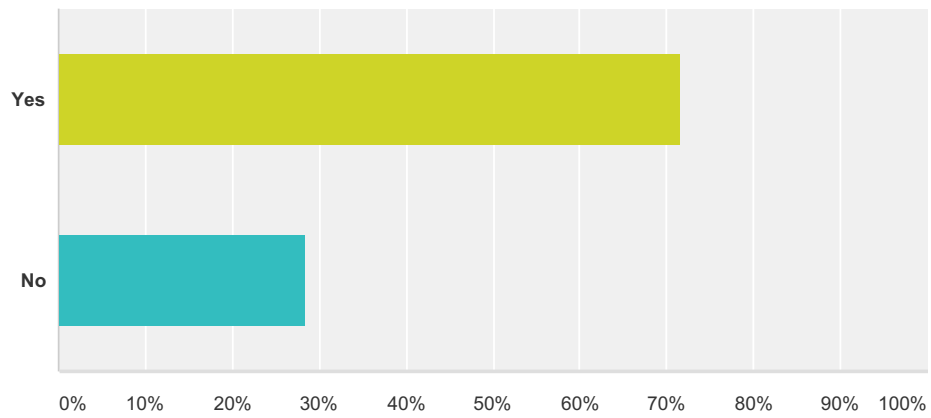

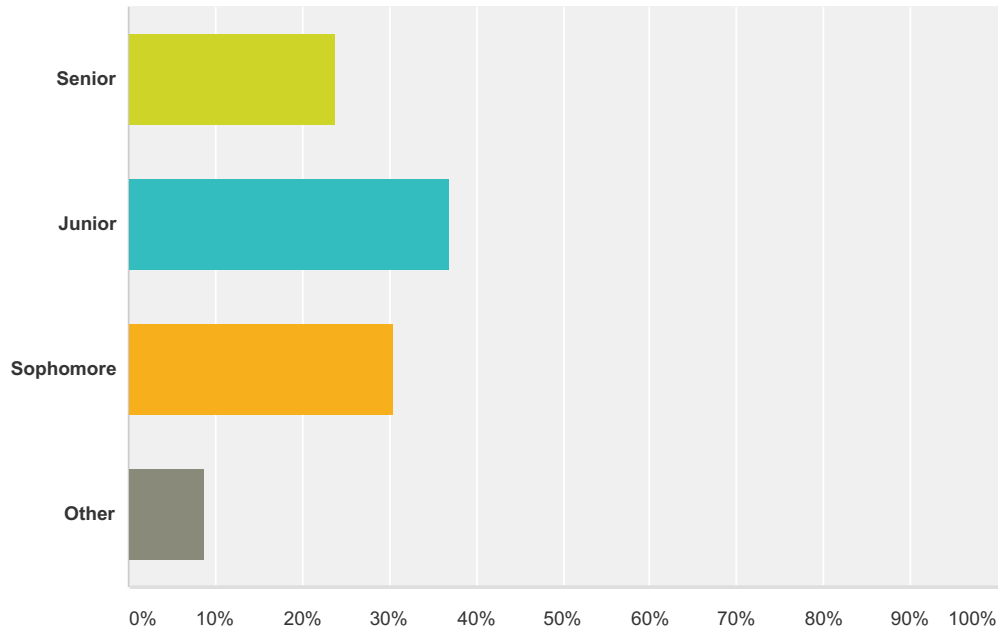

Q2 What year are you in high school?

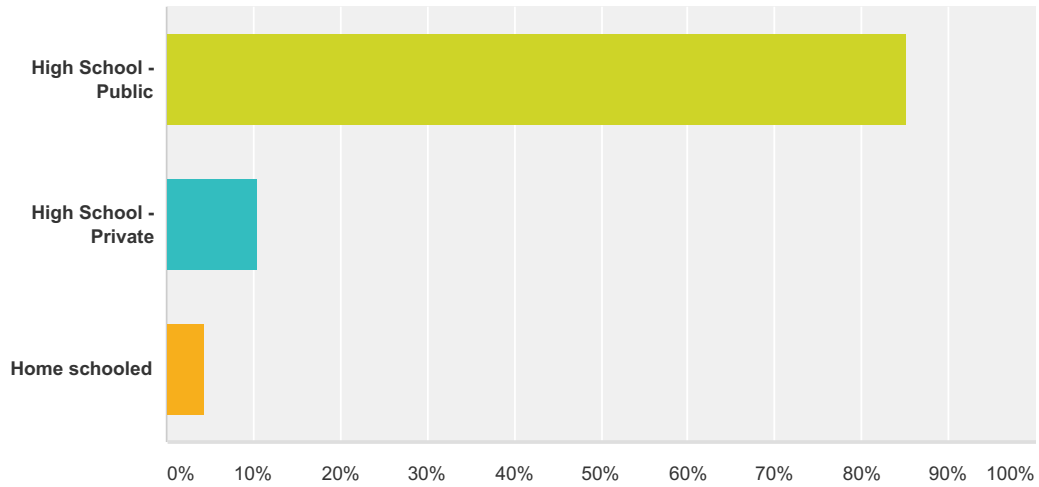

Q3 What is your education to date?

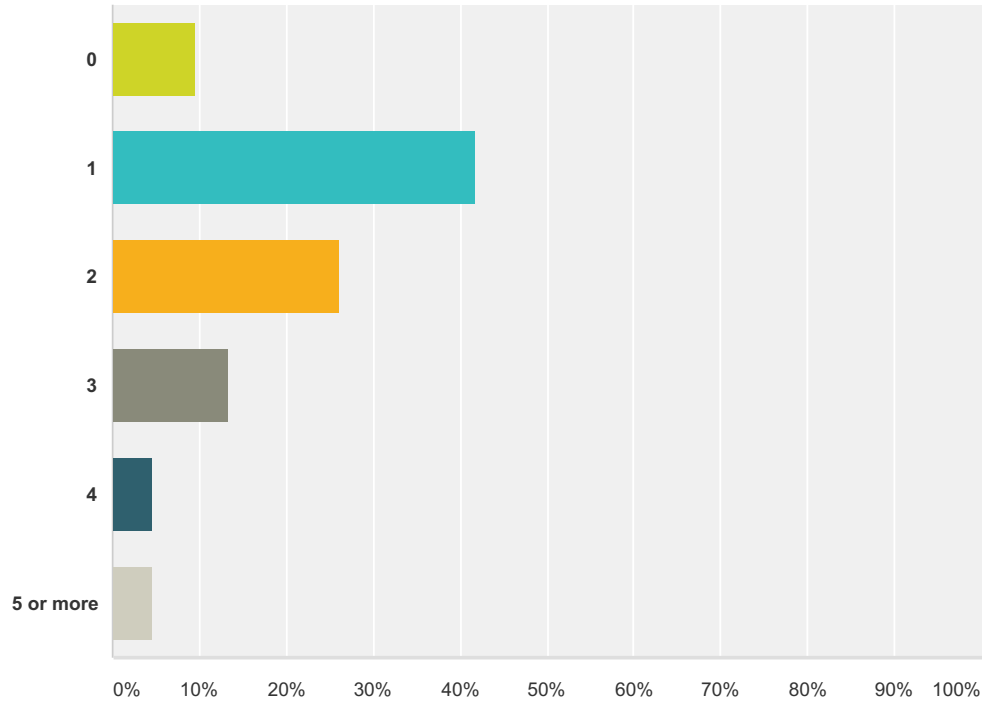

Q4 How many siblings do you have?

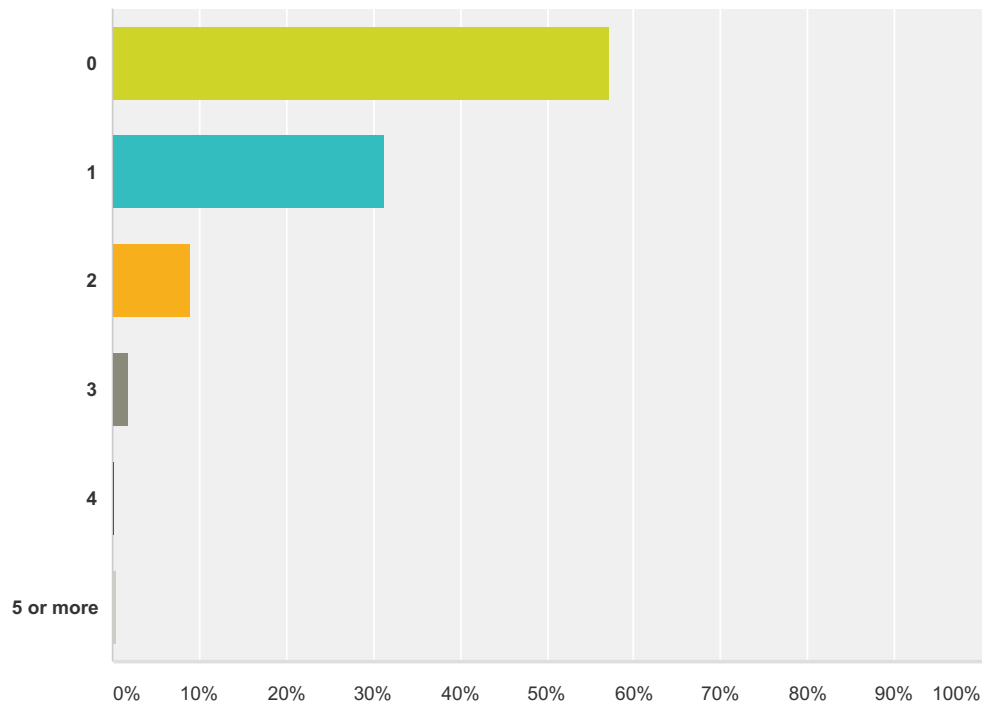

Q5 How many siblings do you have in or within one year of college or career school?

