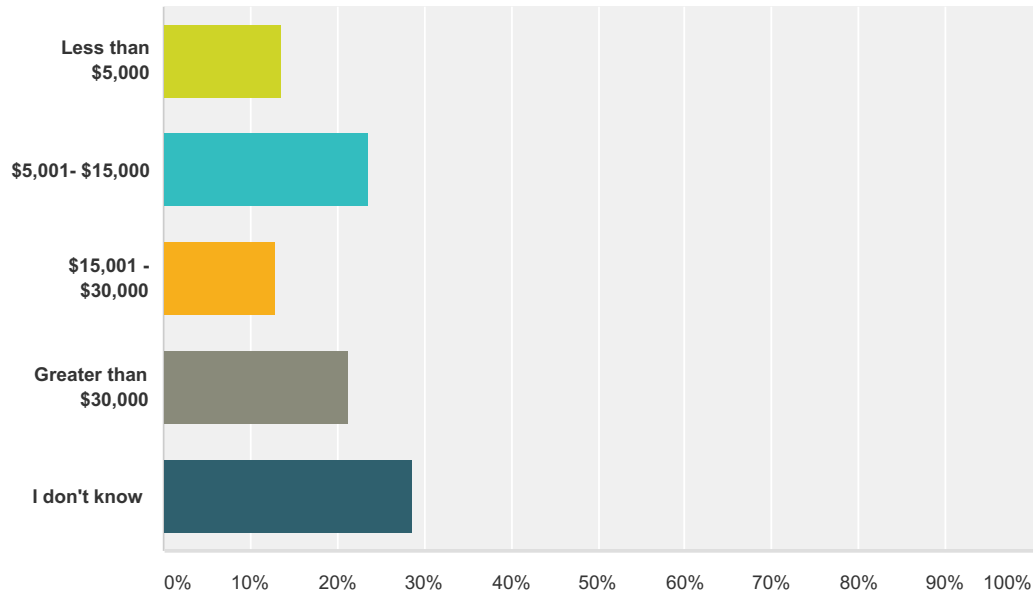

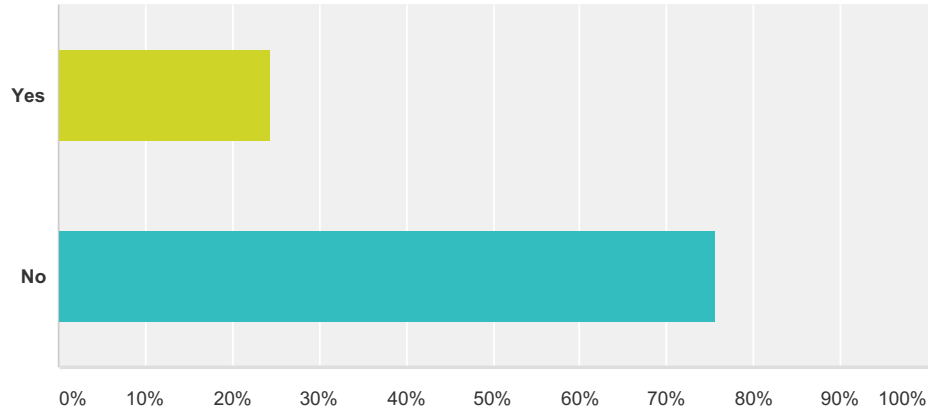

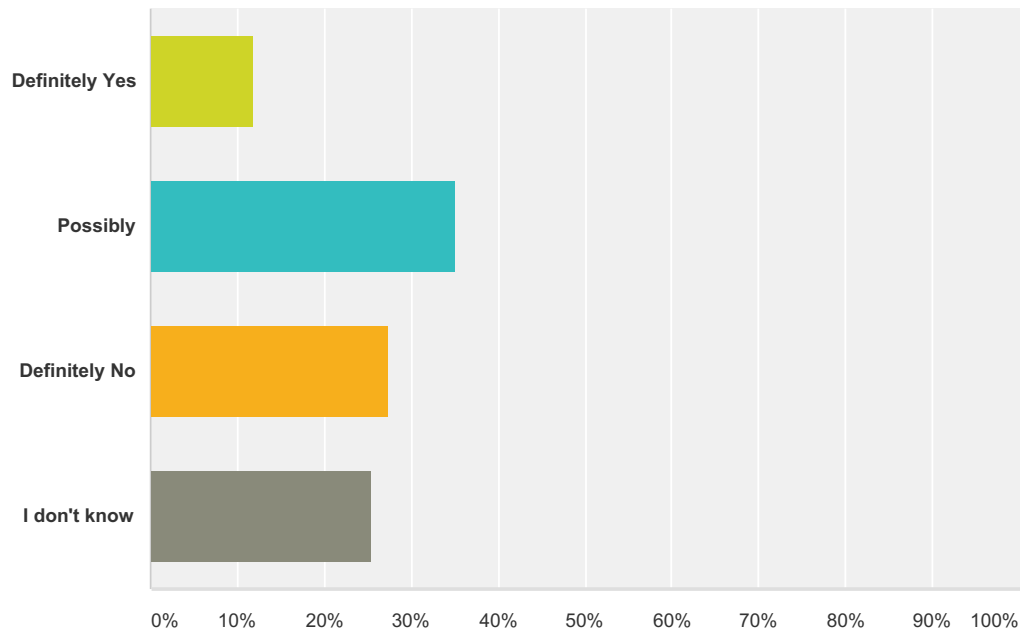

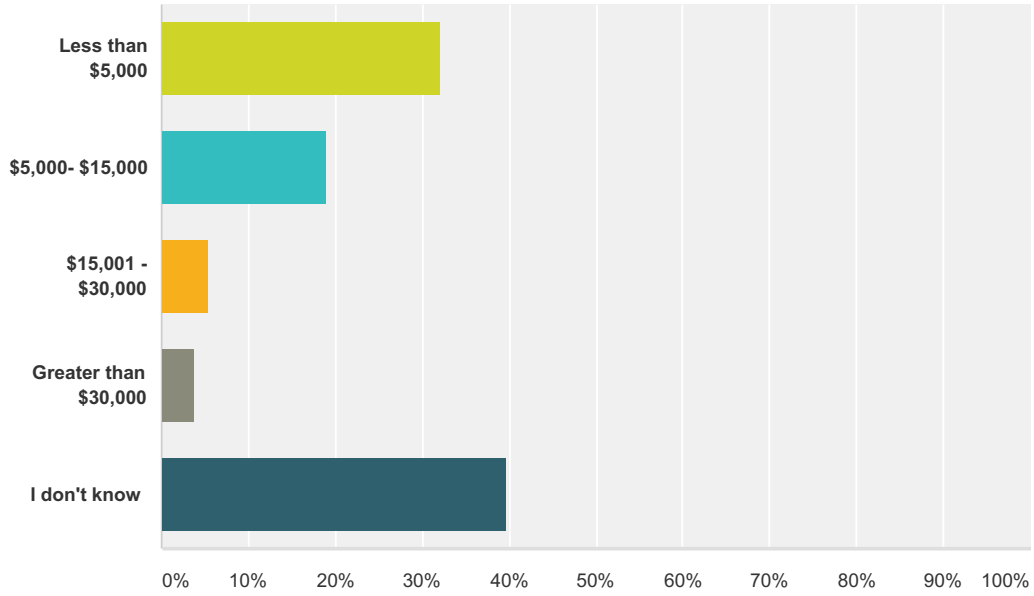

