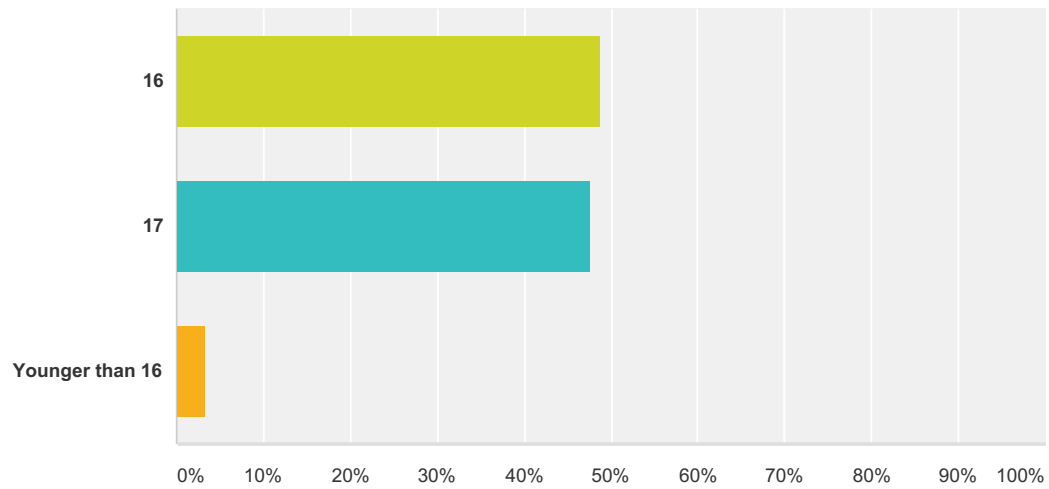

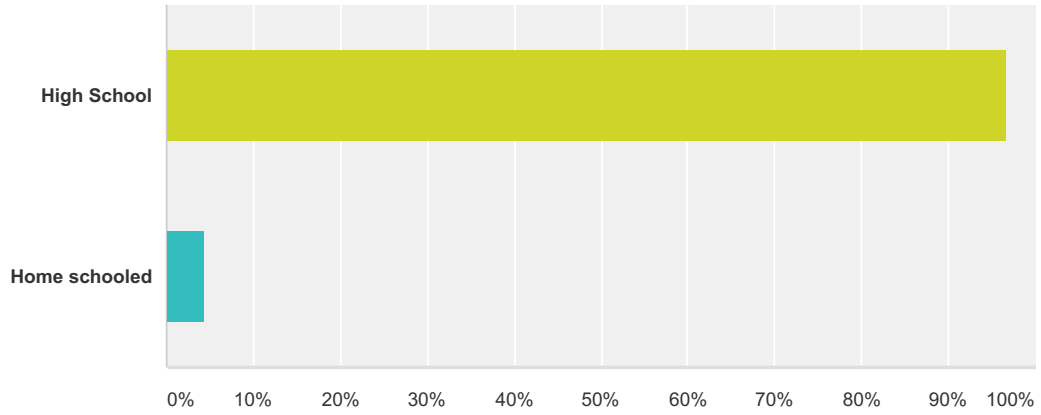

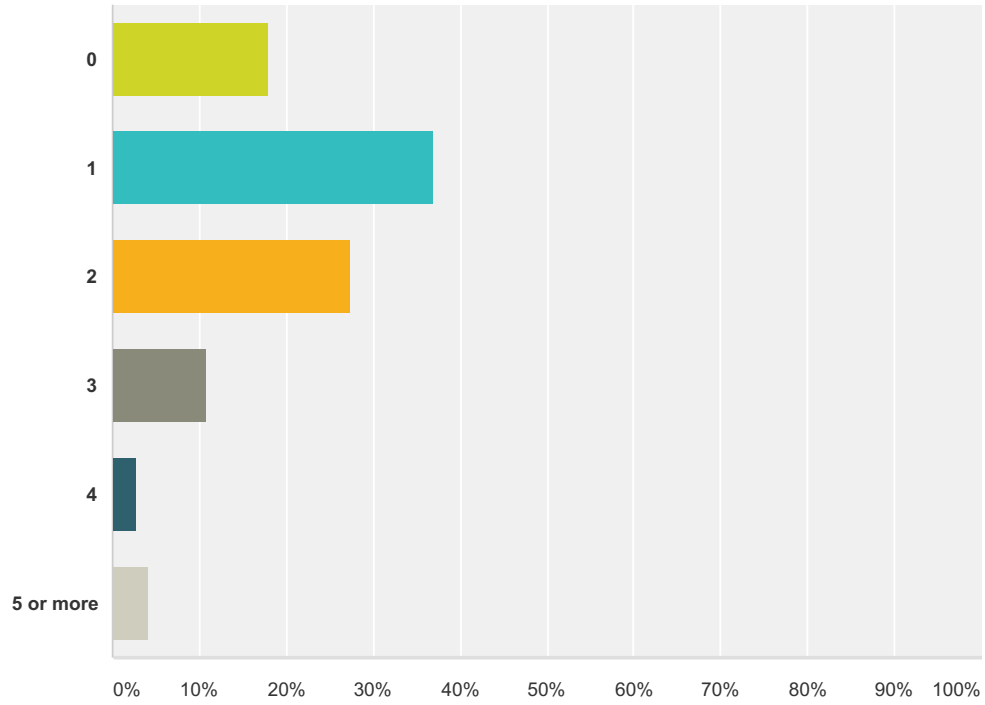

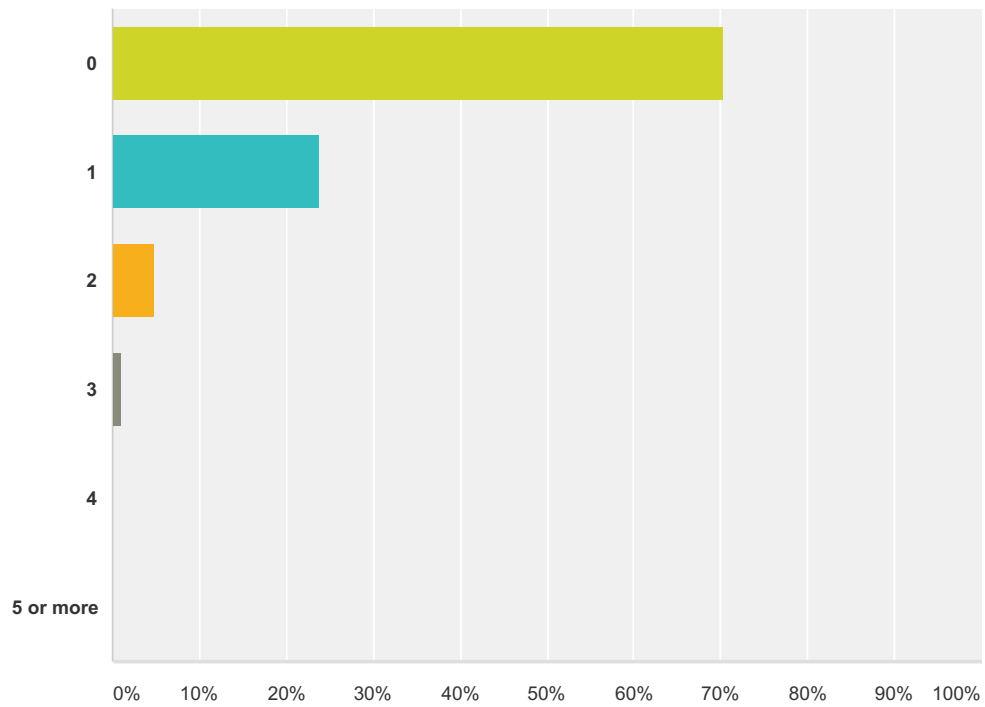

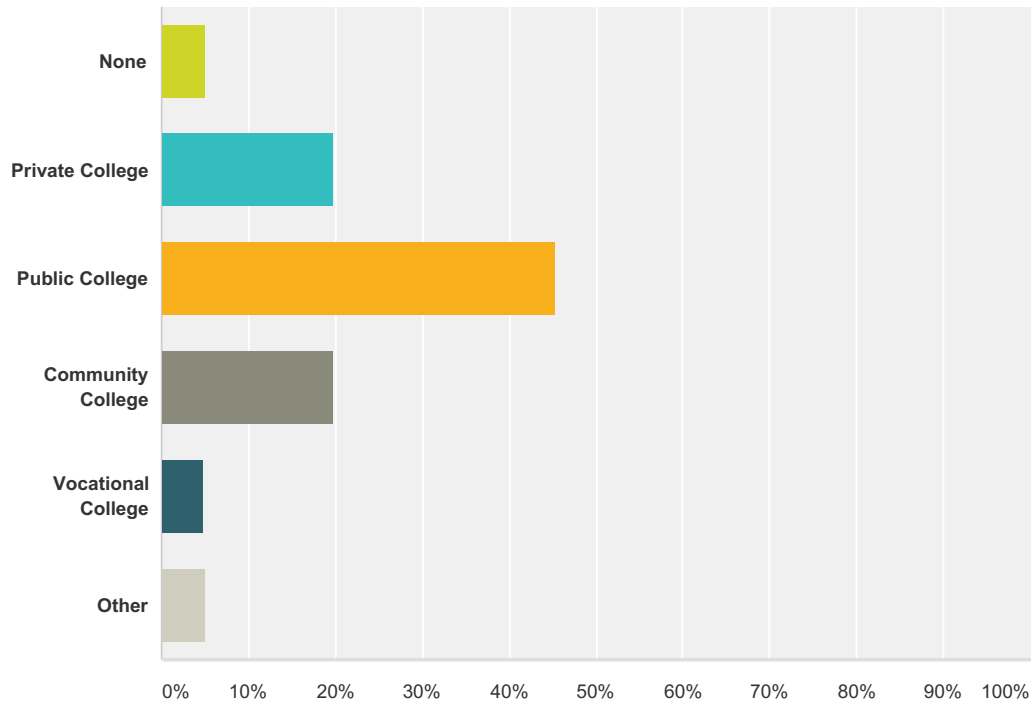

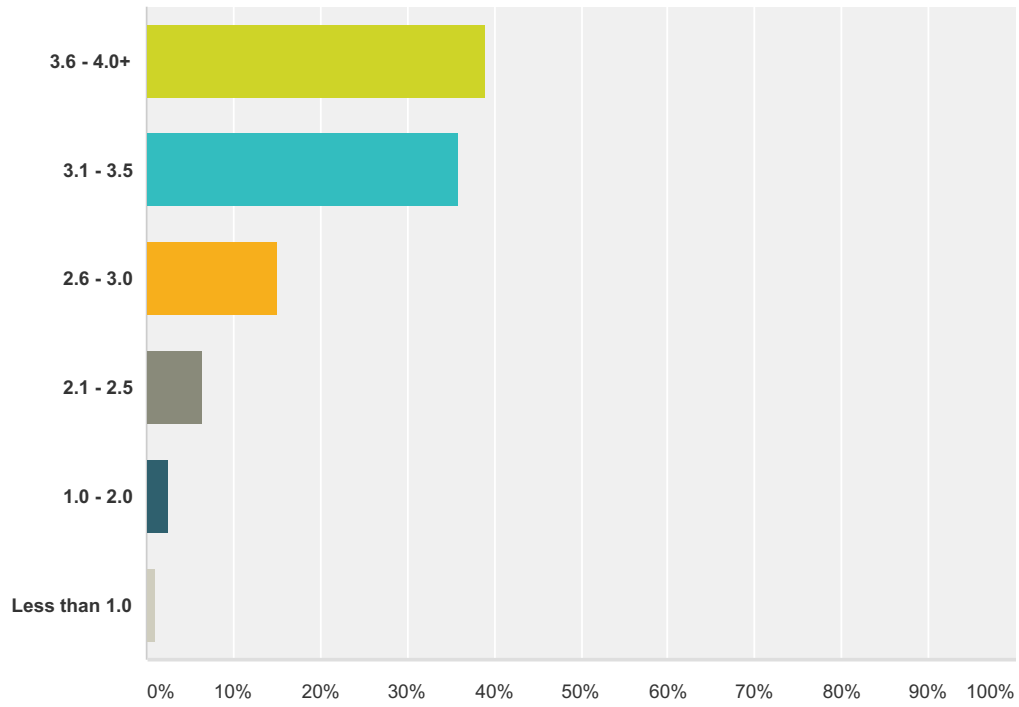

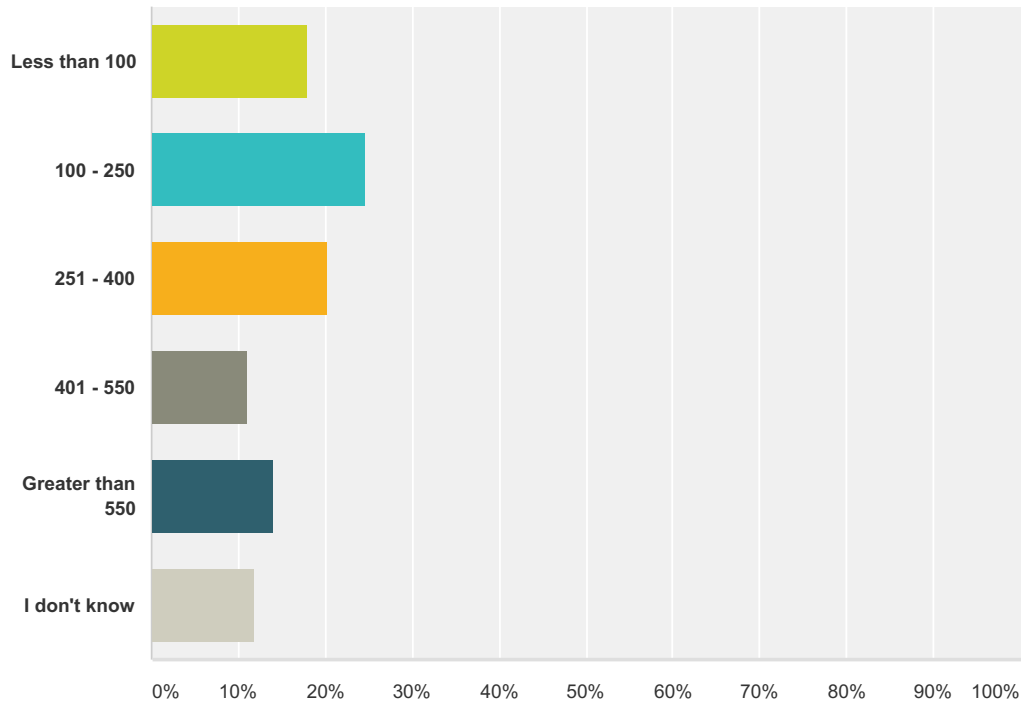

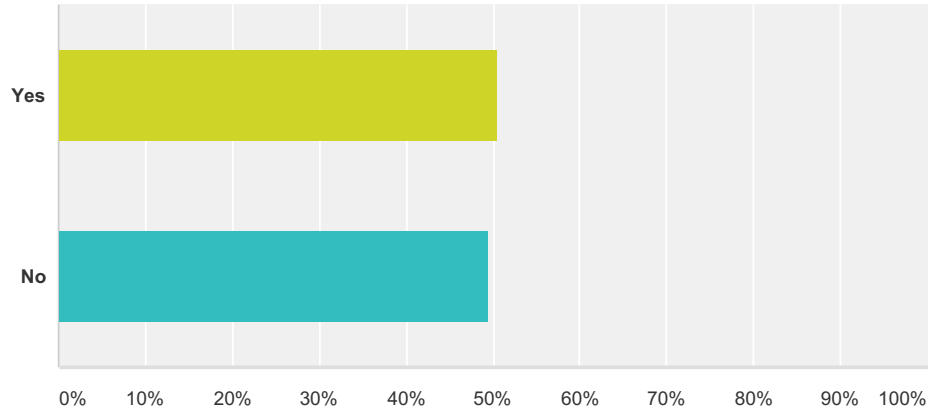