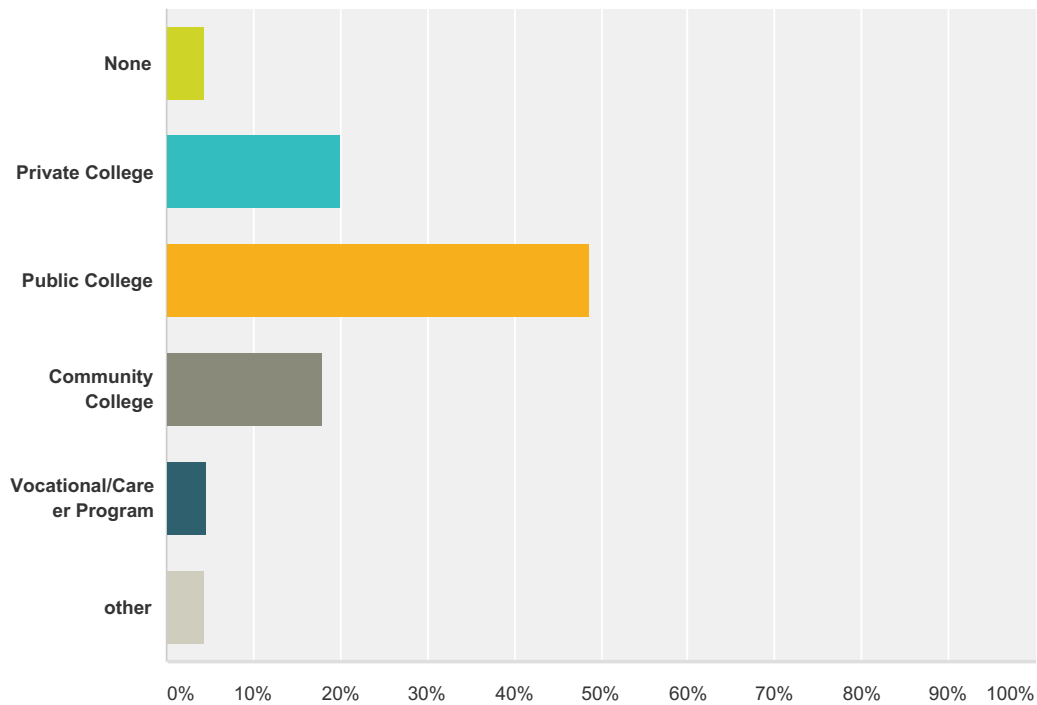

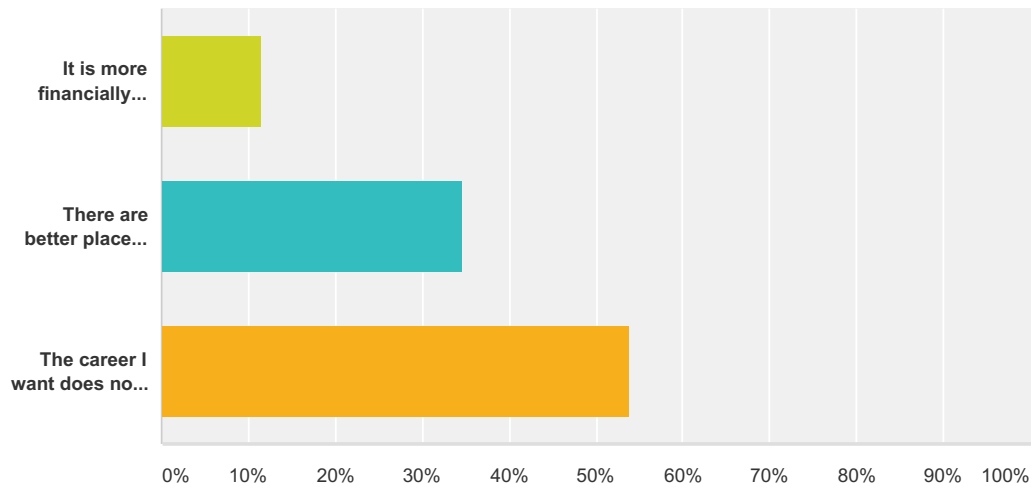

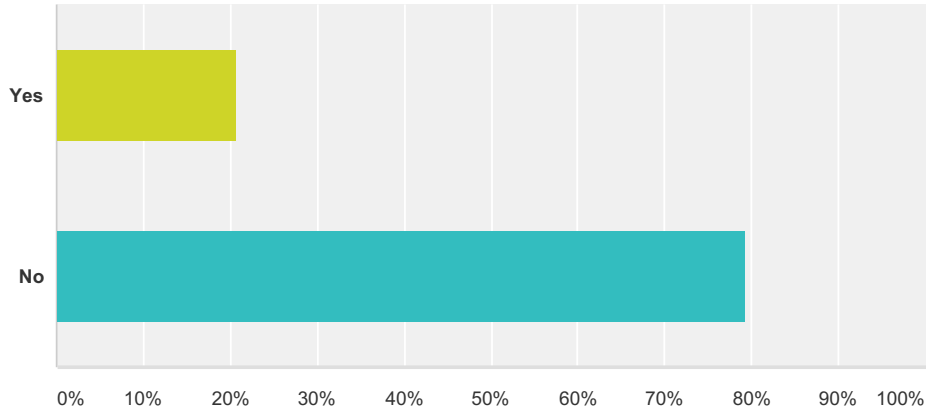

Q8 Q. When thinking about college, do you think of vocational and career schools in the same way that you think about public or private colleges?