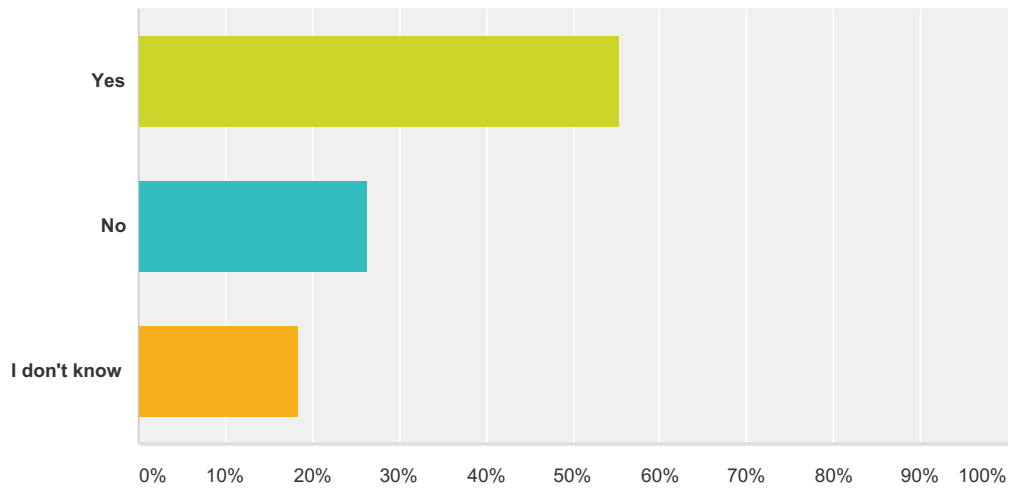

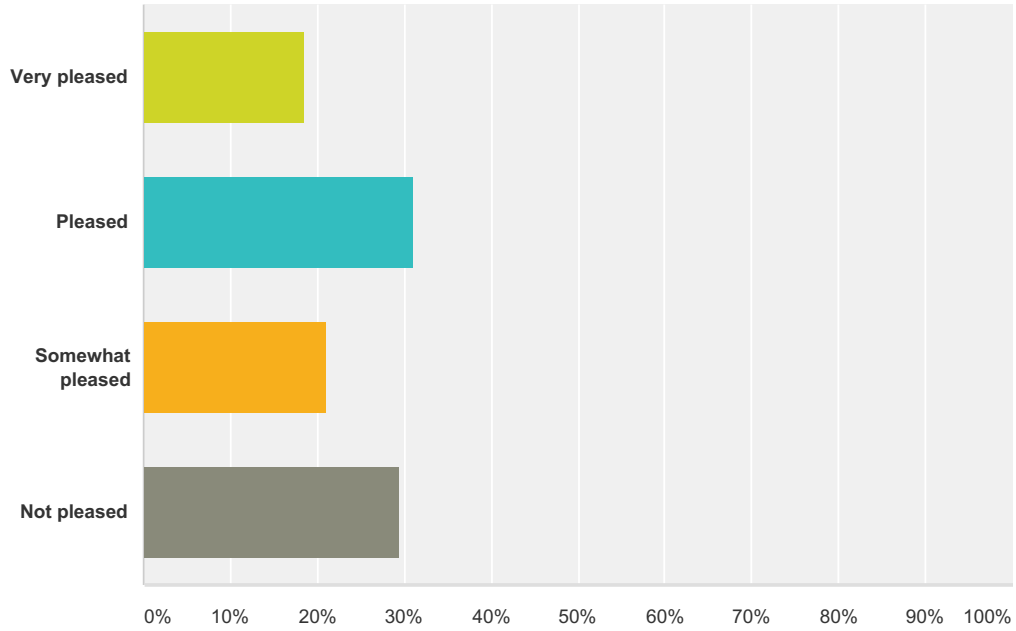

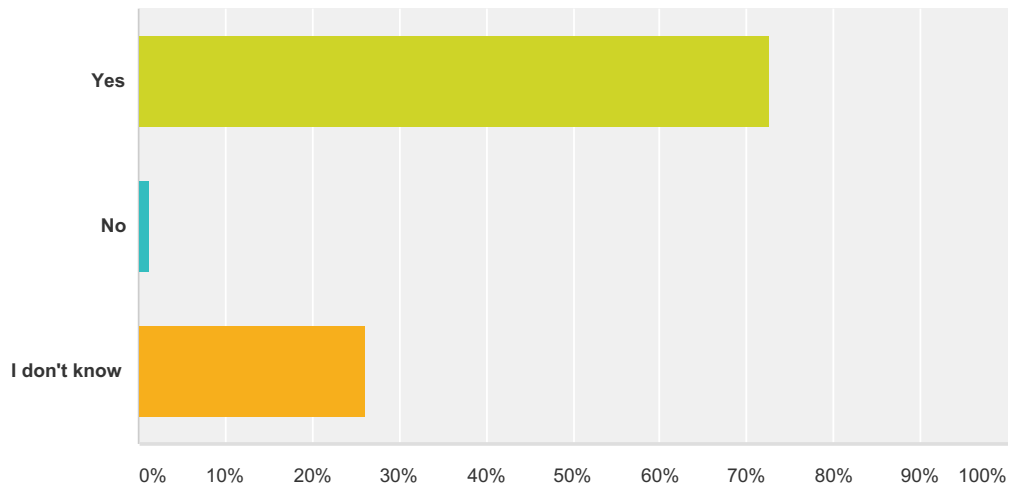

