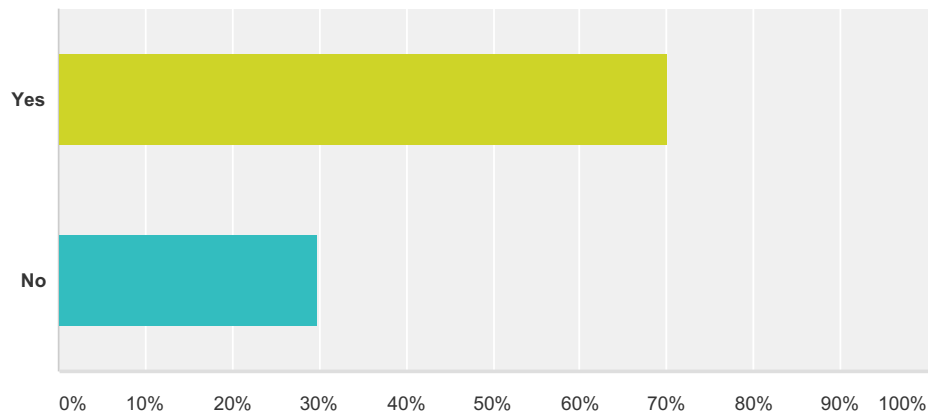

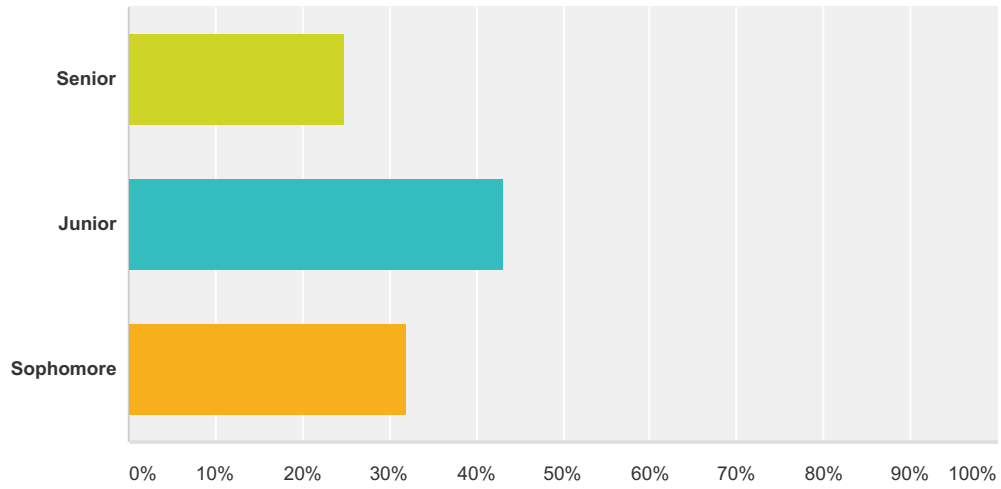

## Q2 What year are you in High School?

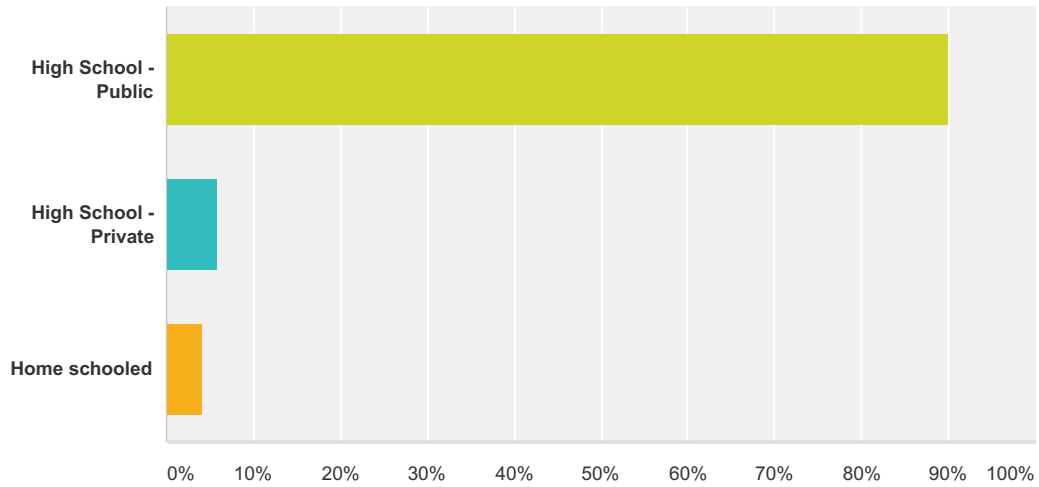

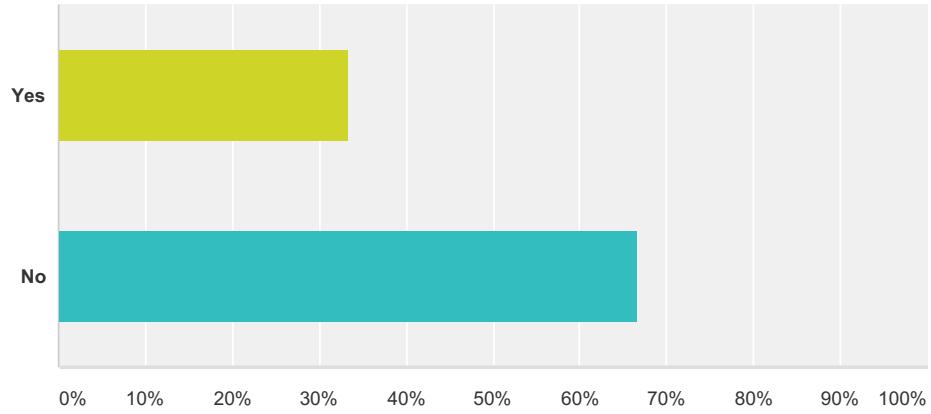

**Q4 Does/will the cost of your attending a private high school negatively affect your choice of college because of cost of tuition for both high school and college?**