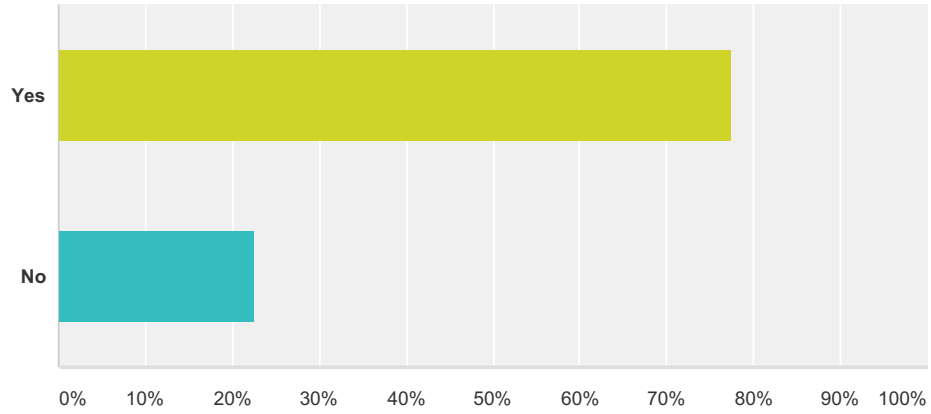

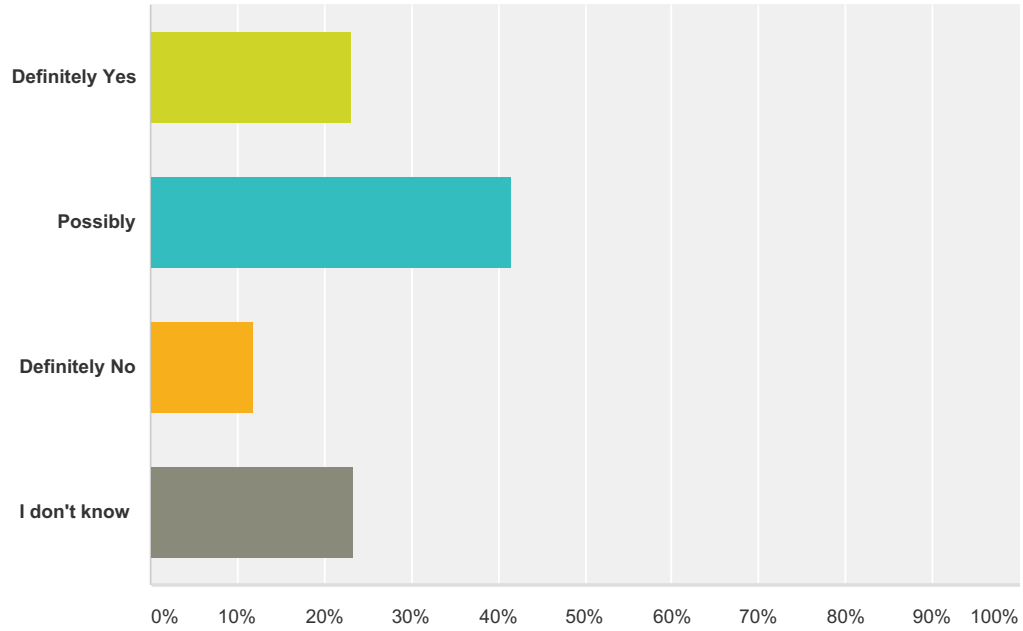

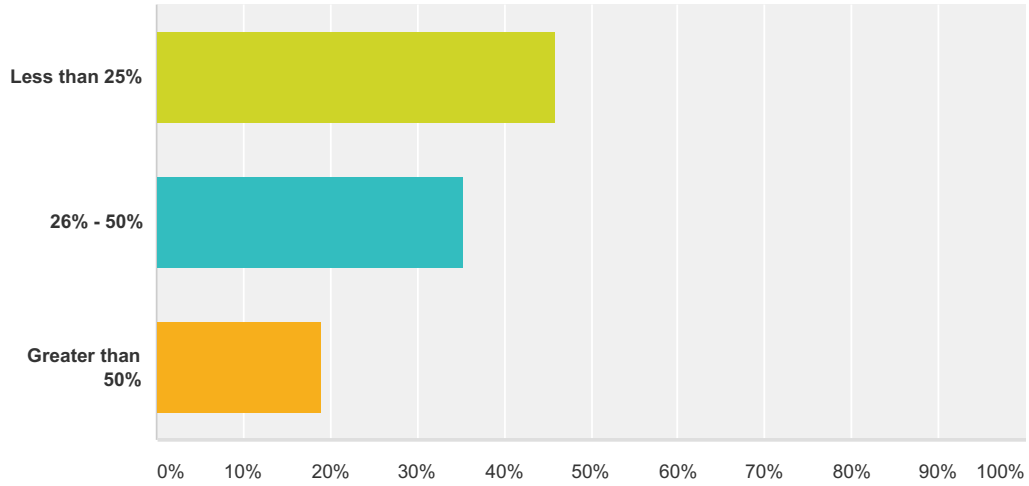

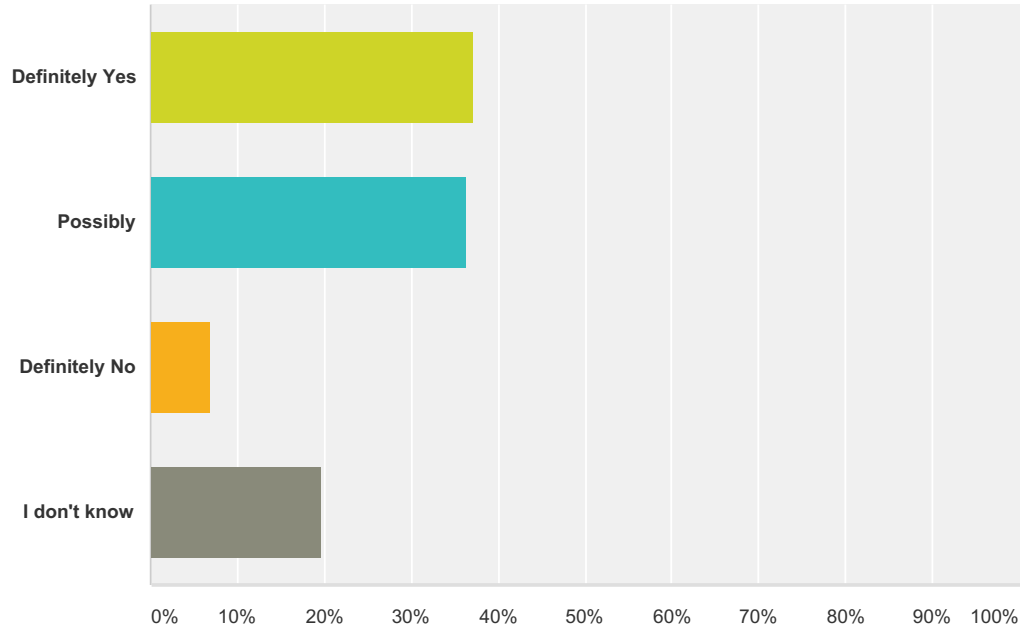

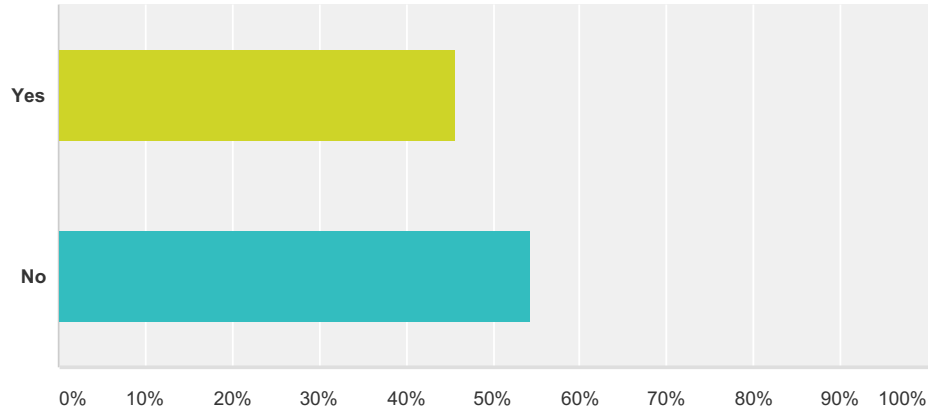

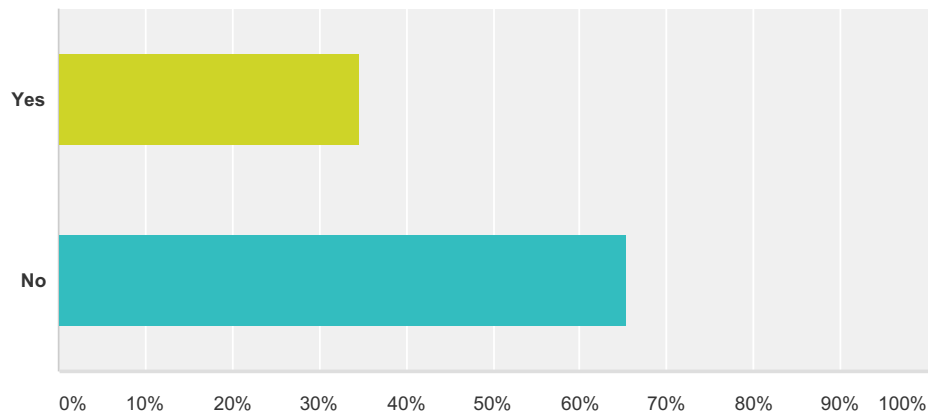

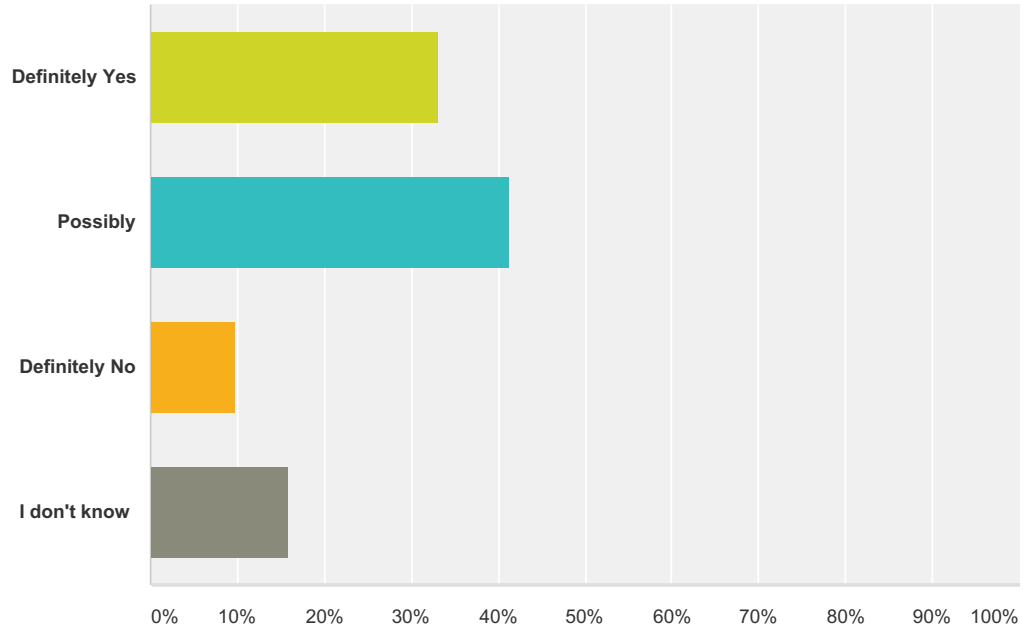

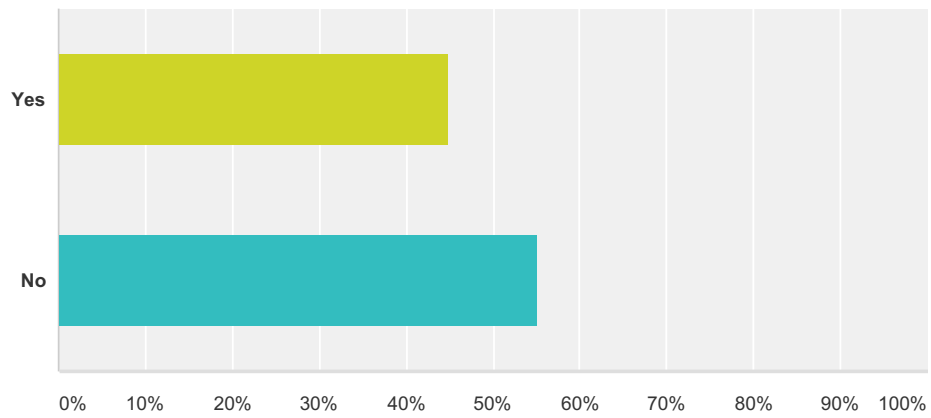