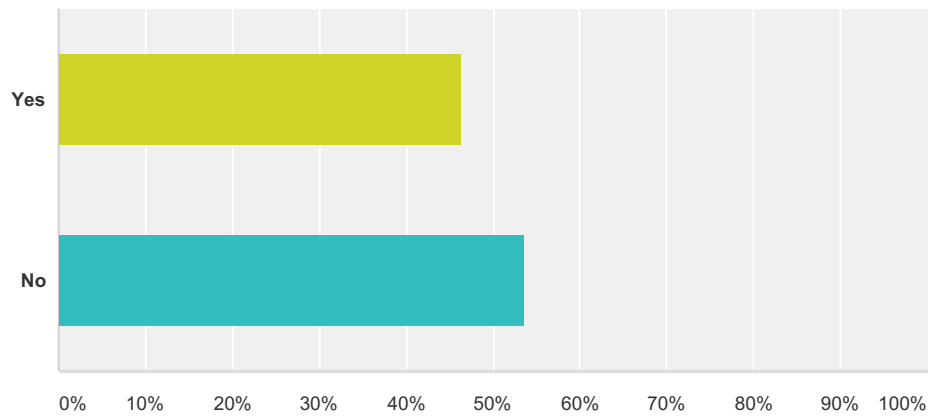

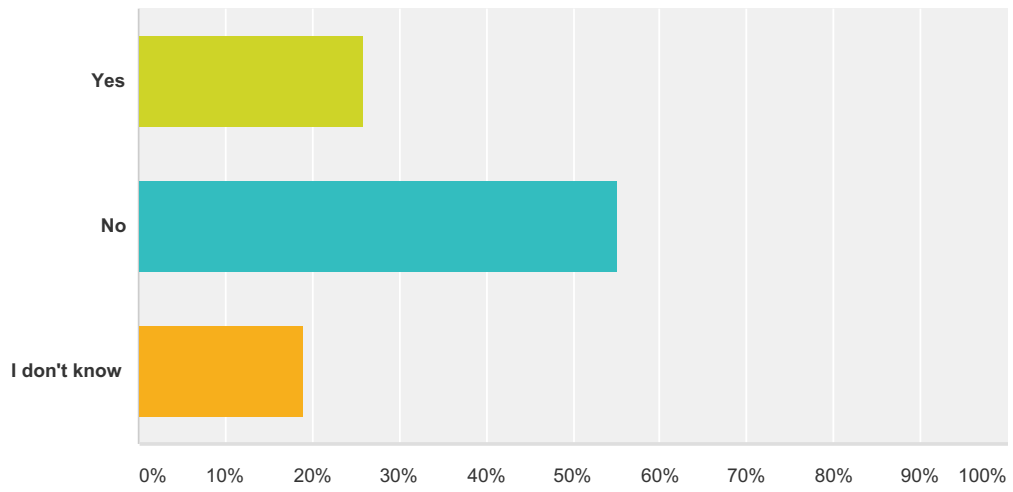

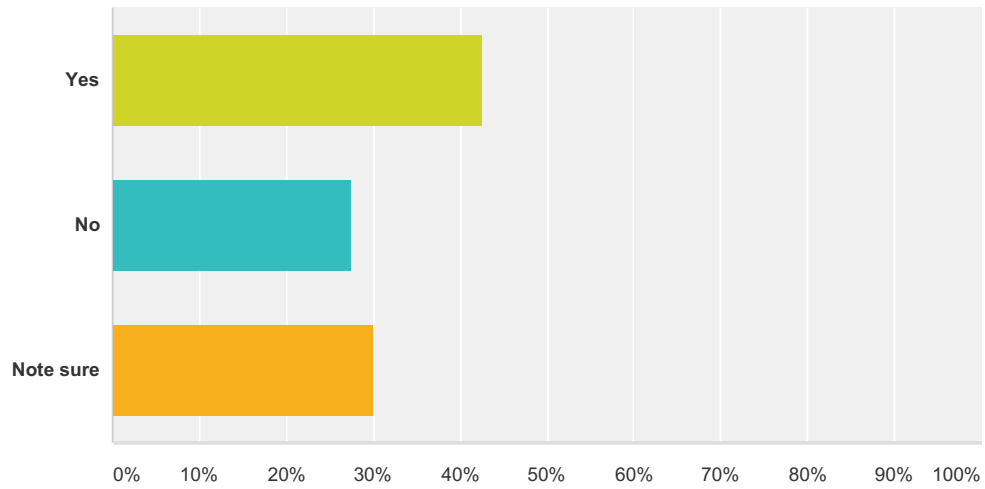

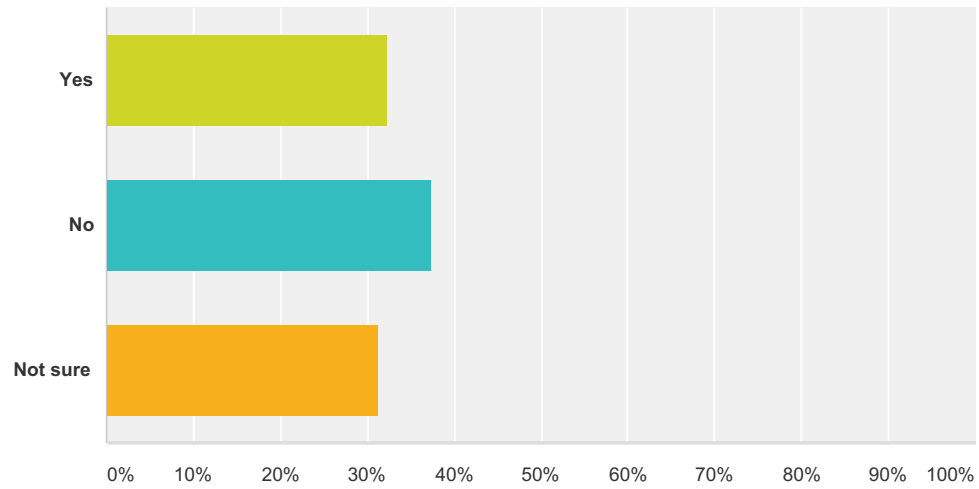