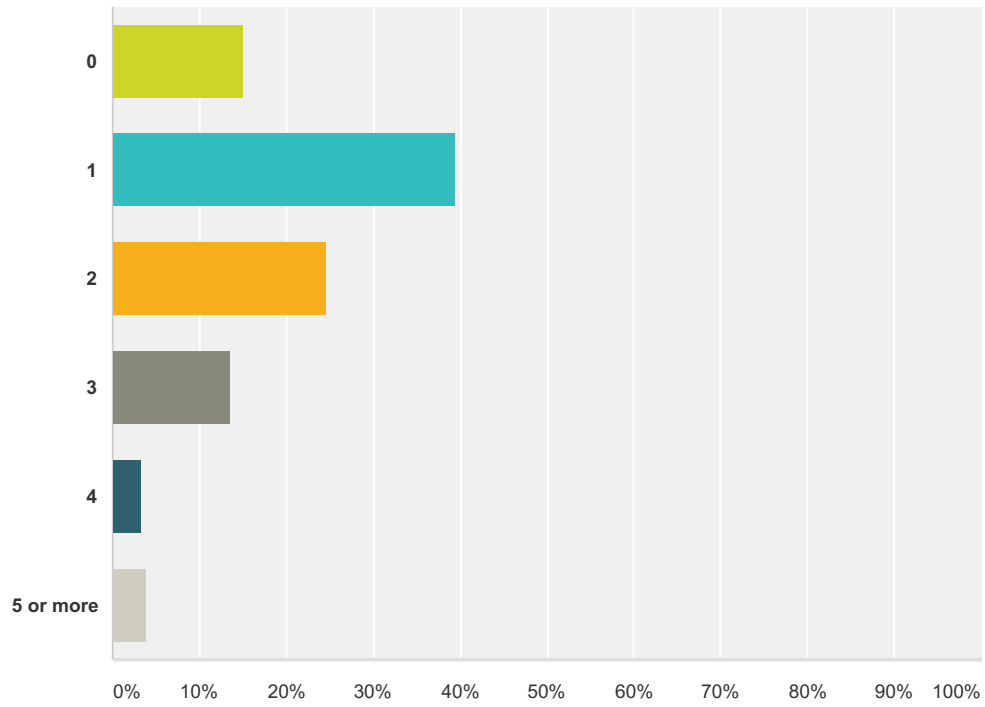

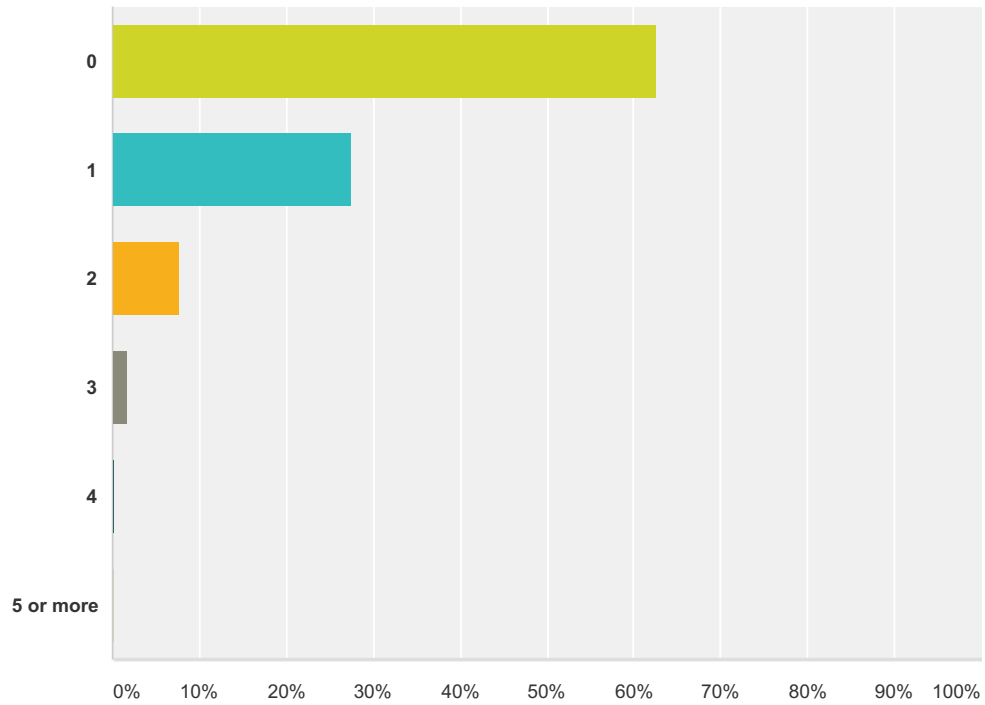

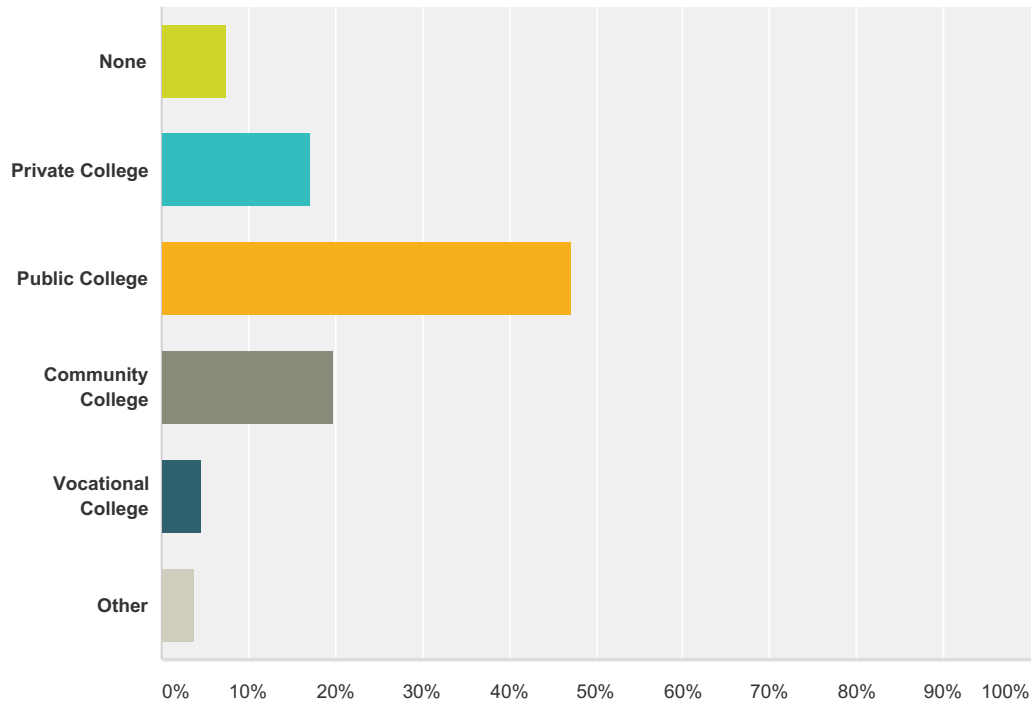

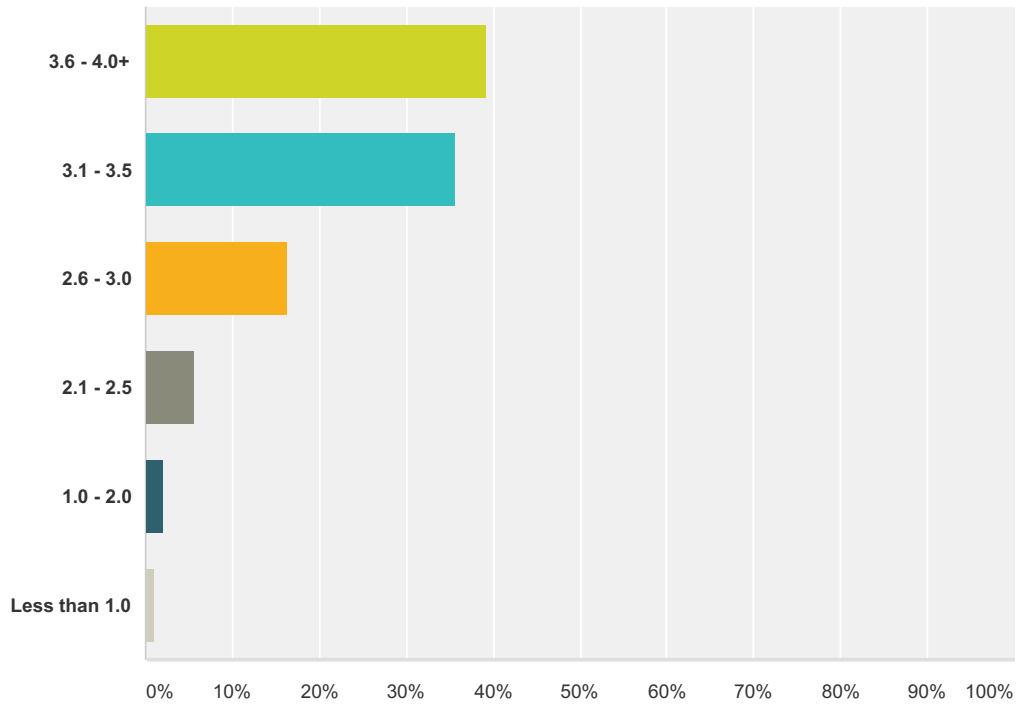

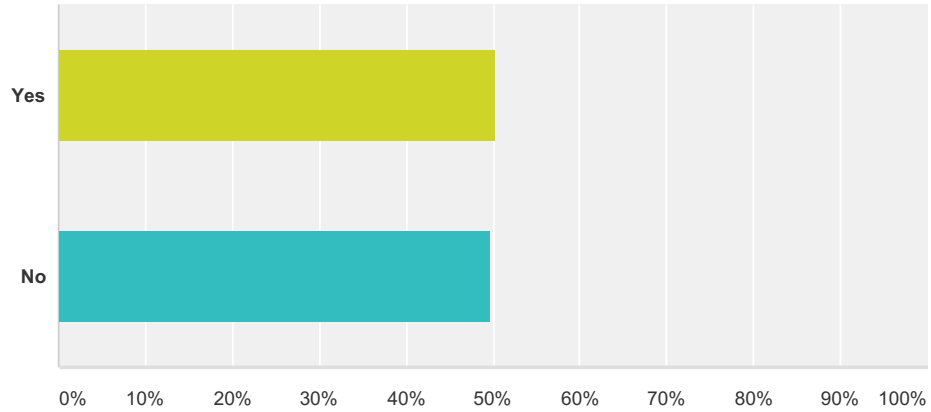

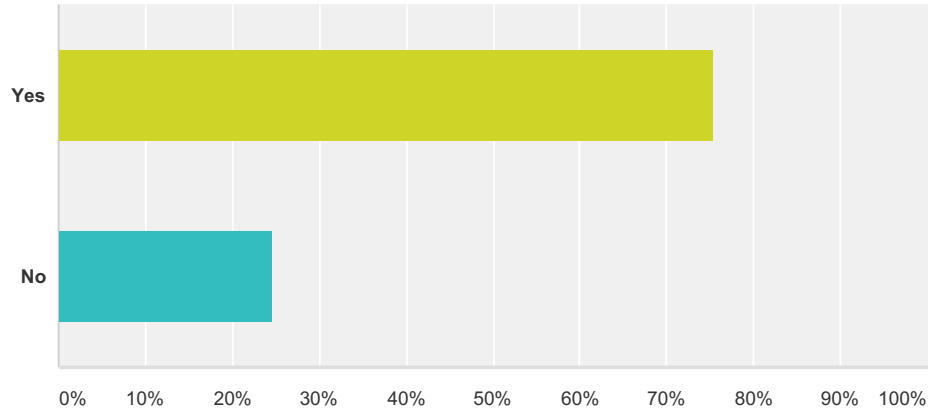

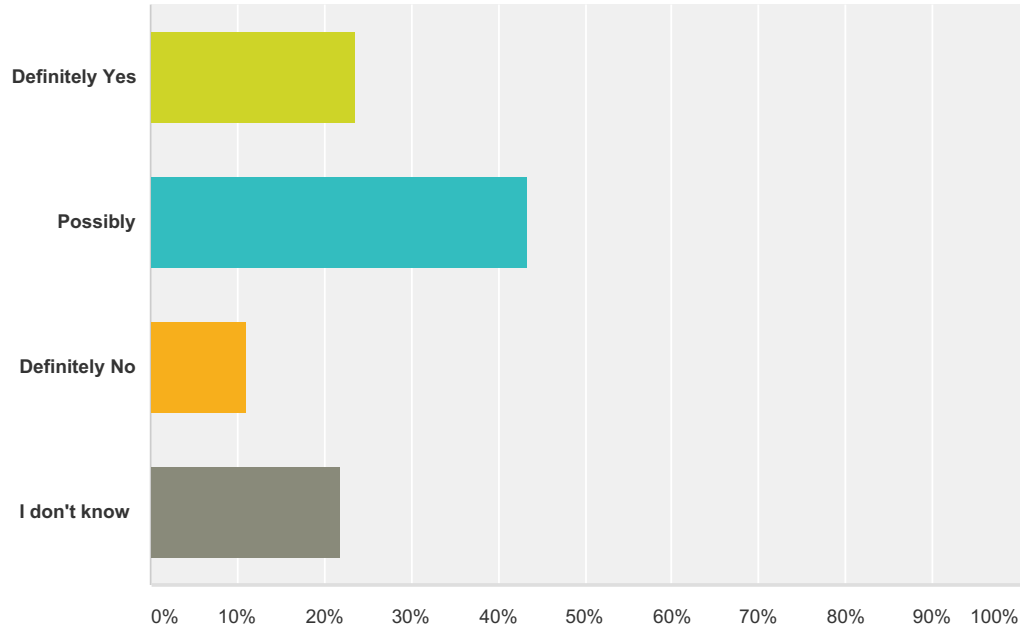

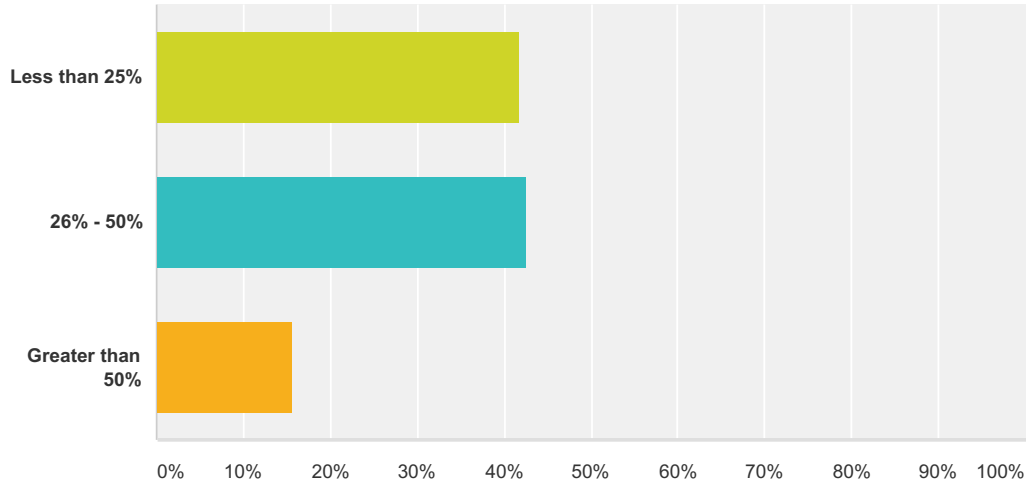

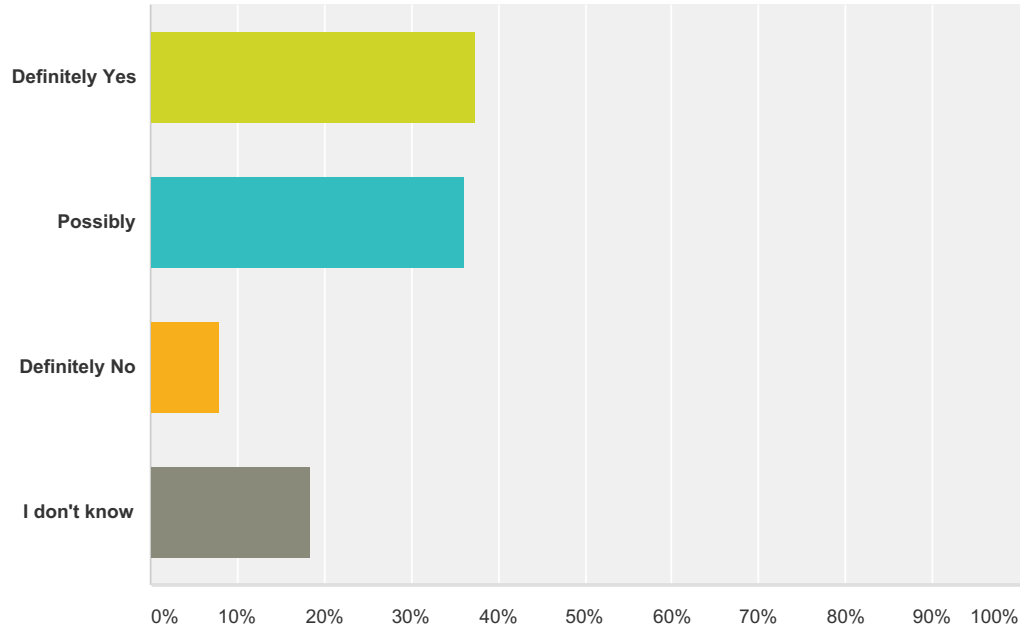

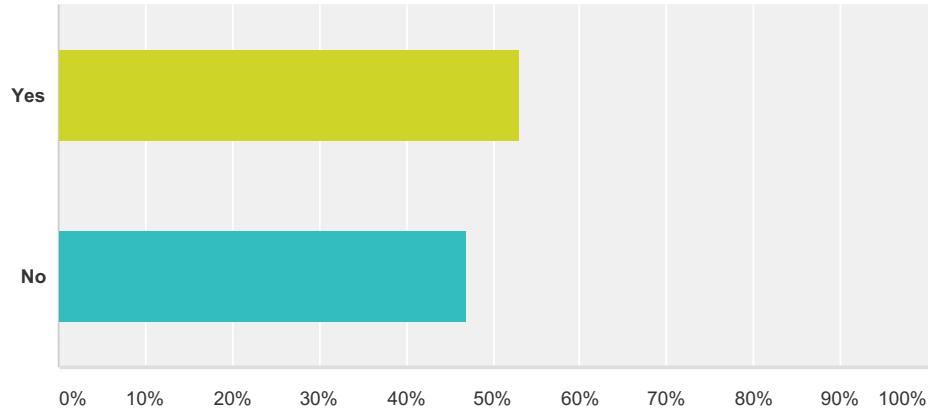

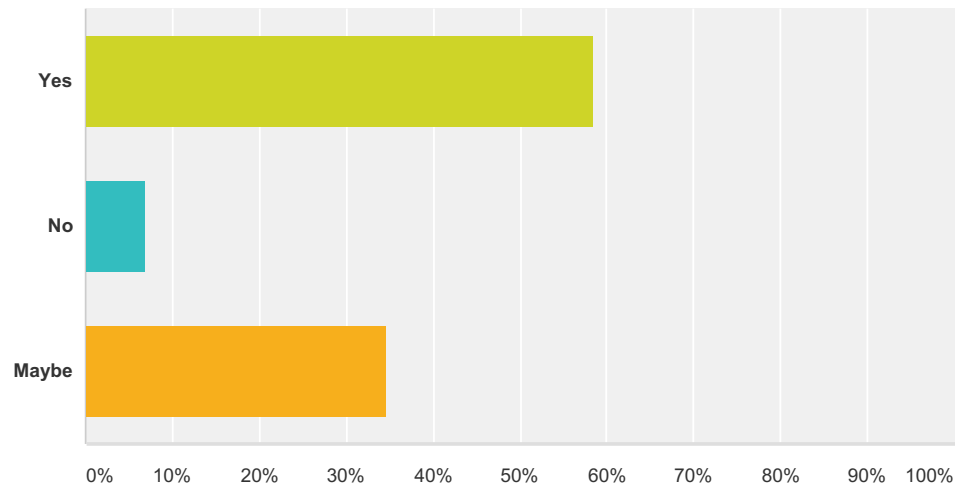