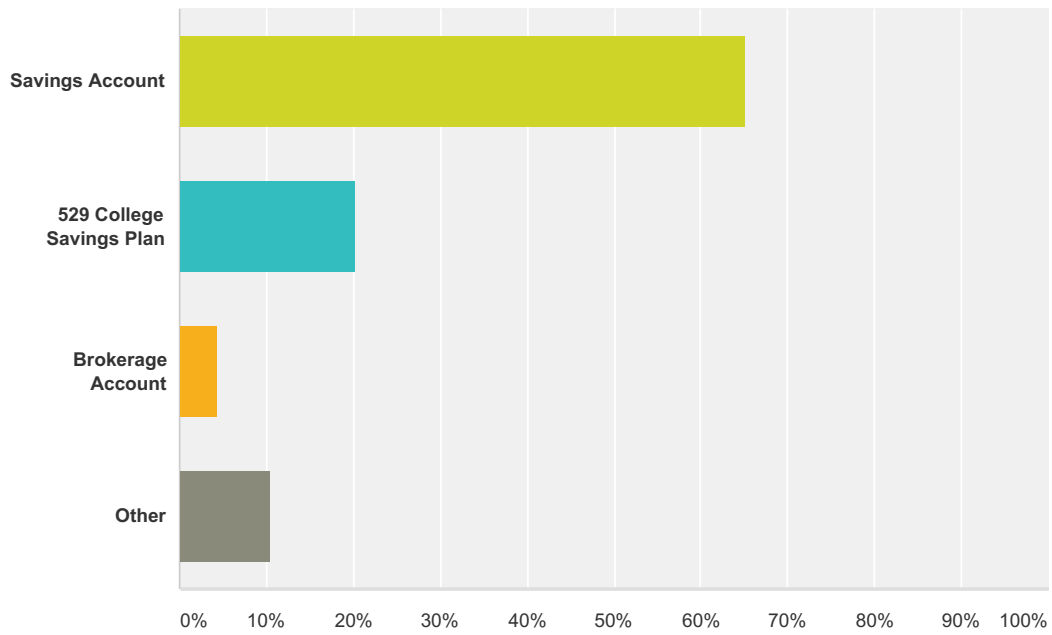

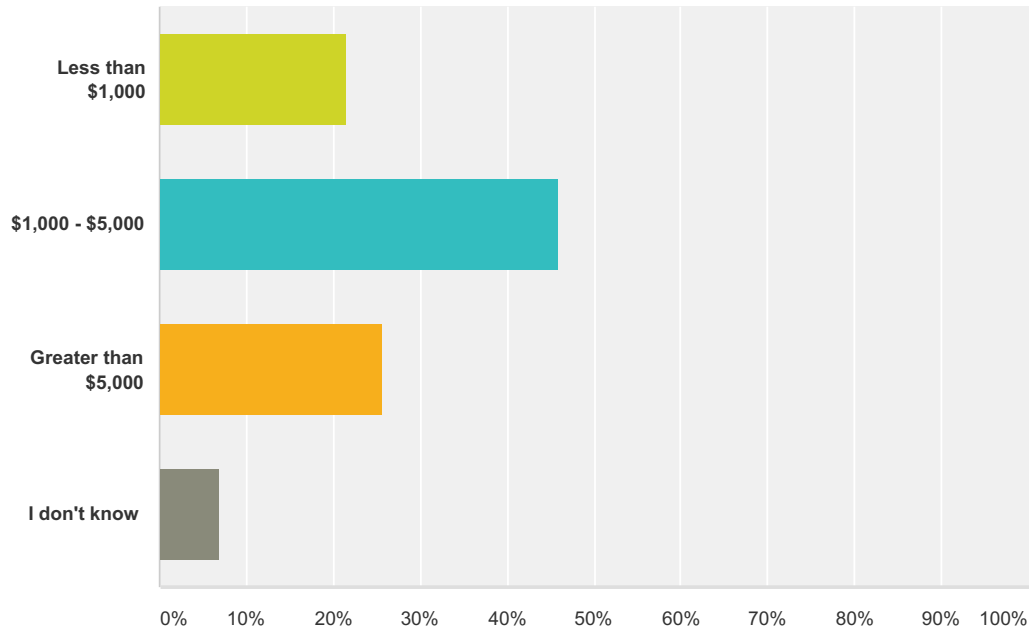

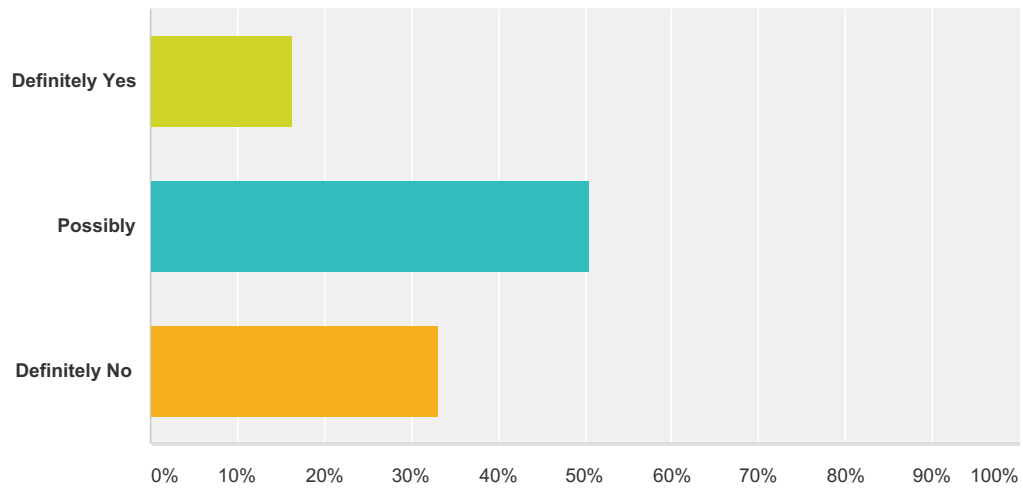

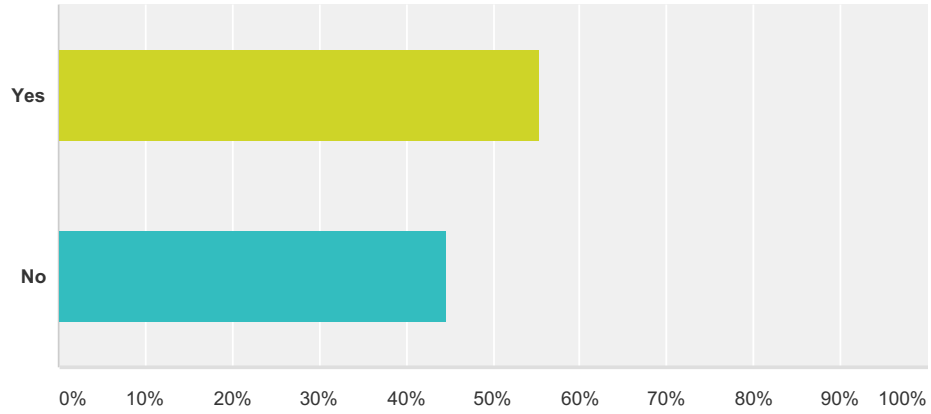

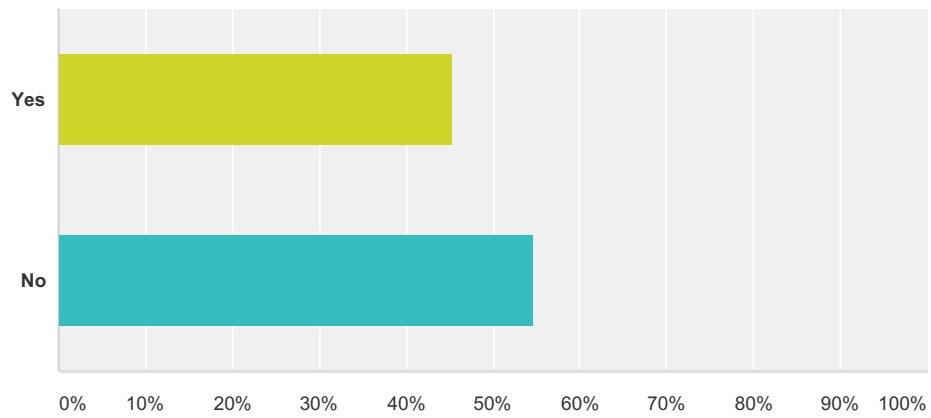

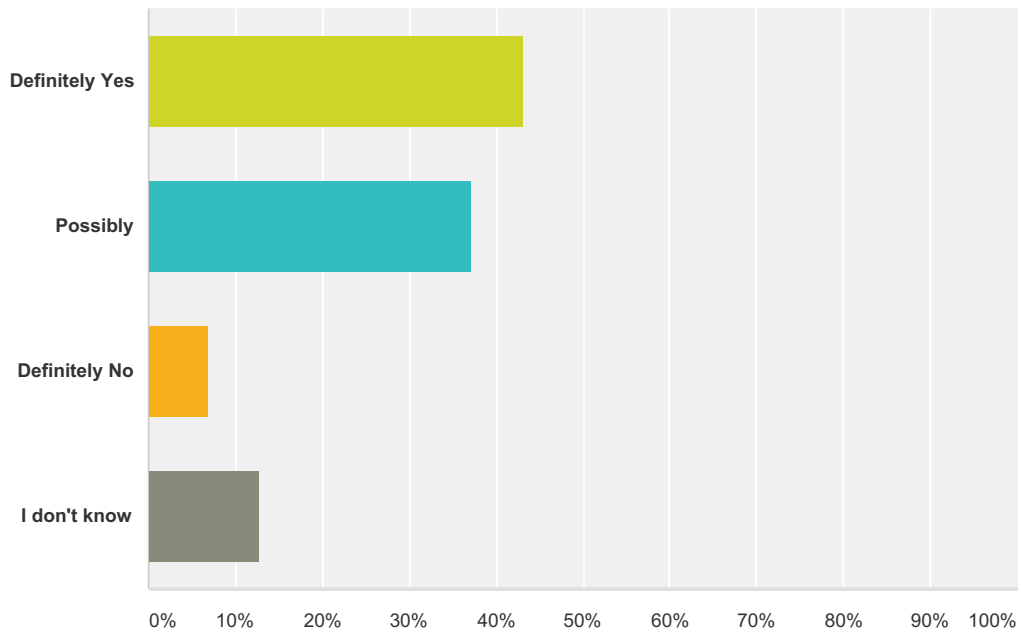

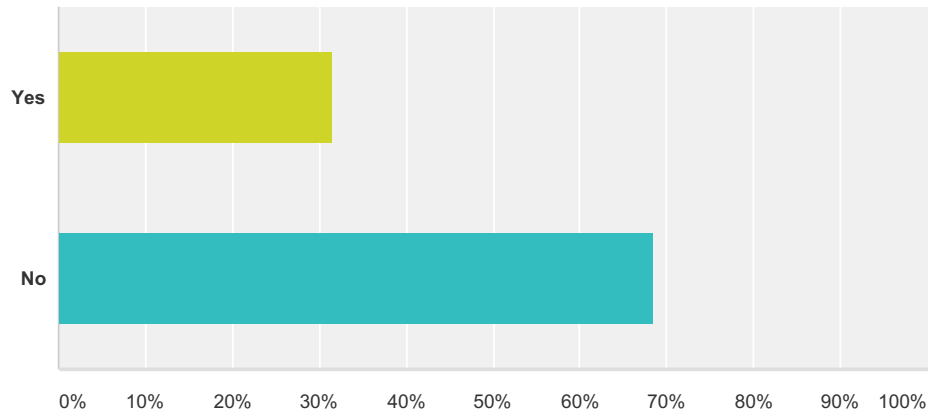

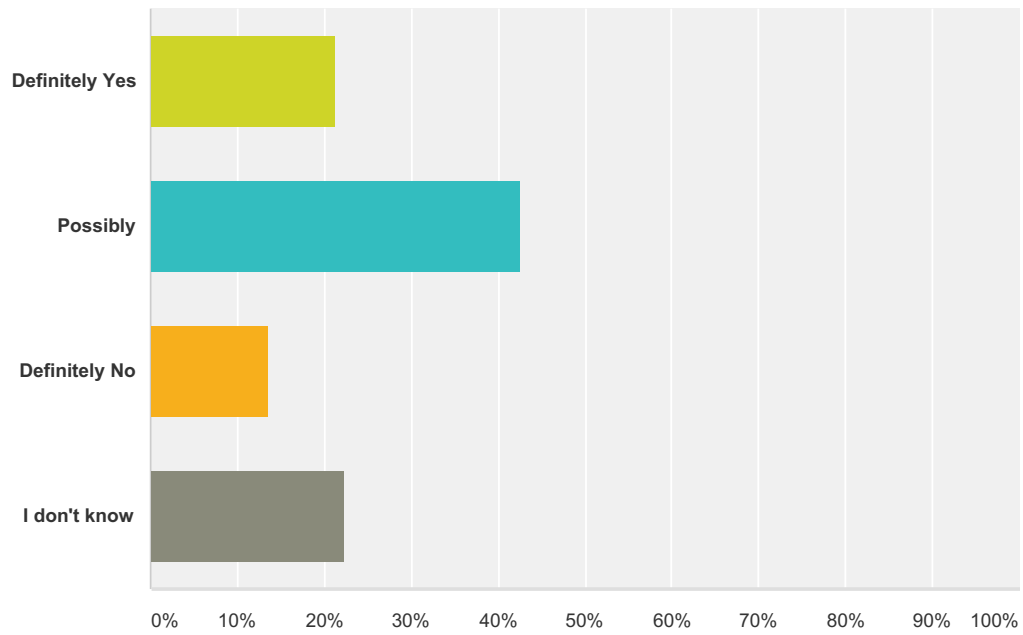

