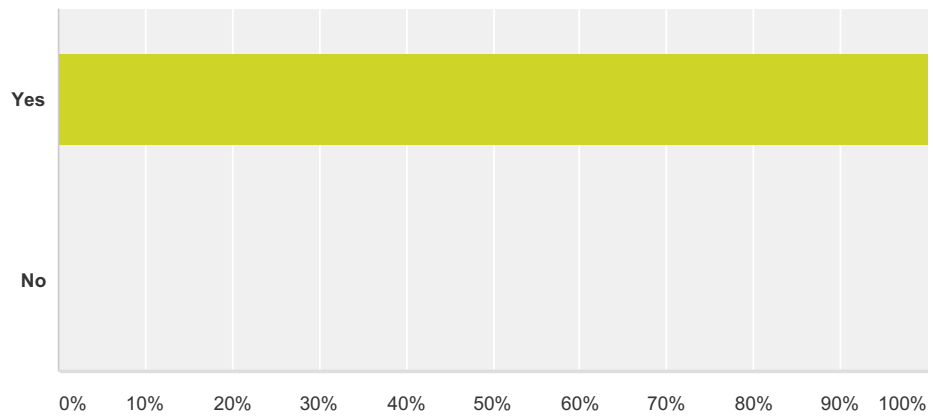

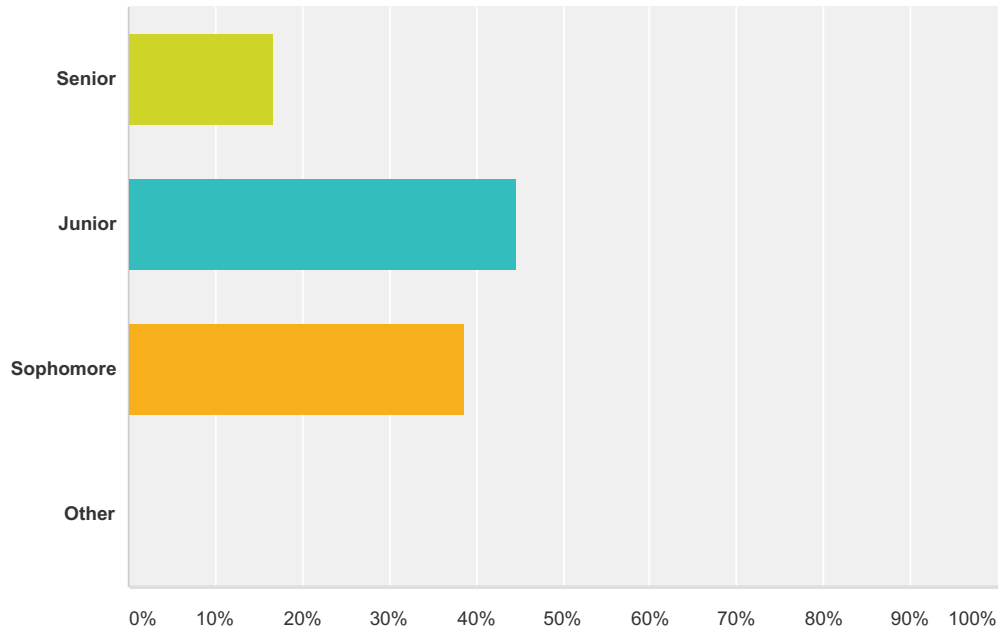

## Q2 What year are you in high school?

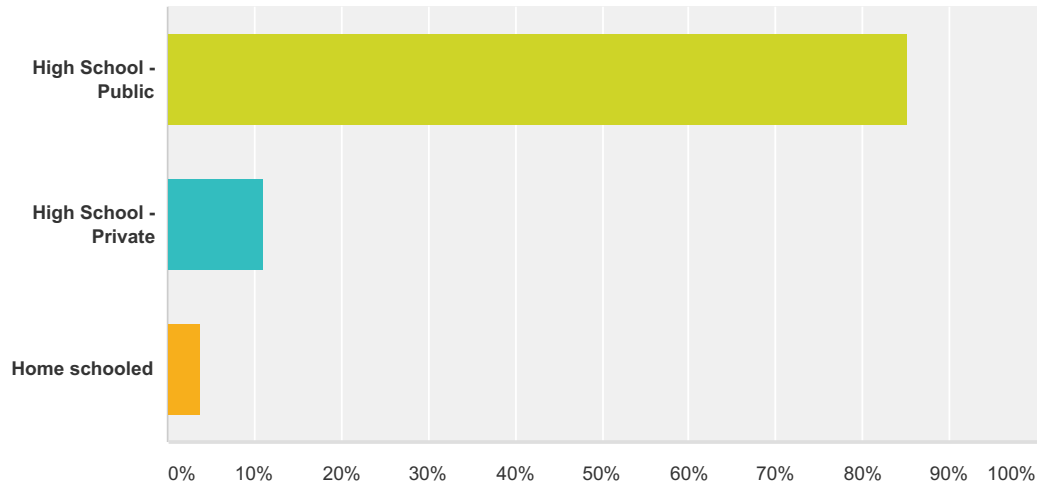

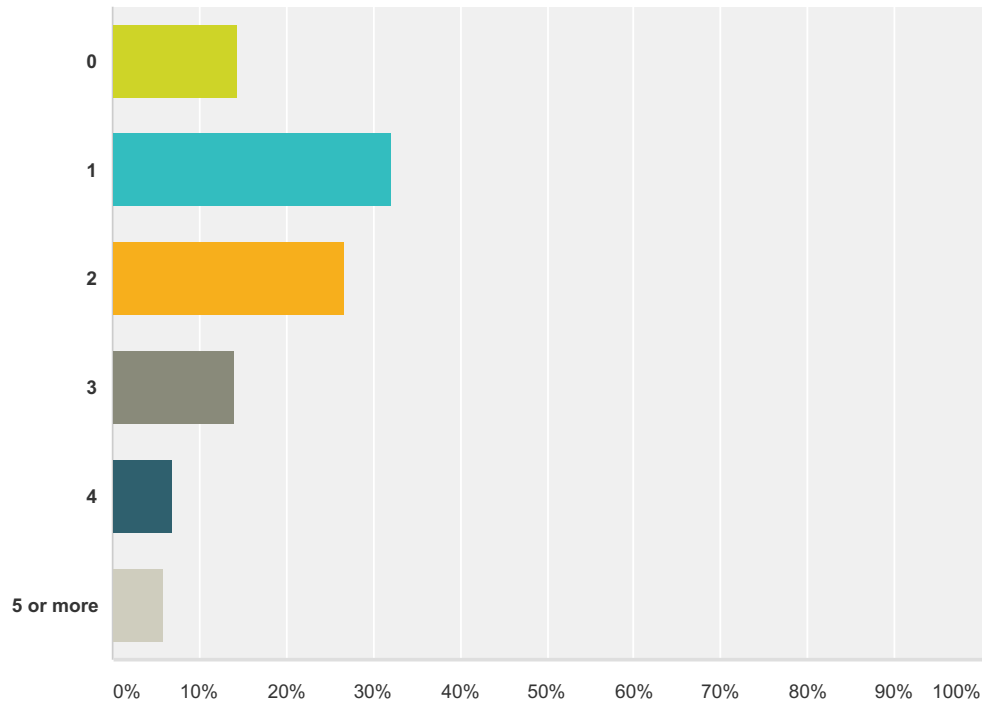

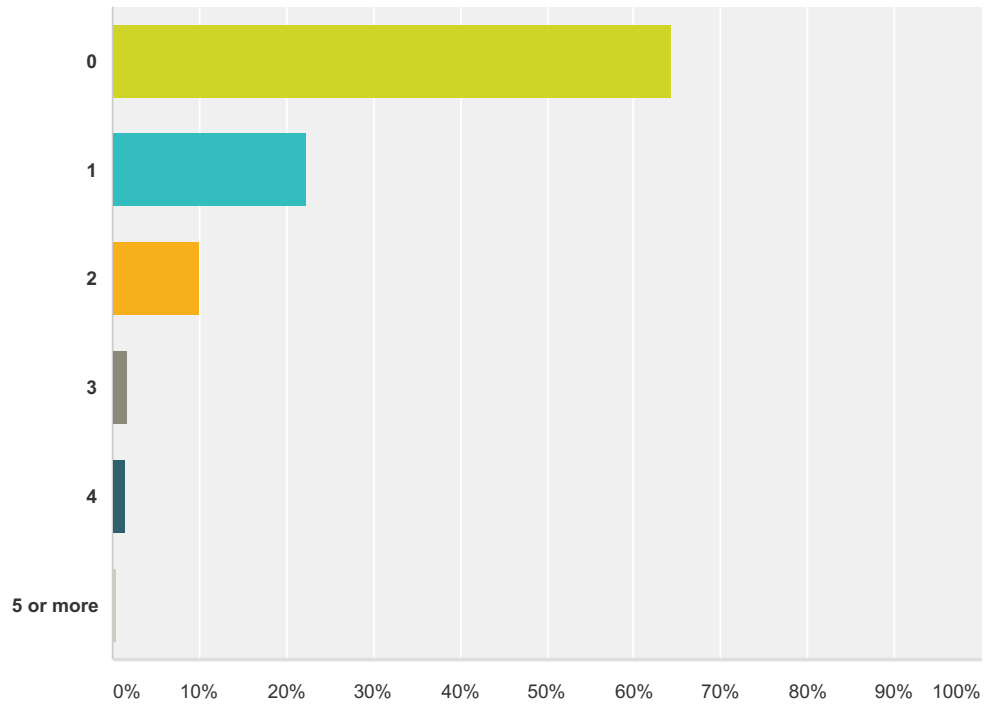

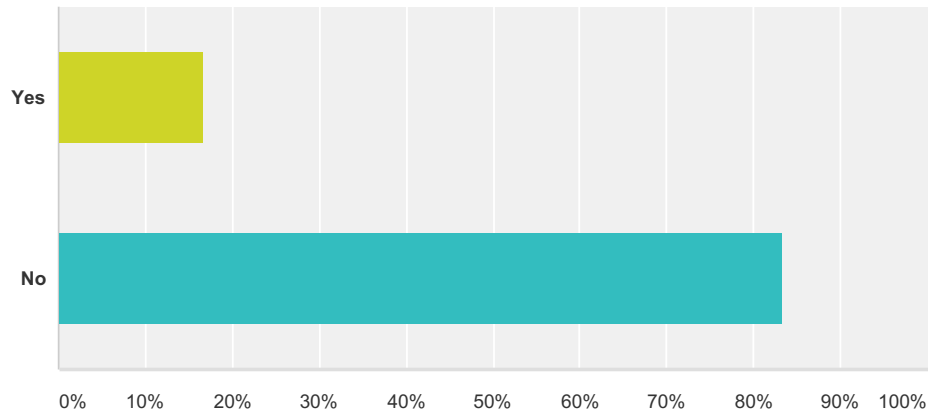

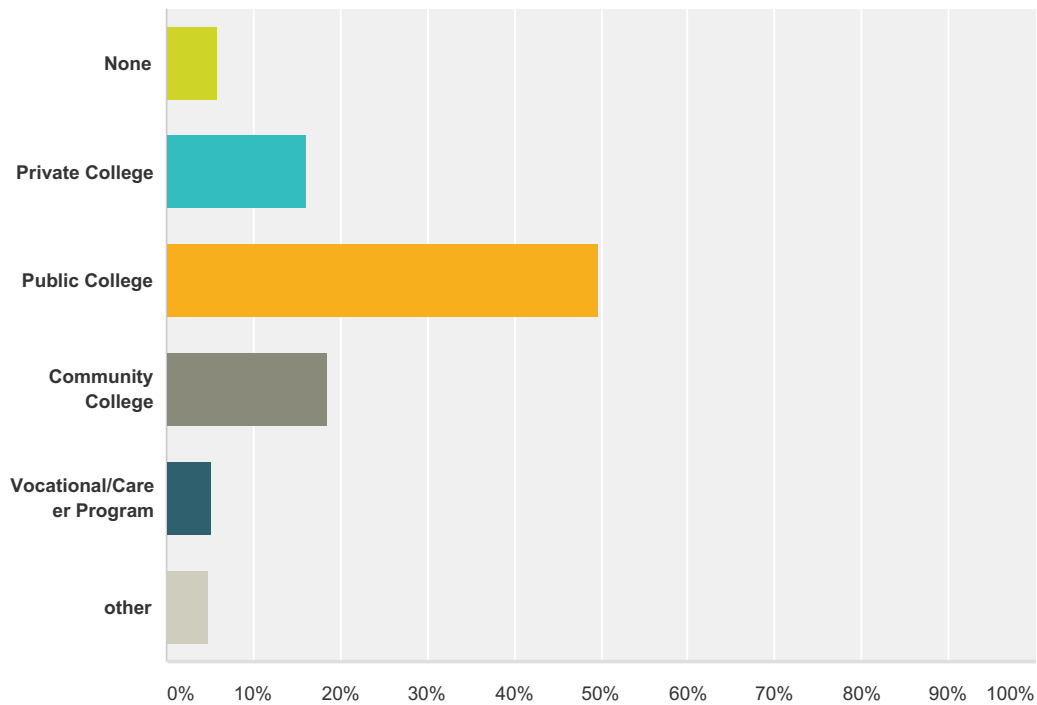

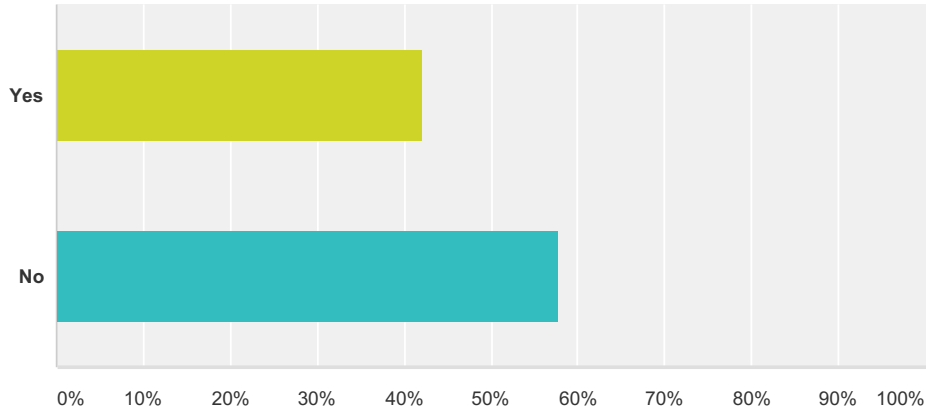

**Q9 Q. When thinking about college, do you think of vocational and career schools in the same way that you think about public or private colleges?**