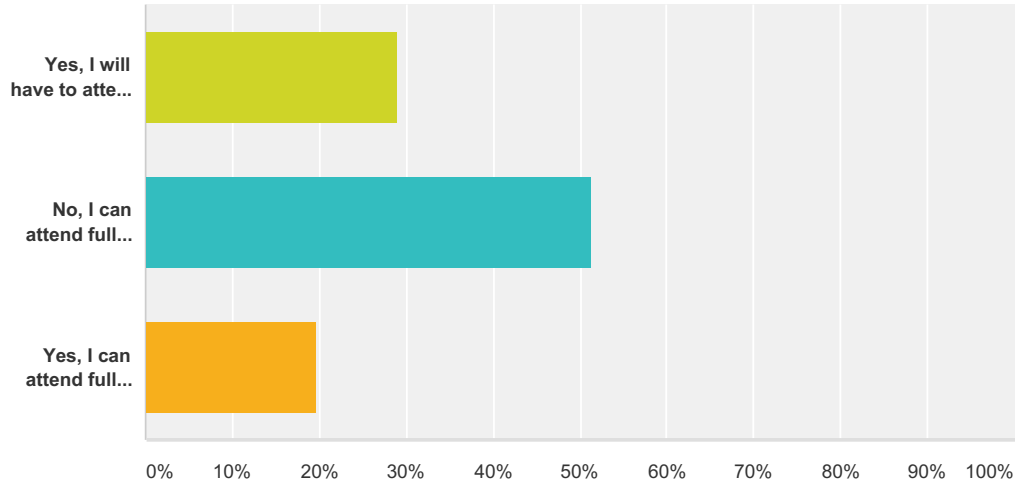

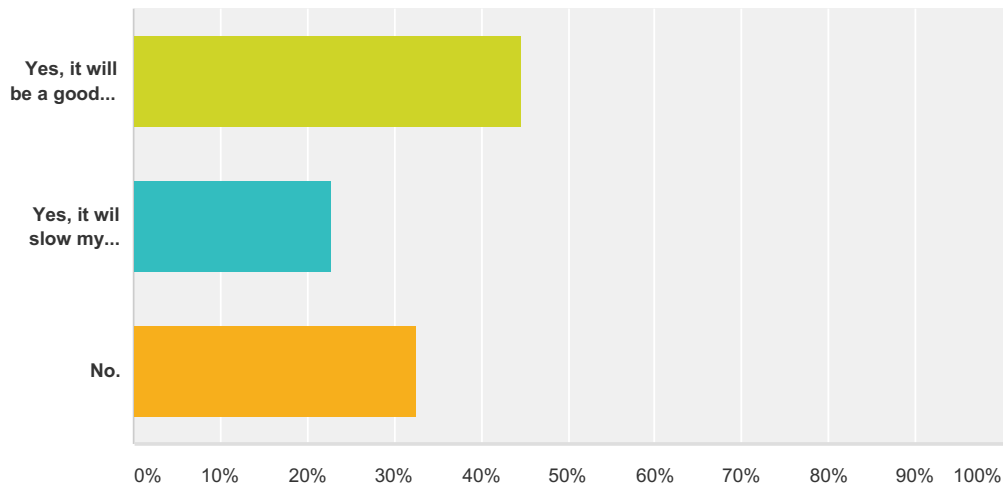

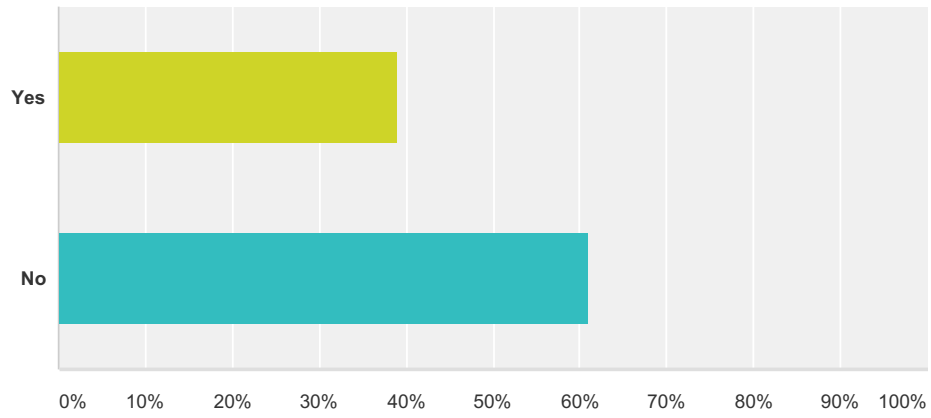

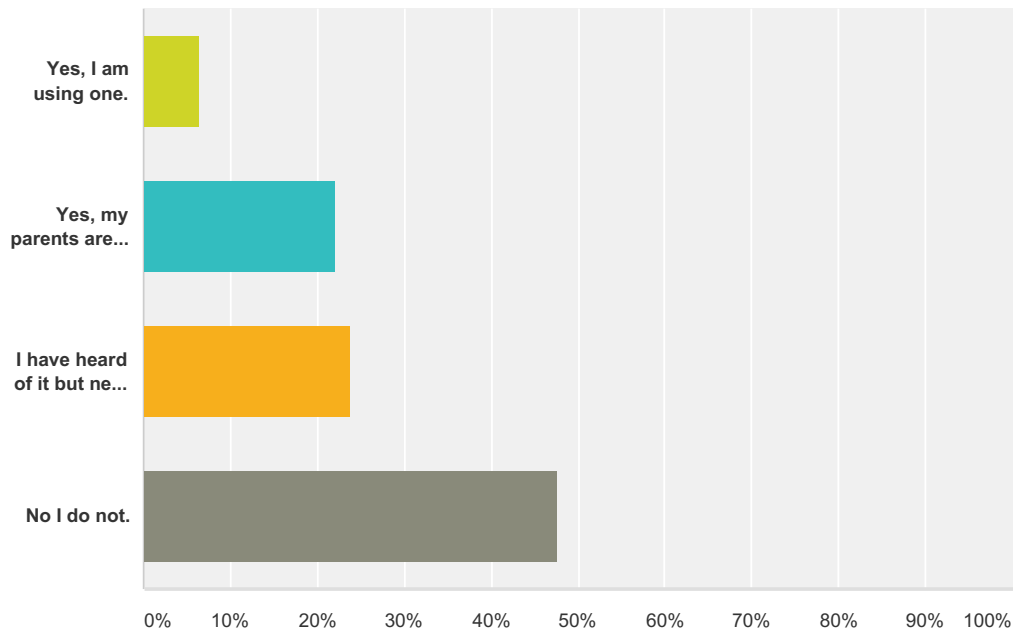

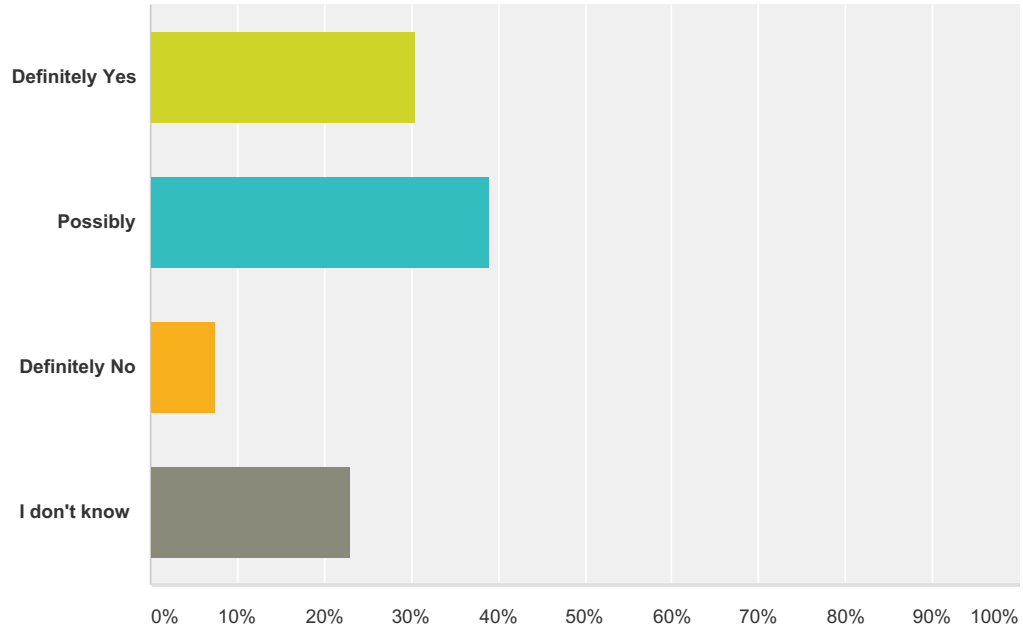

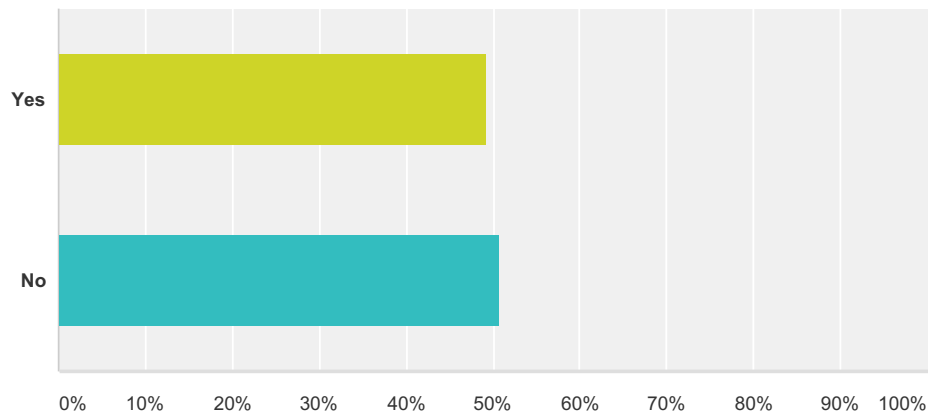

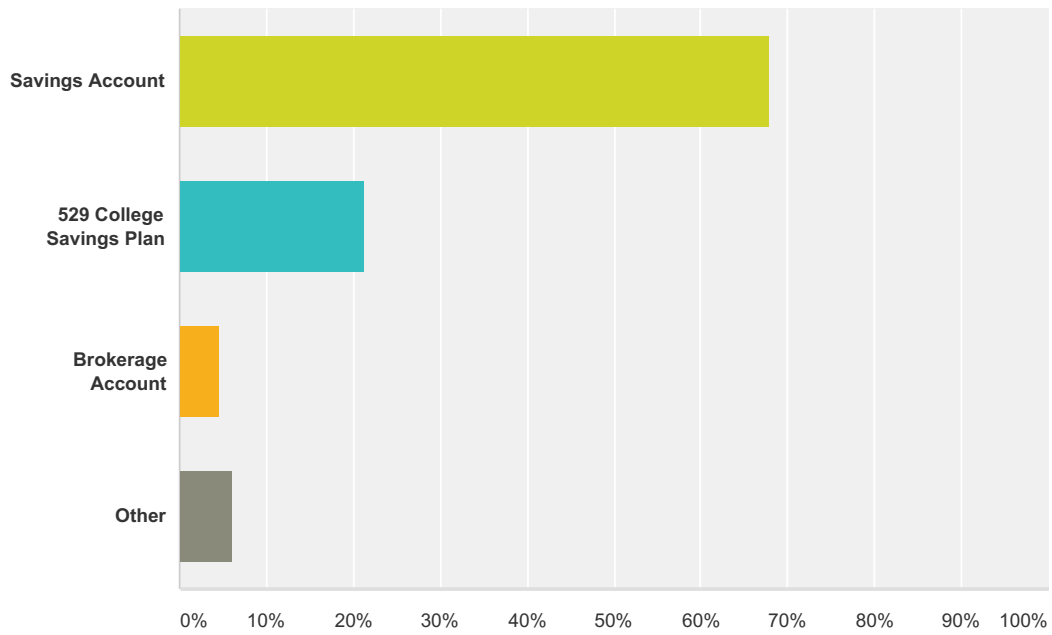

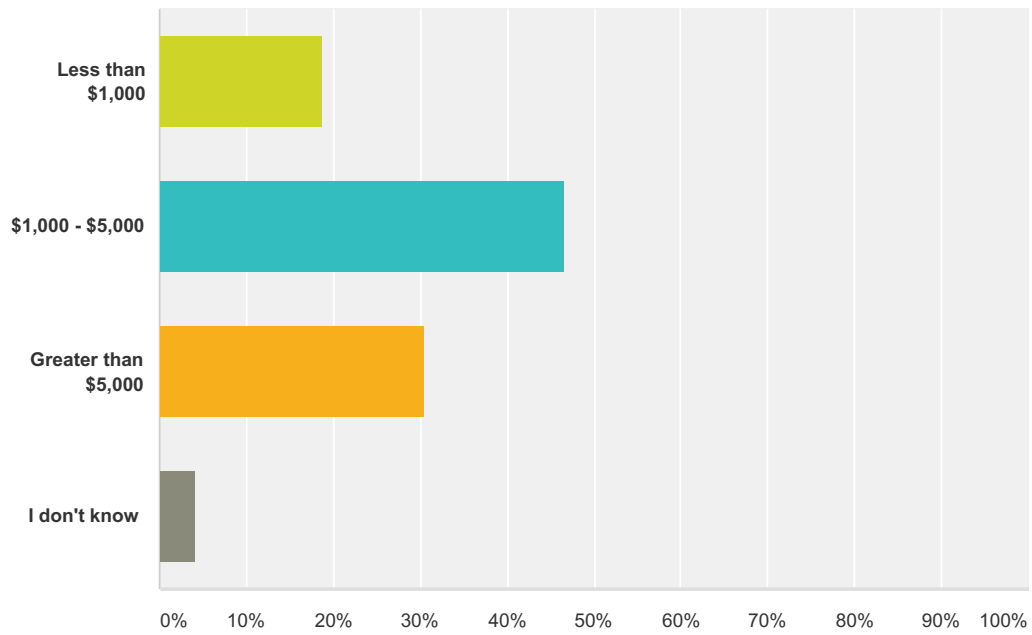

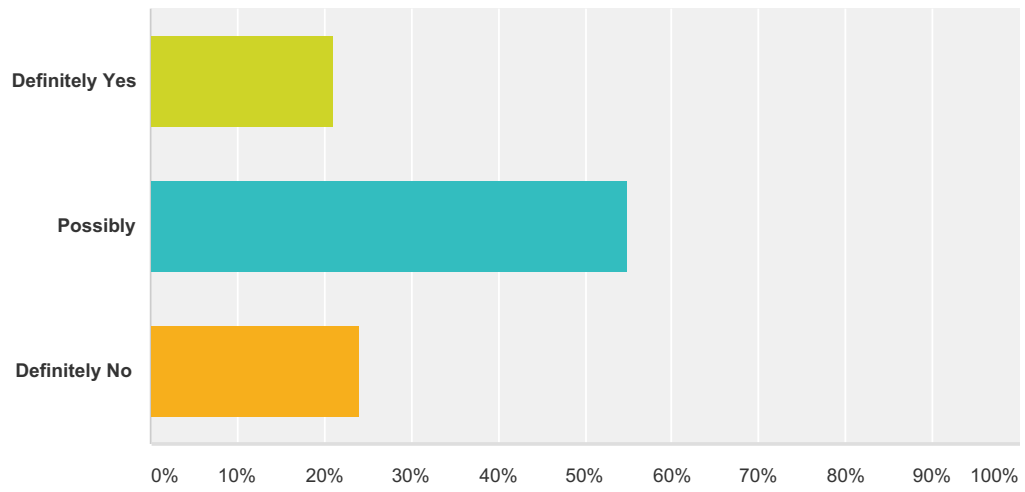

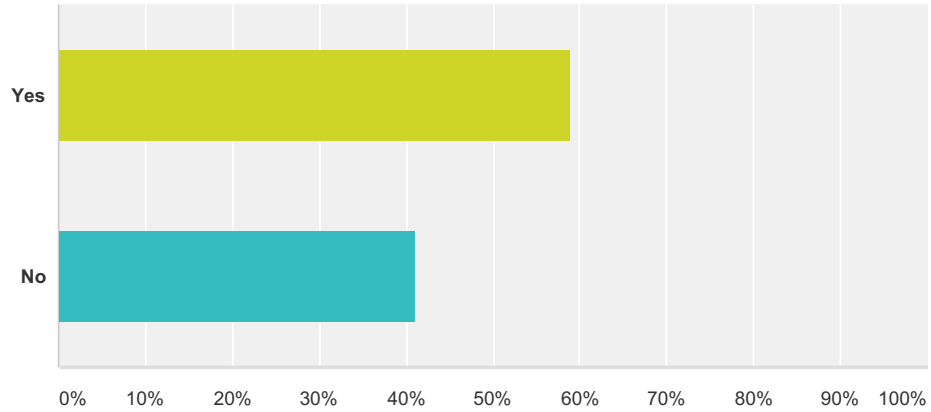