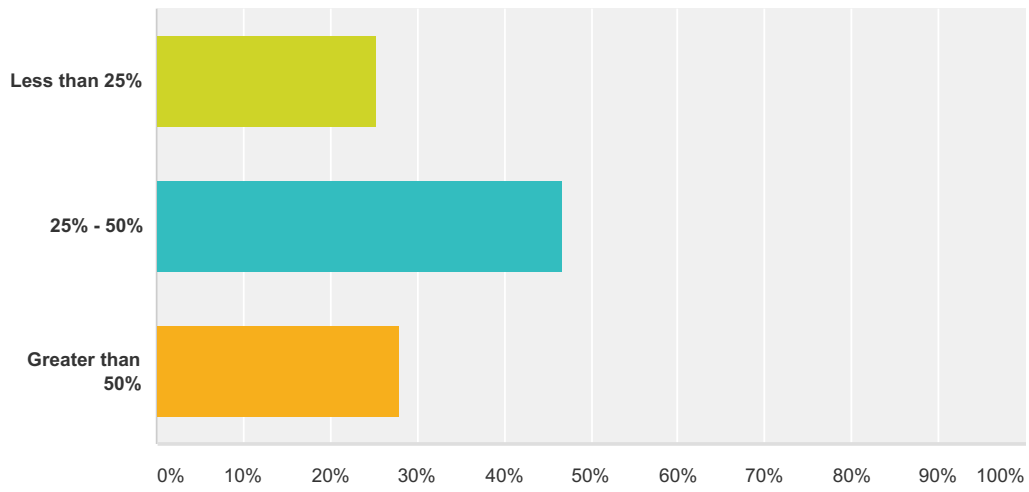

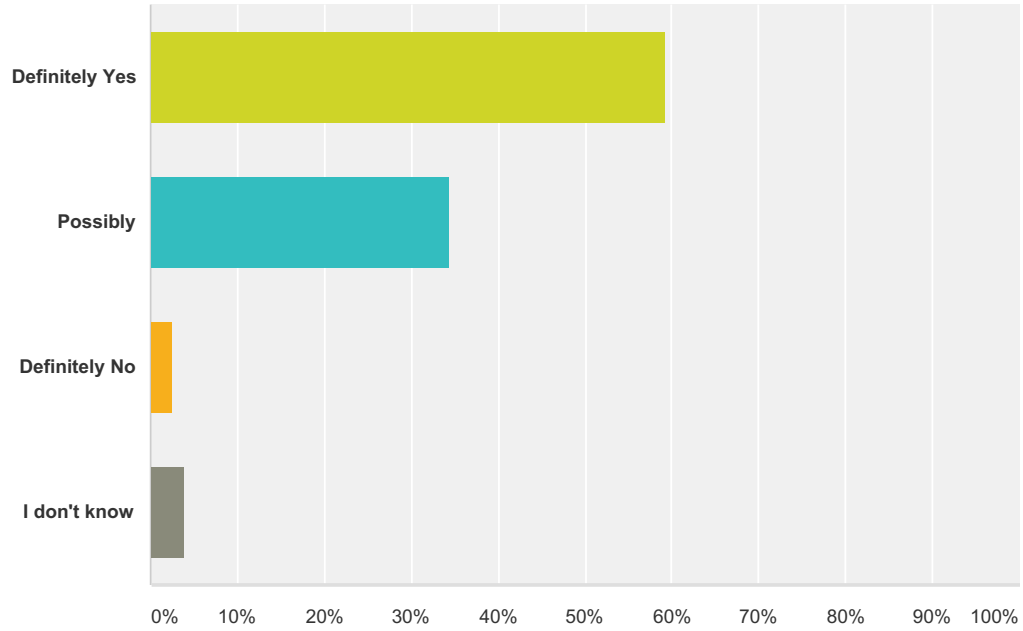

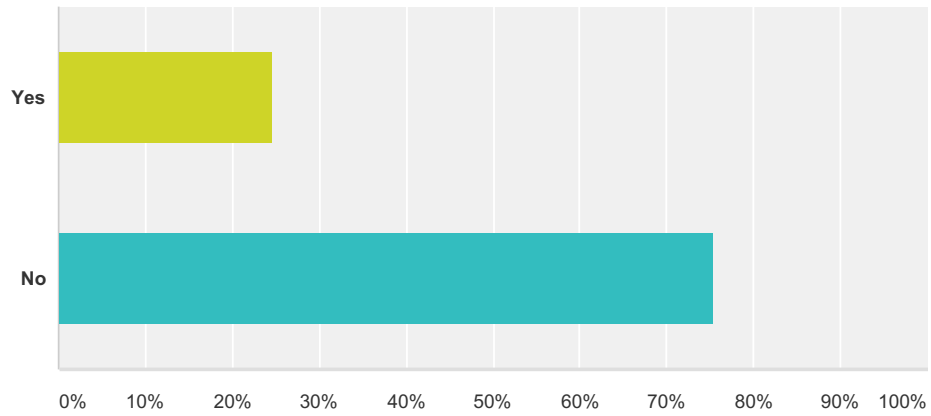

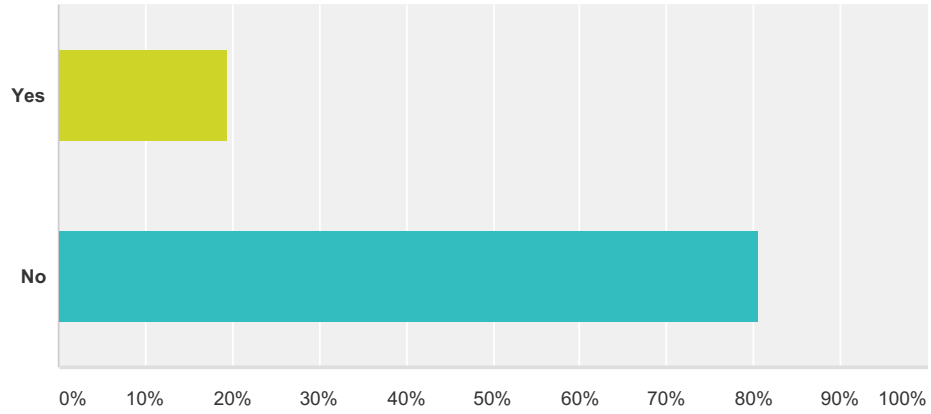

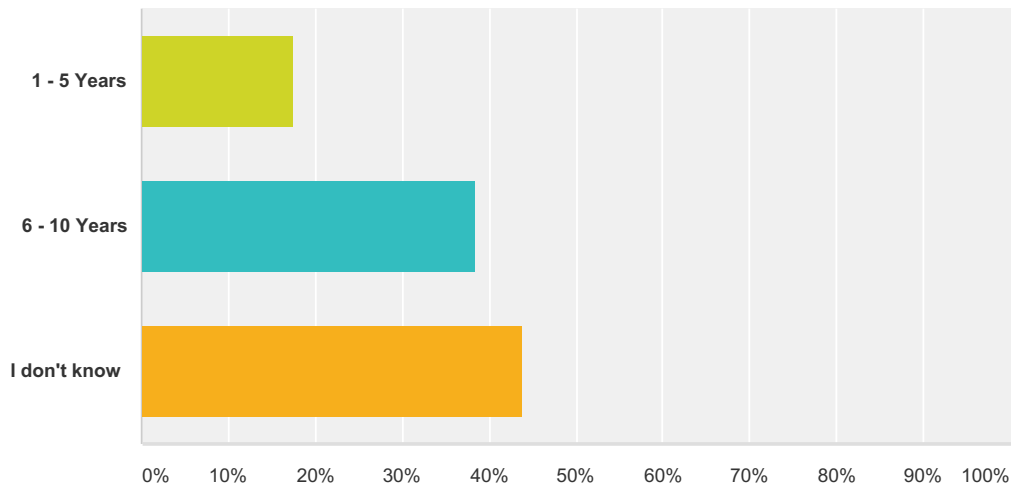

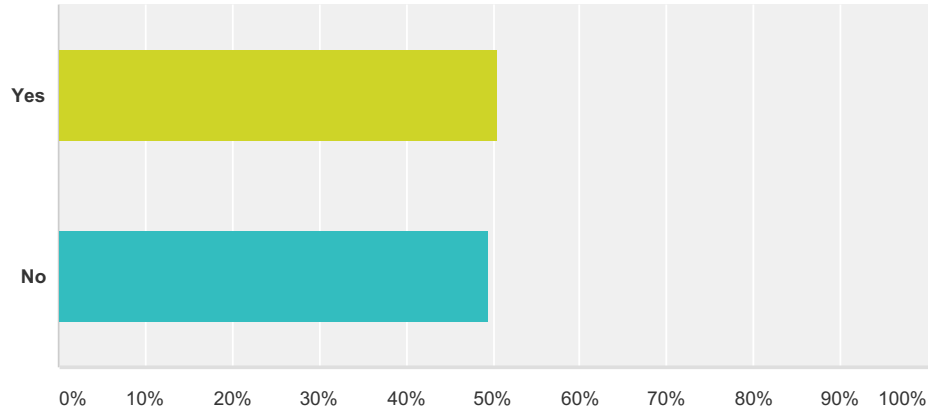

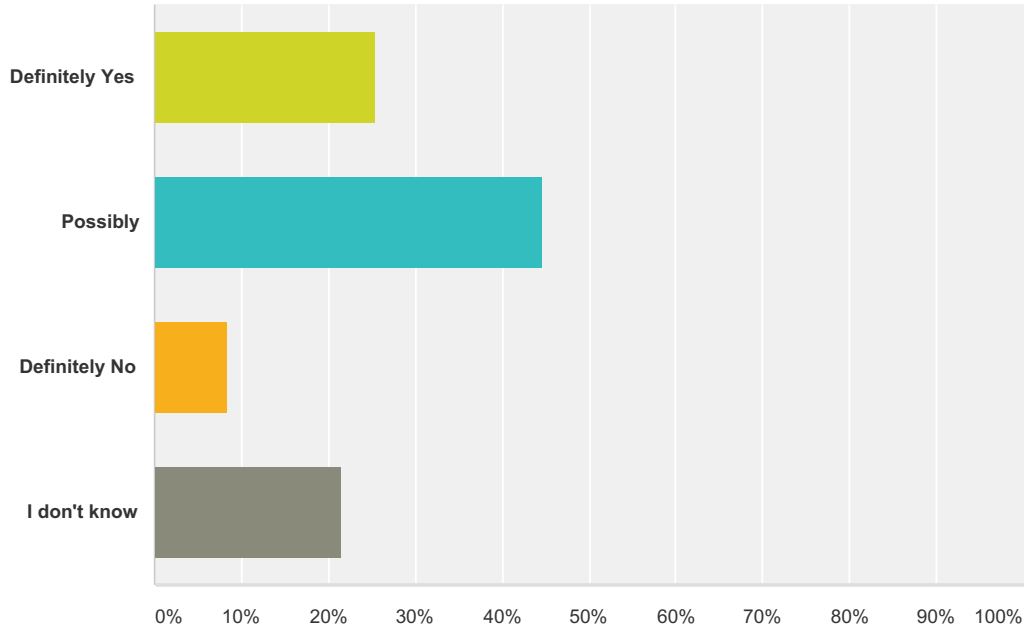