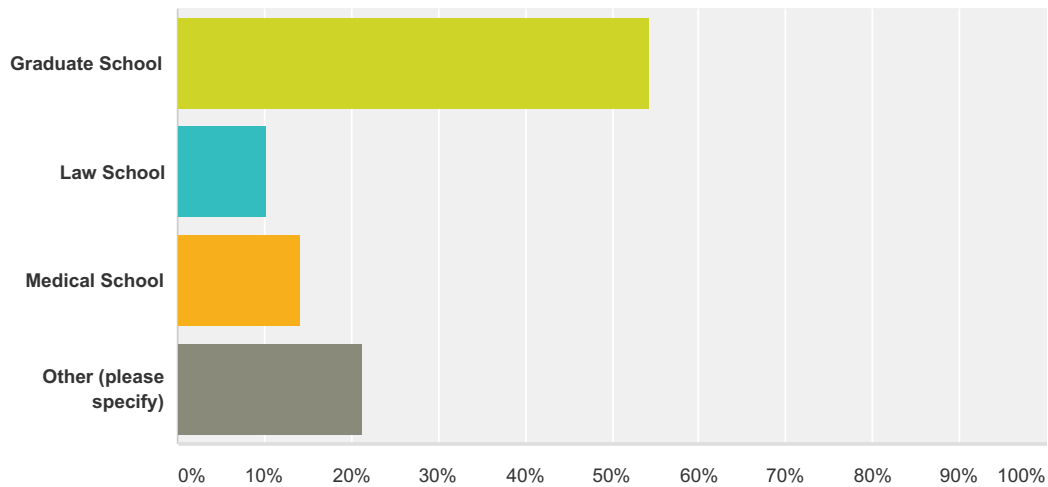

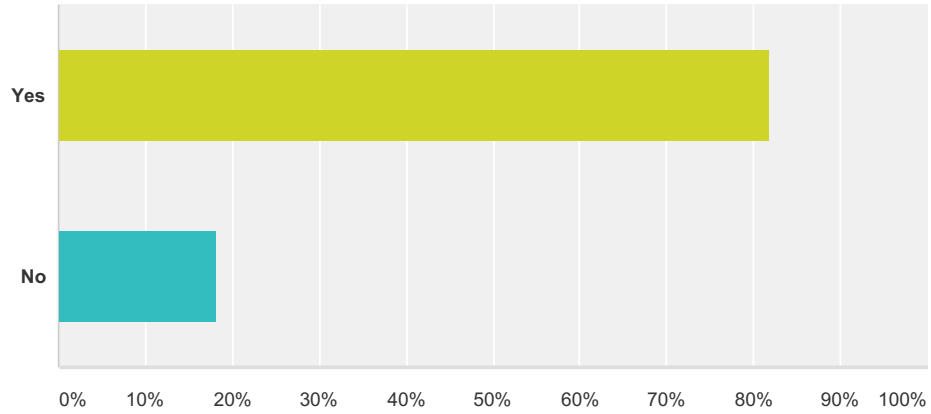

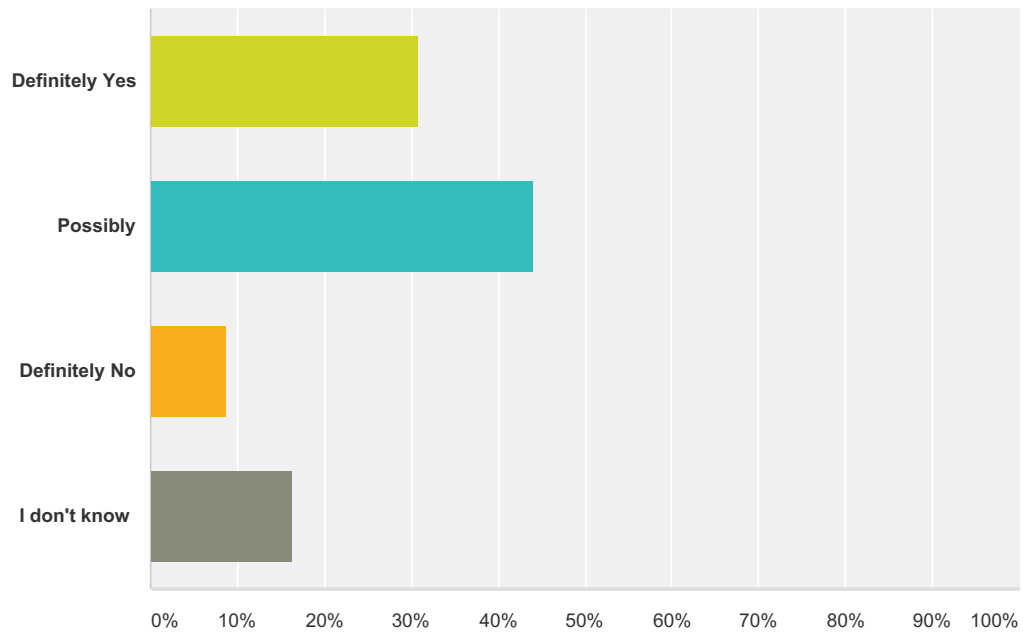

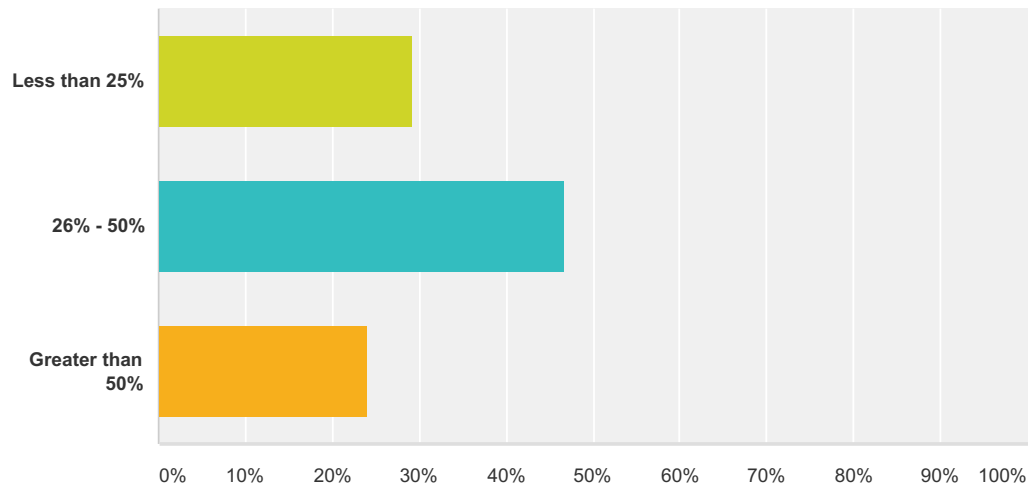

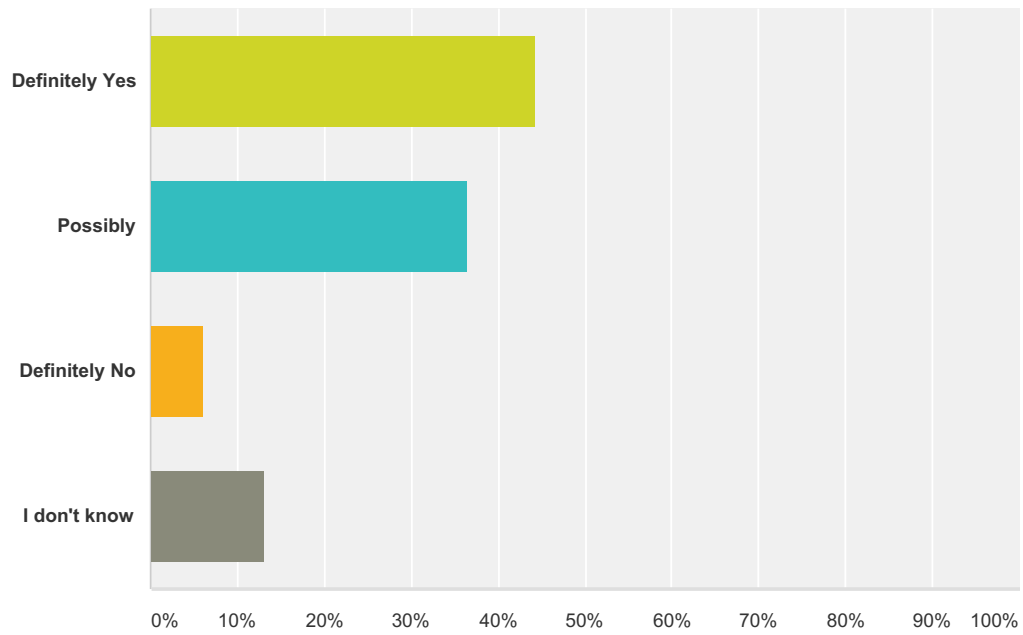

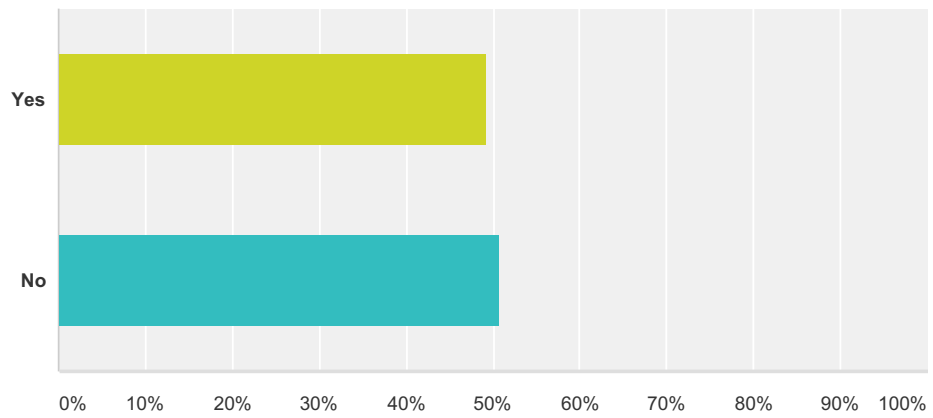

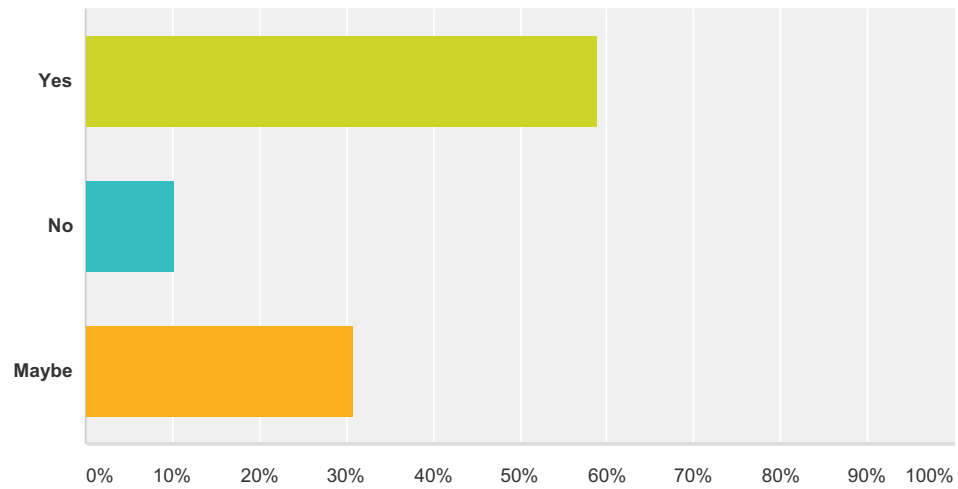