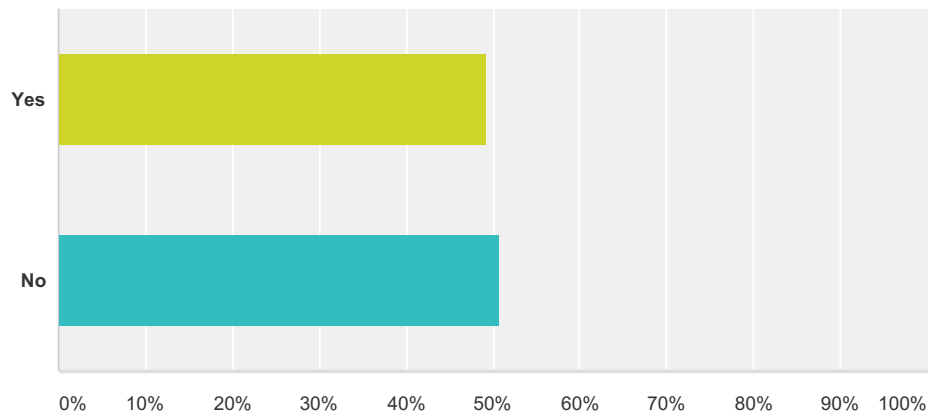

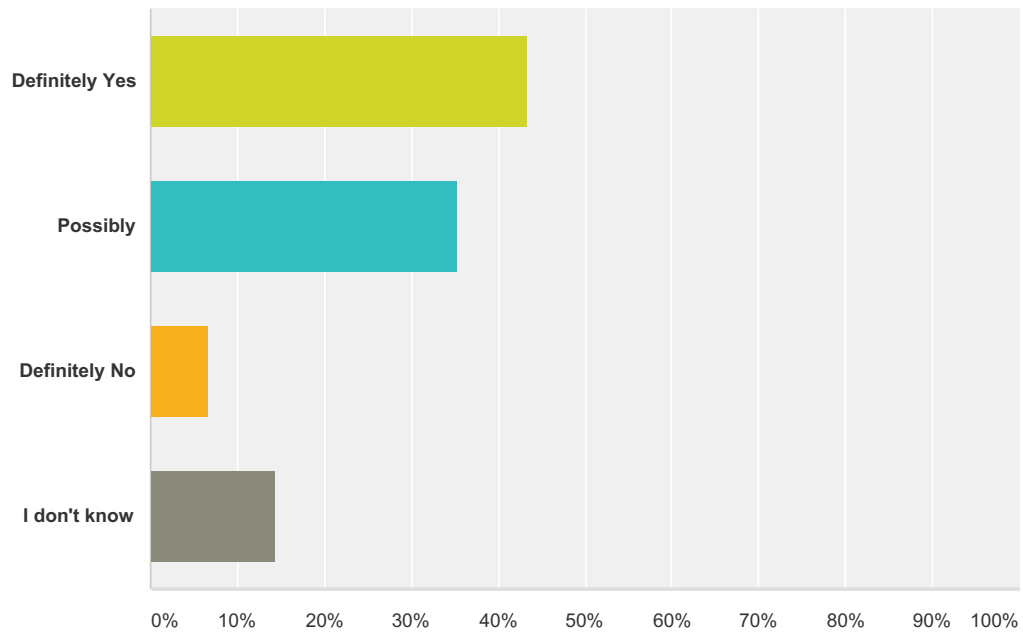

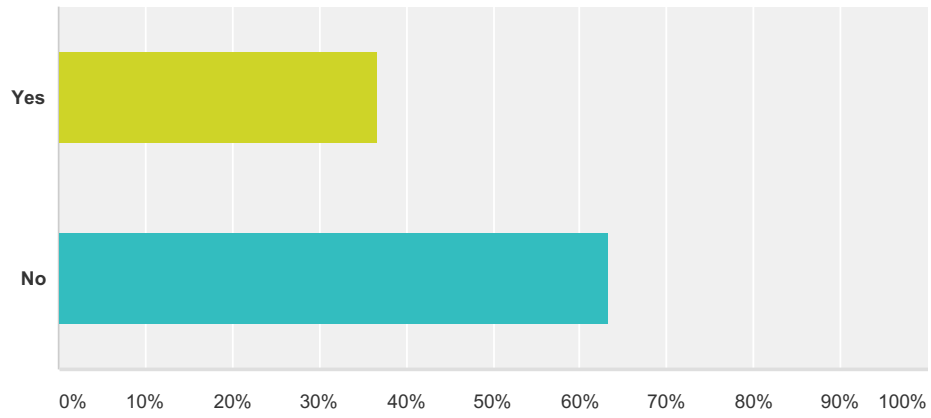

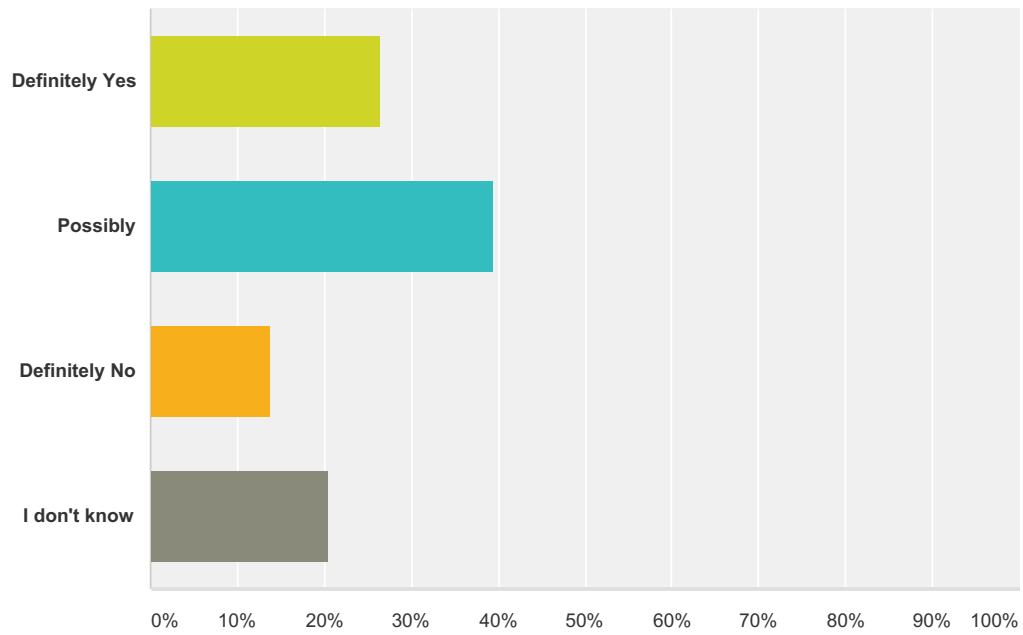

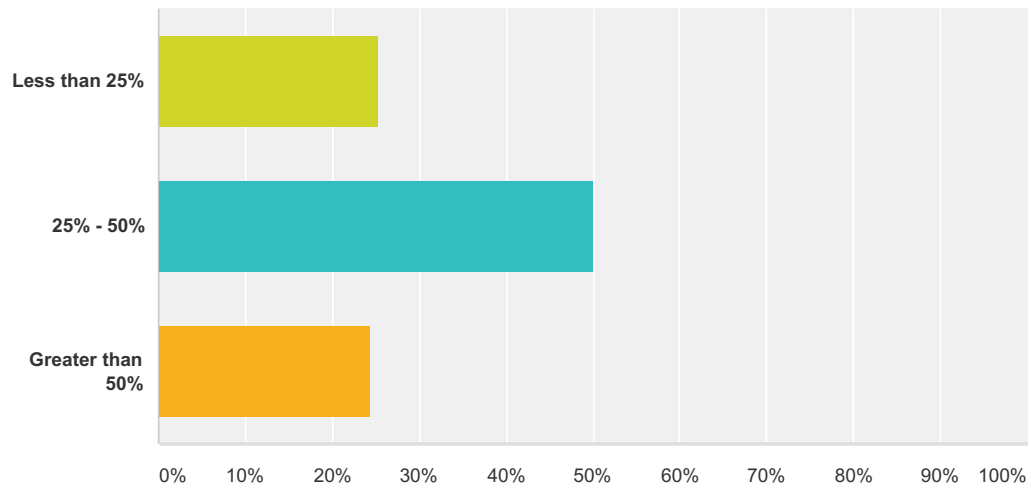

### Q30 What % of your total education costs do you plan on borrowing?

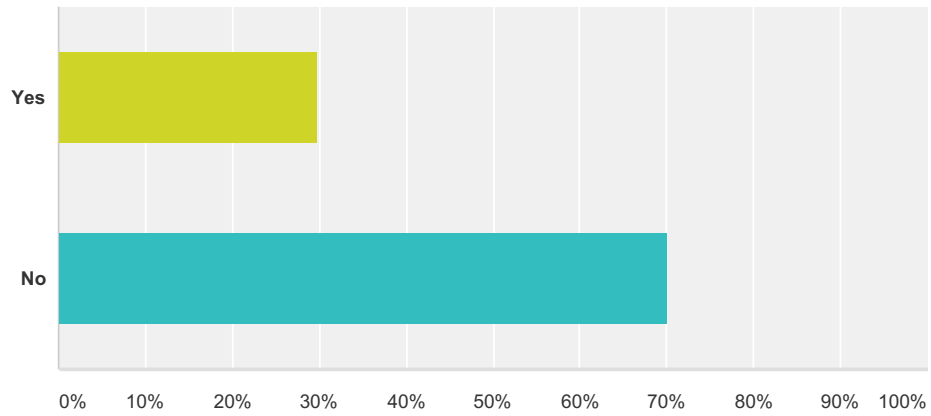

### Q31 Have you projected the total amount you will have borrow in order to graduate?

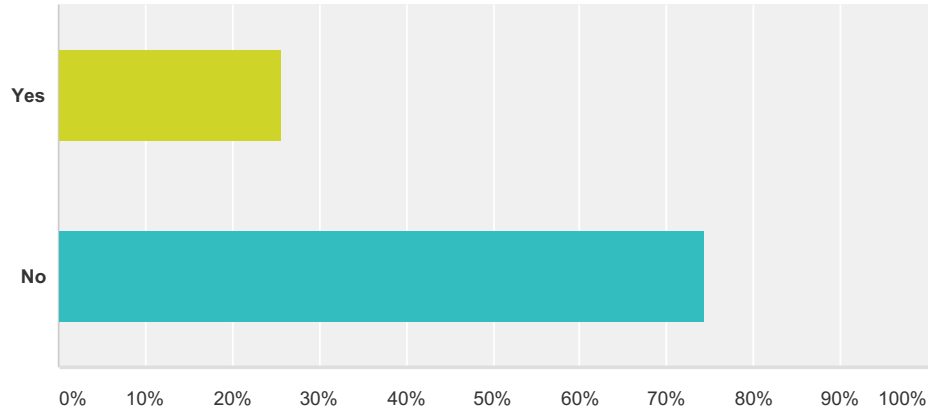