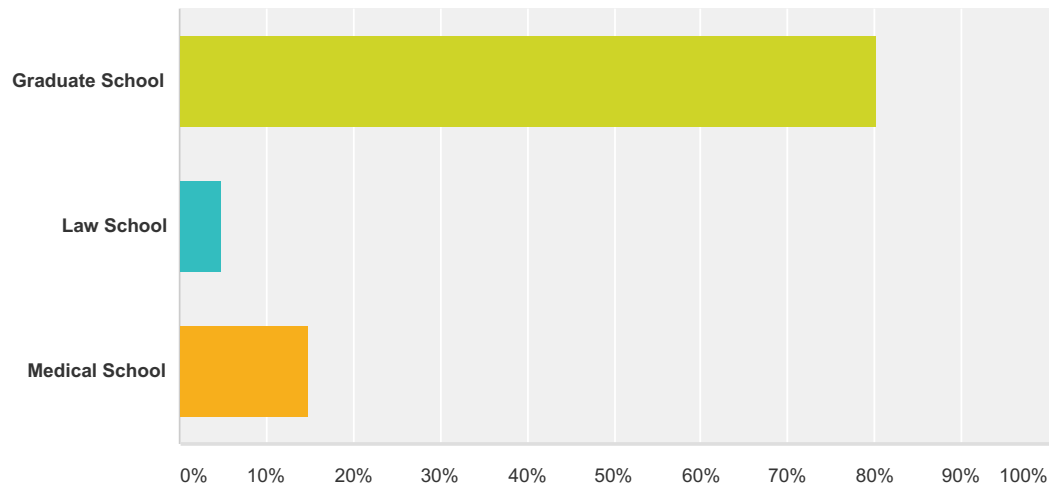

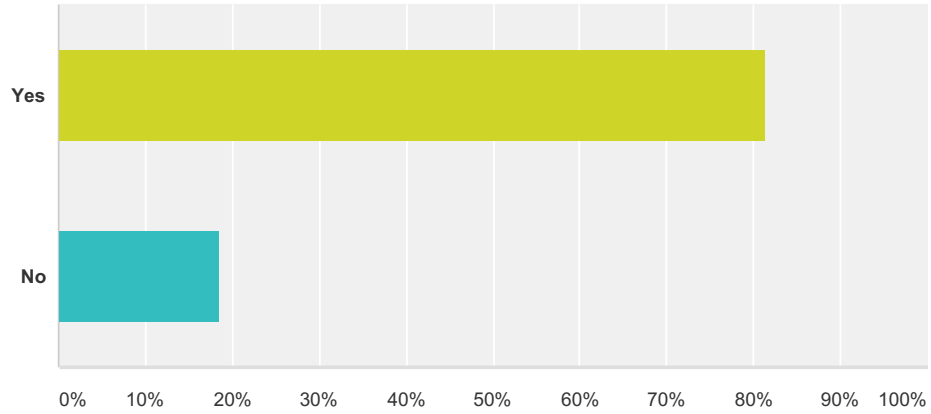

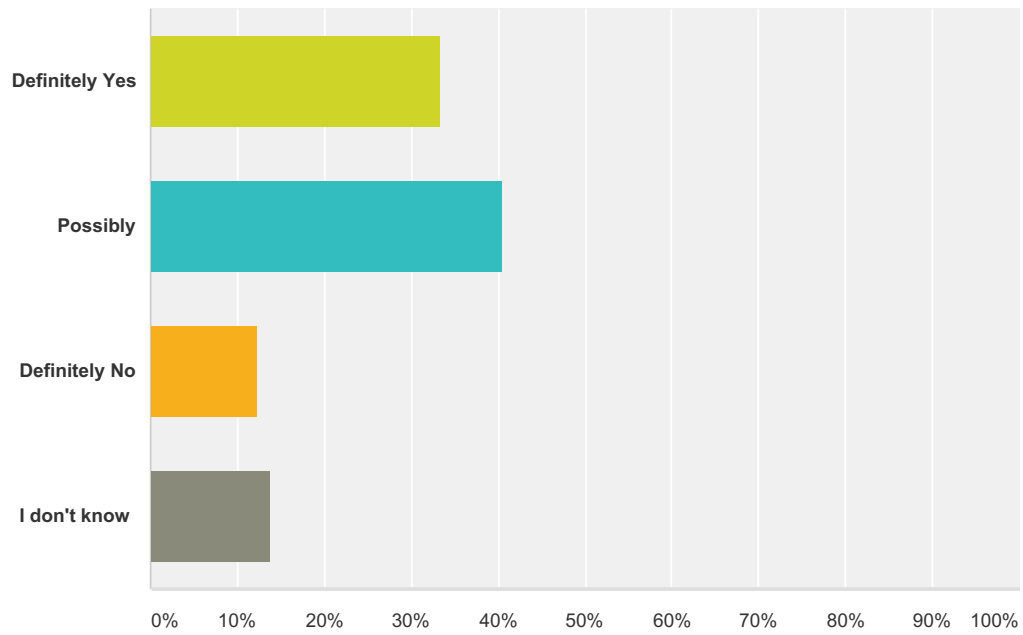

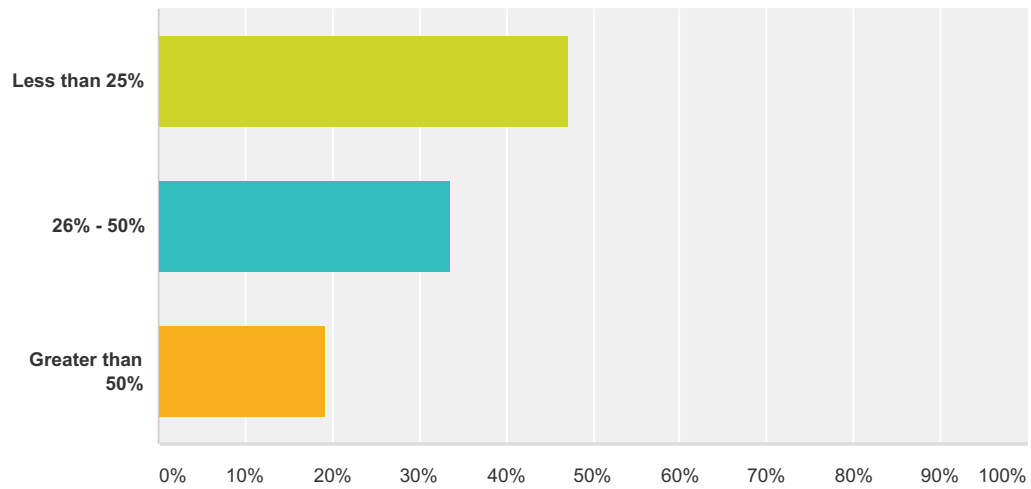

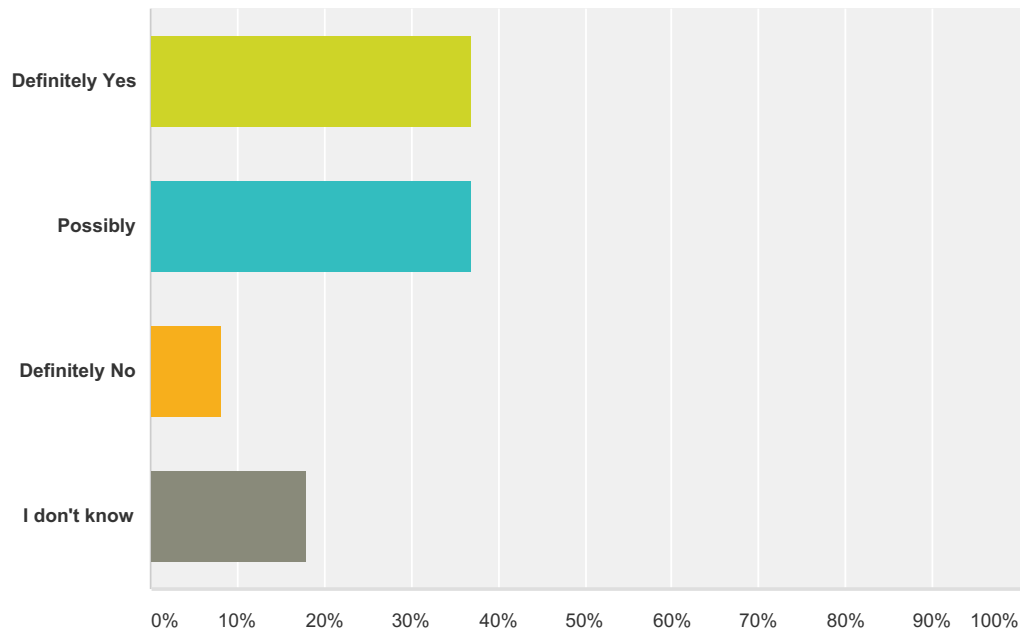

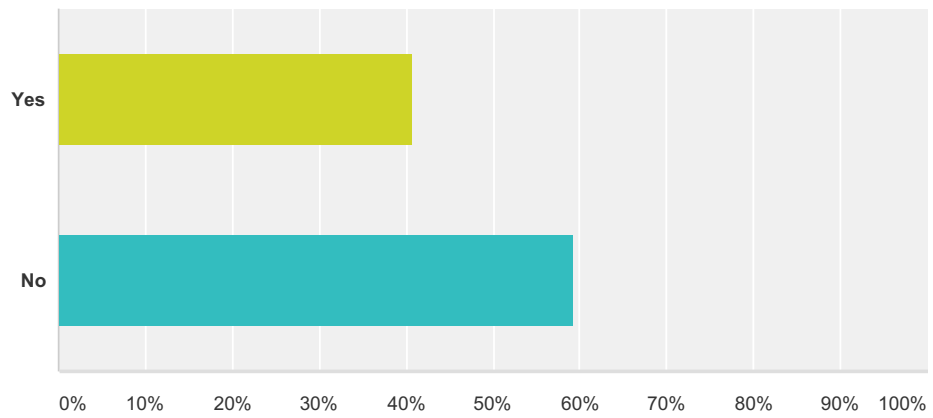

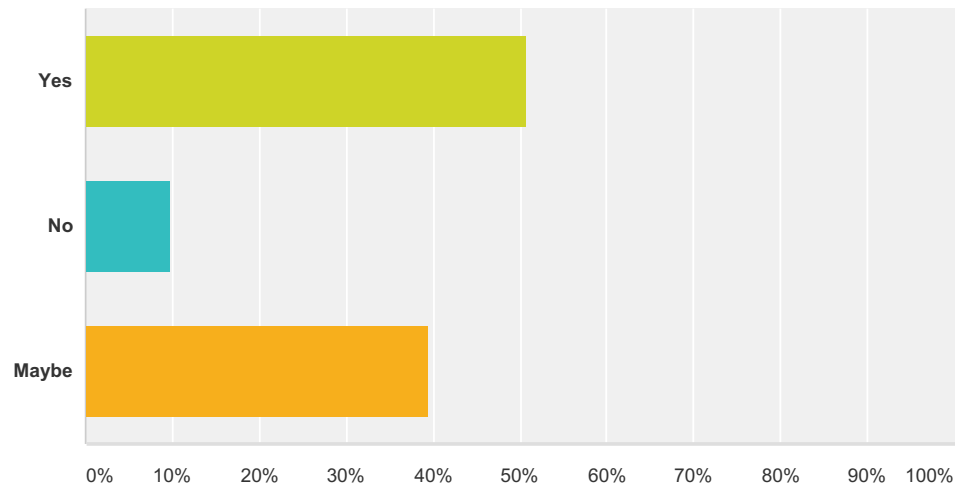

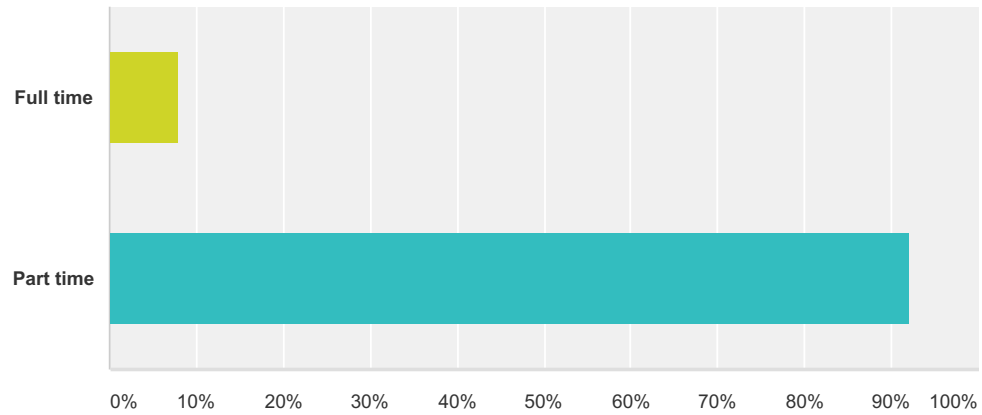