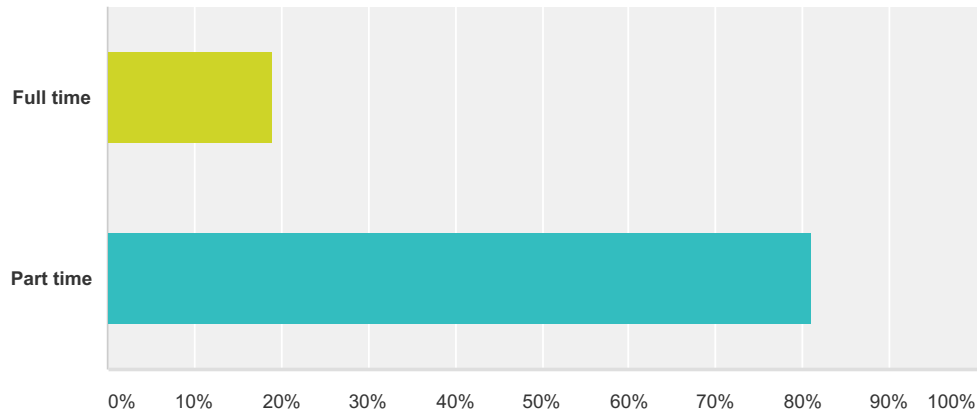

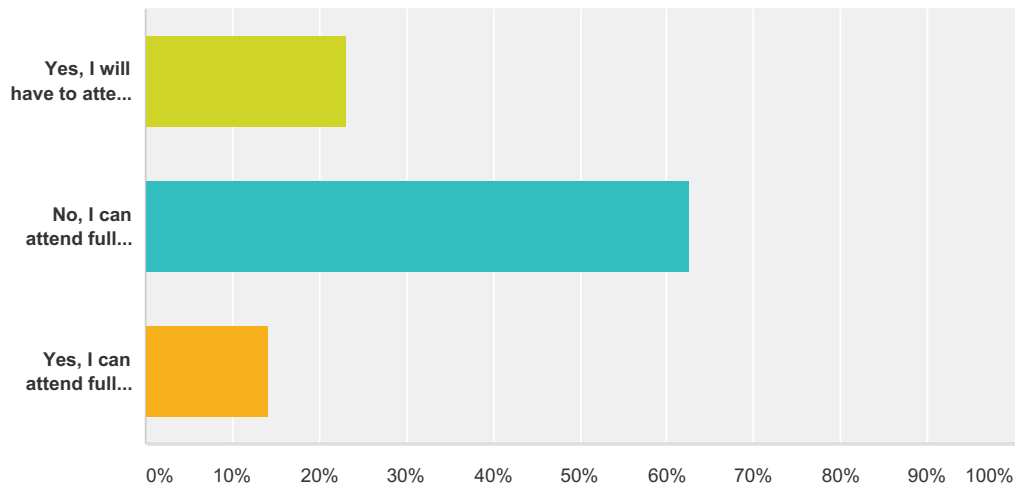

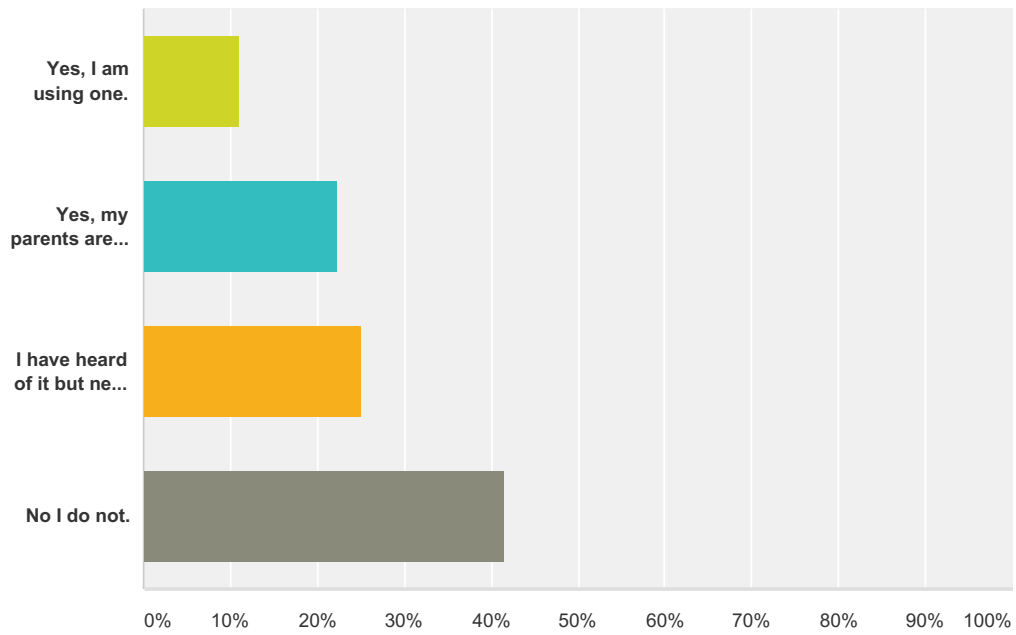

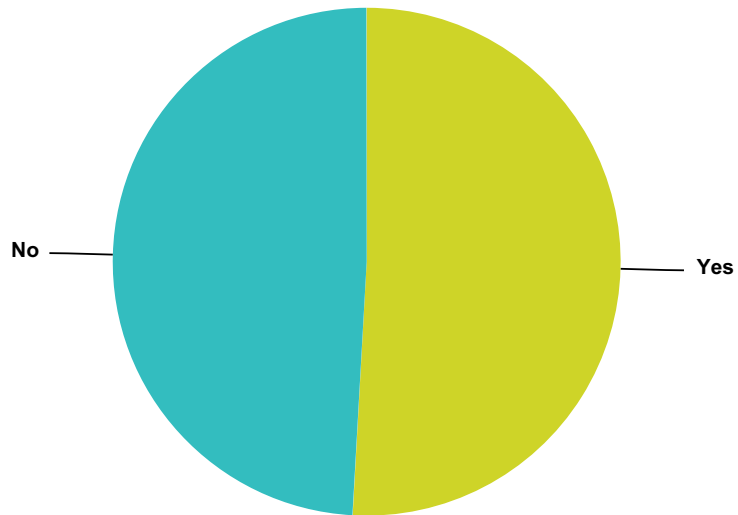

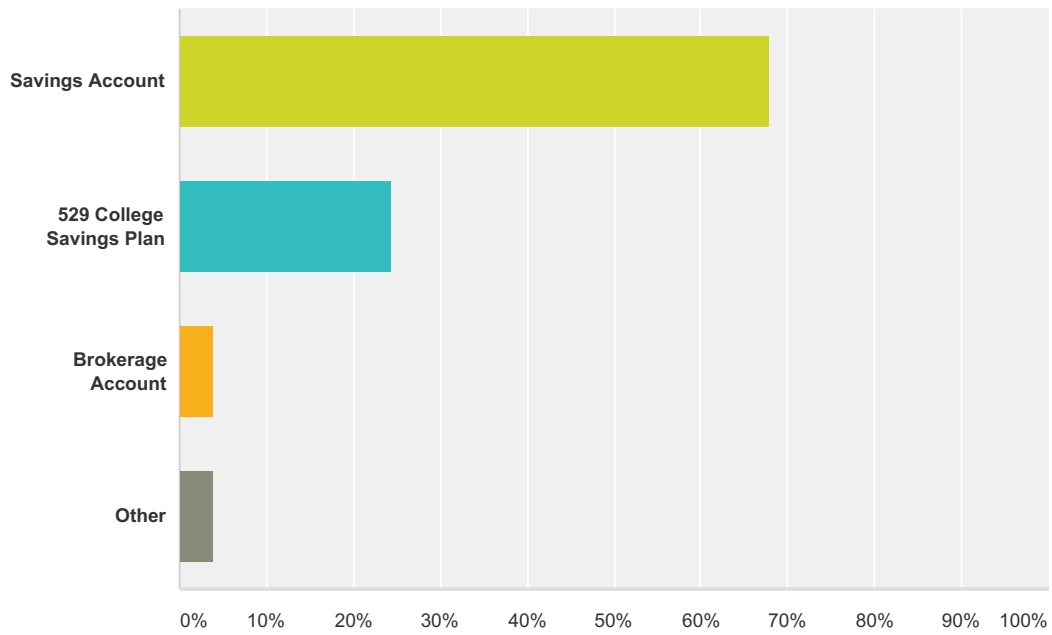

**Q22 What is the primary way that you are saving for higher education costs?