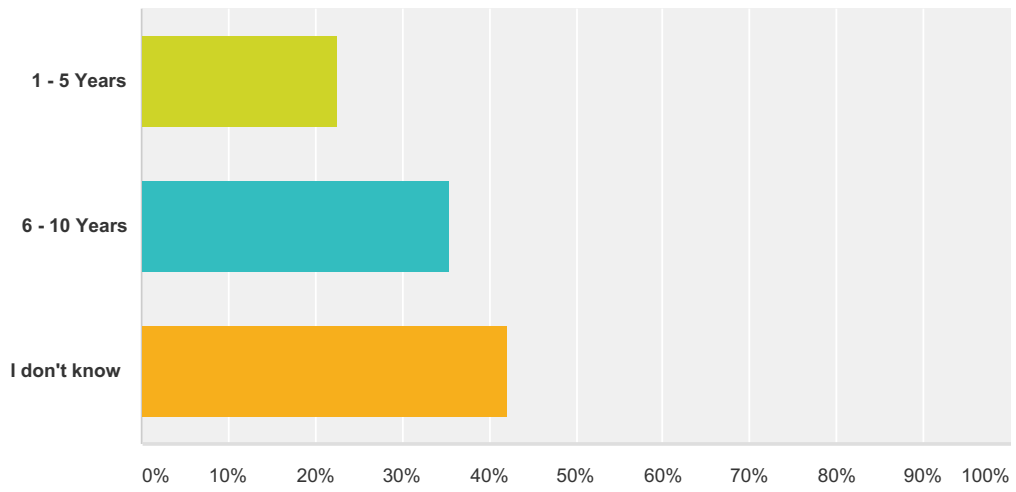

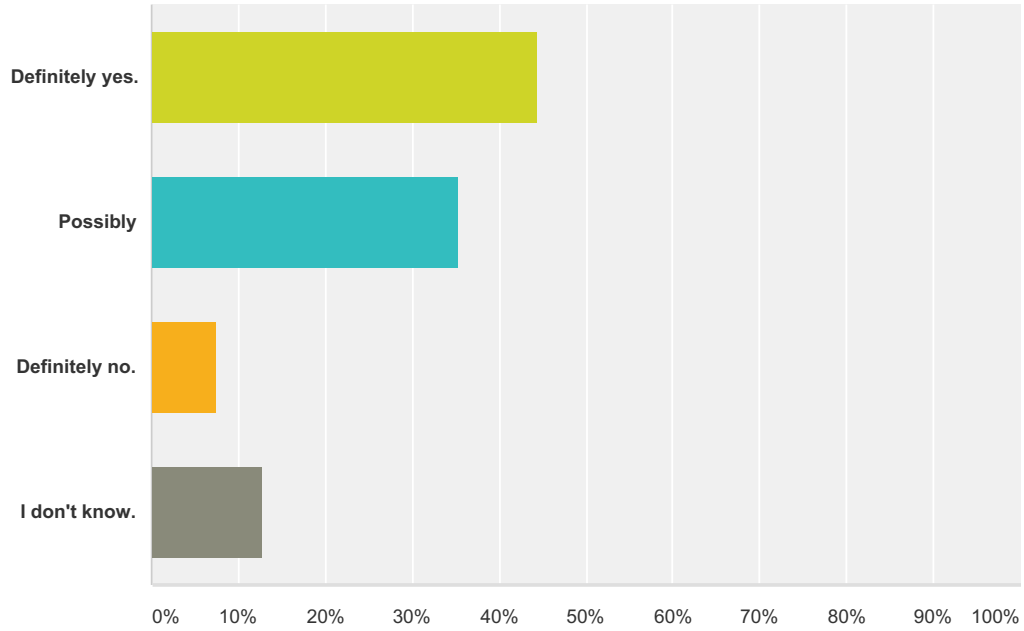

**Q34 Are you concerned with the debt burden you may be faced with after college or higher education?**

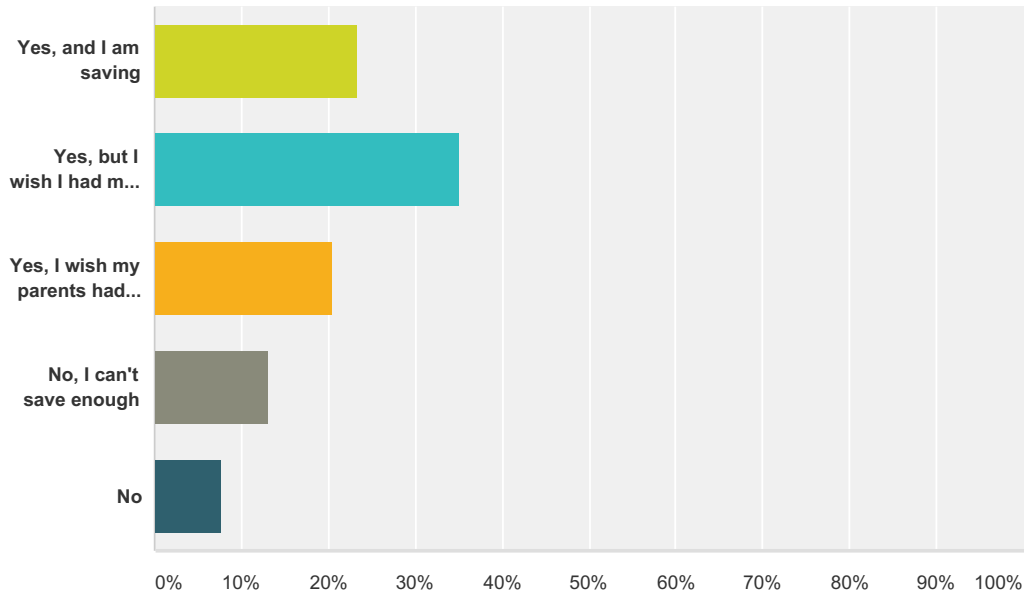

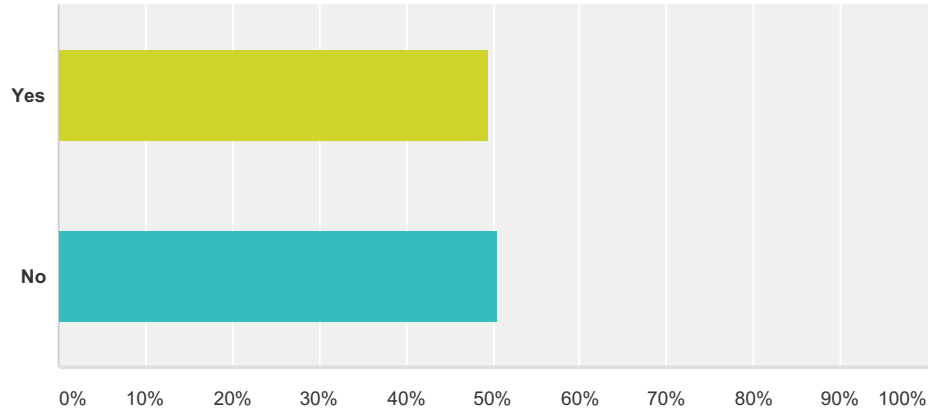

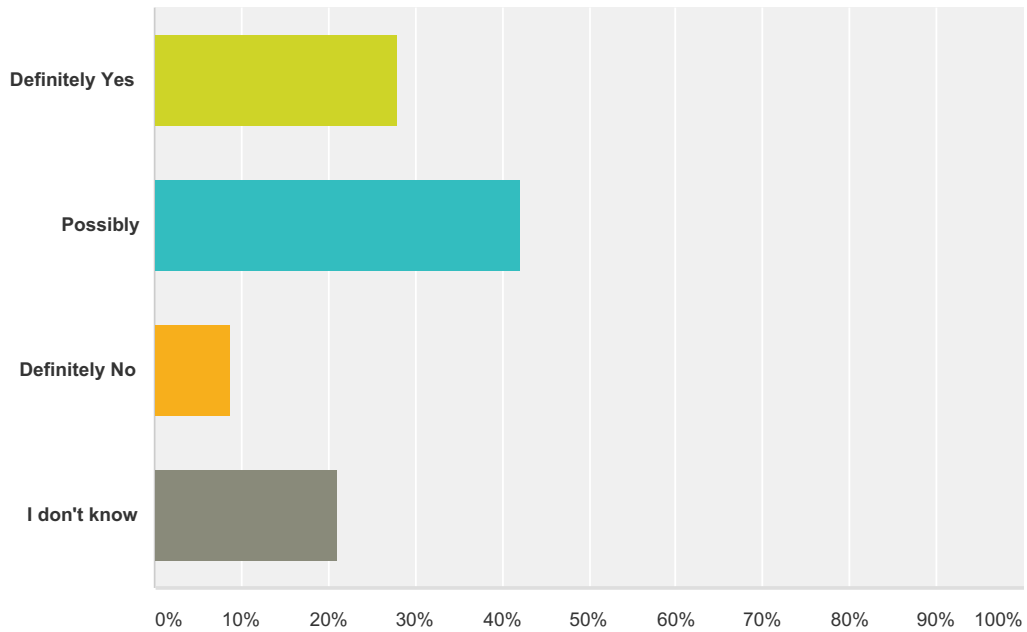

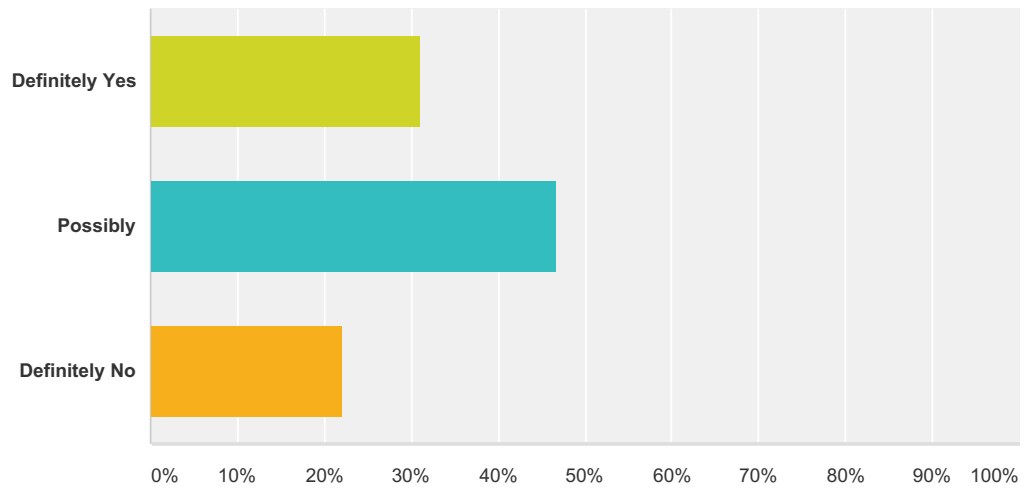

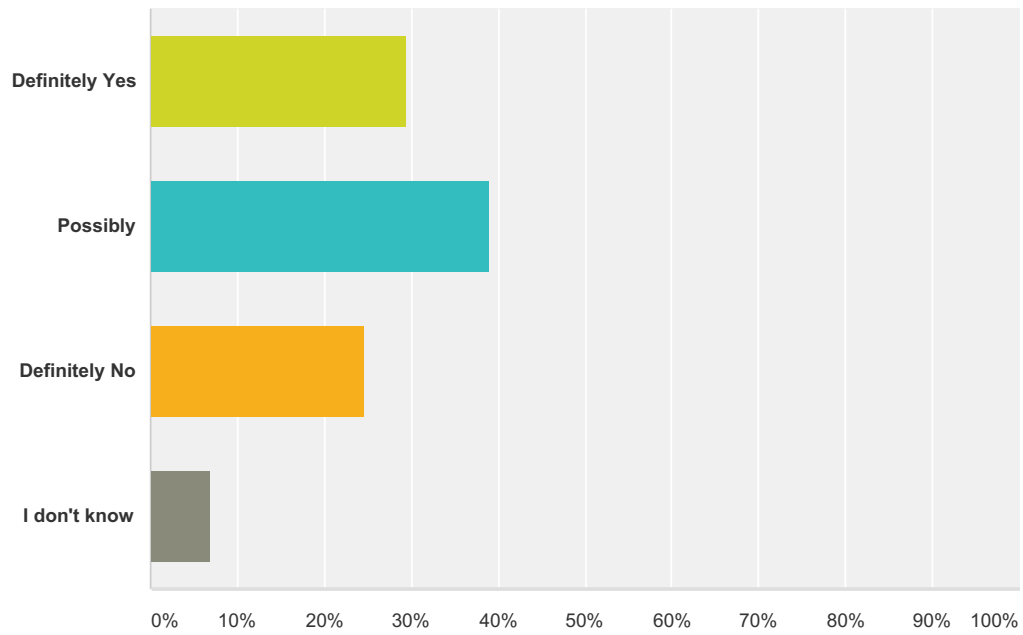

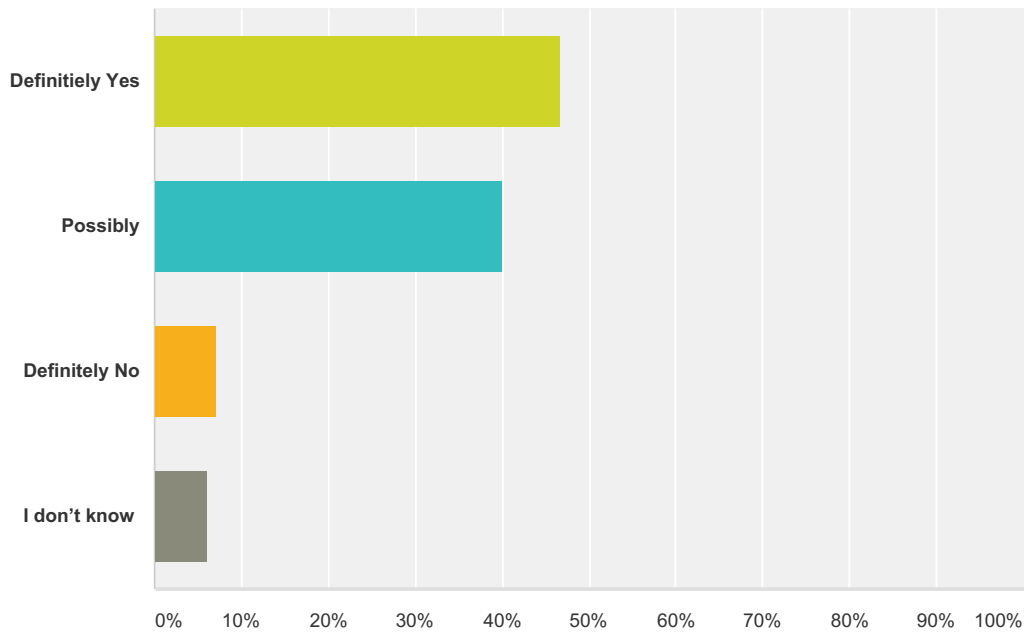