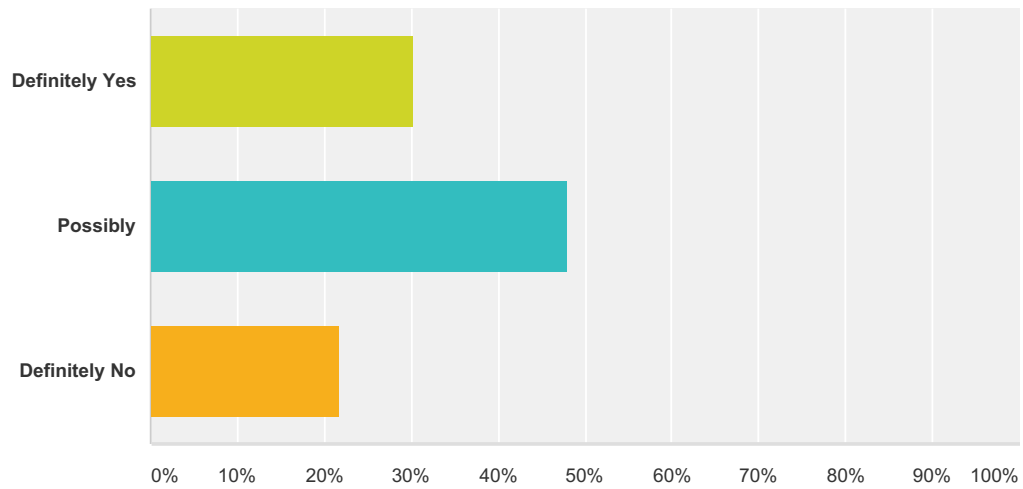

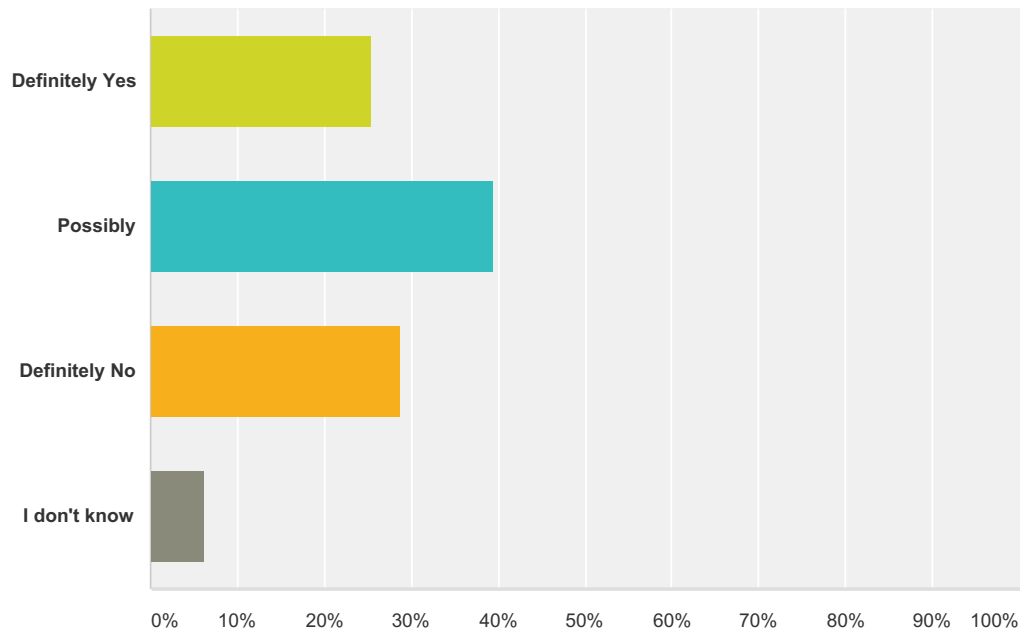

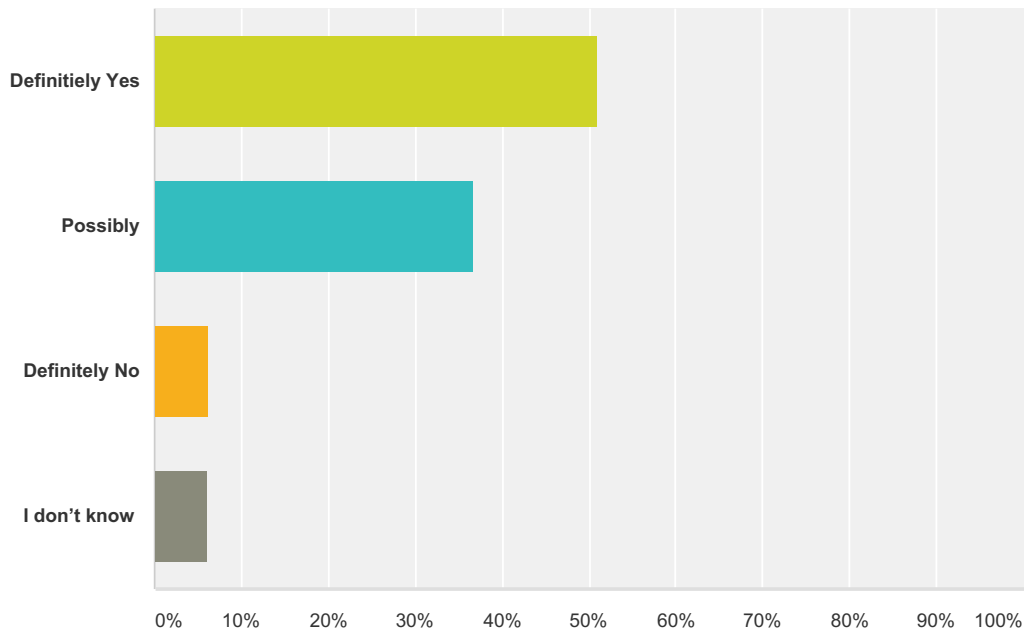

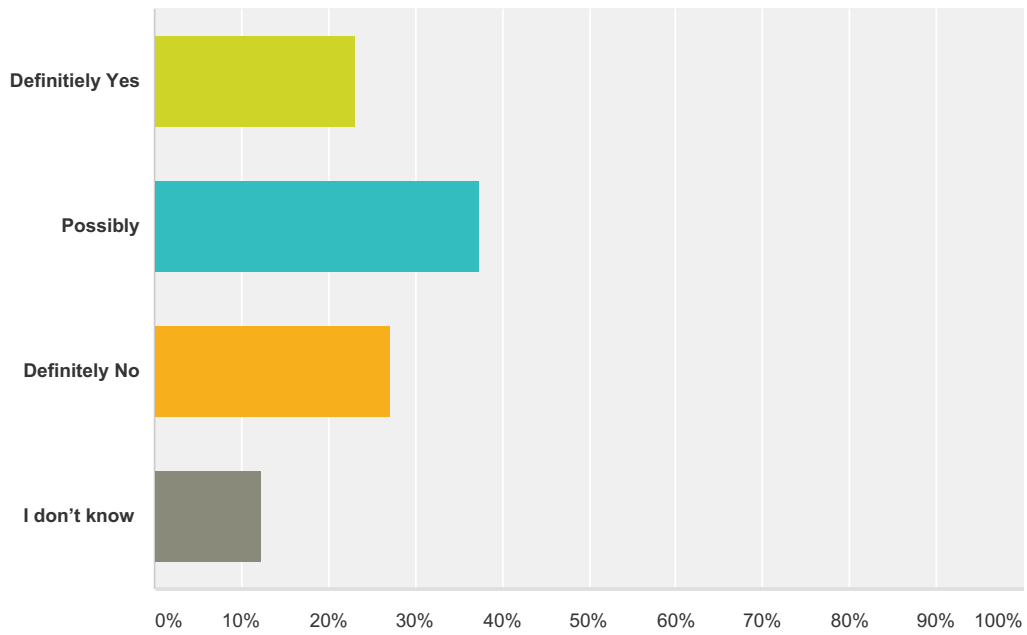

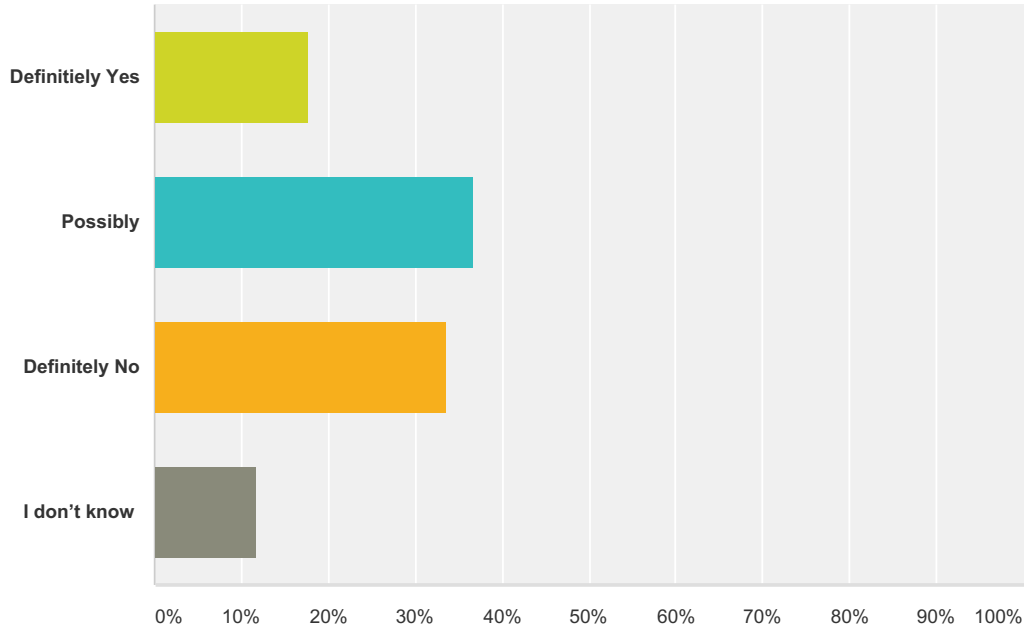

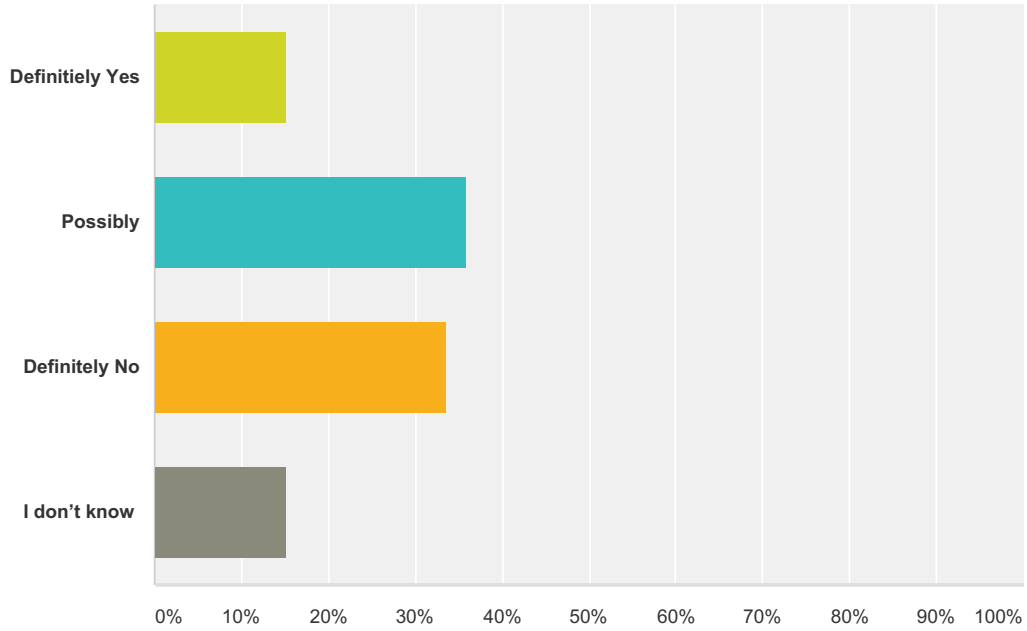

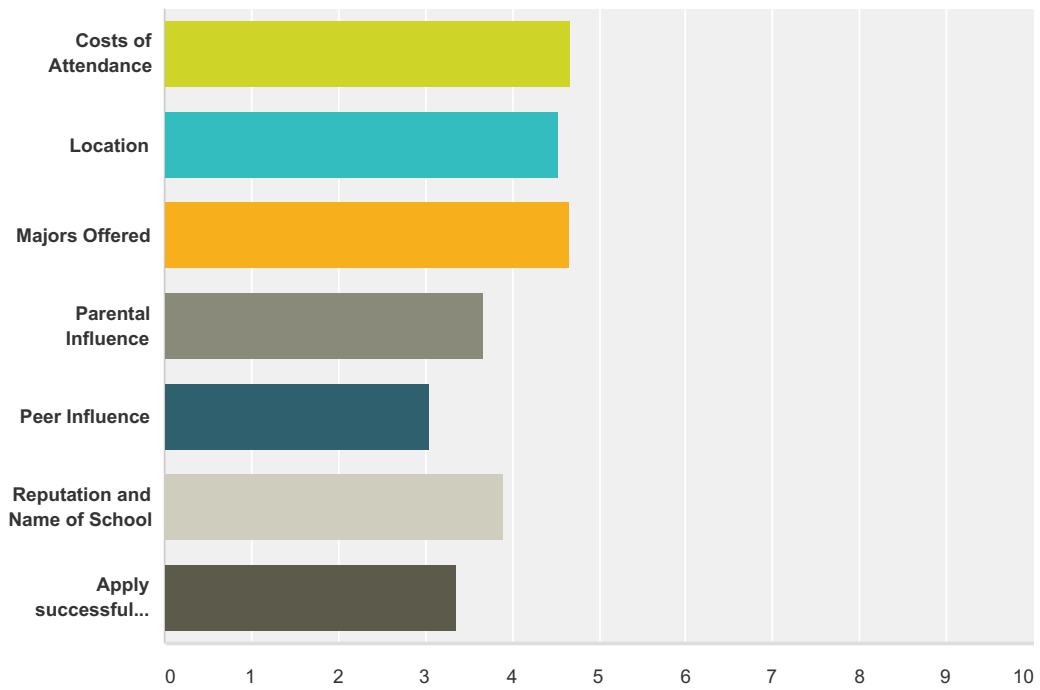

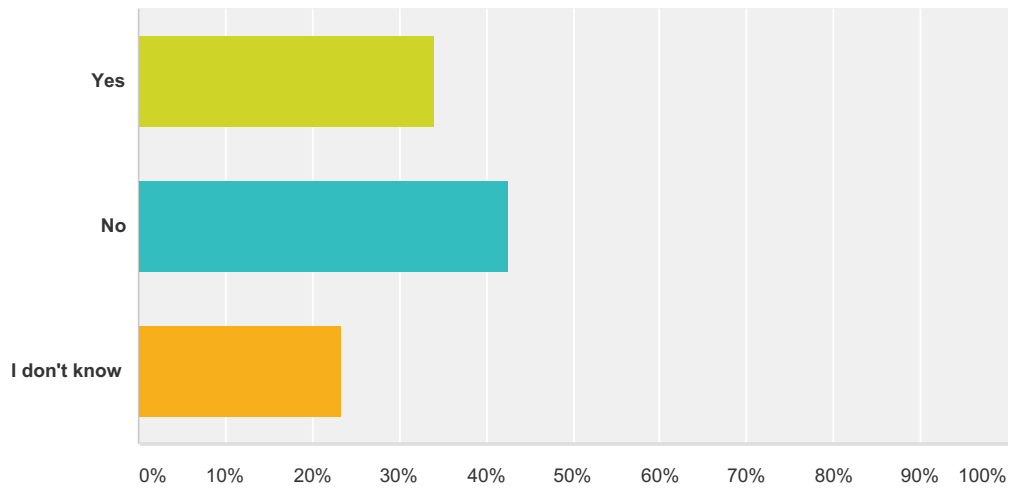