**

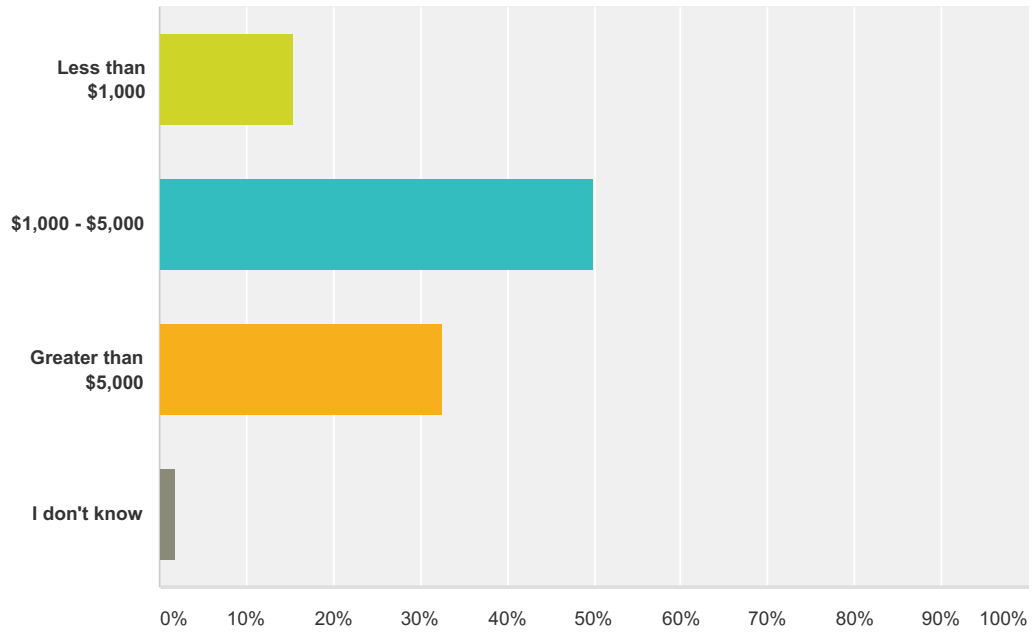

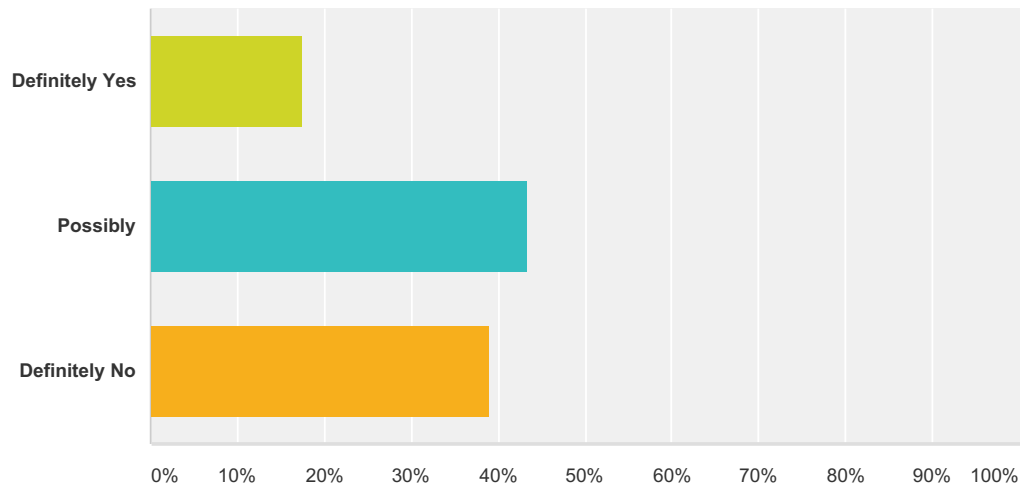

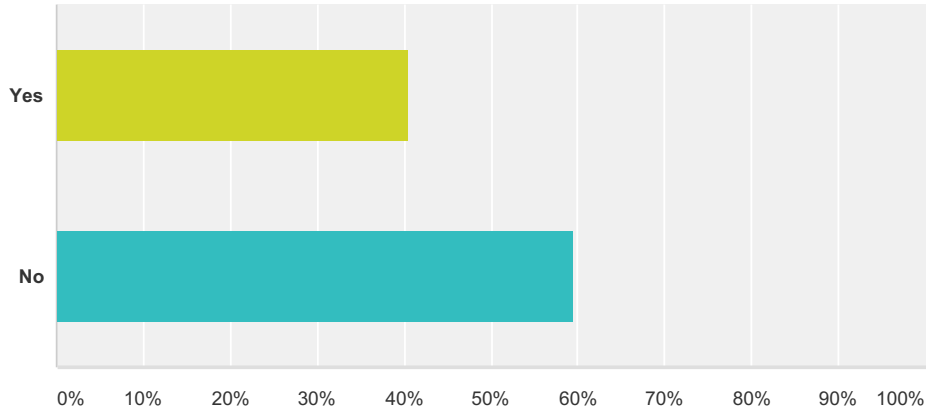

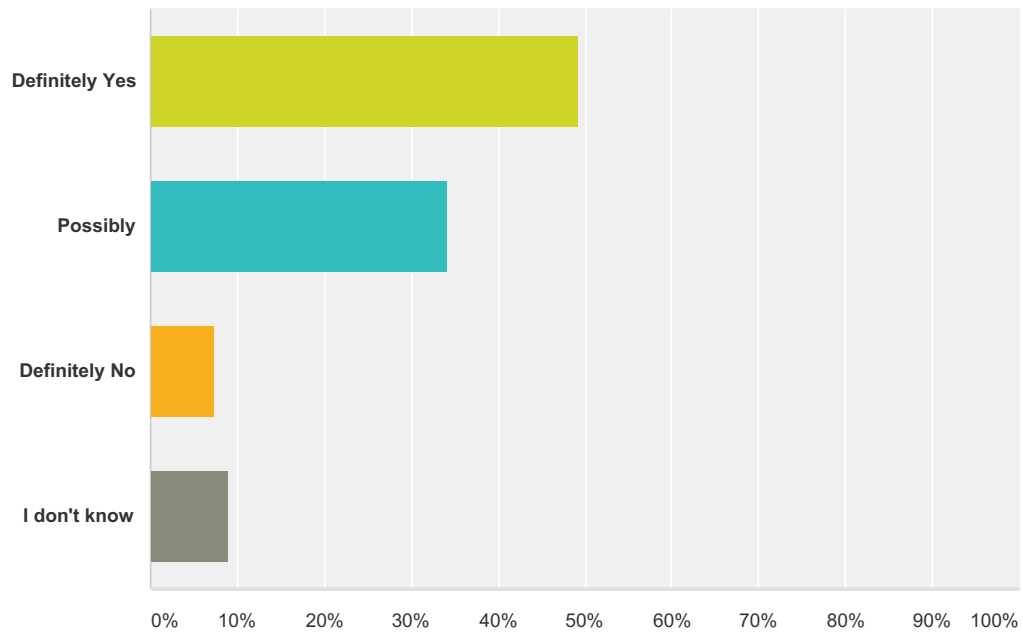

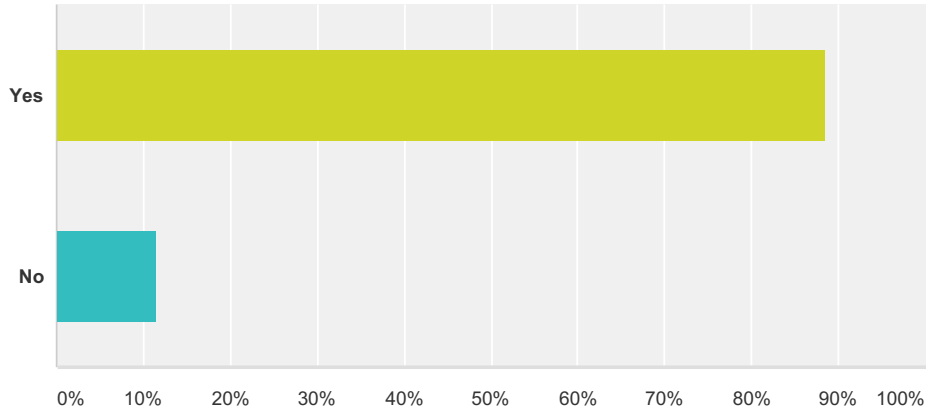

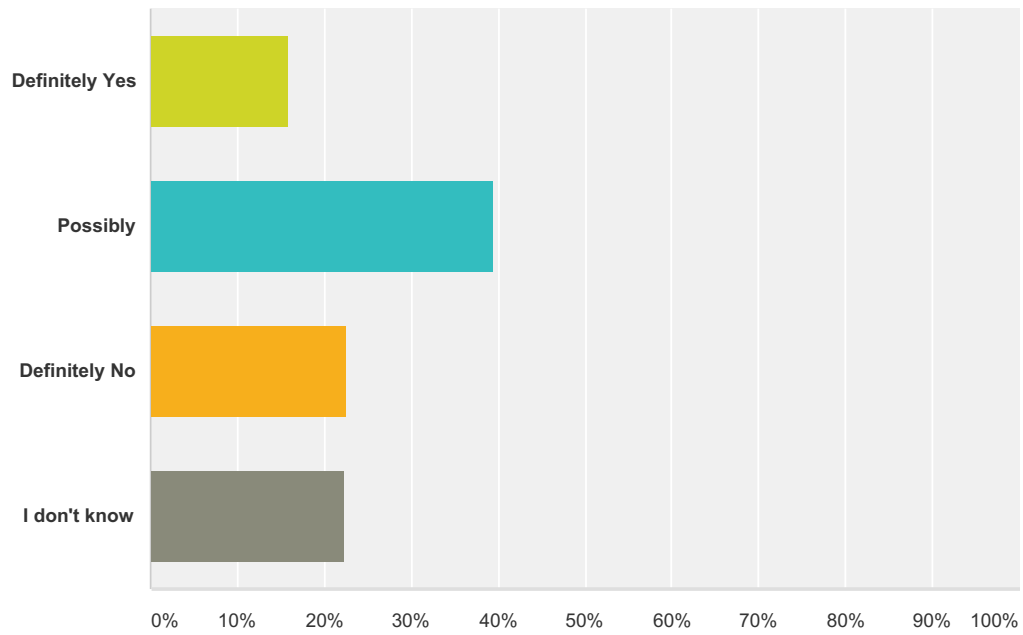