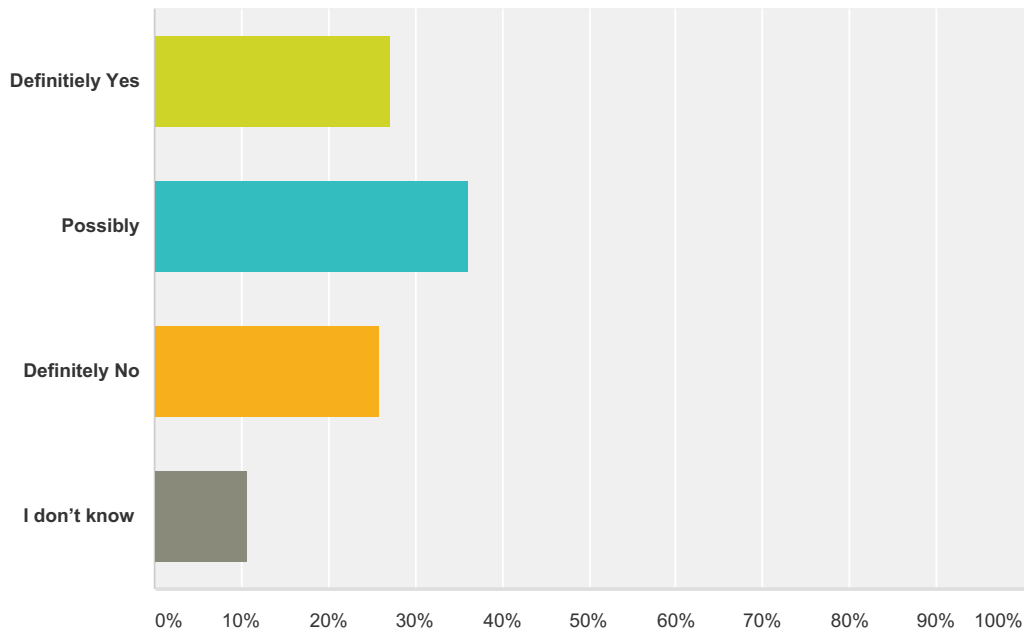

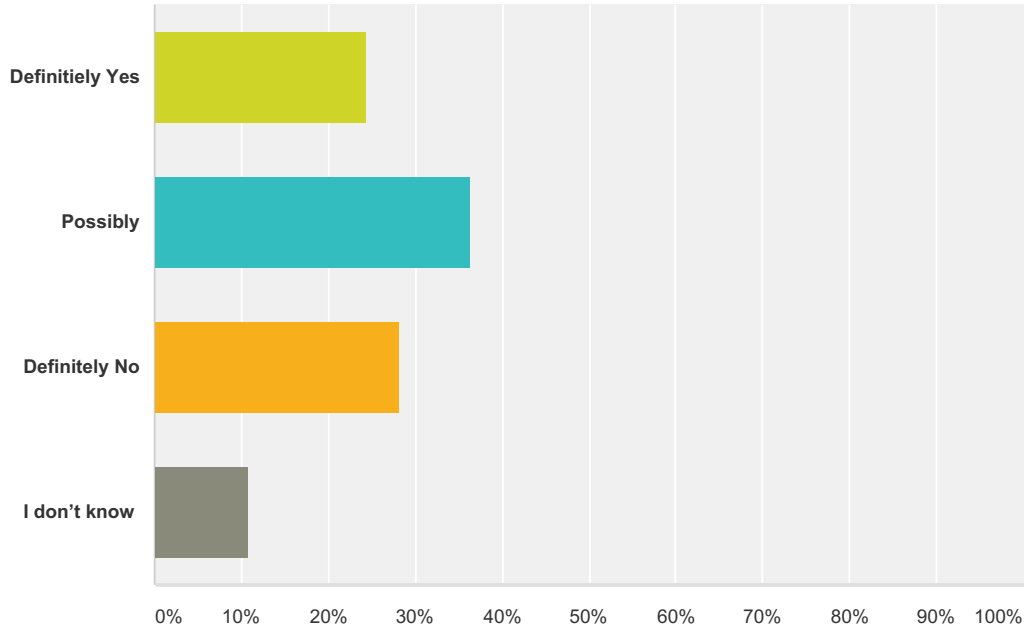

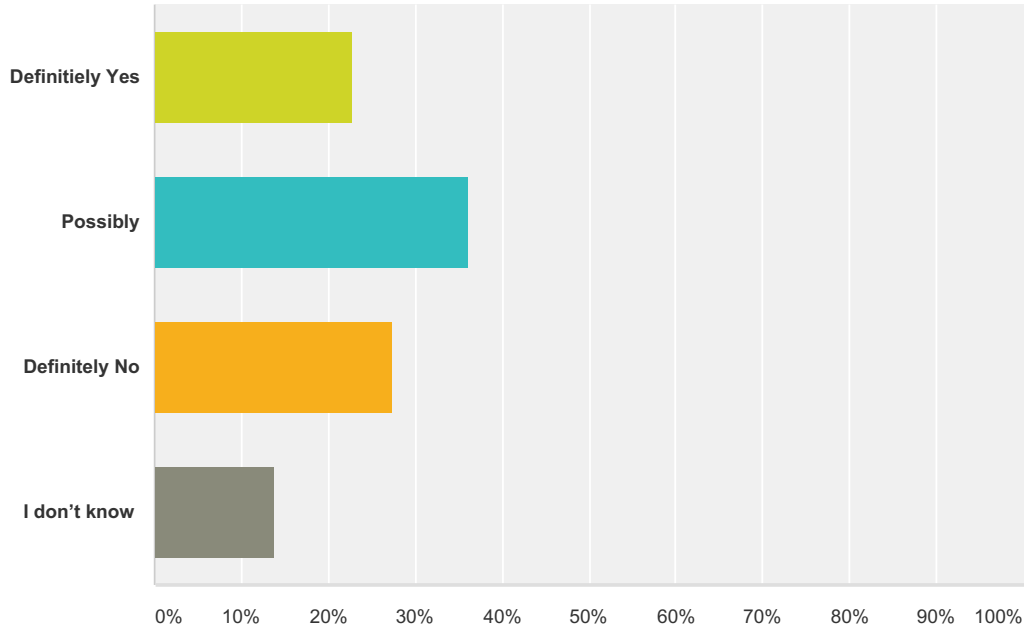

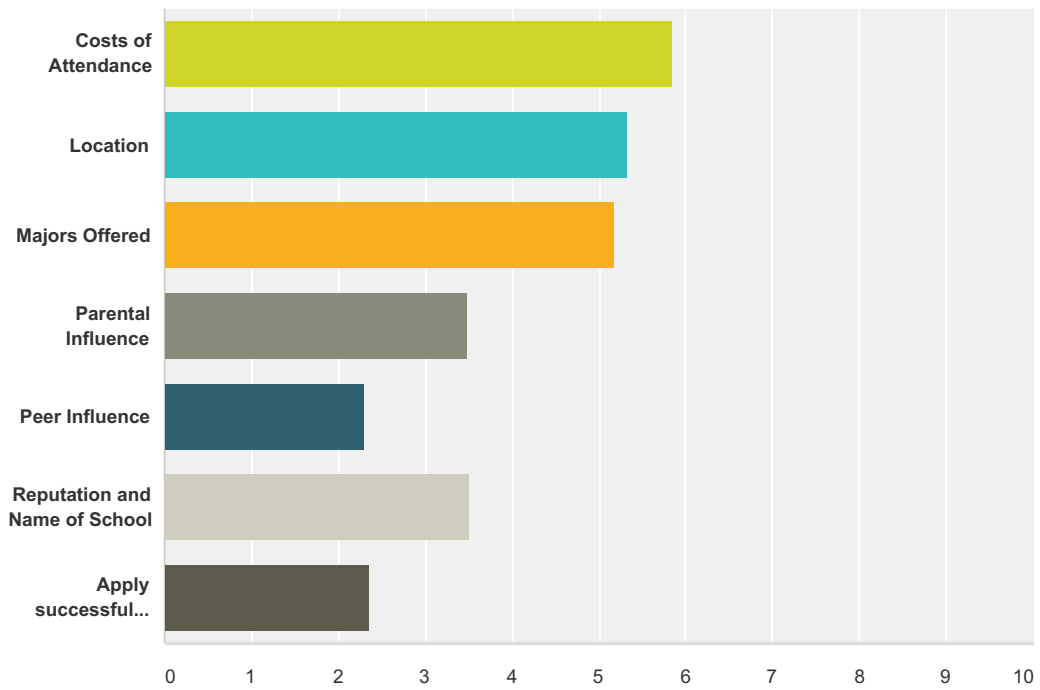

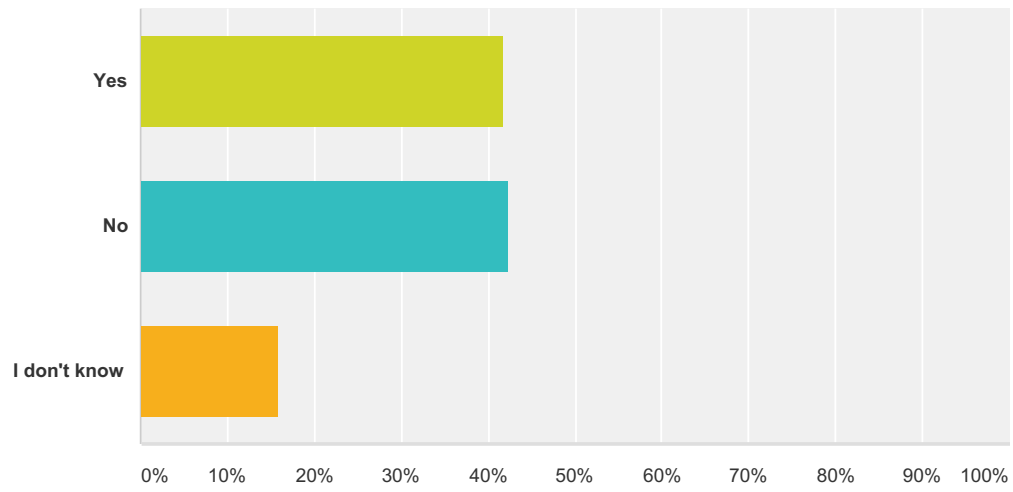

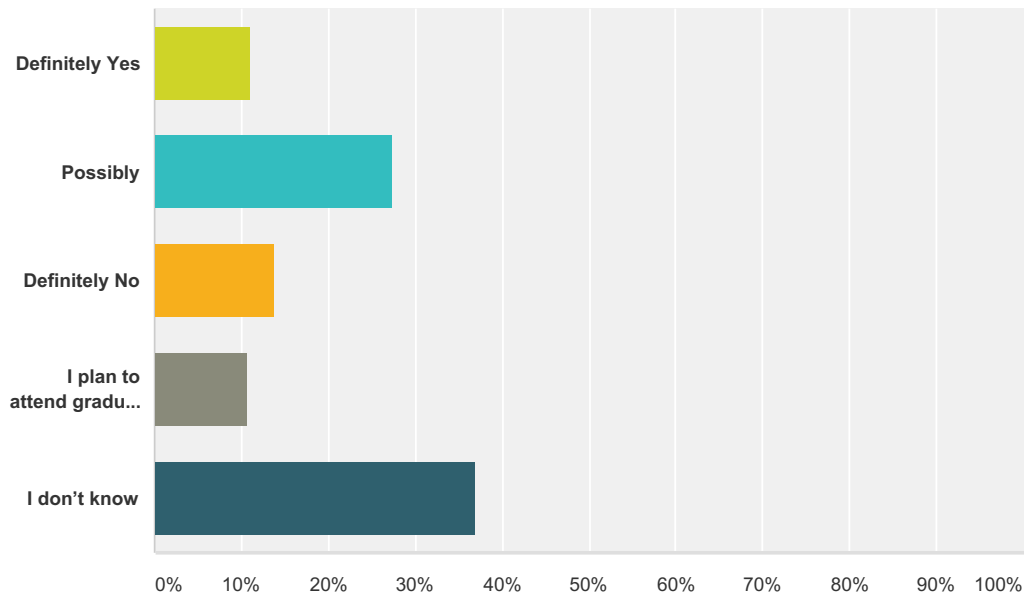

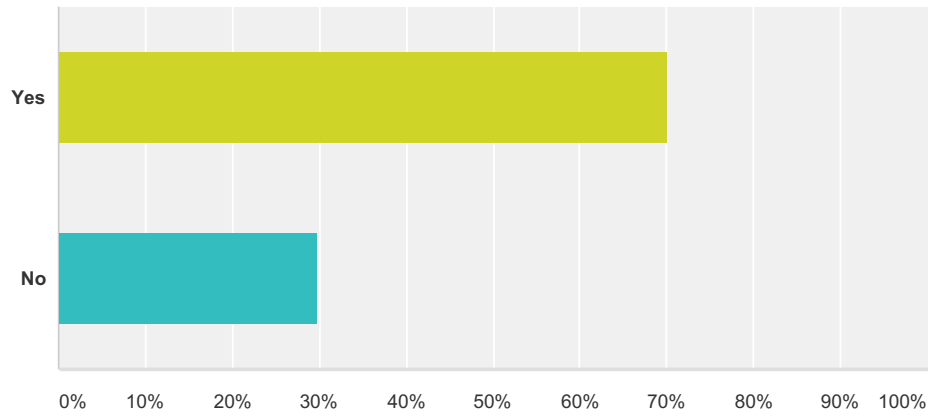

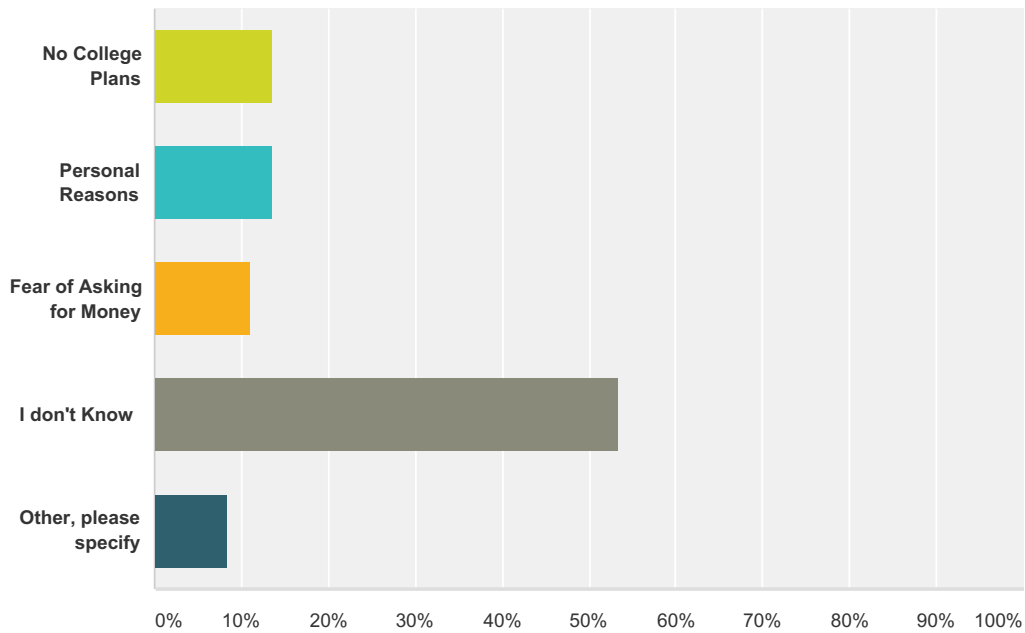

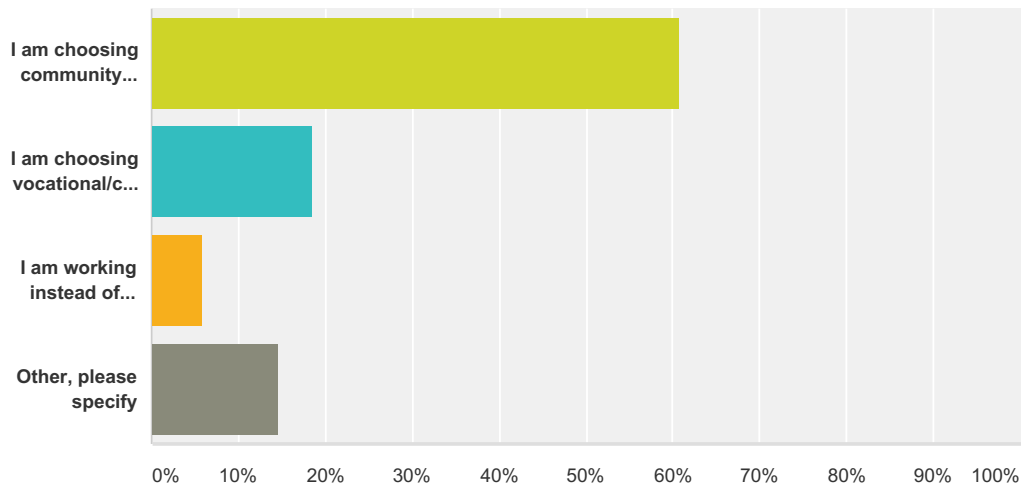

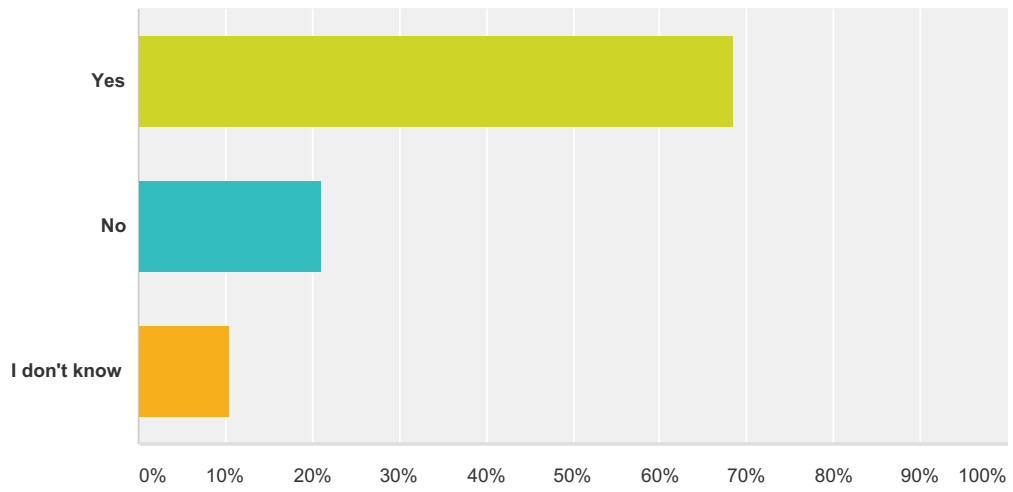

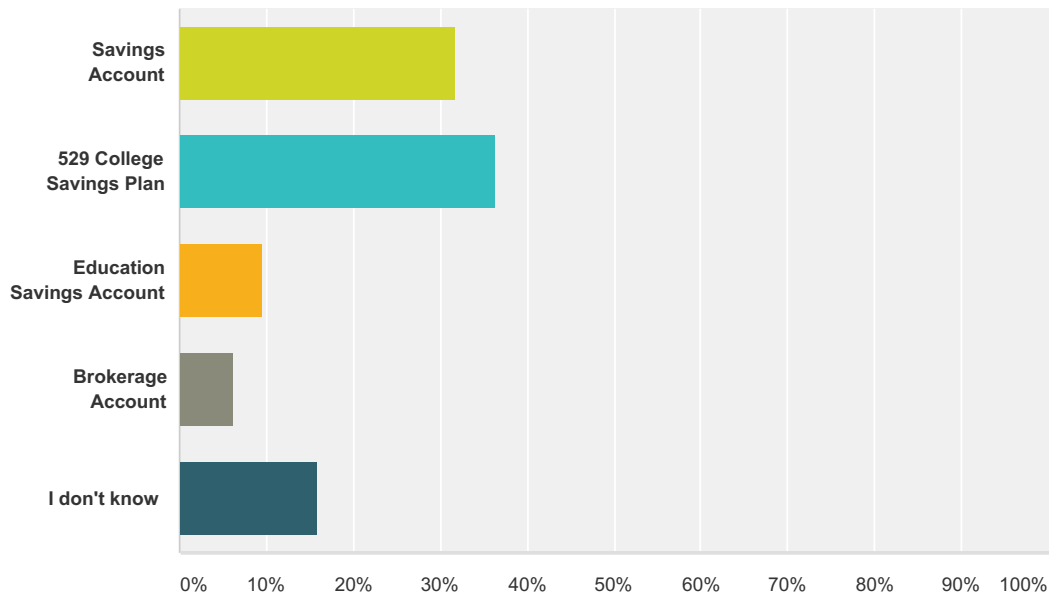