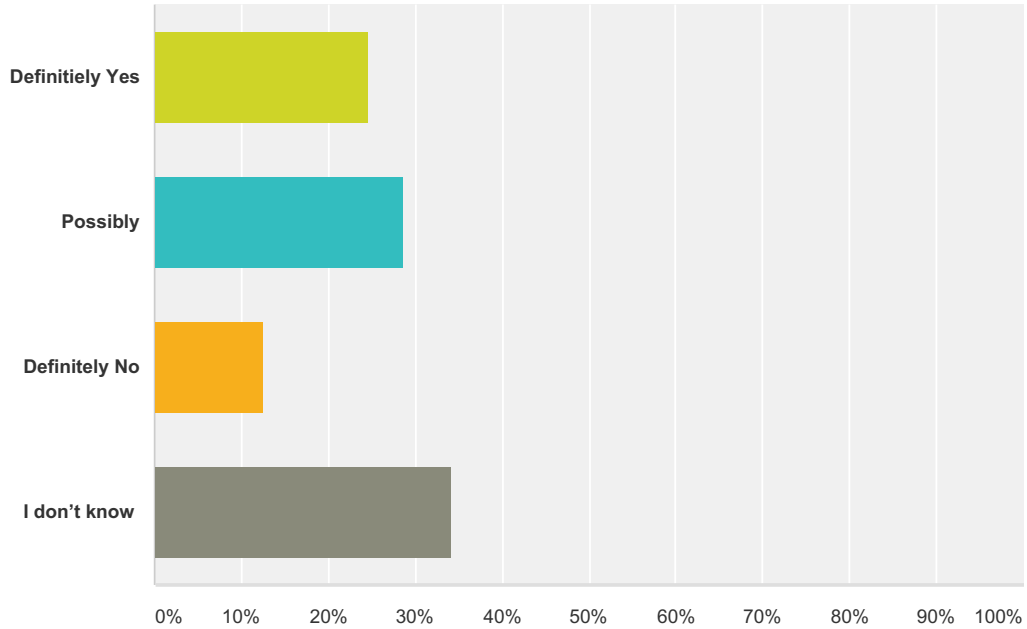

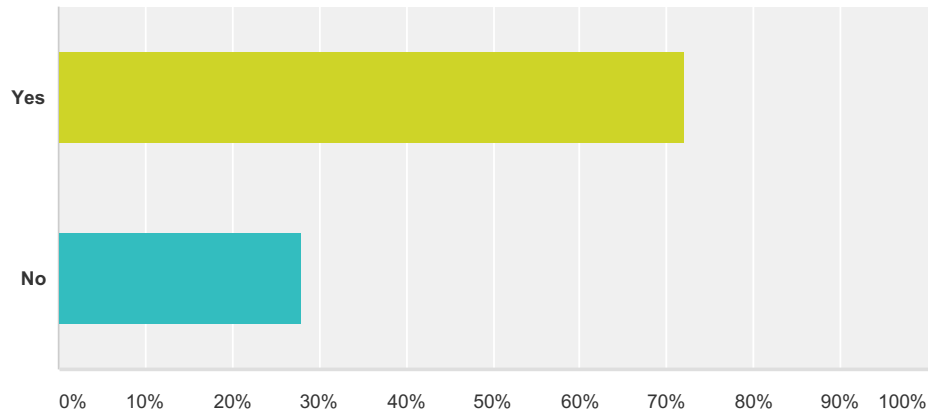

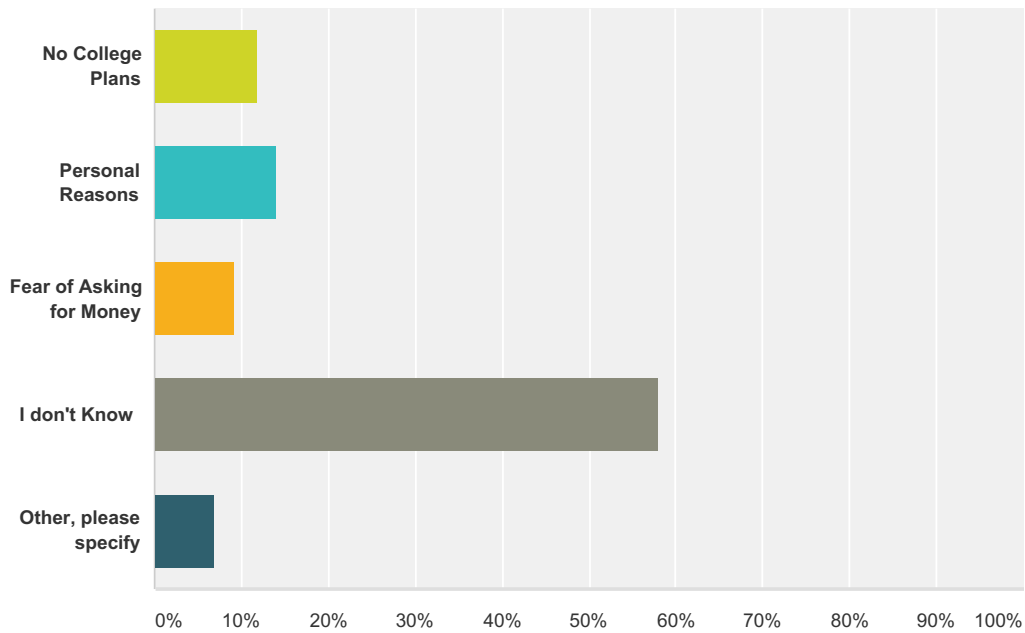

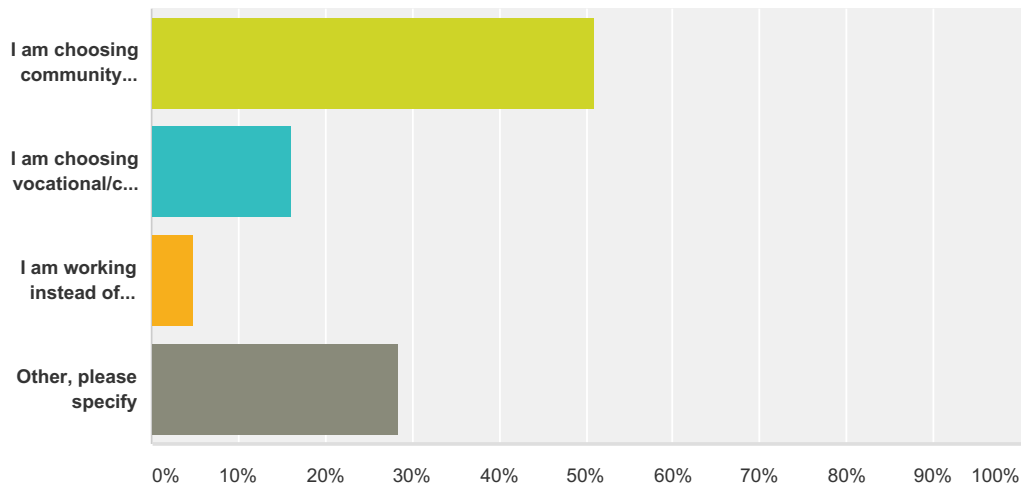

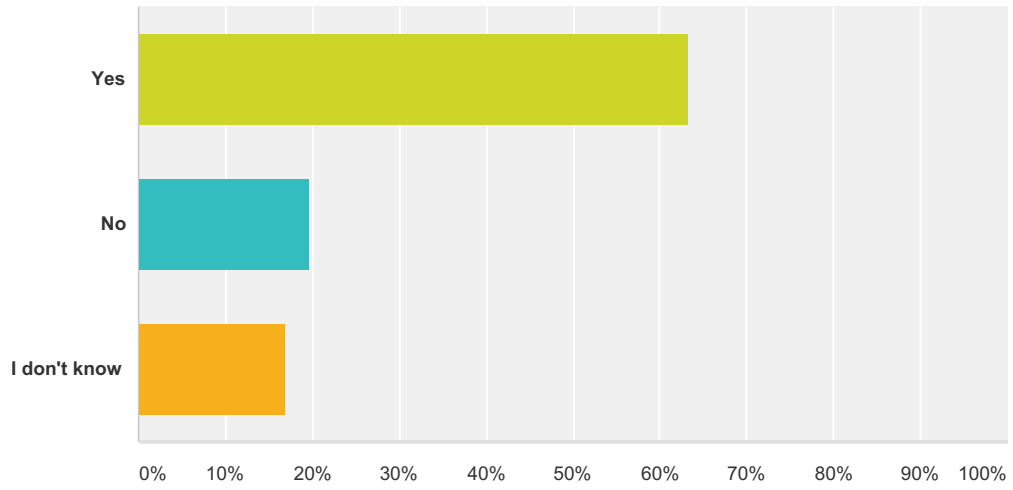

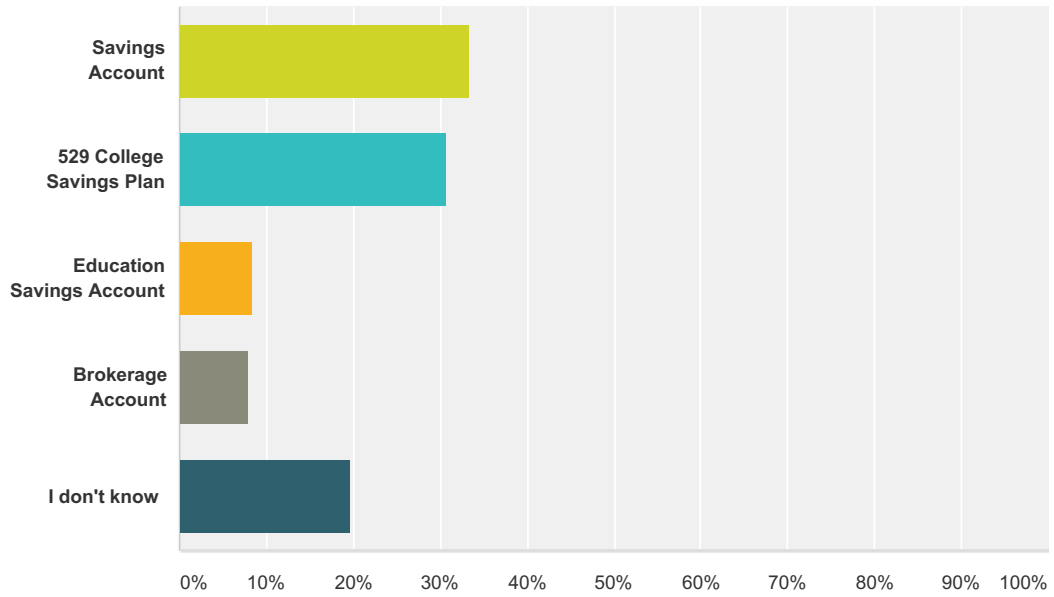

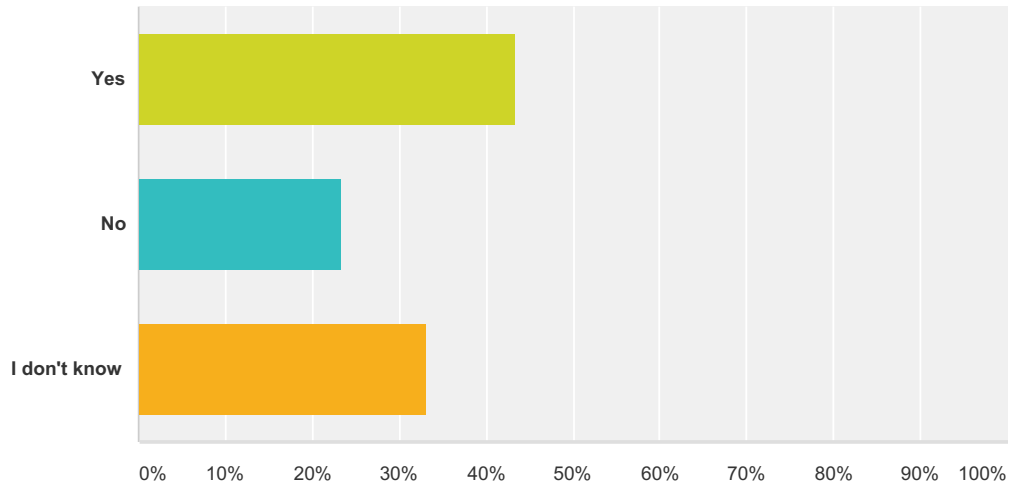

Q49 Are they saving a fixed amount per month?