Q61 Do you feel that your current high school has prepared you to adequately prepare for future college costs?

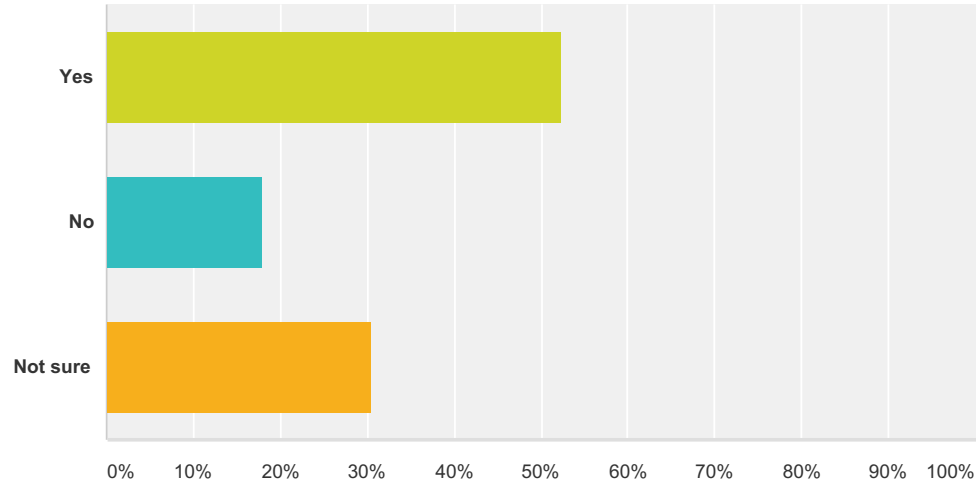

Q62 Do you wish that your current high school offered financial literacy to you and your family to prepare you for college costs?