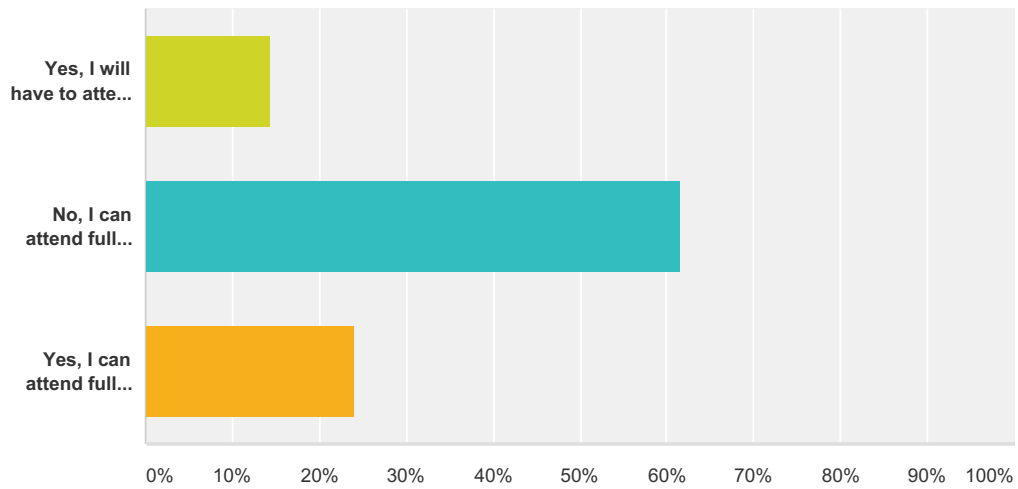

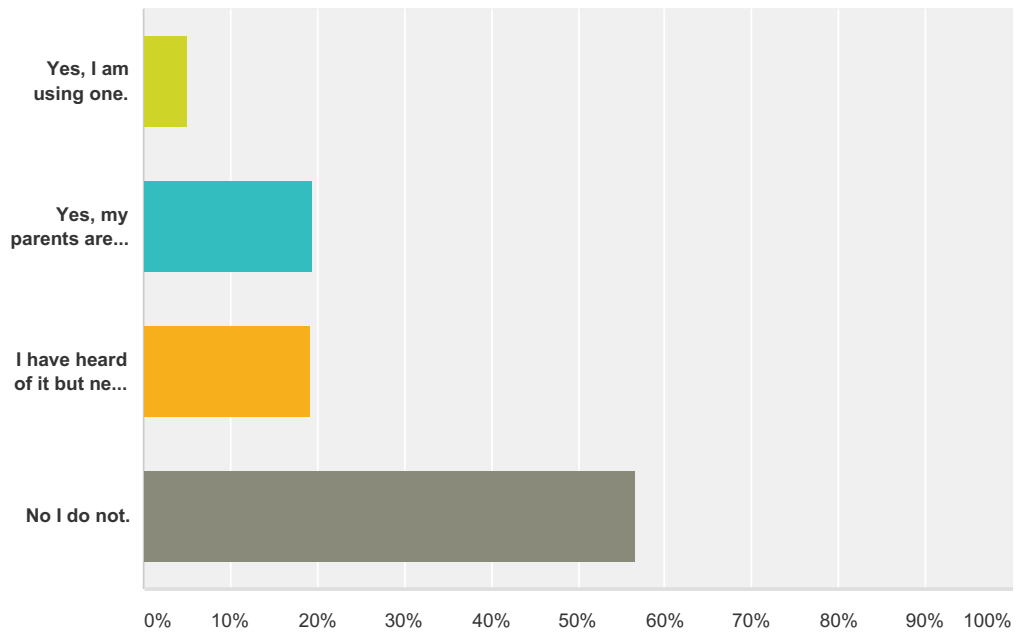

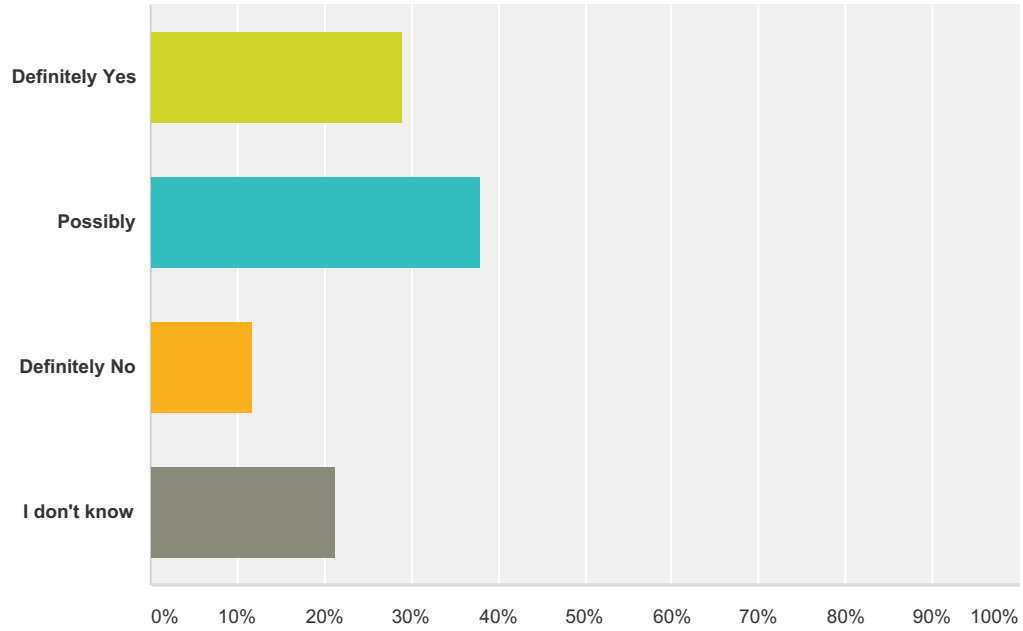

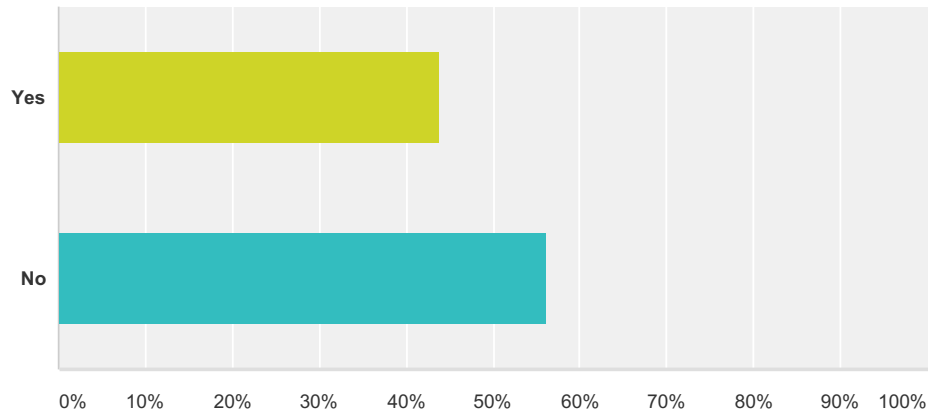

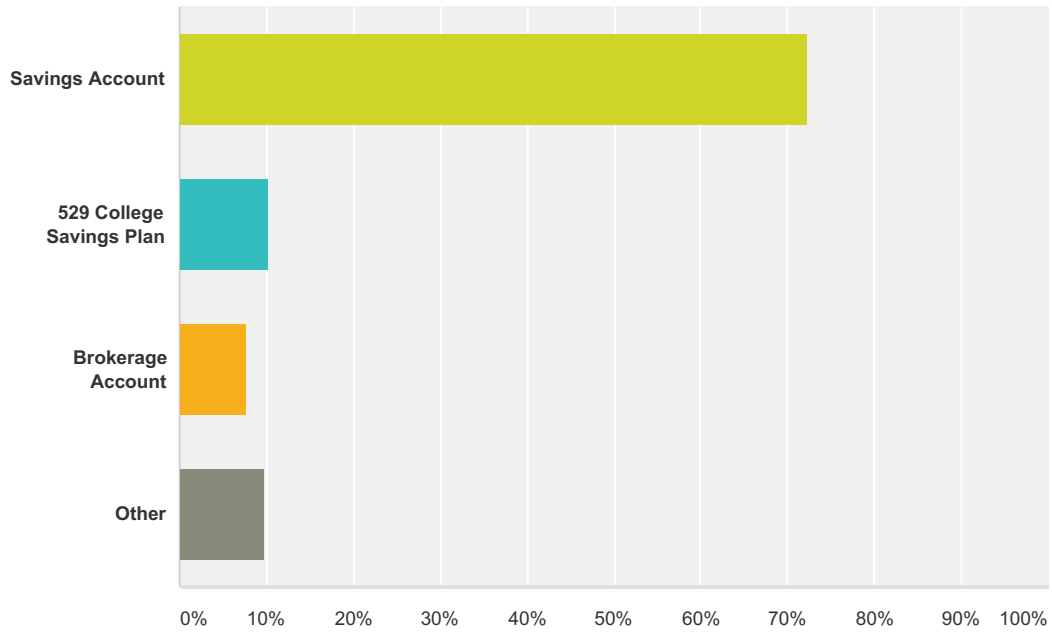

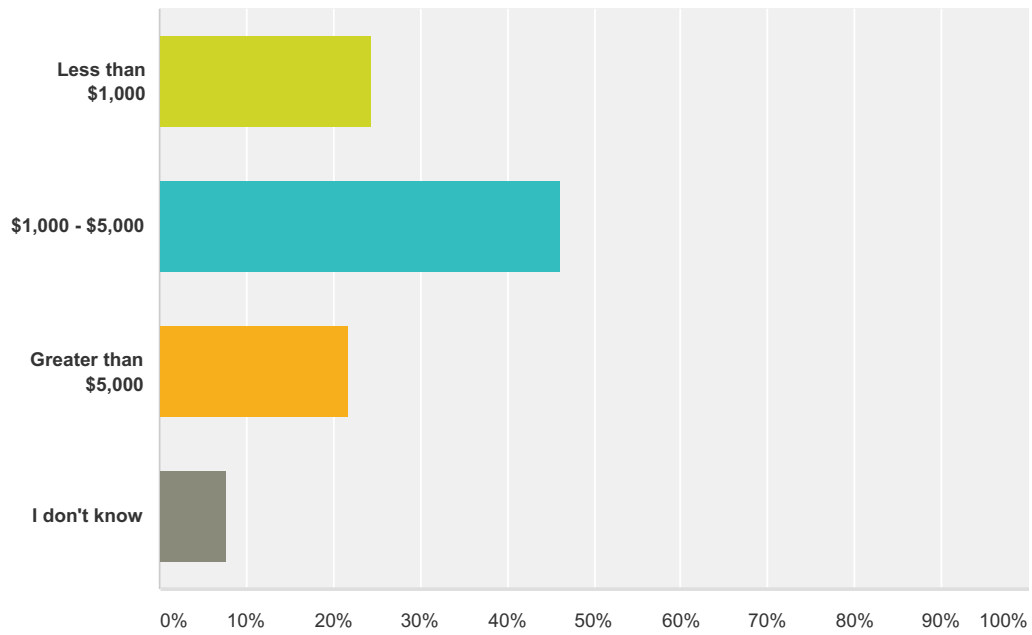

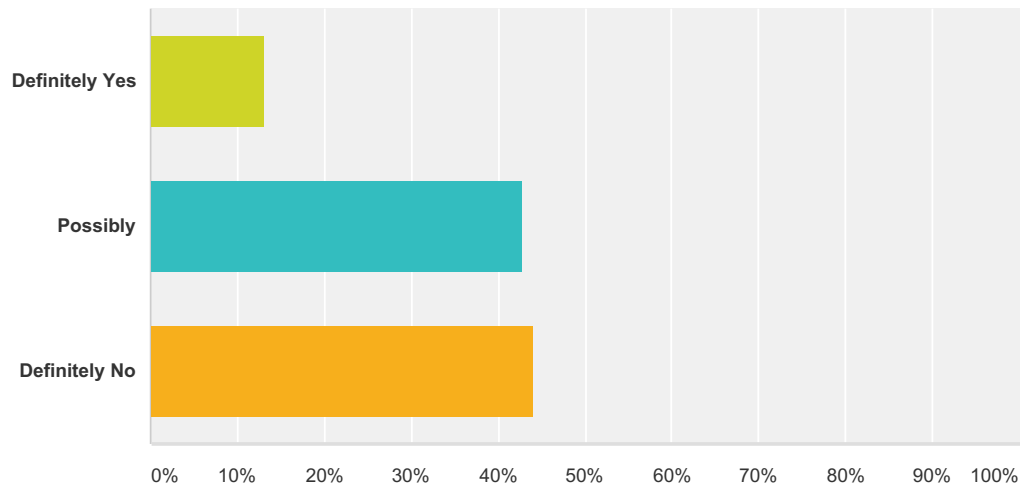

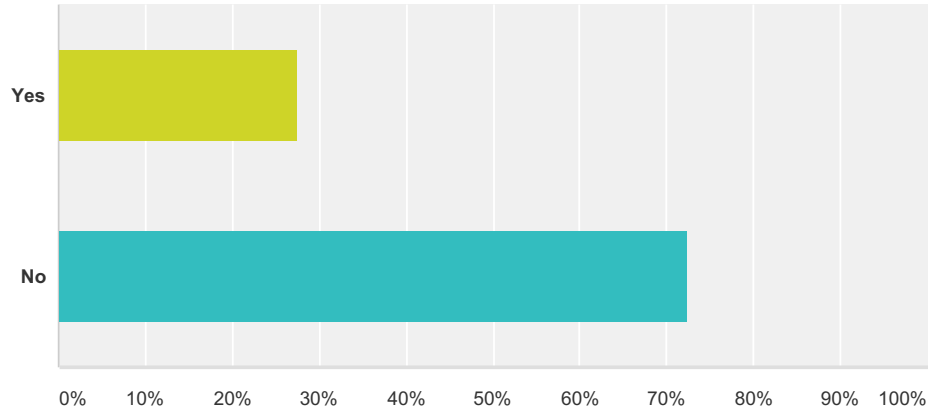

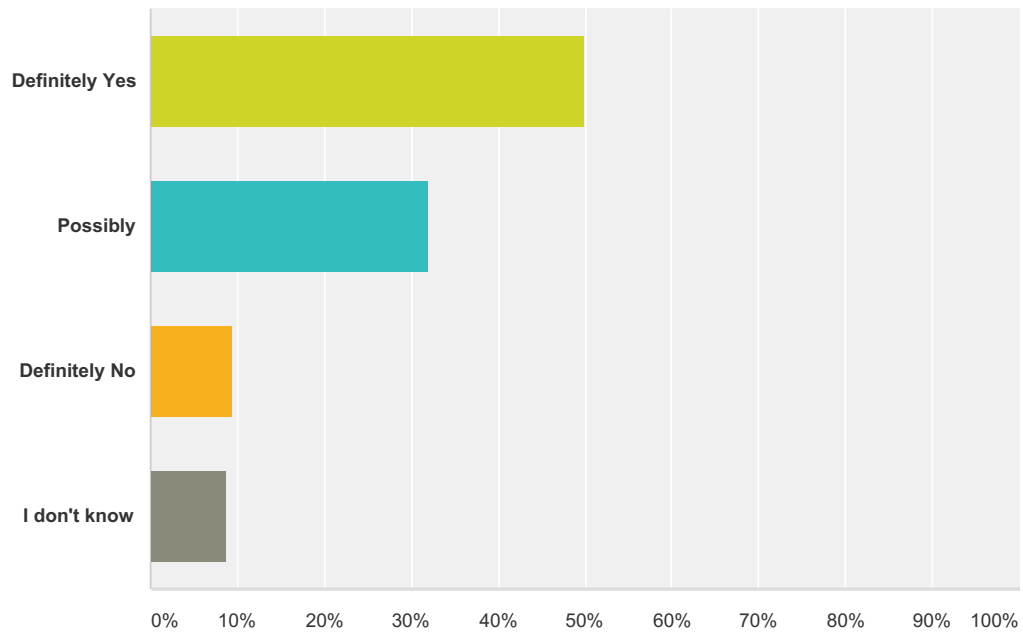