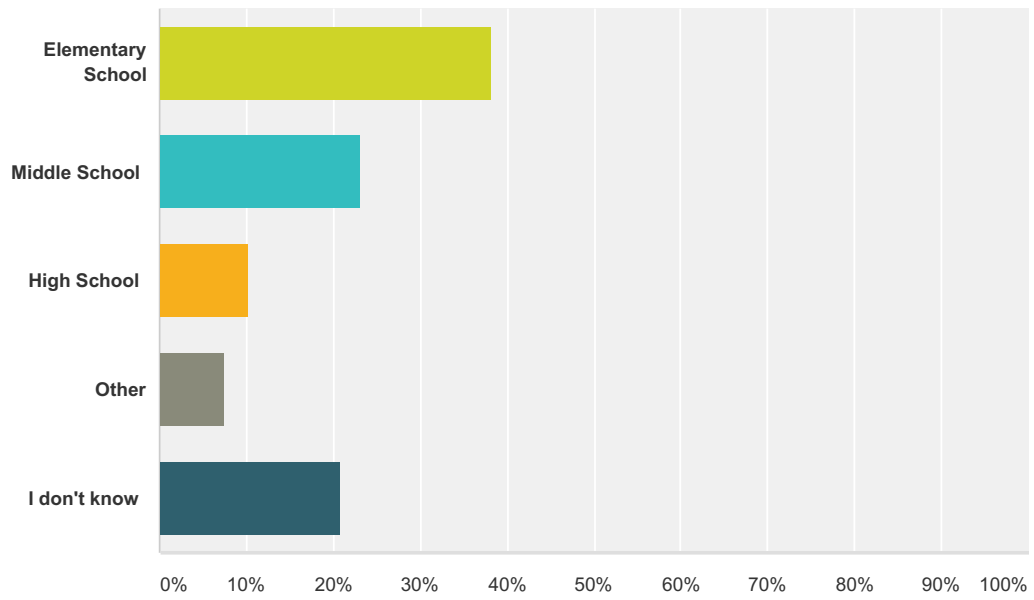

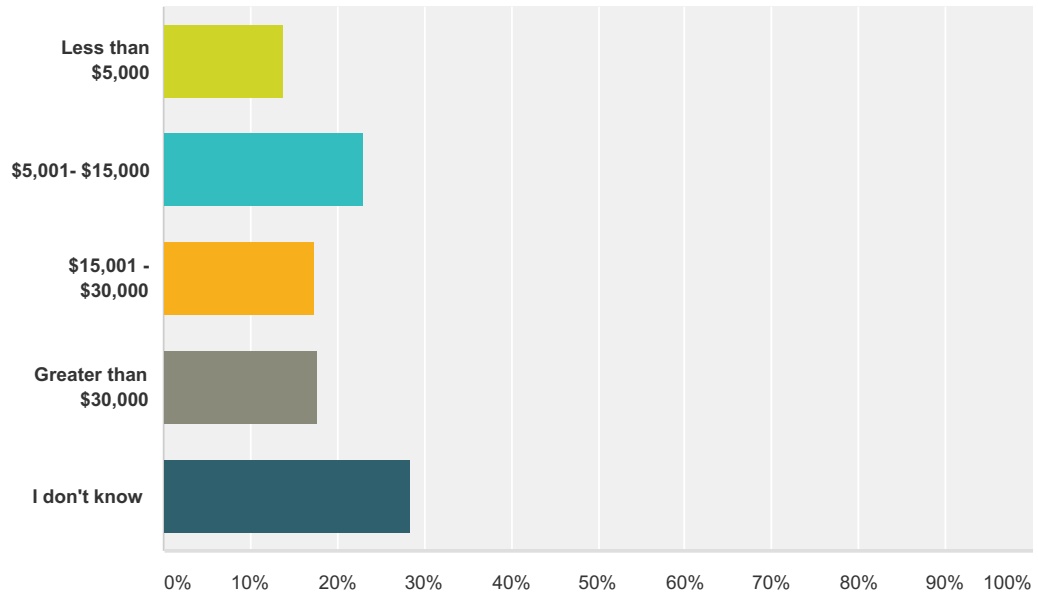

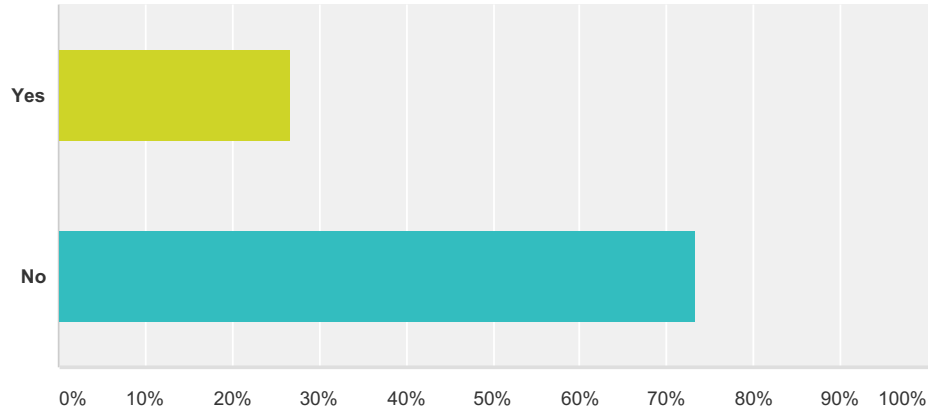

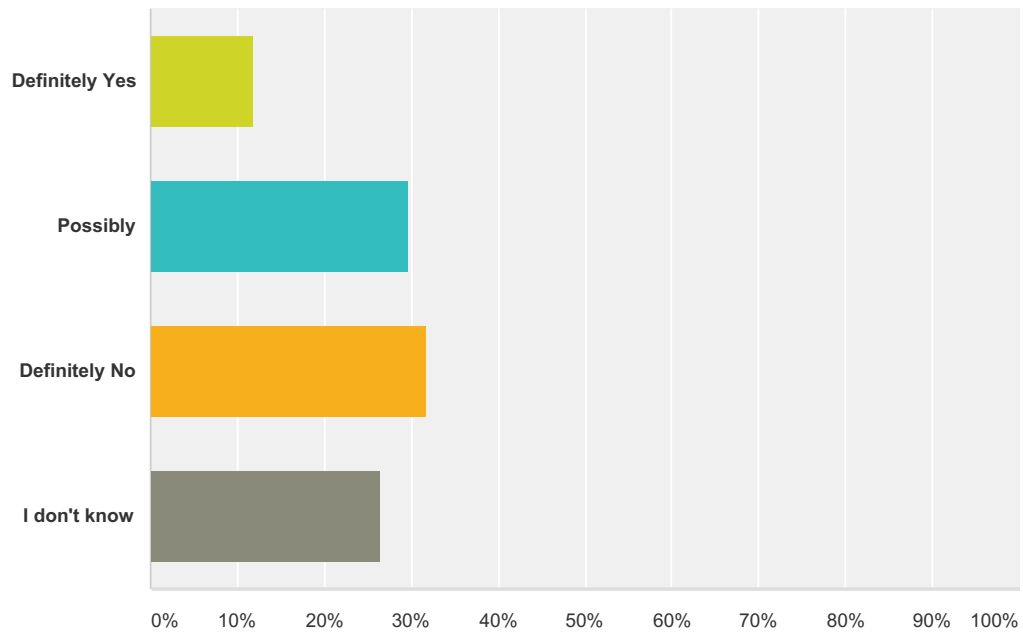

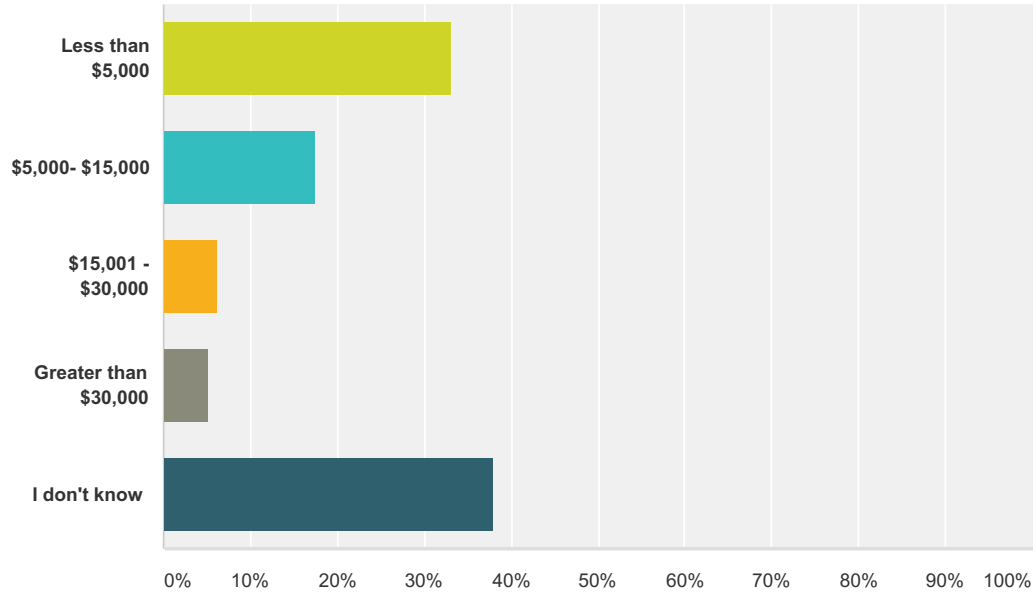

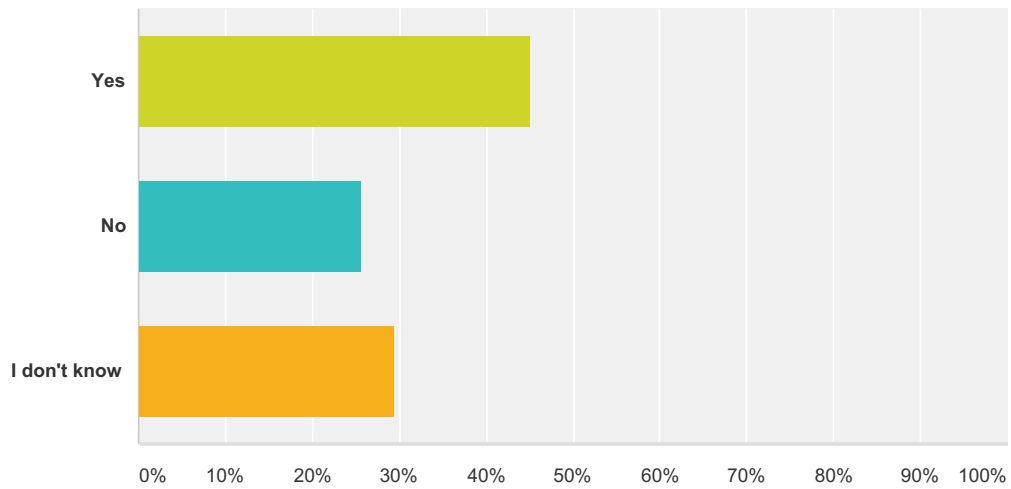

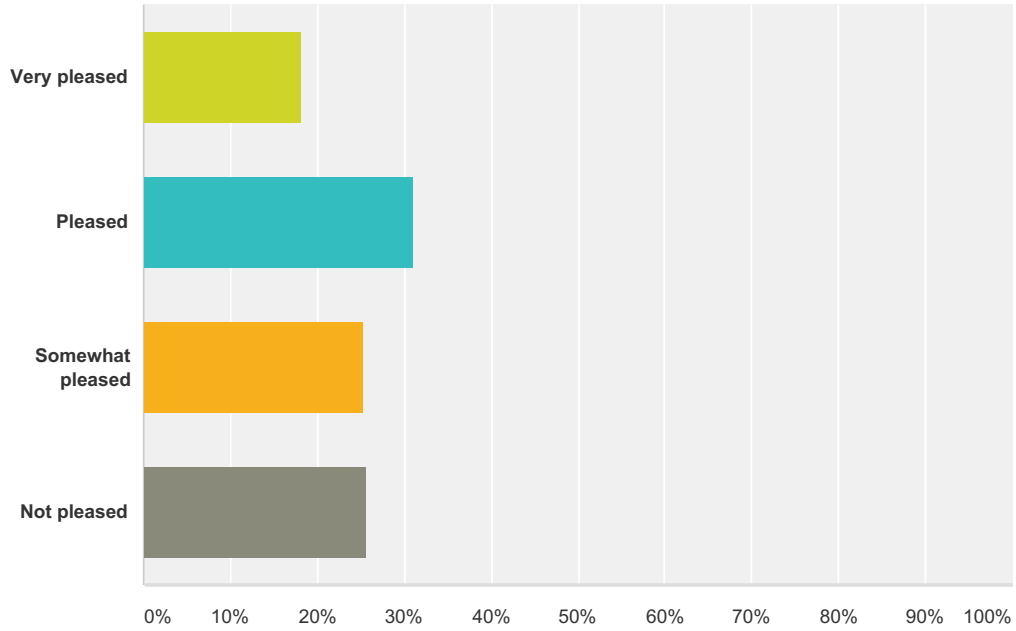

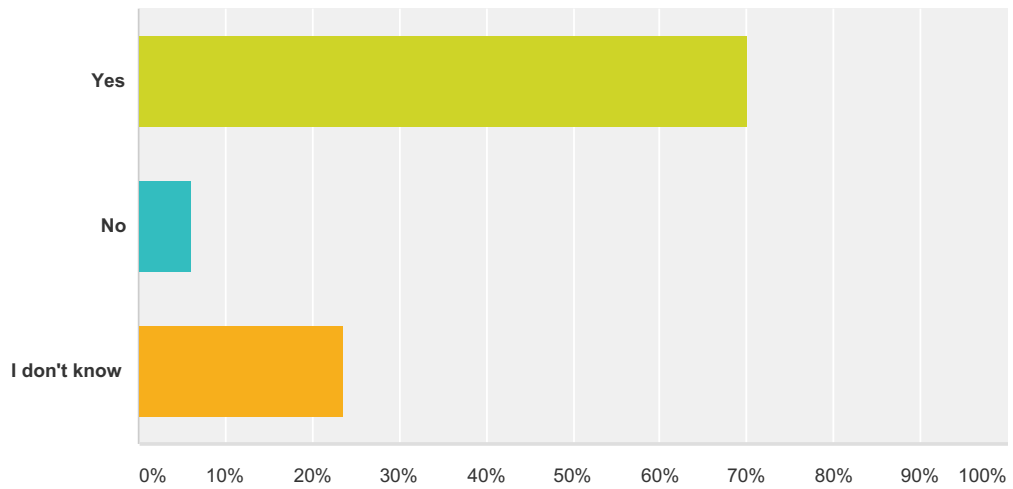

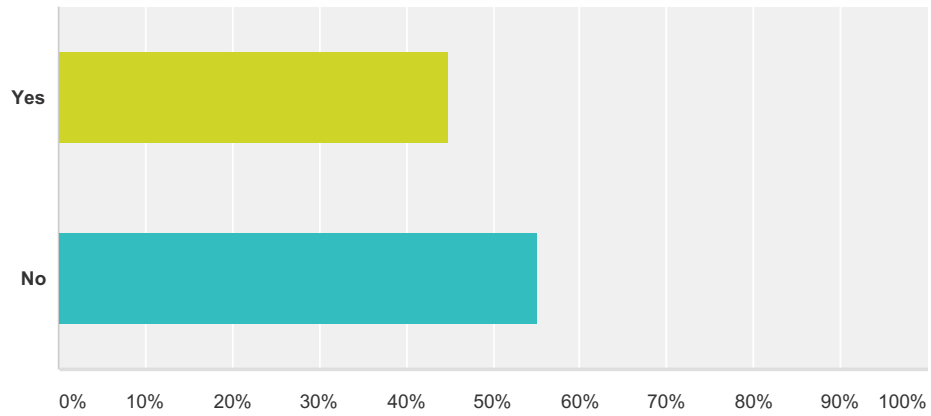