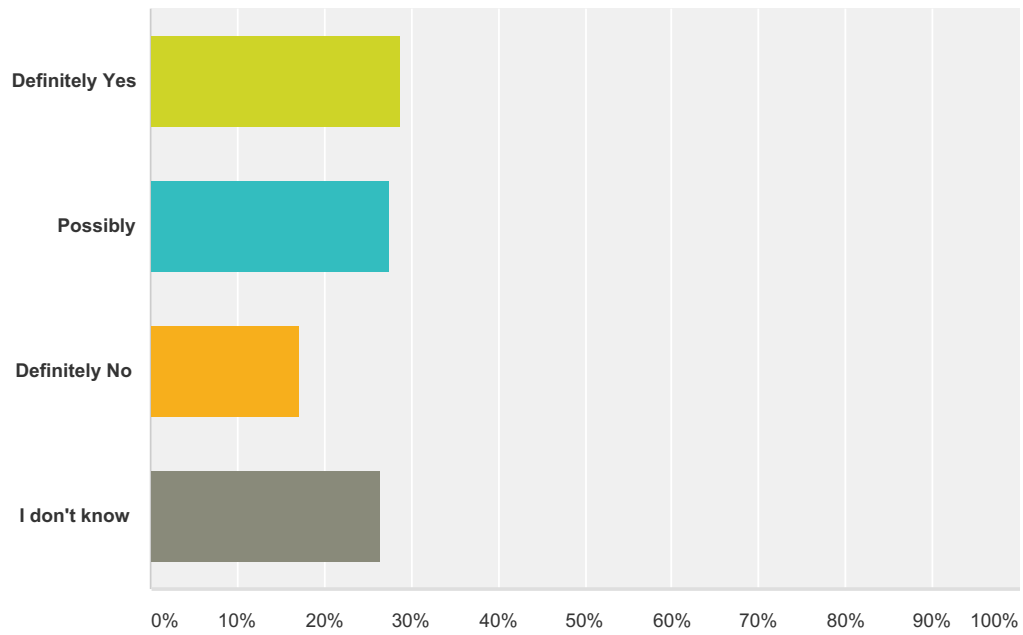

Q63 Have your college savings been affected by the current market conditions?

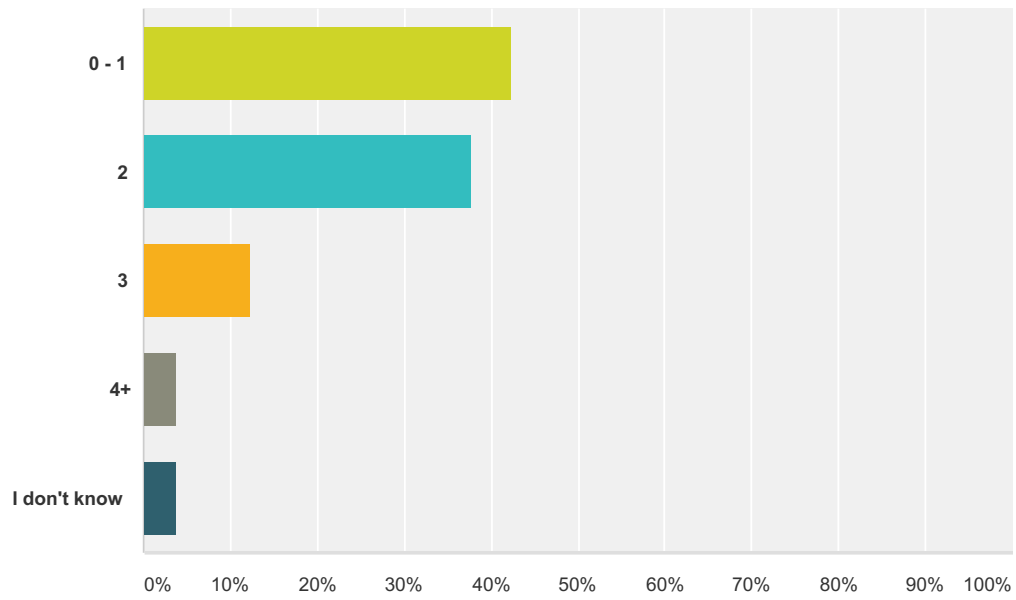

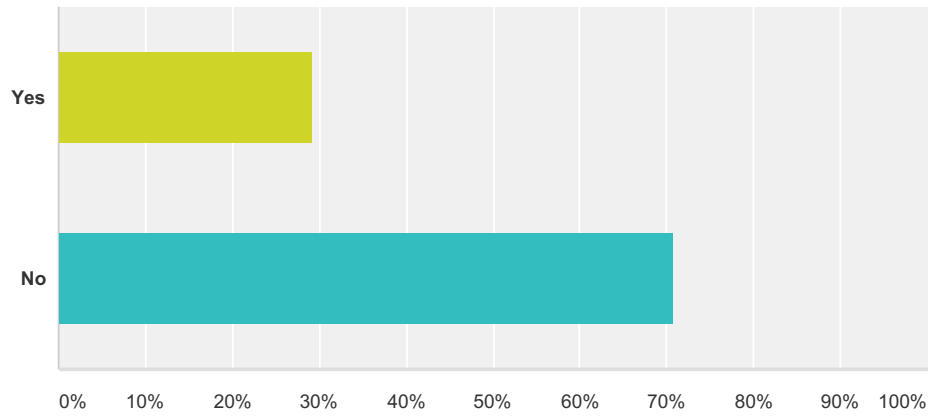