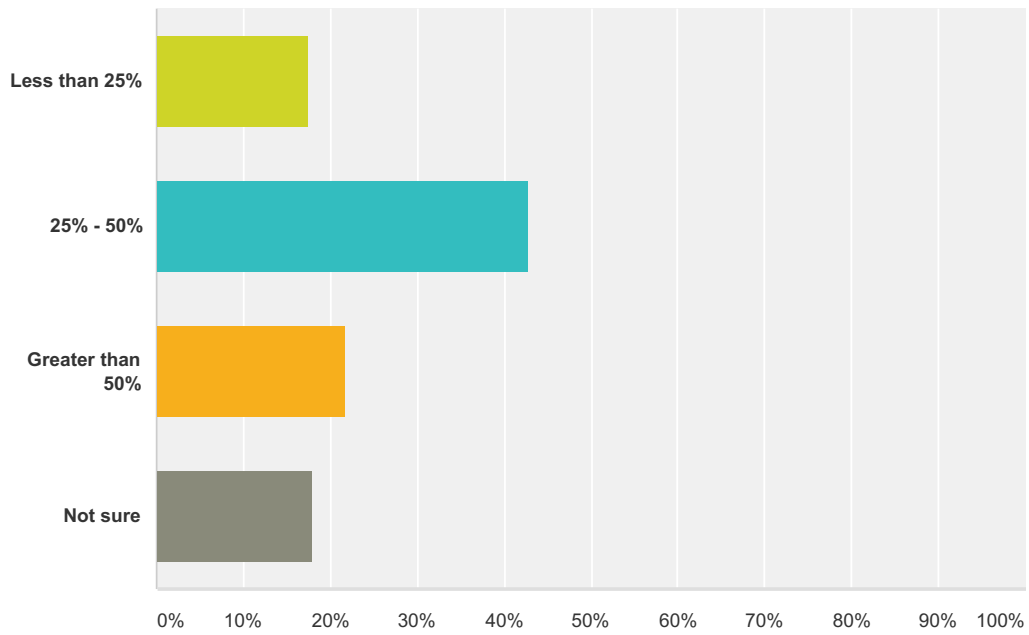

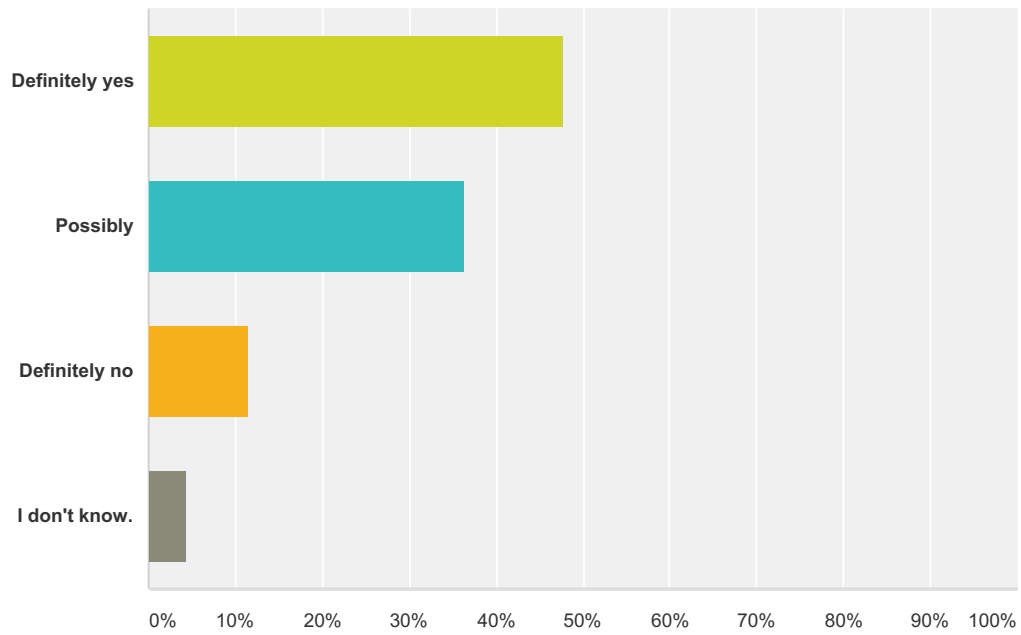

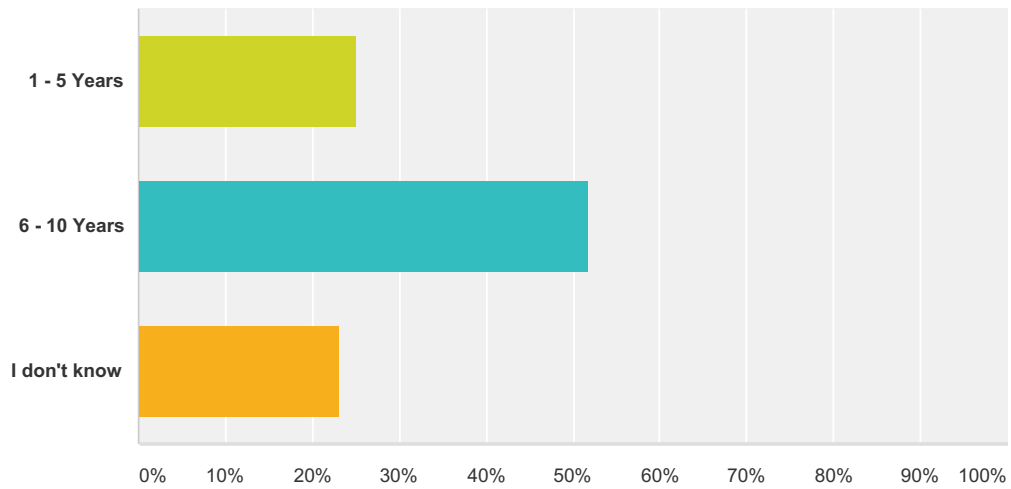

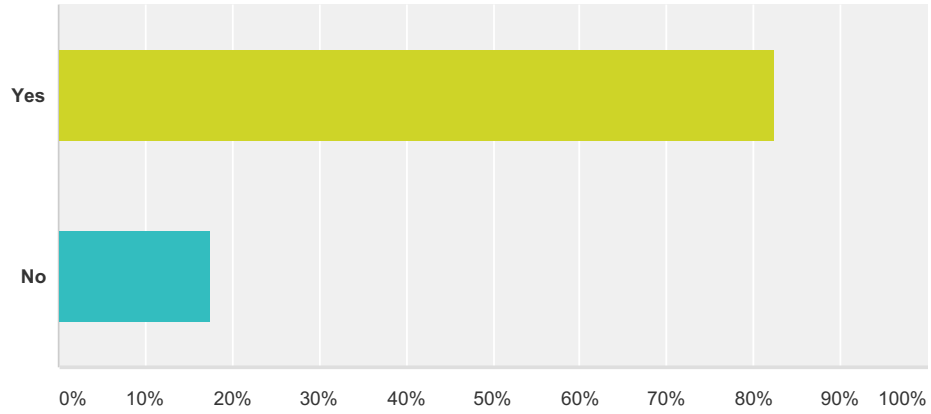

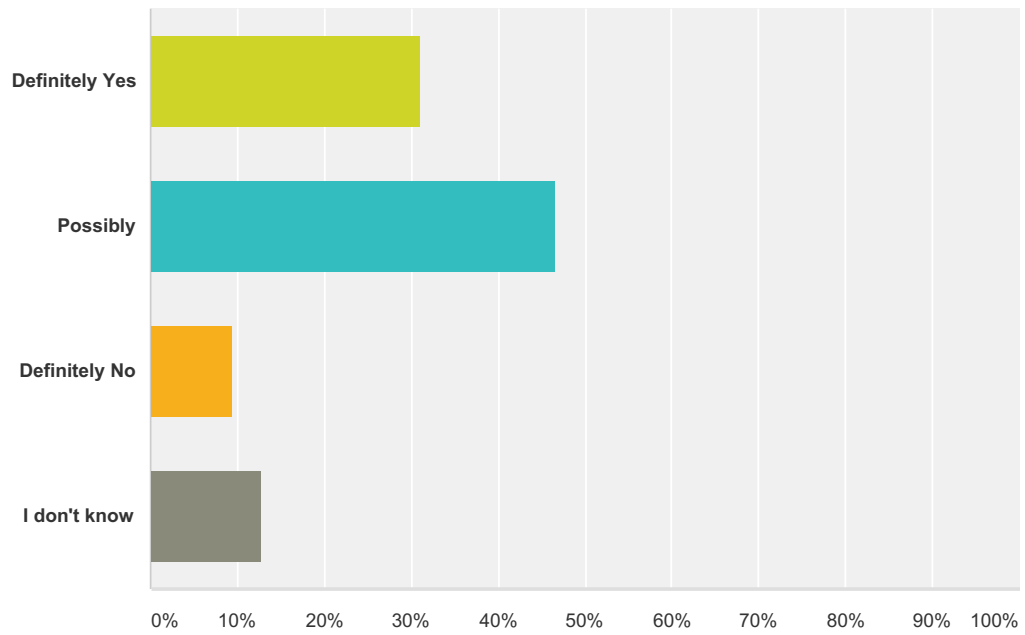

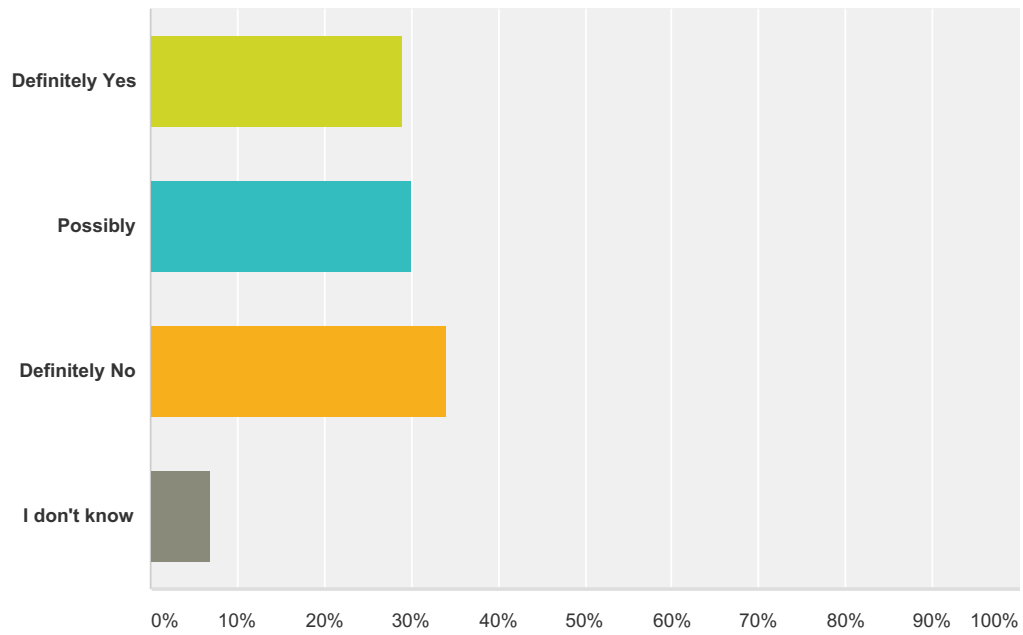

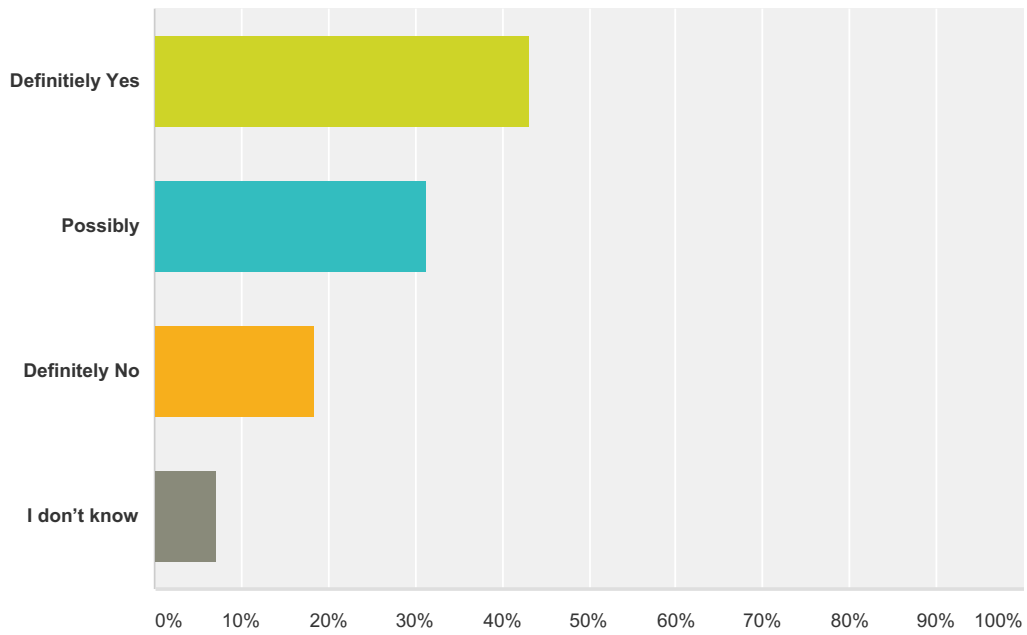