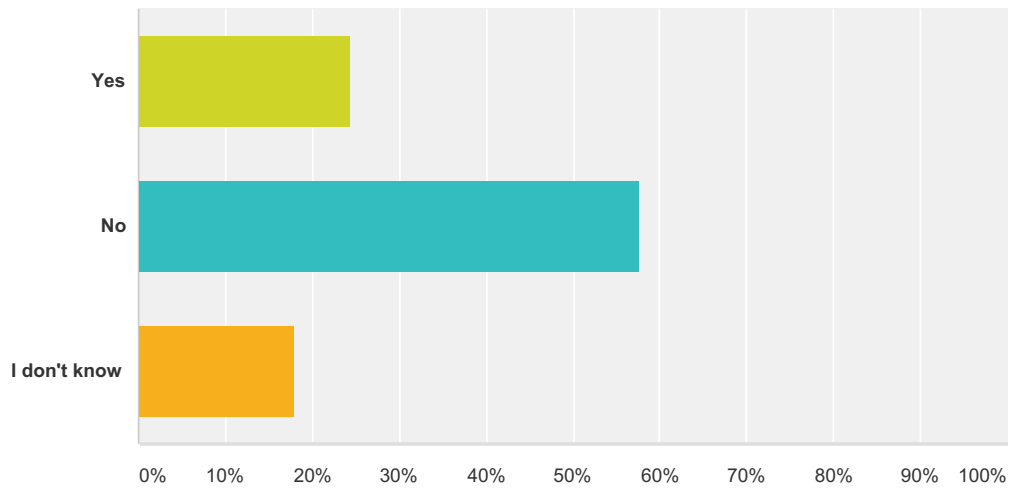

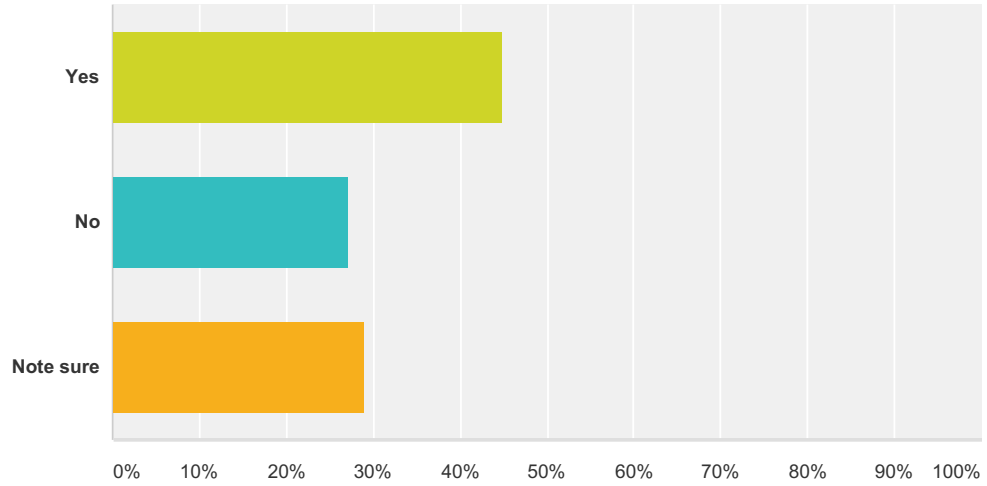

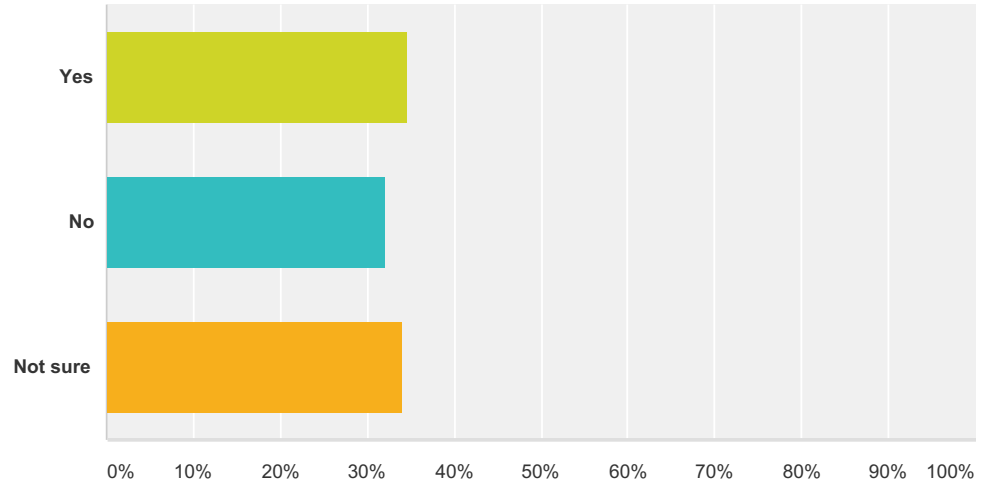

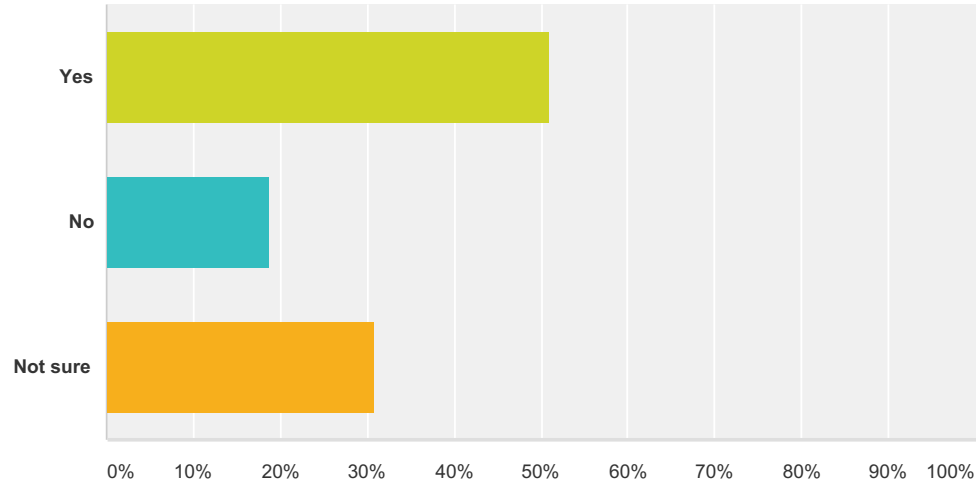

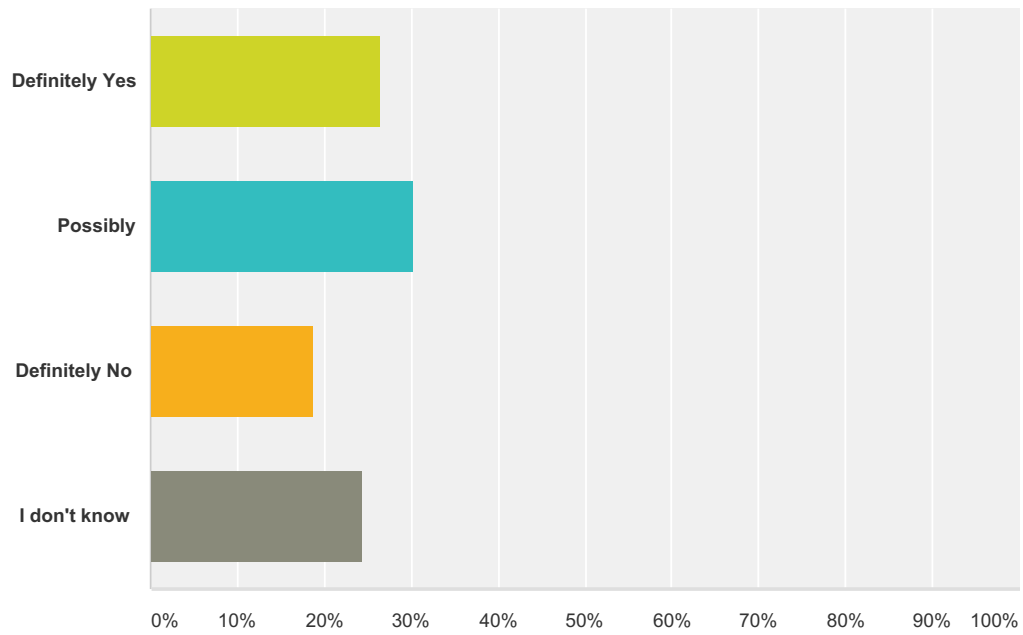

Q63 Have your college savings been affected by the current market conditions?

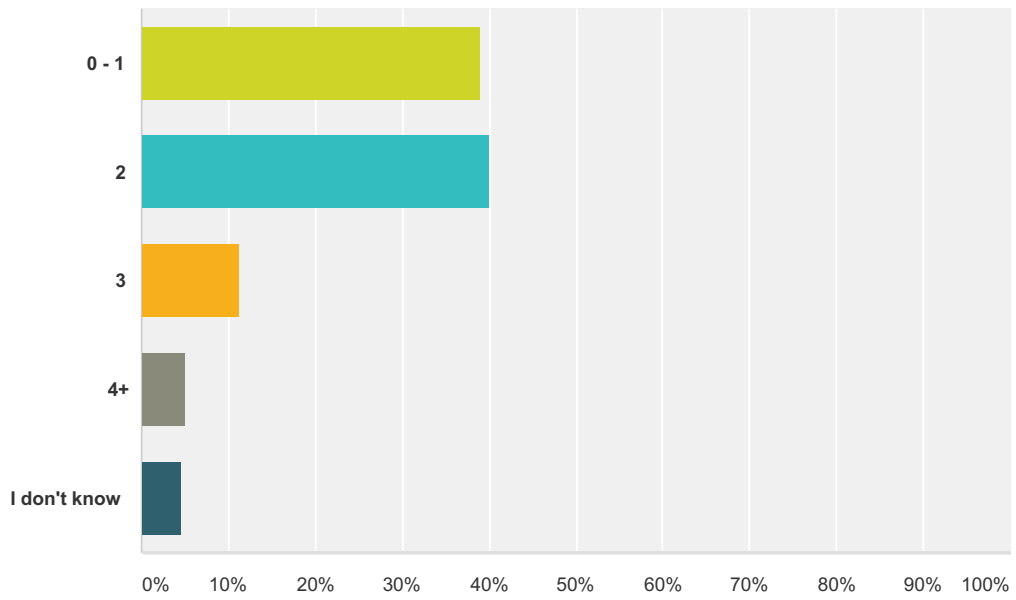

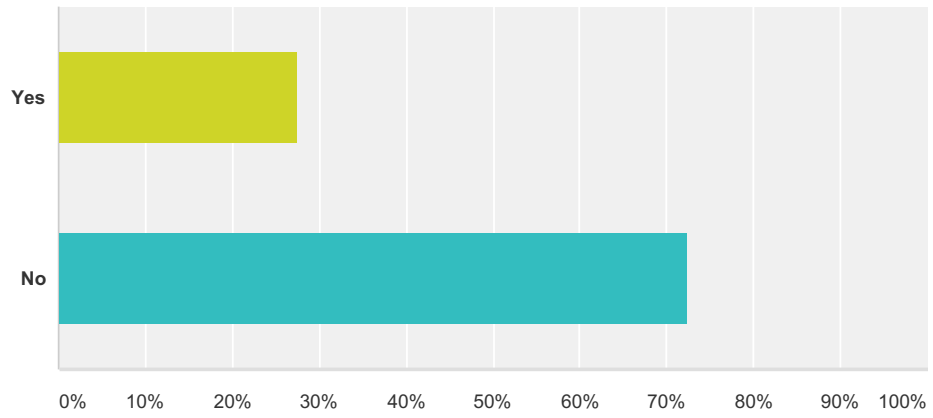