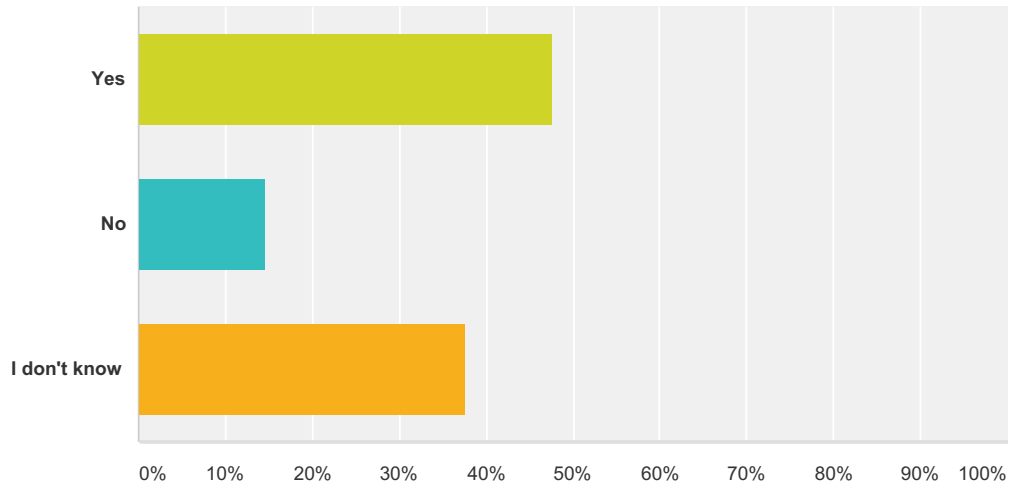

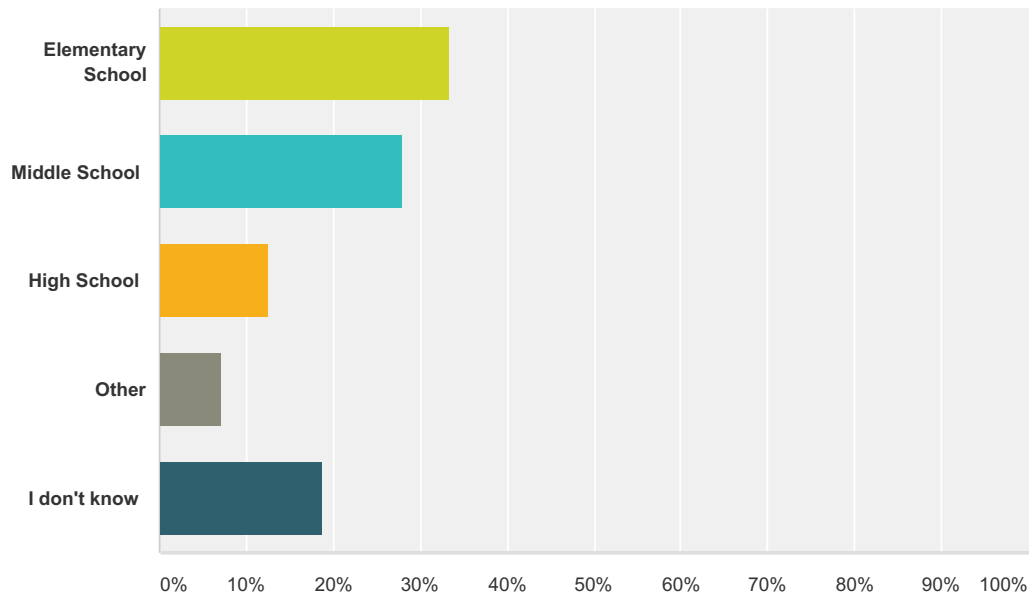

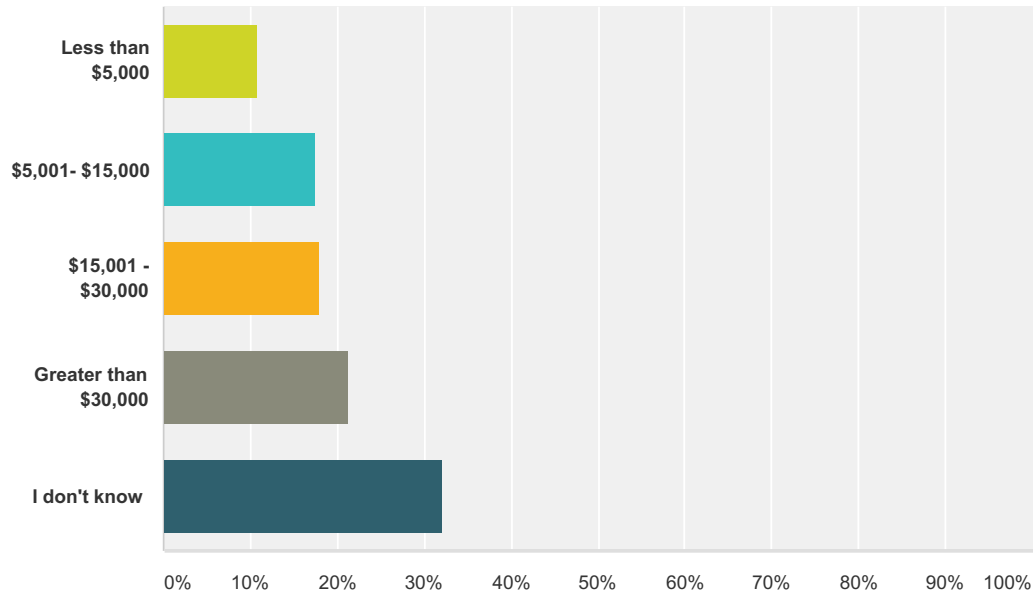

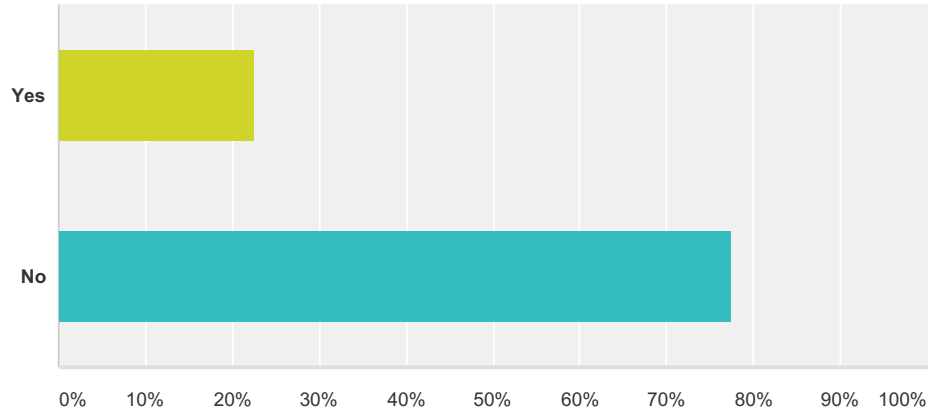

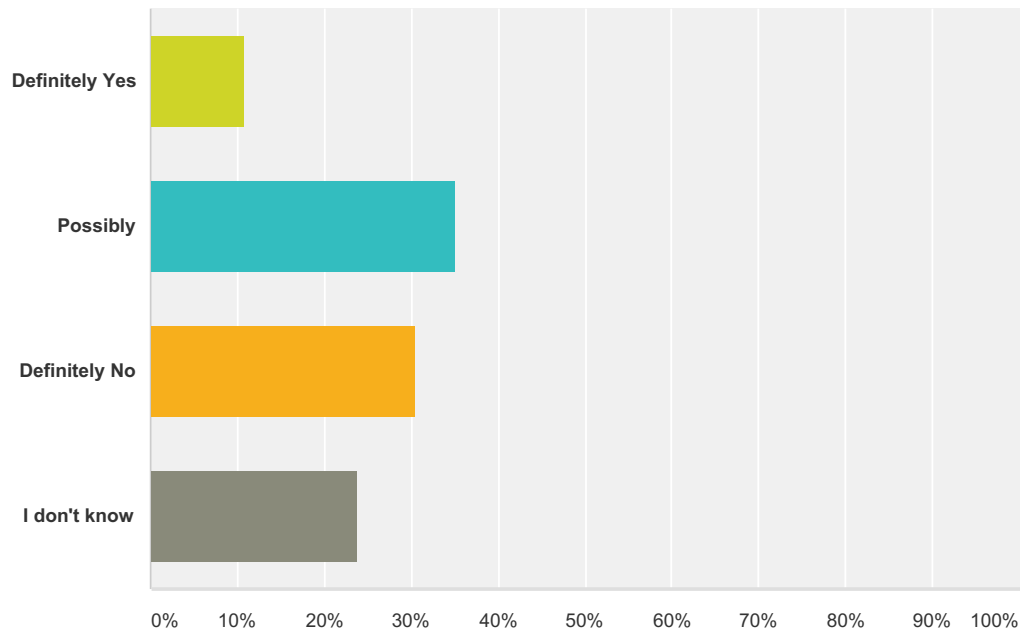

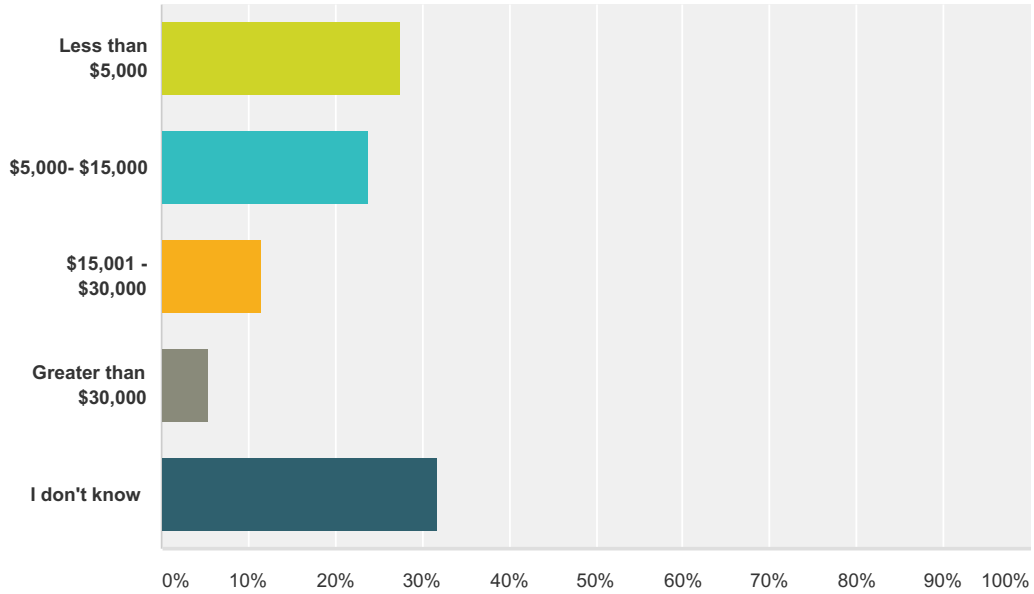

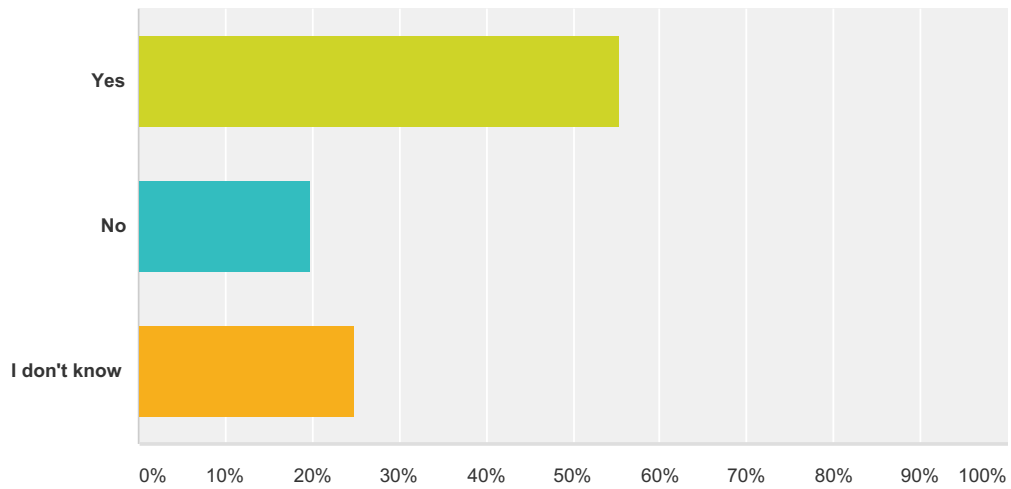

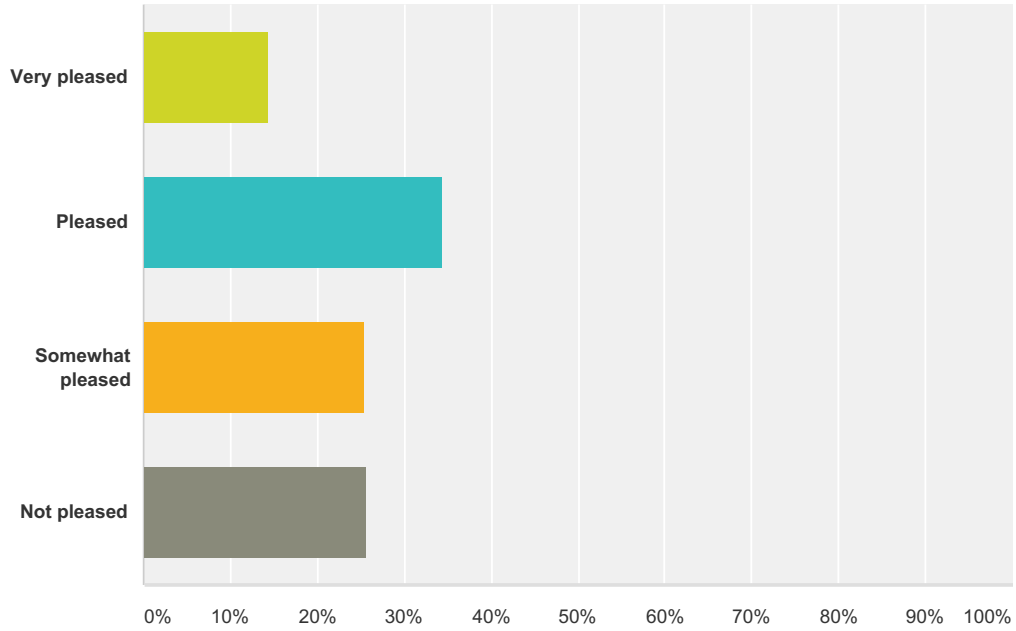

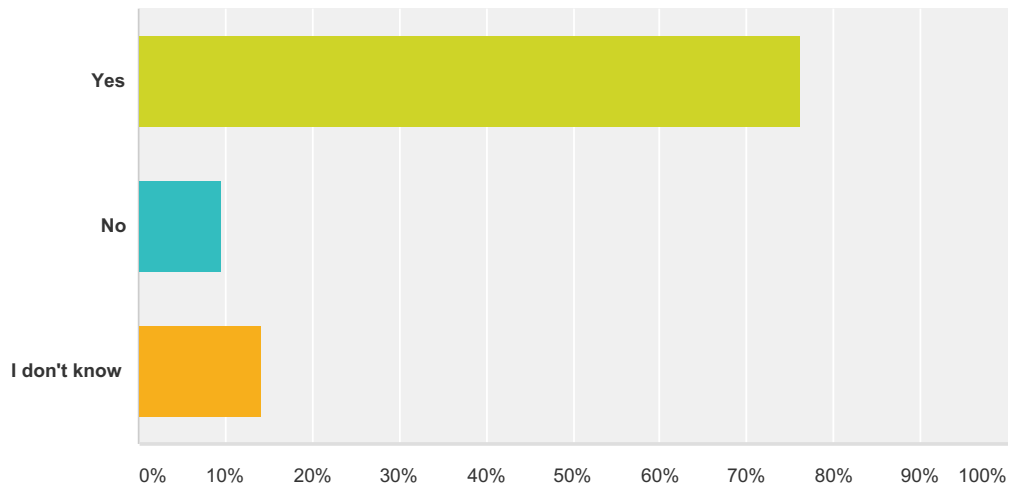

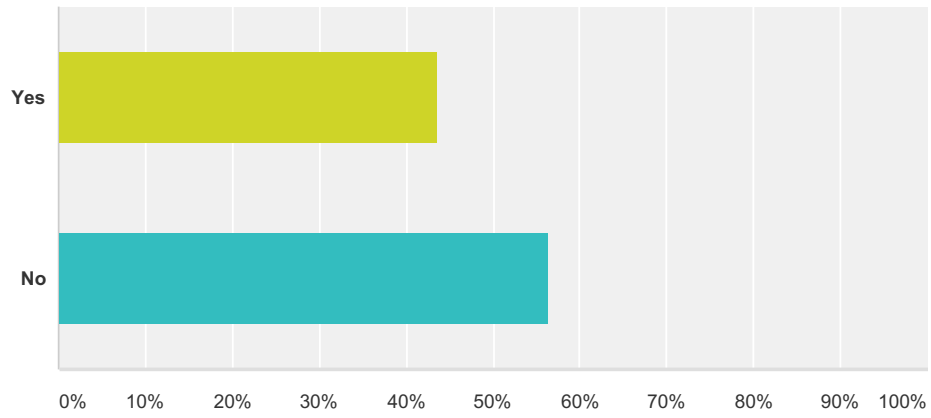

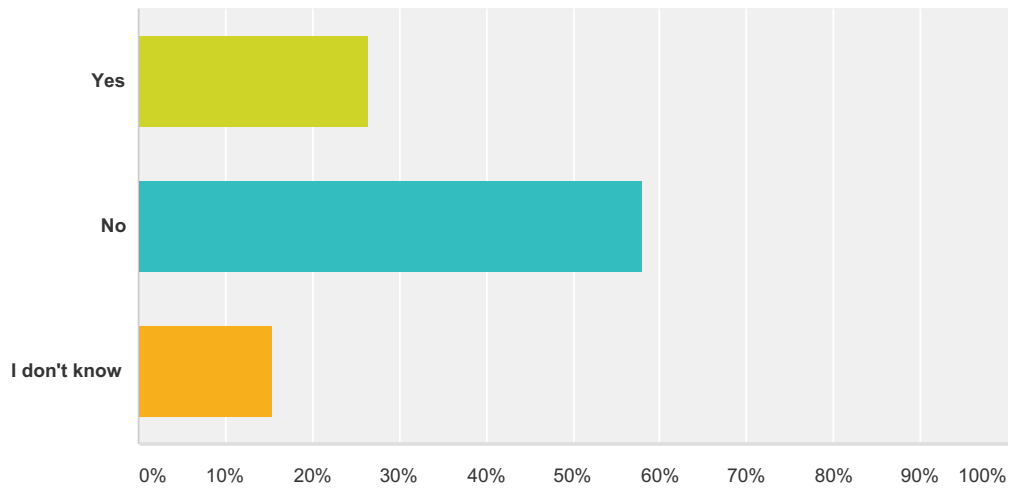