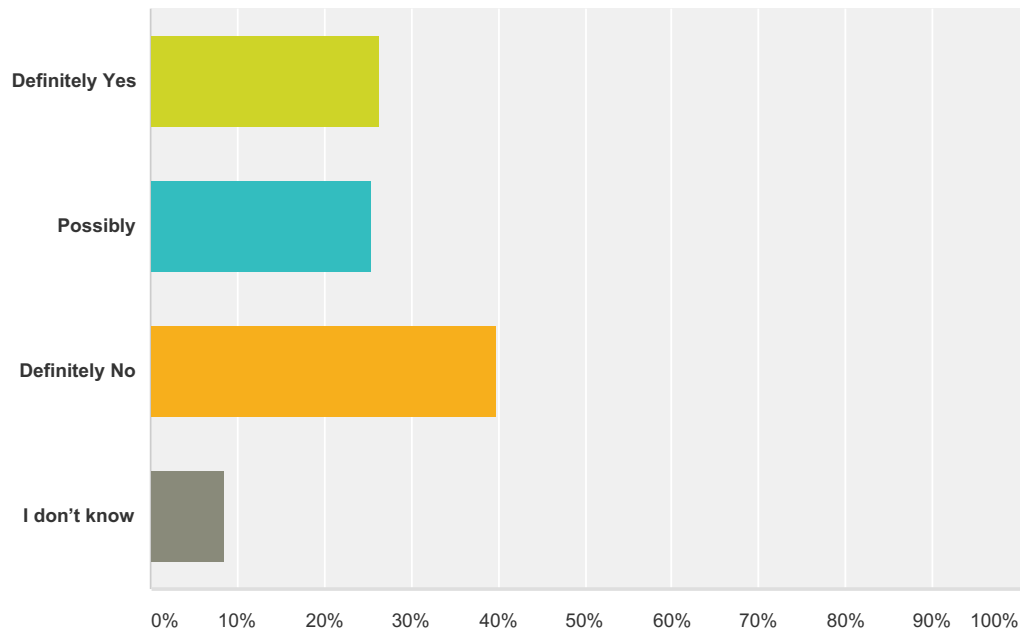

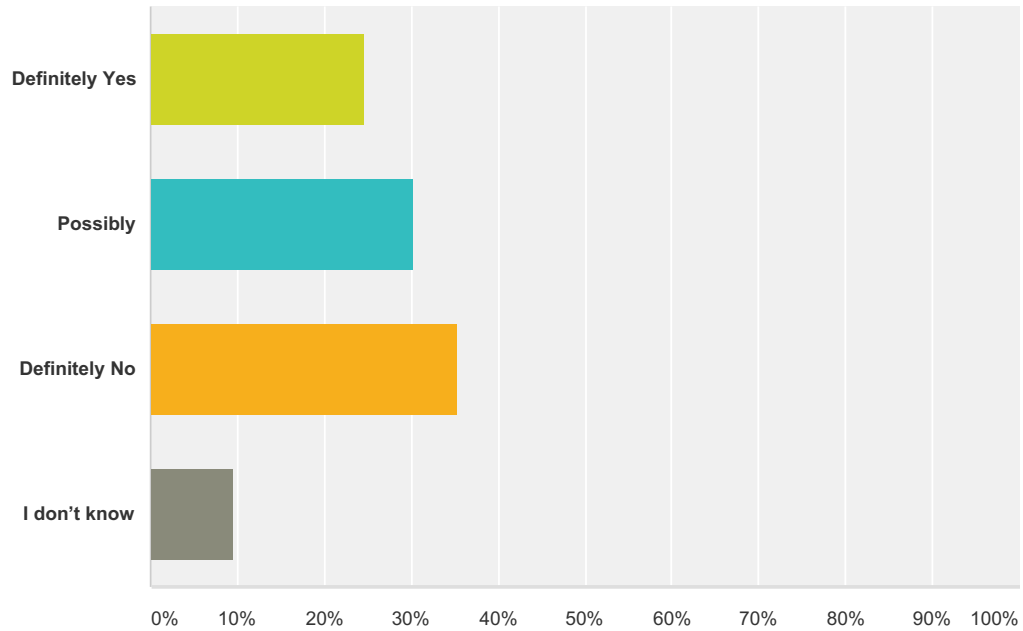

**Q37 Will costs be a factor in choosing a major (i.e., some careers have a higher starting salary, some careers have steady raises throughout the lifetime of a career)?**