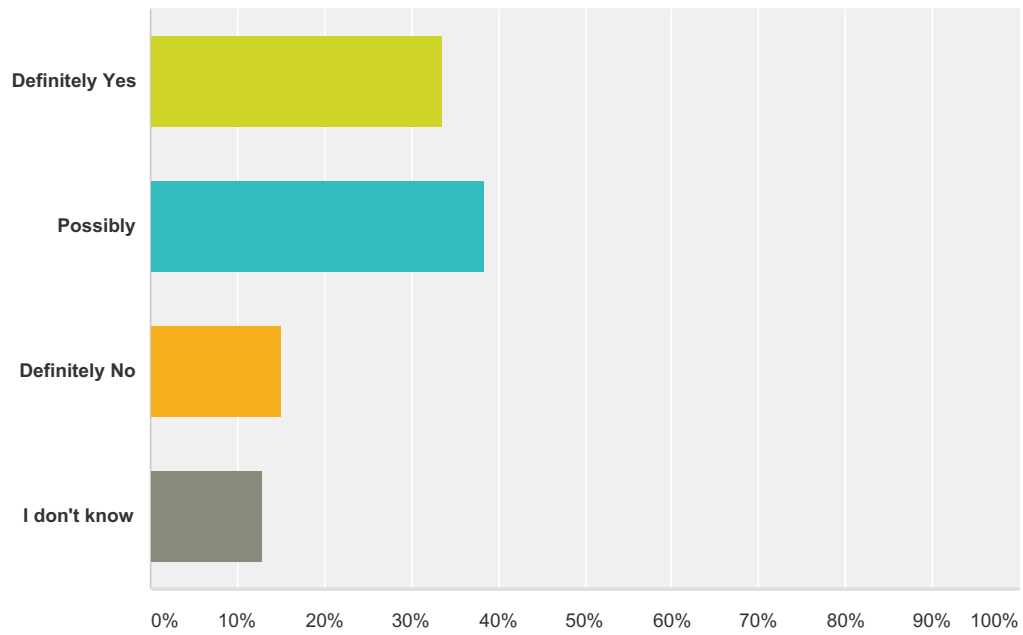

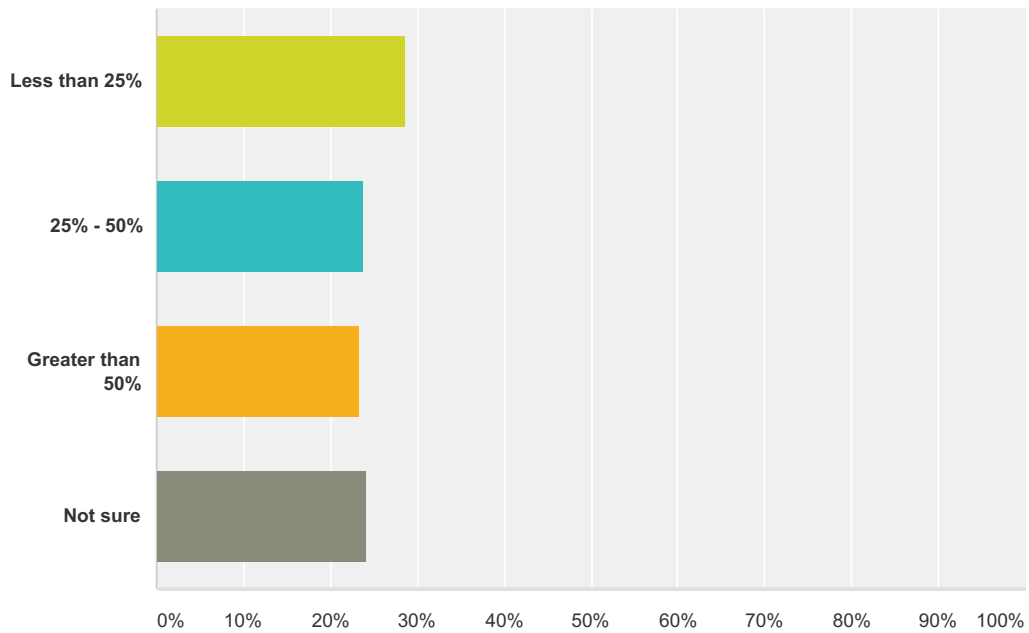

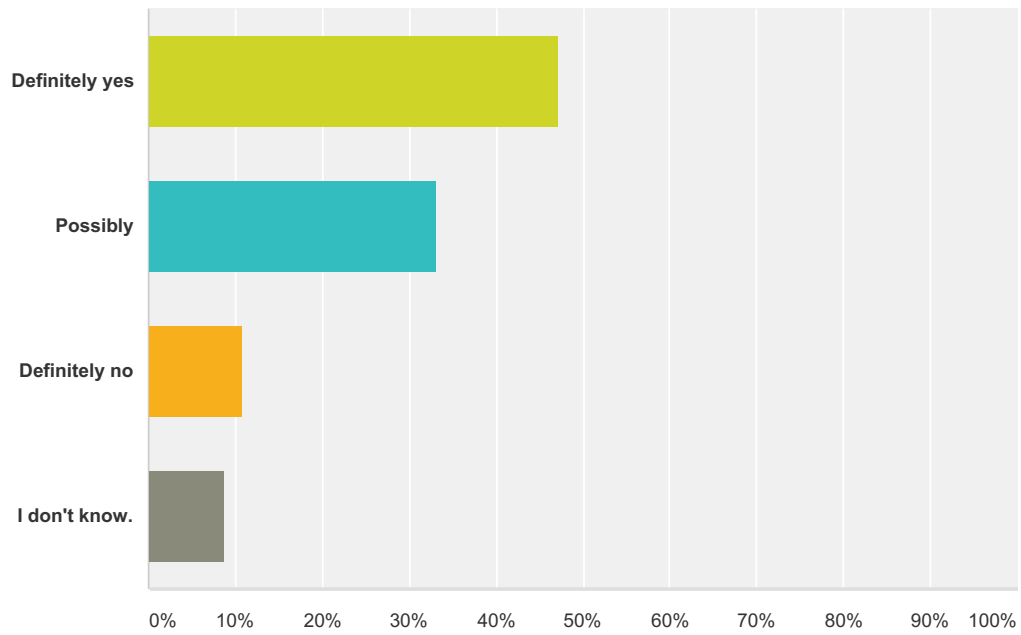

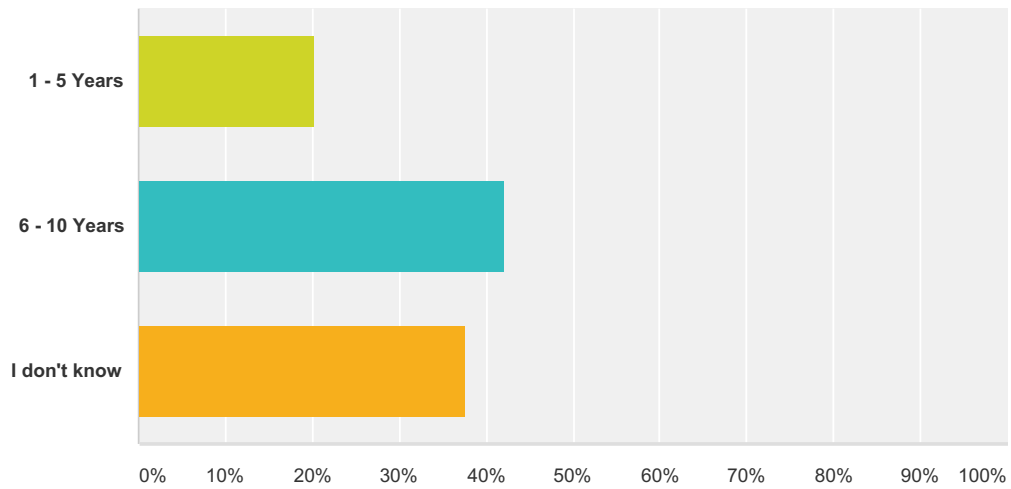

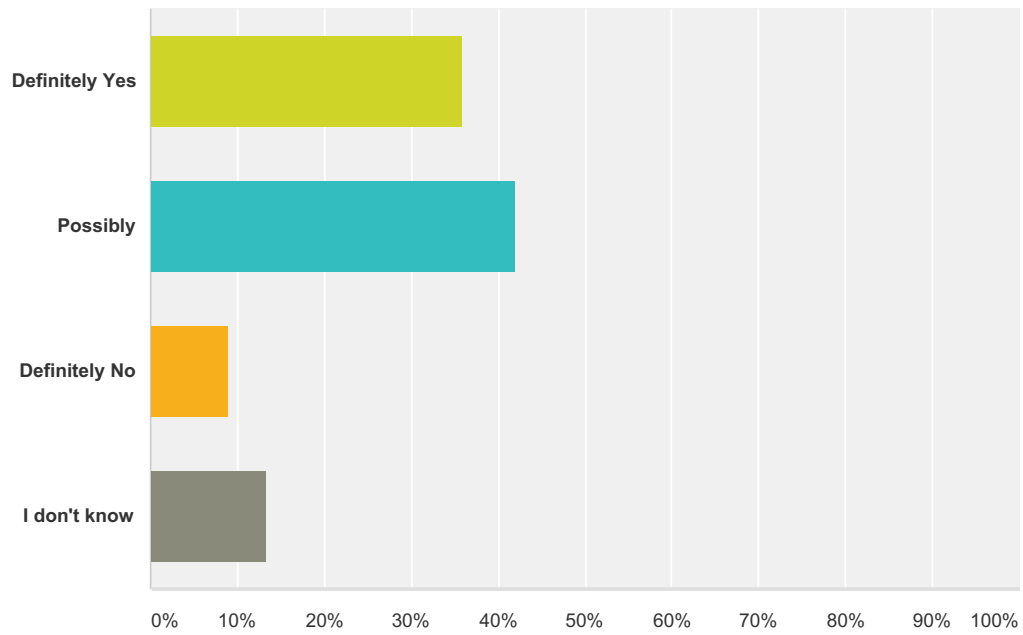

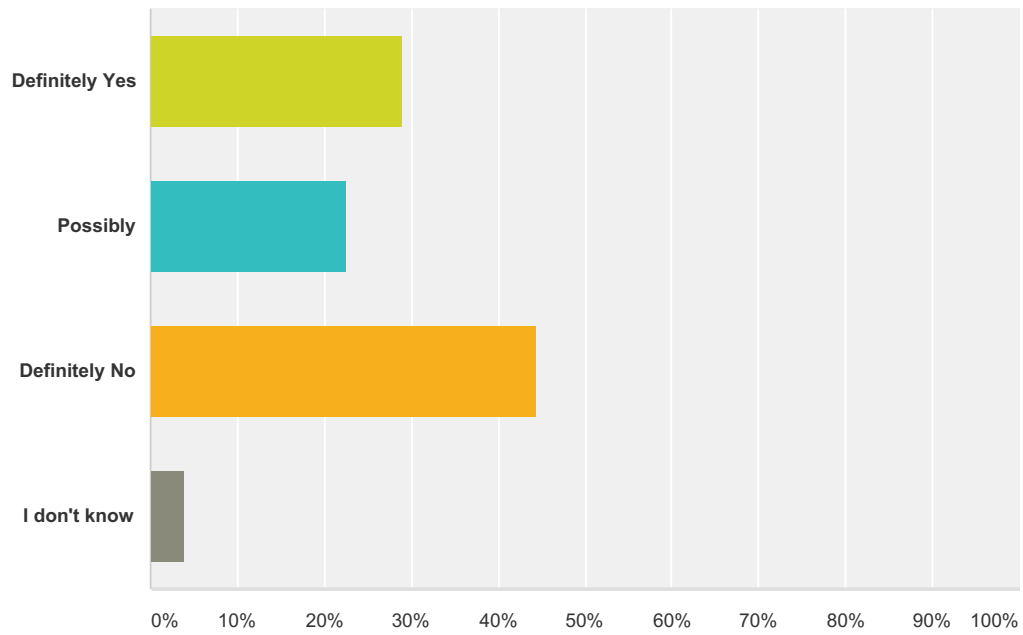

Q32 Have costs been a factor in deciding whether or not to attend college?