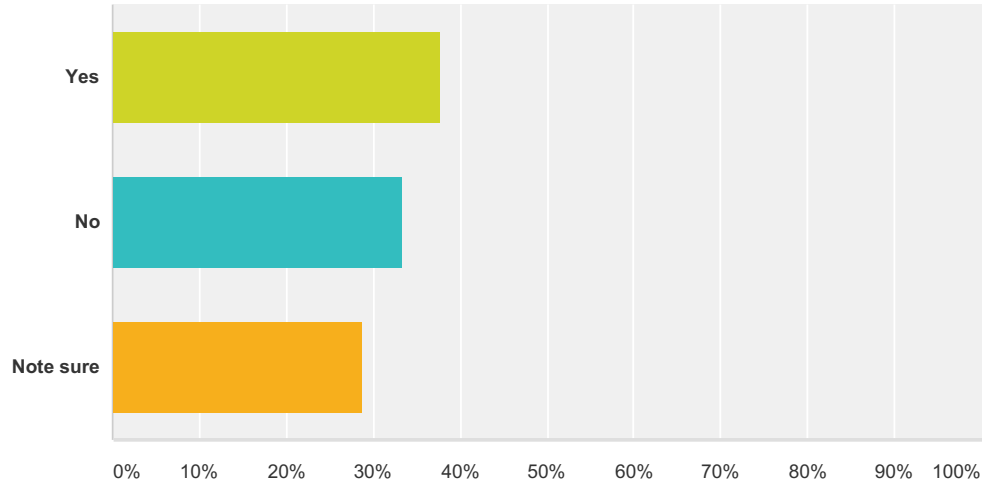

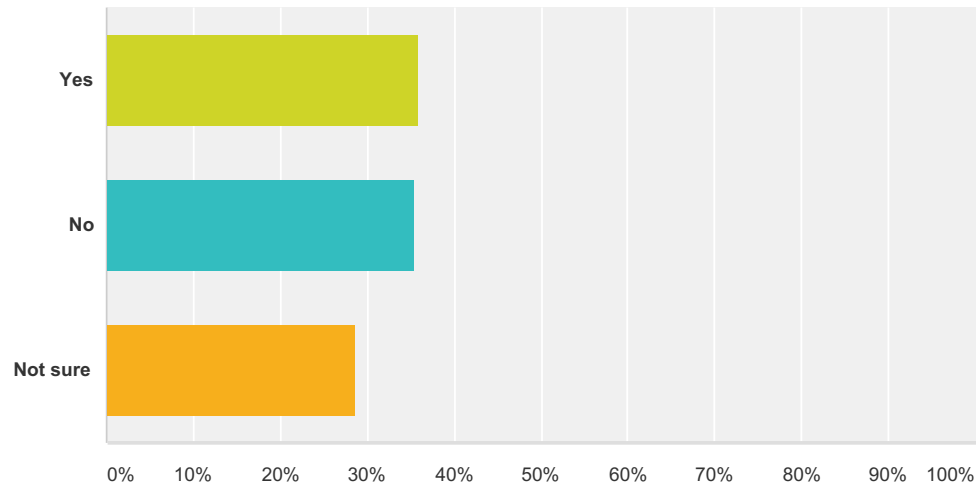

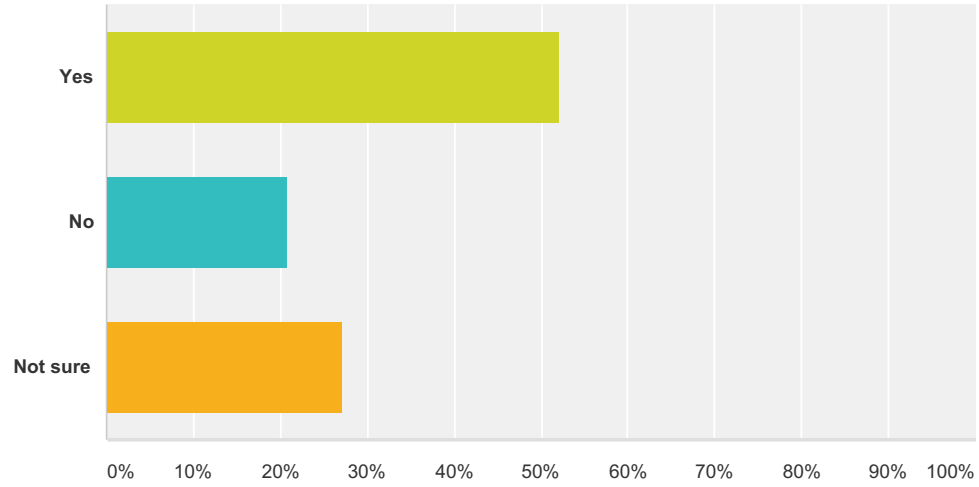

**Q67 Do you wish that your current high school offered financial literacy to you and your family to prepare you for college costs?**

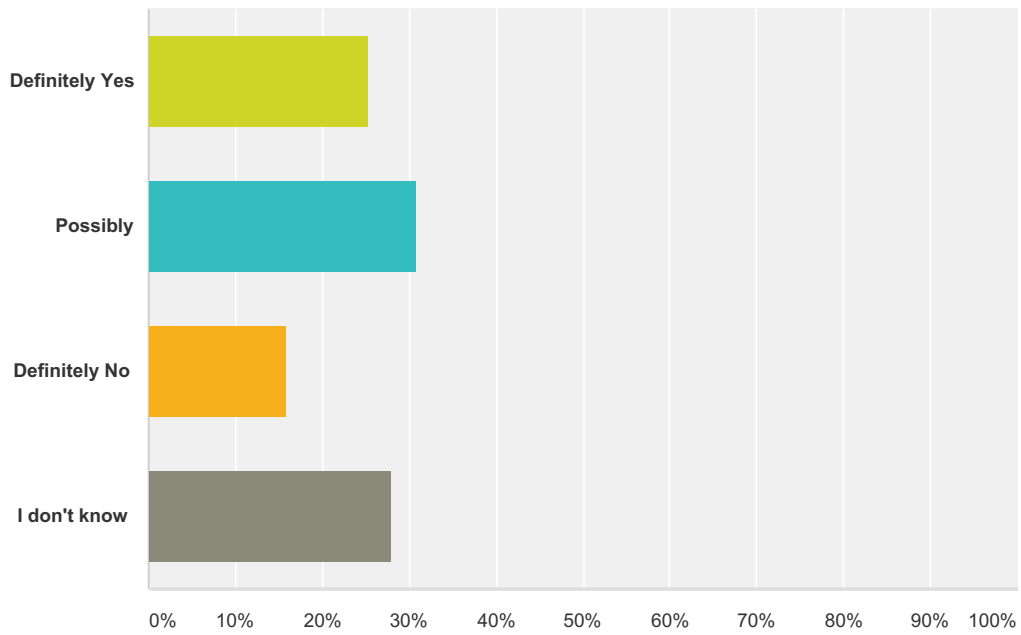

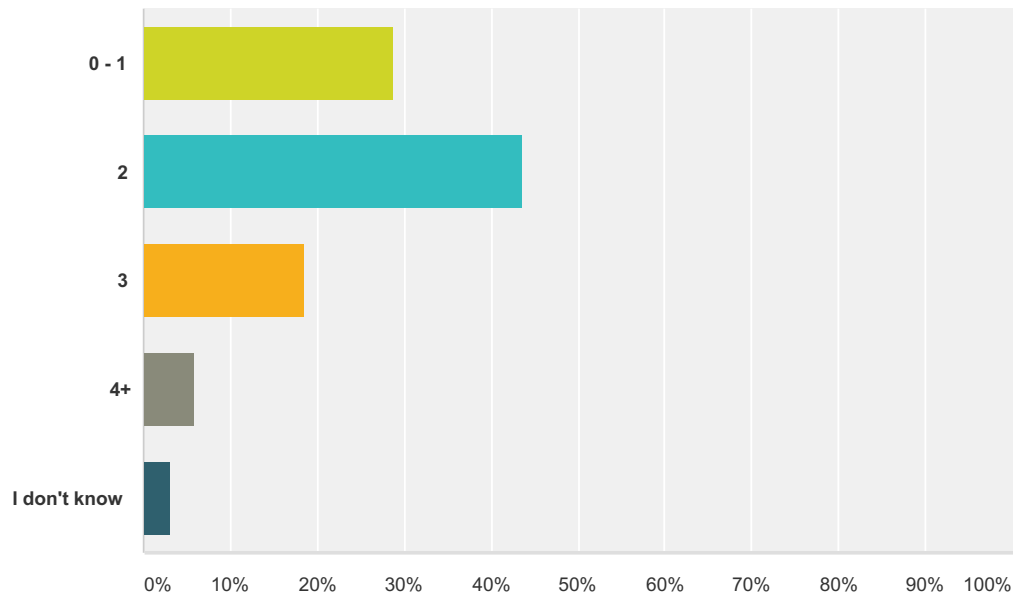

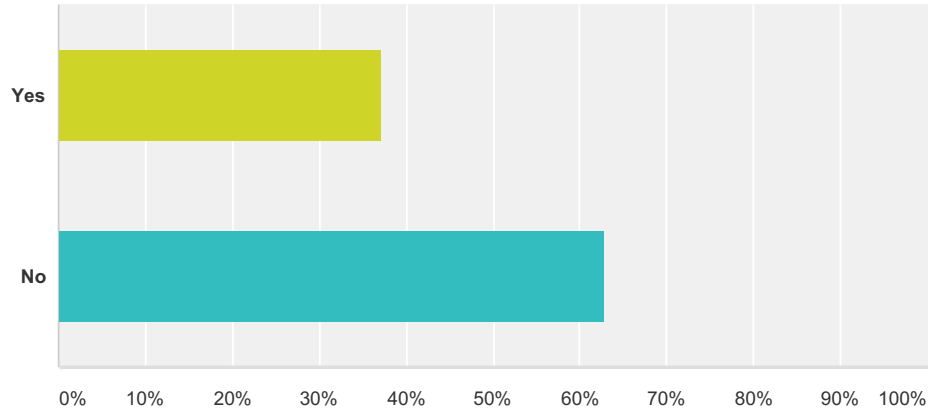

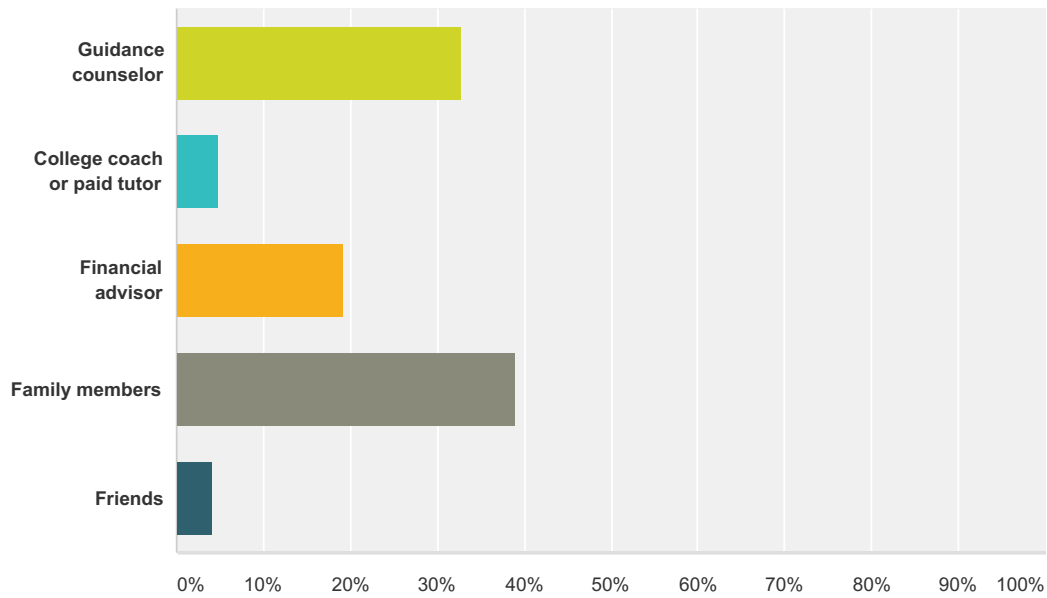