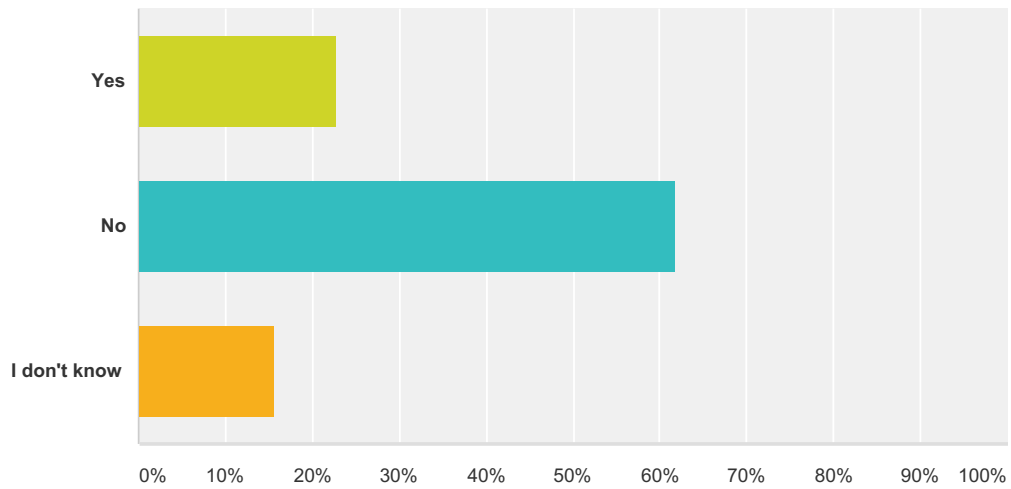

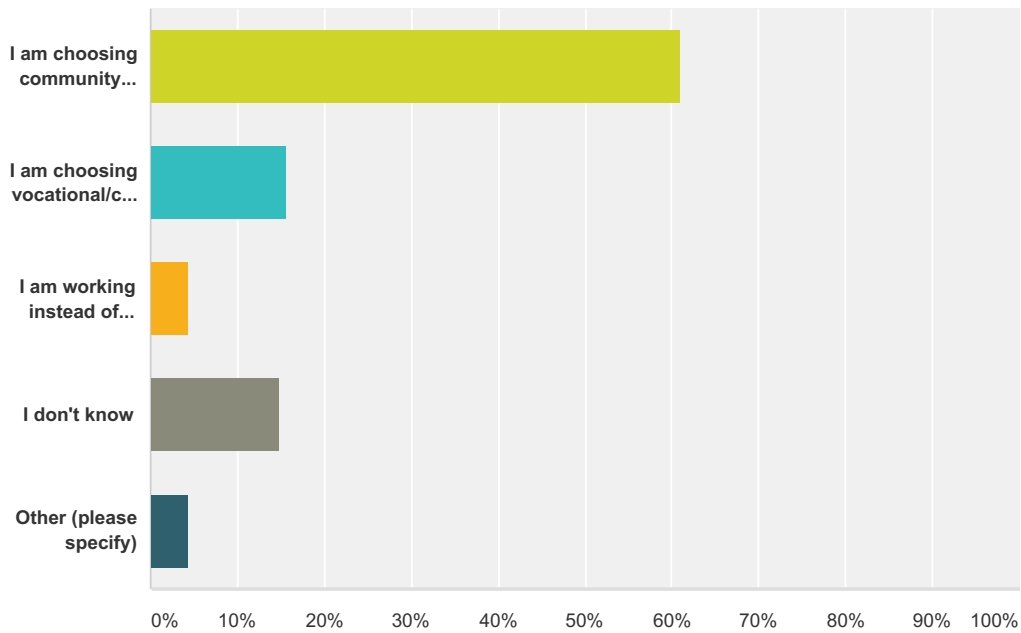

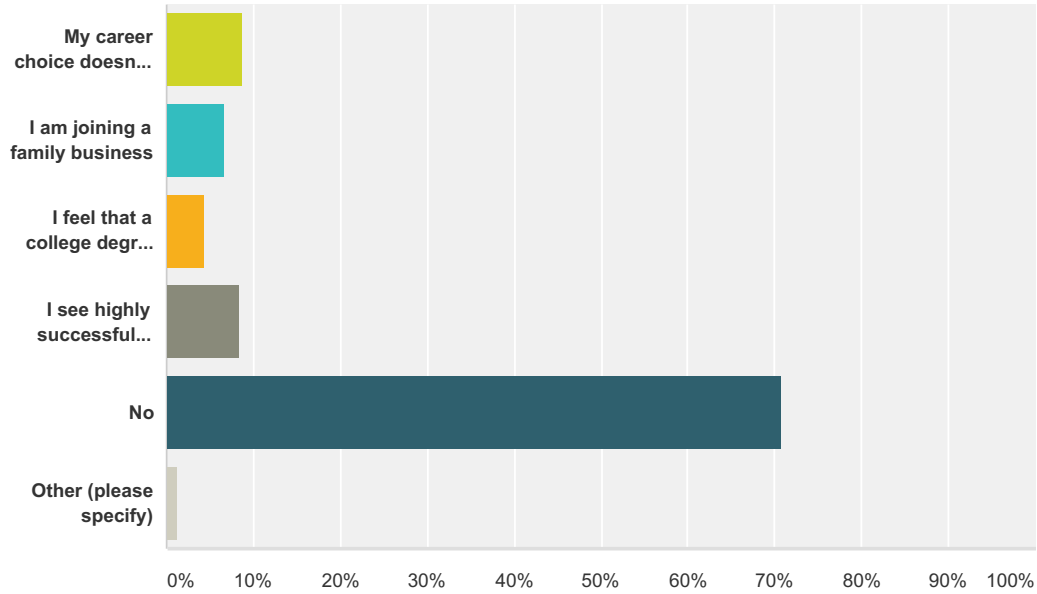

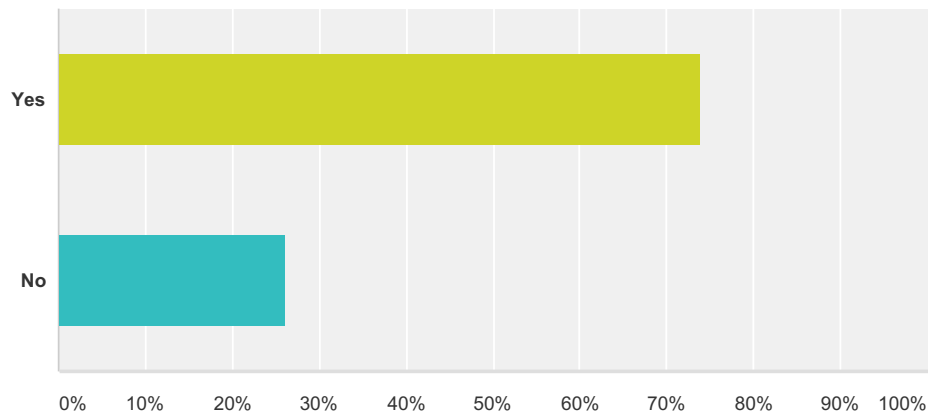

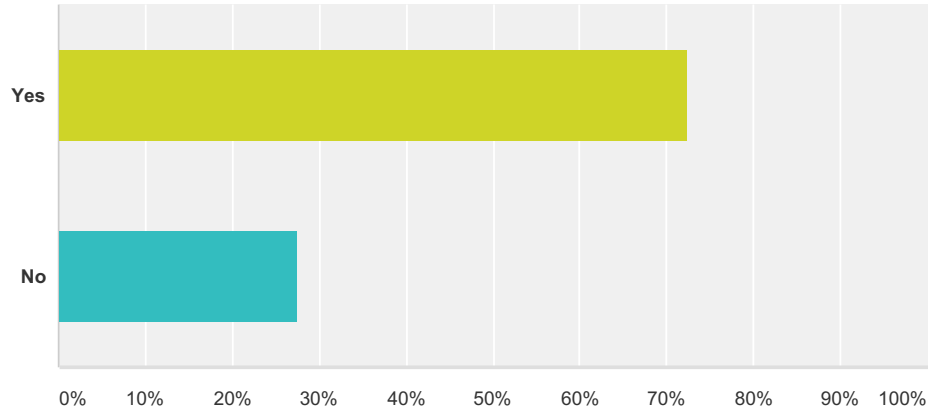

**Q42 Have you talked to your parents about their involvement in funding your college education?**

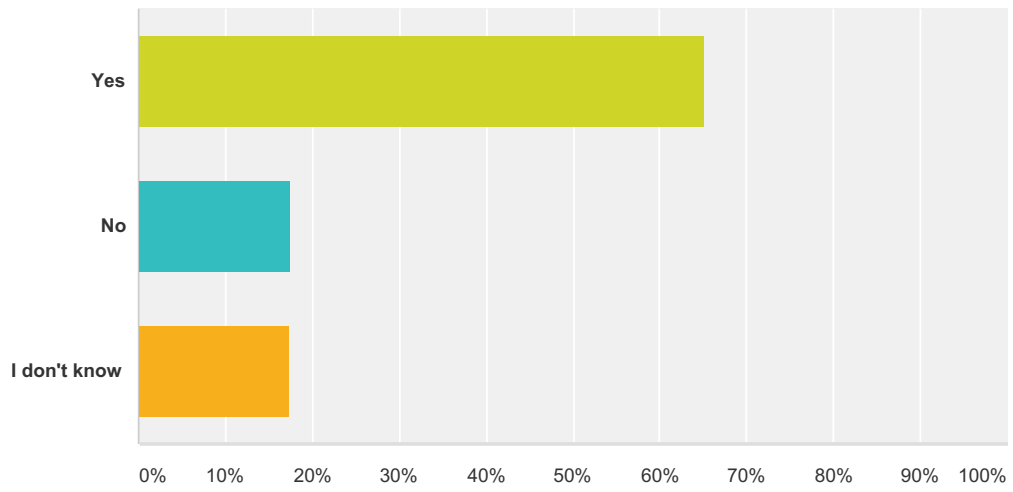

### Q43 Are your parents saving for you to attend college?

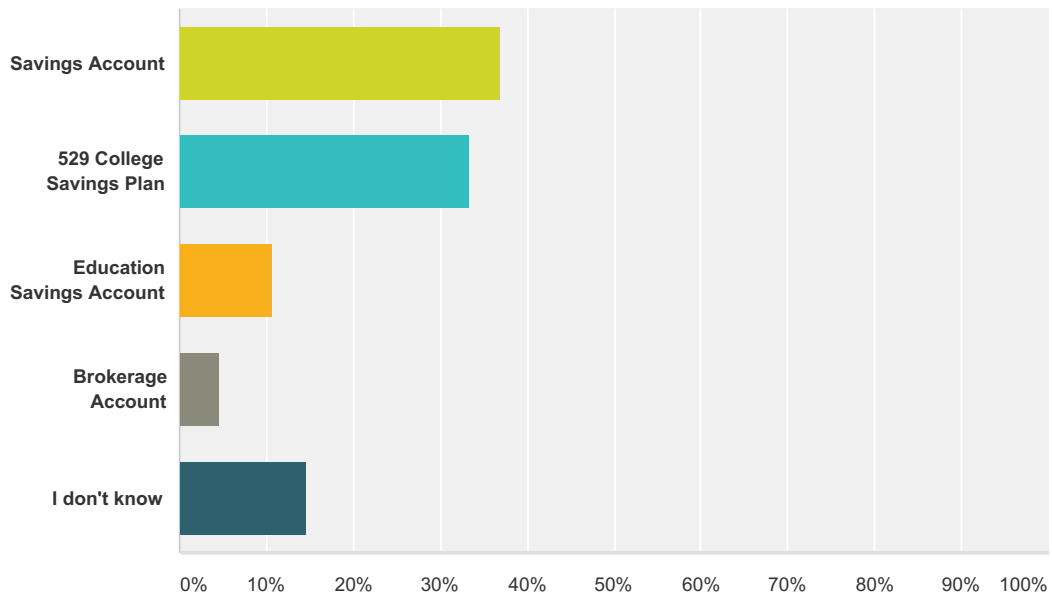