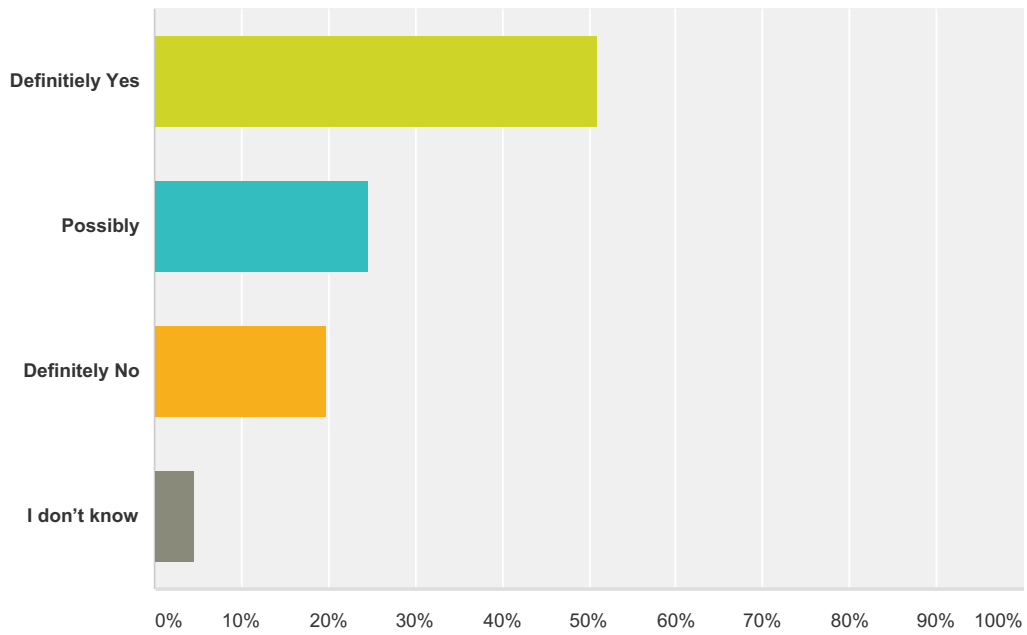

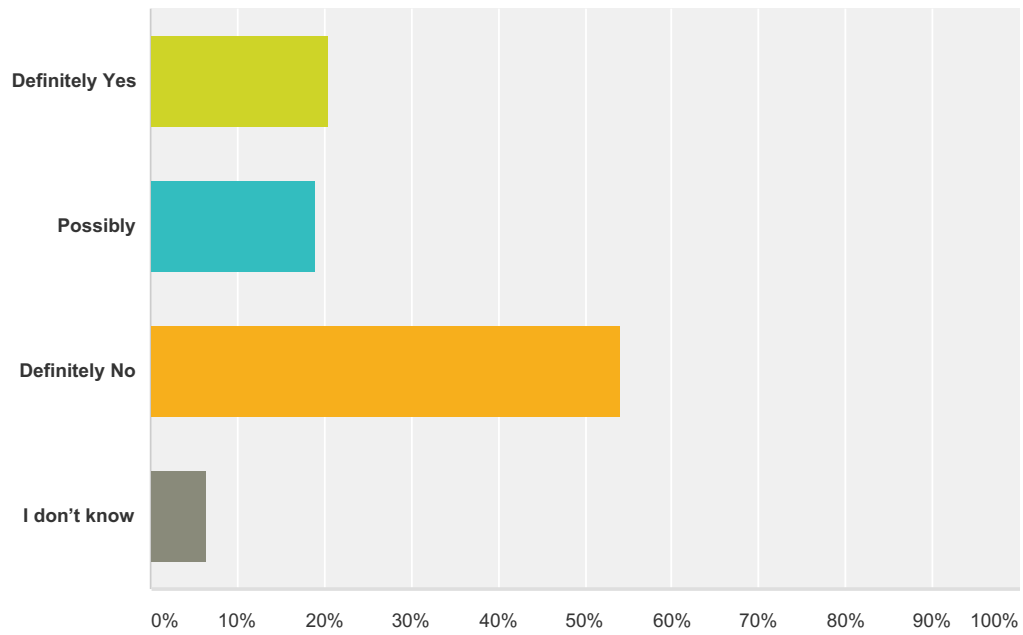

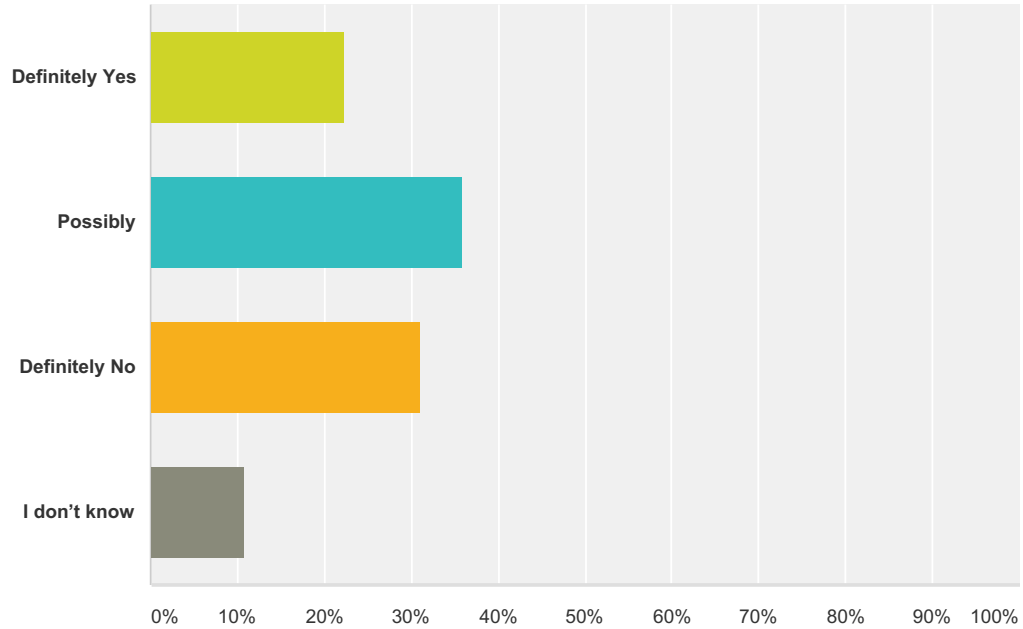

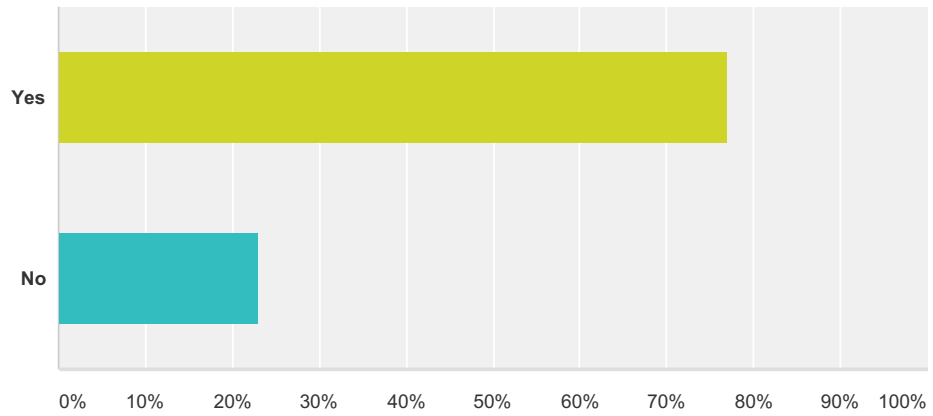

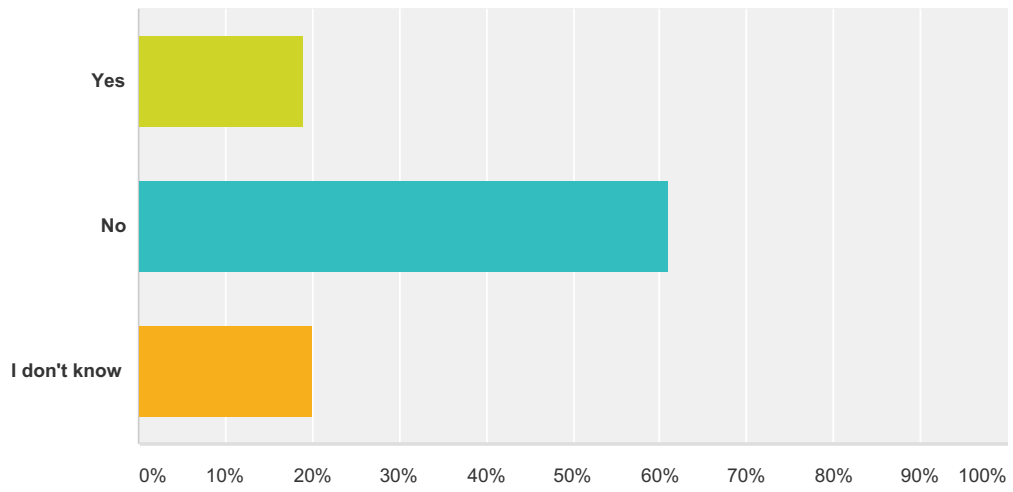

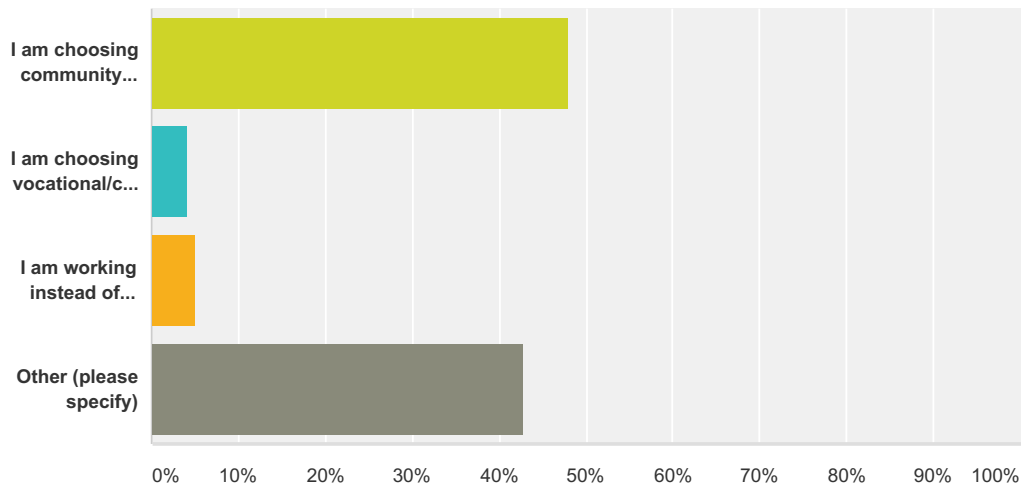

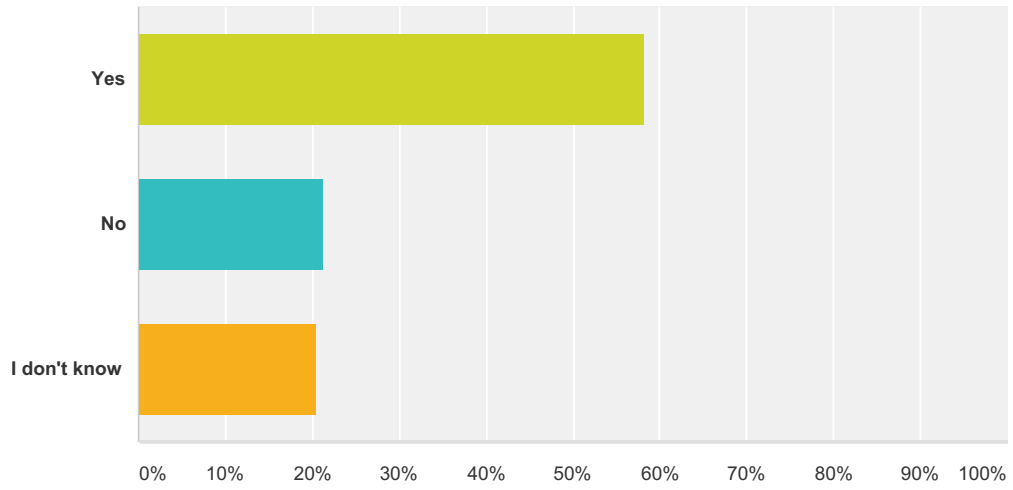

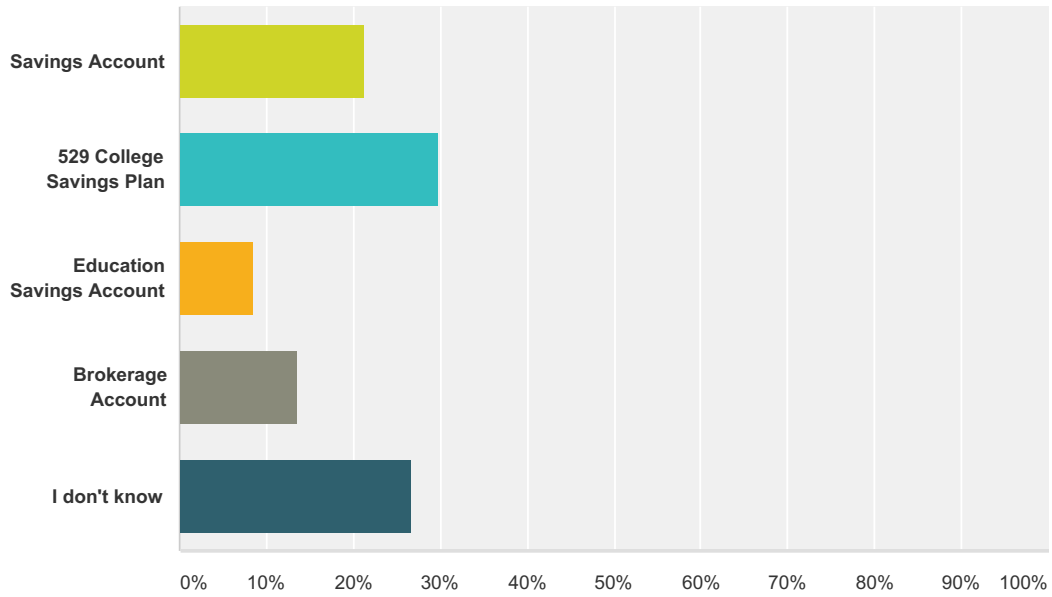

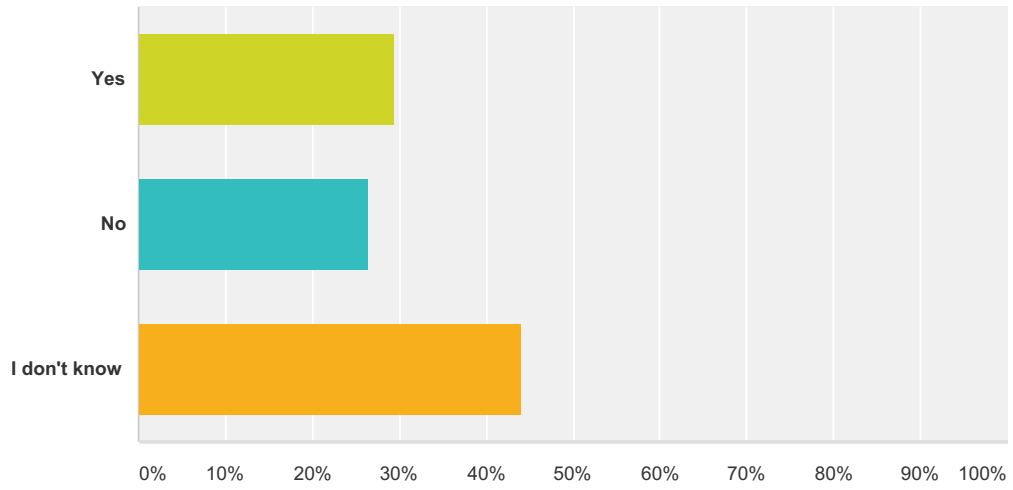

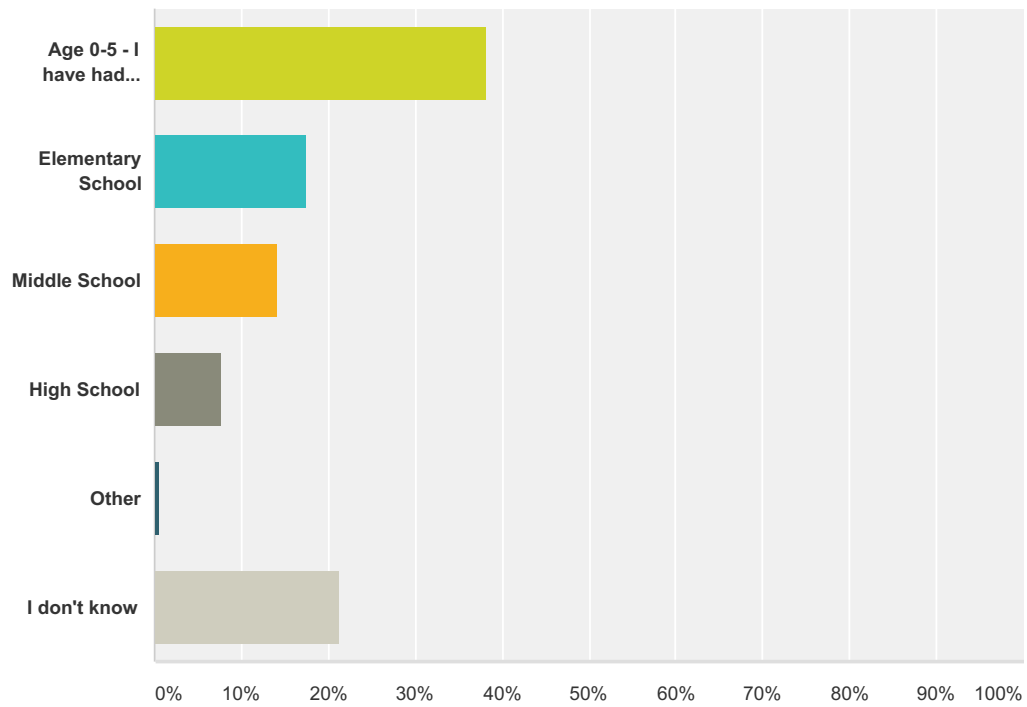

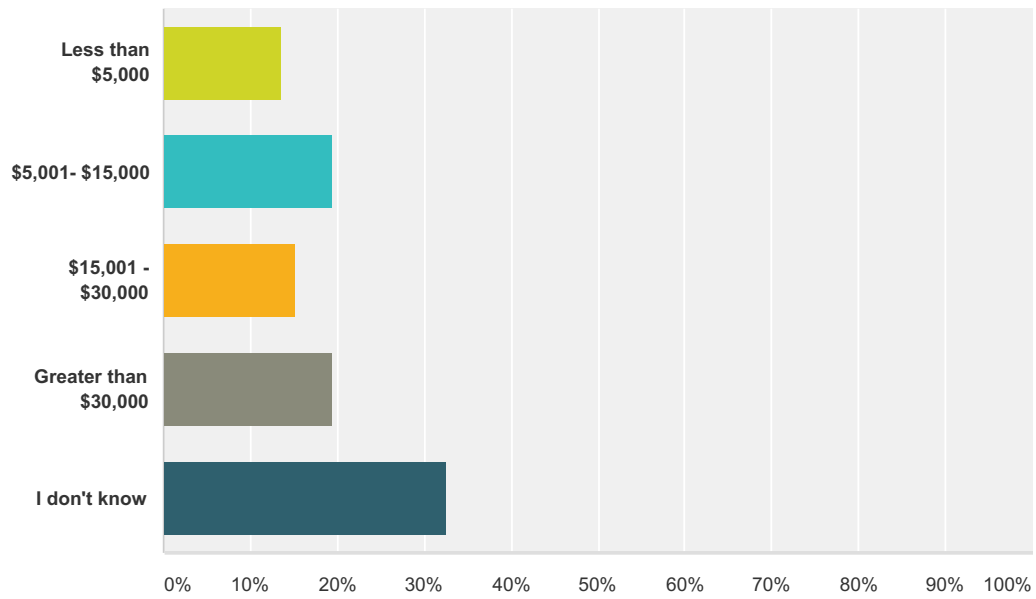

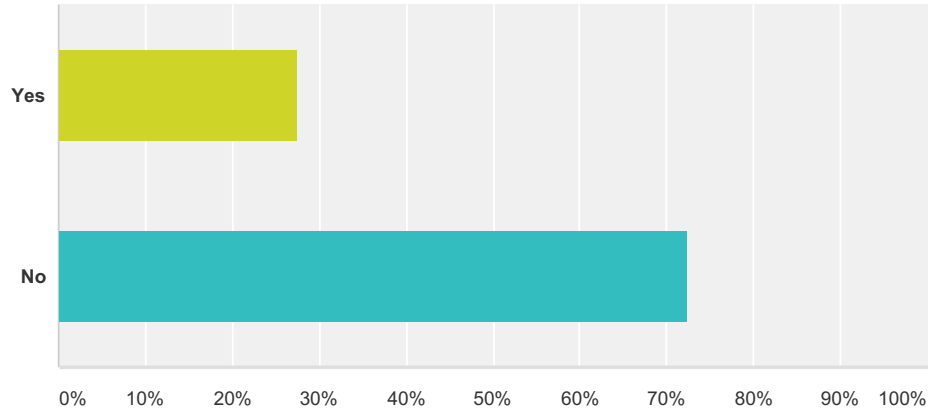

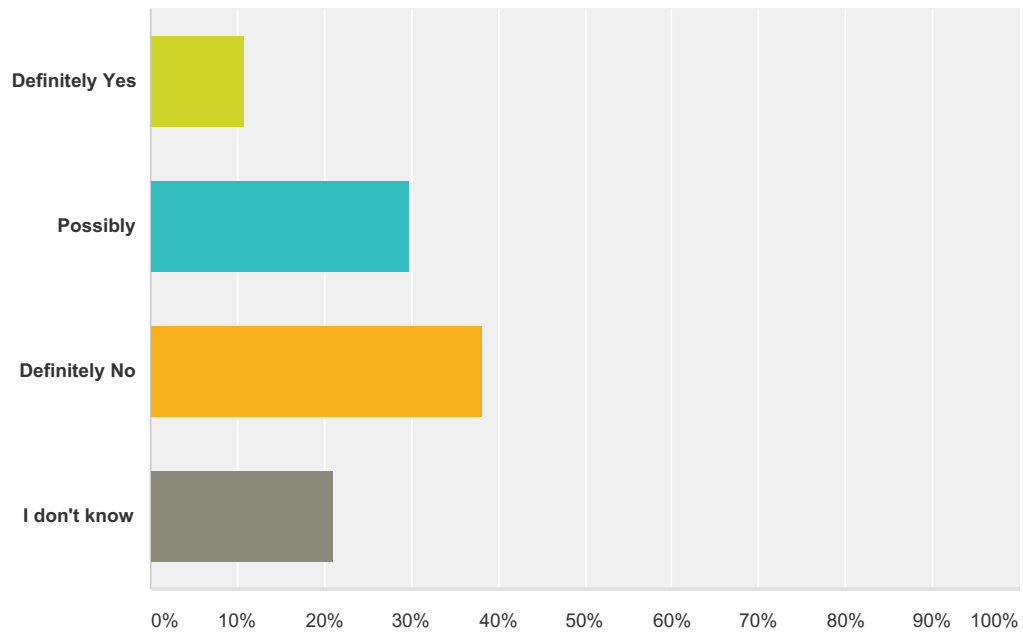

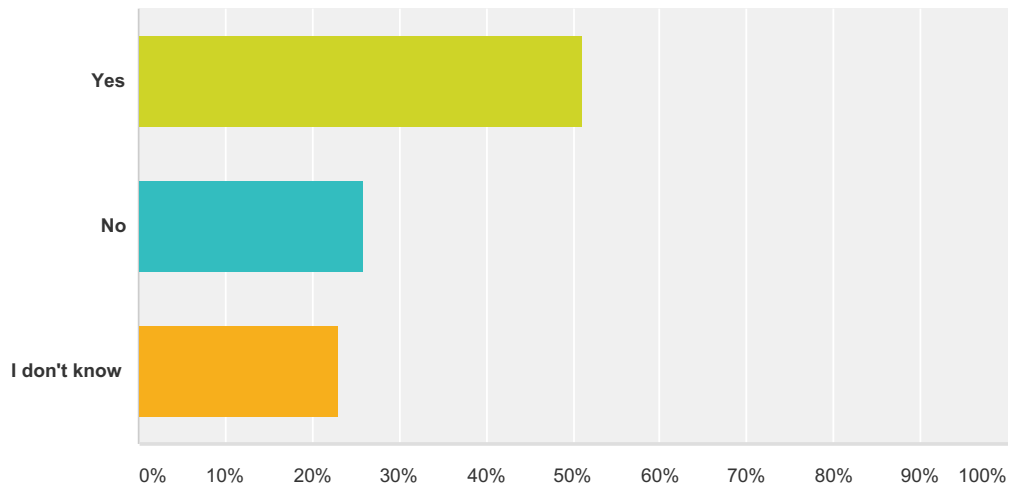

Q47 Do you wish your relatives had offered to give you money for college?

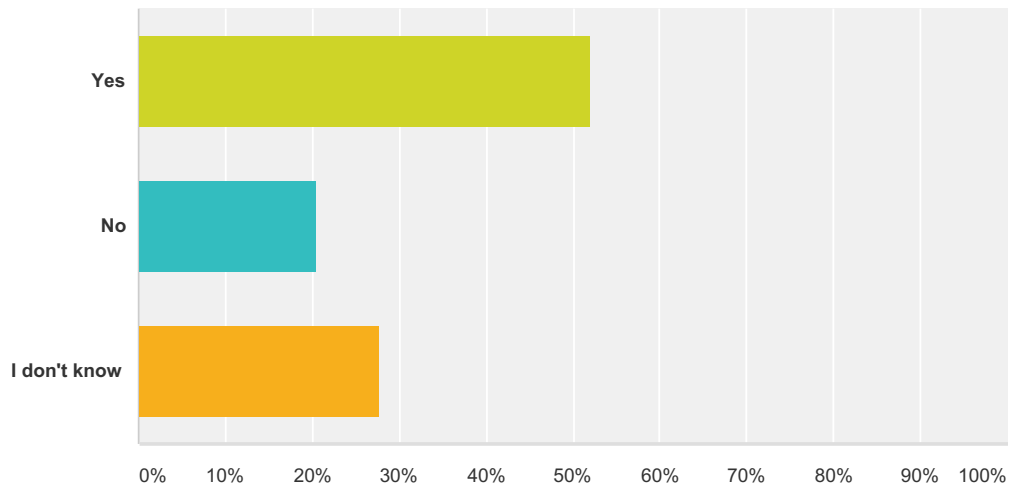

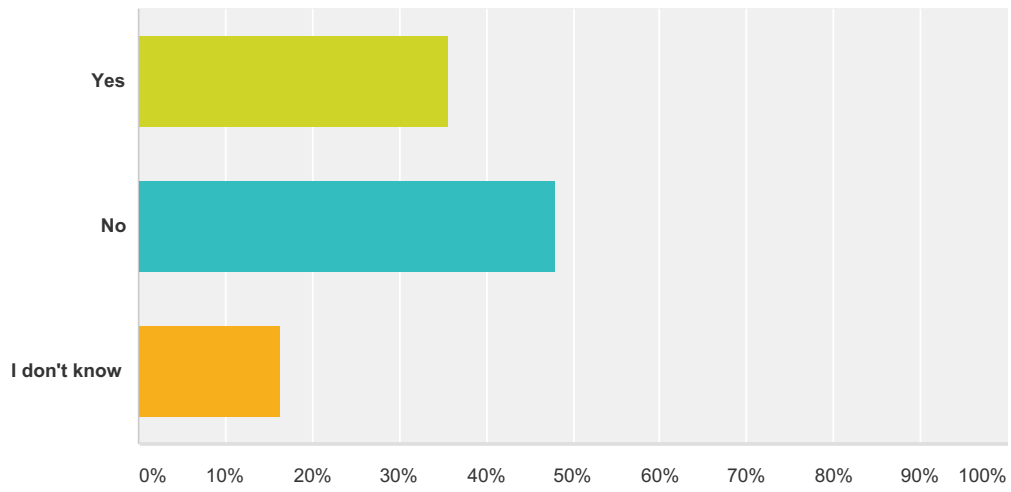

Q49 Has college funding created anxiety in your household?

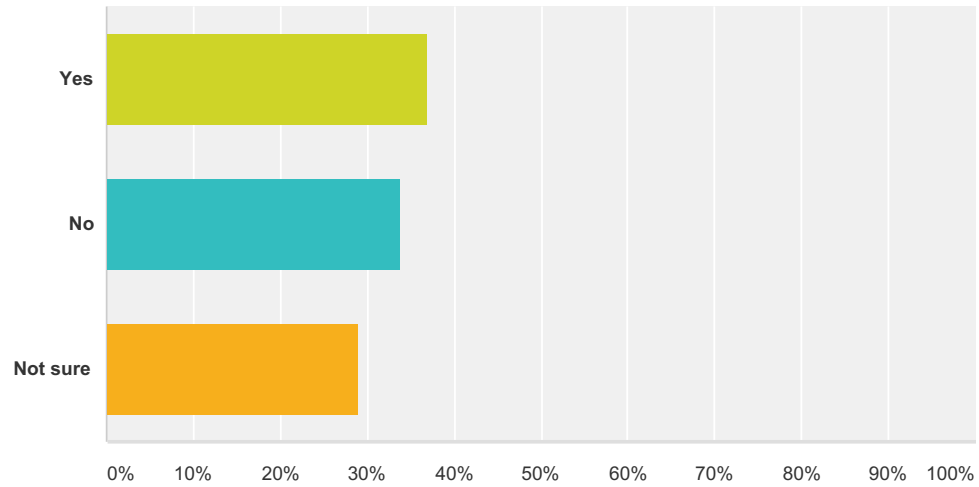

Q50 Do you believe your high school has prepared you adequately for higher education, including costs and ways to reduce the costs?

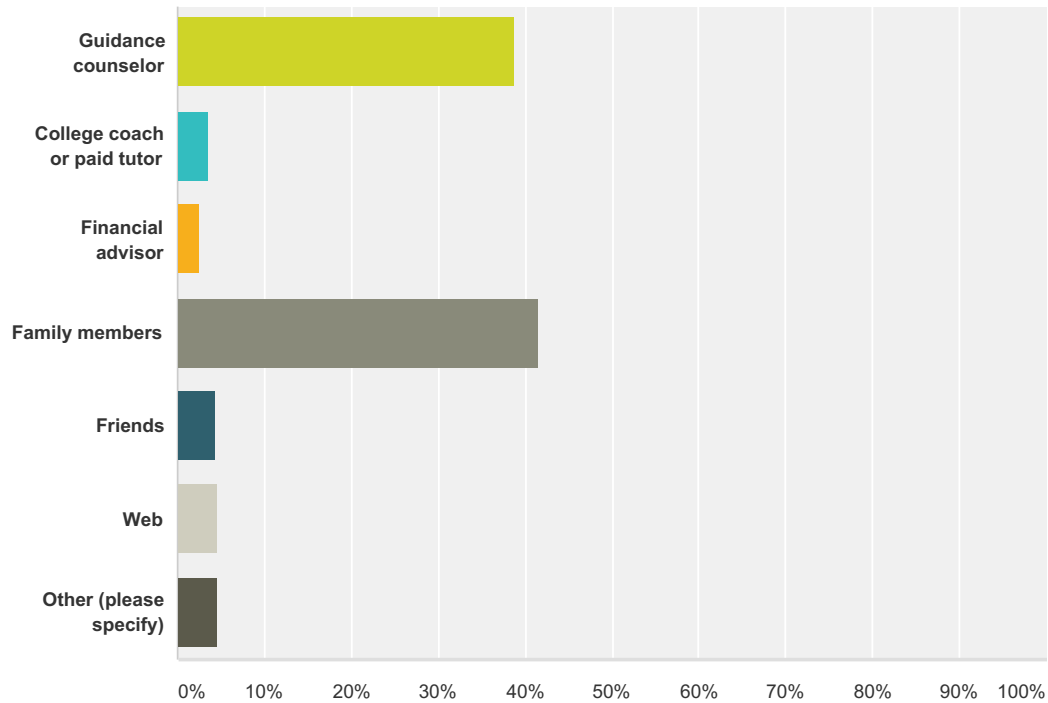

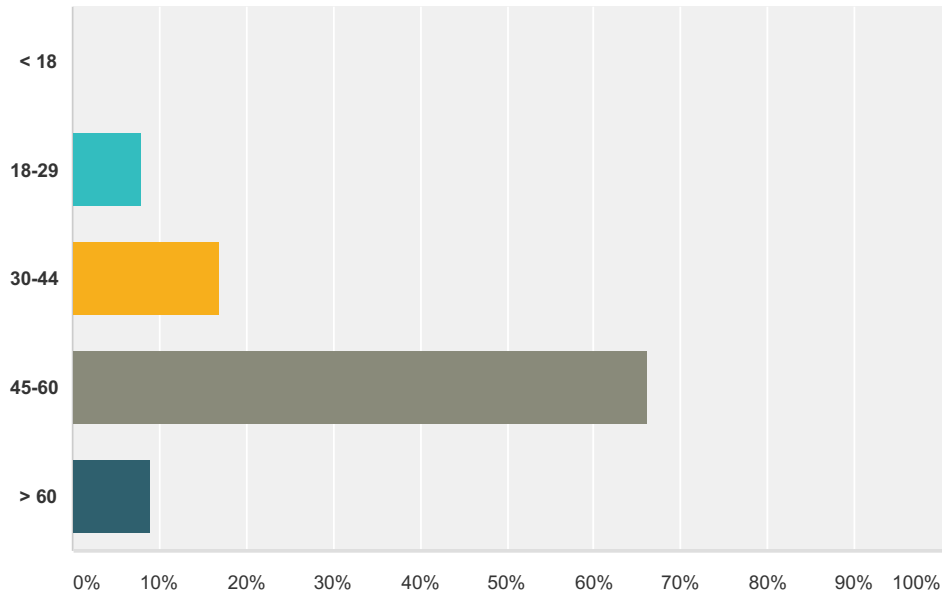

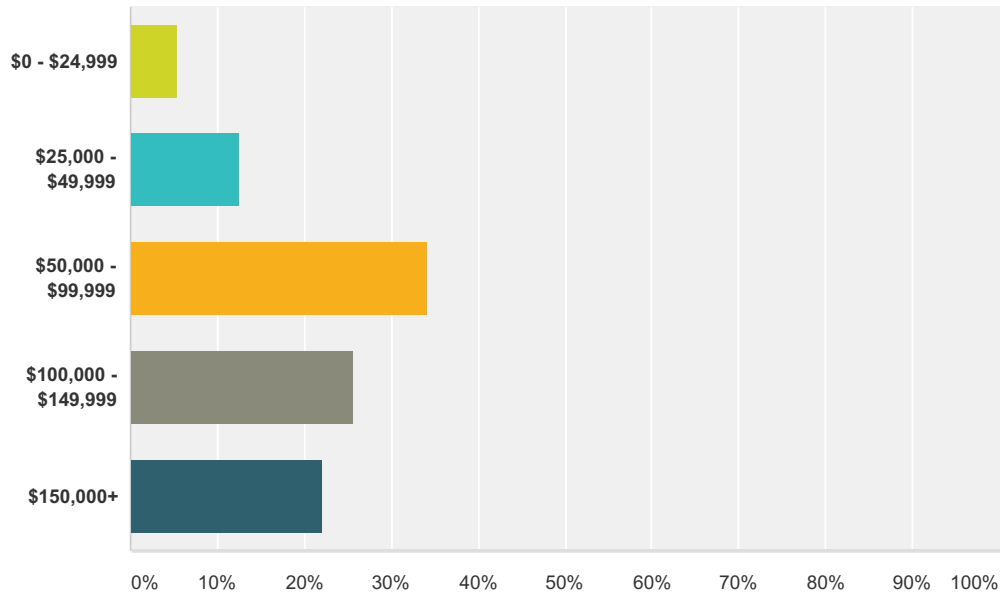

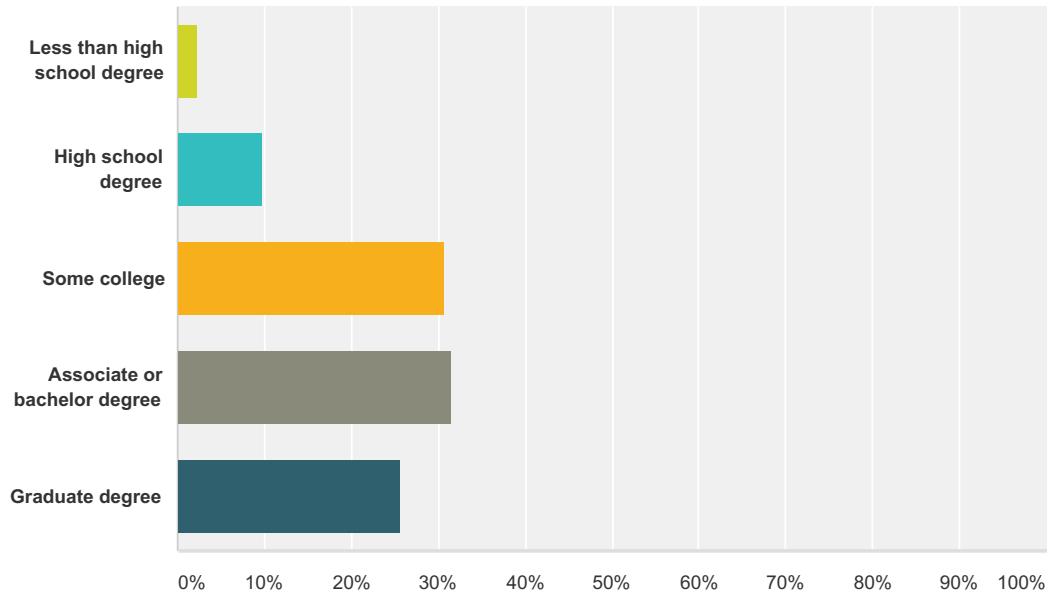

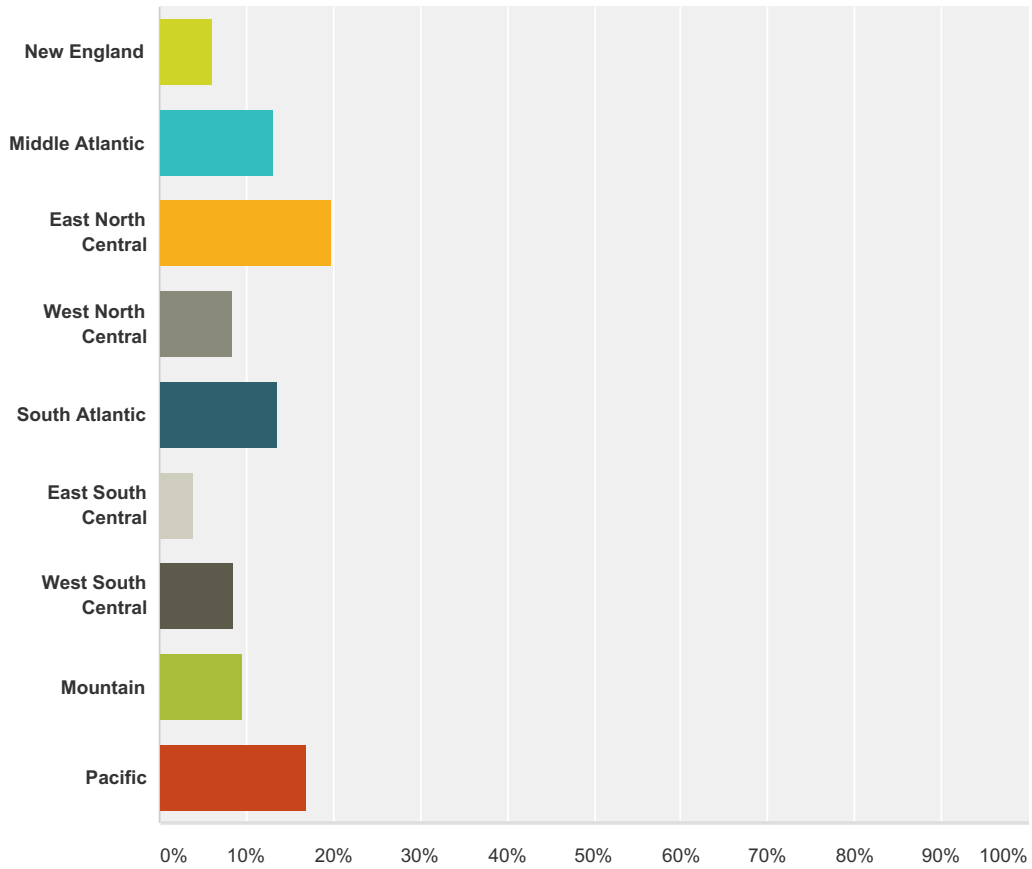