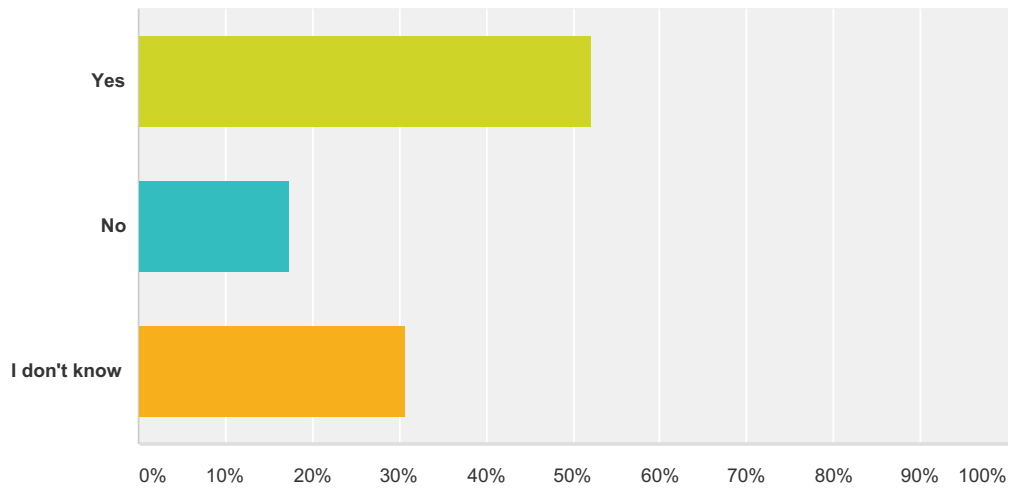

### Q45 Are they saving a fixed amount per month?

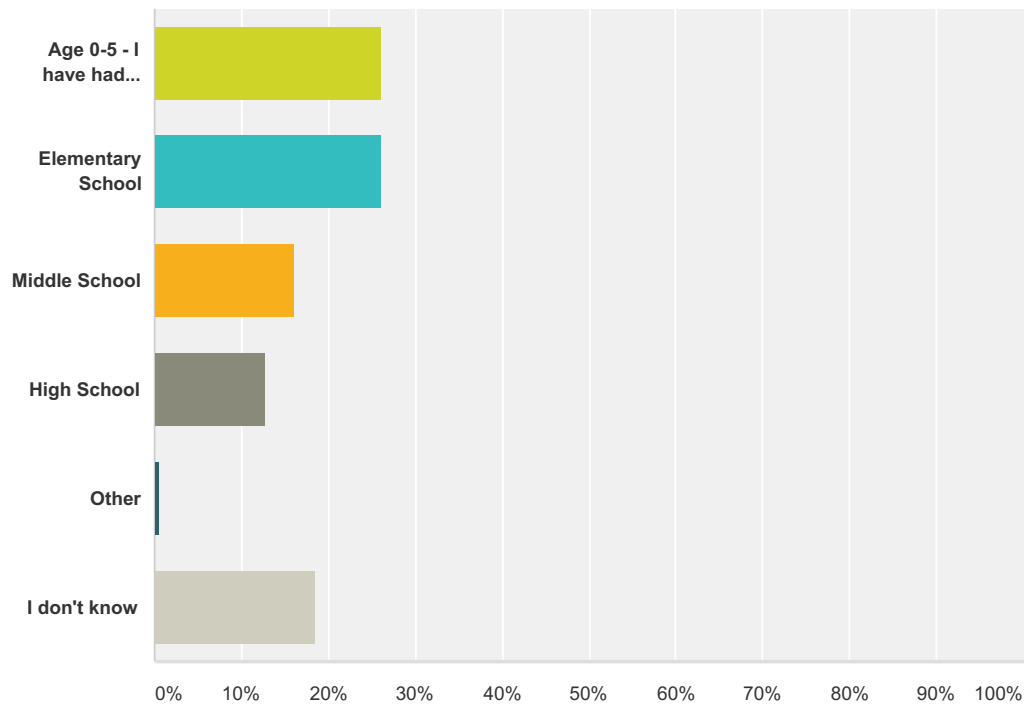

### Q46 What age were you when they started saving?

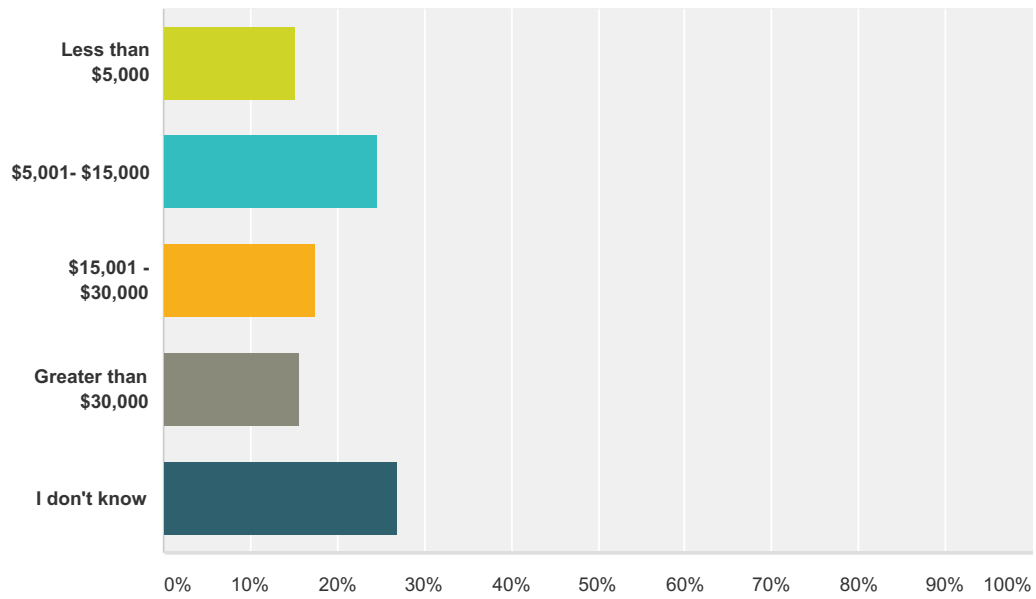

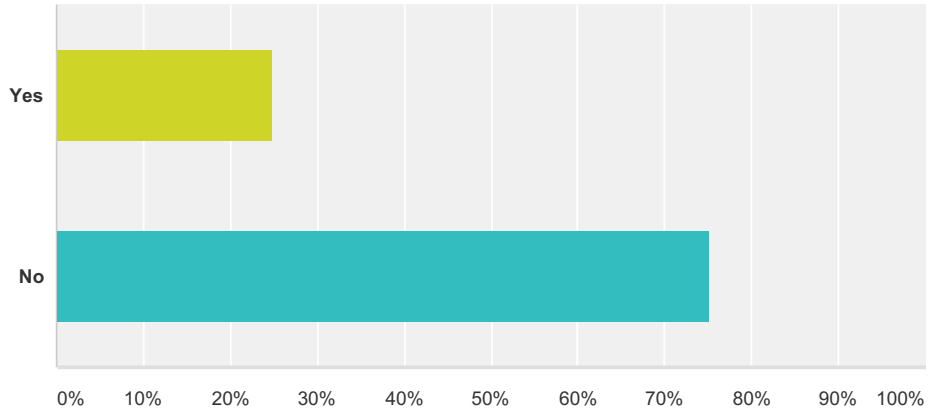

**Q48 Do you know if your relatives (i.e. grandparents, aunts, uncles) are saving for your college costs?**

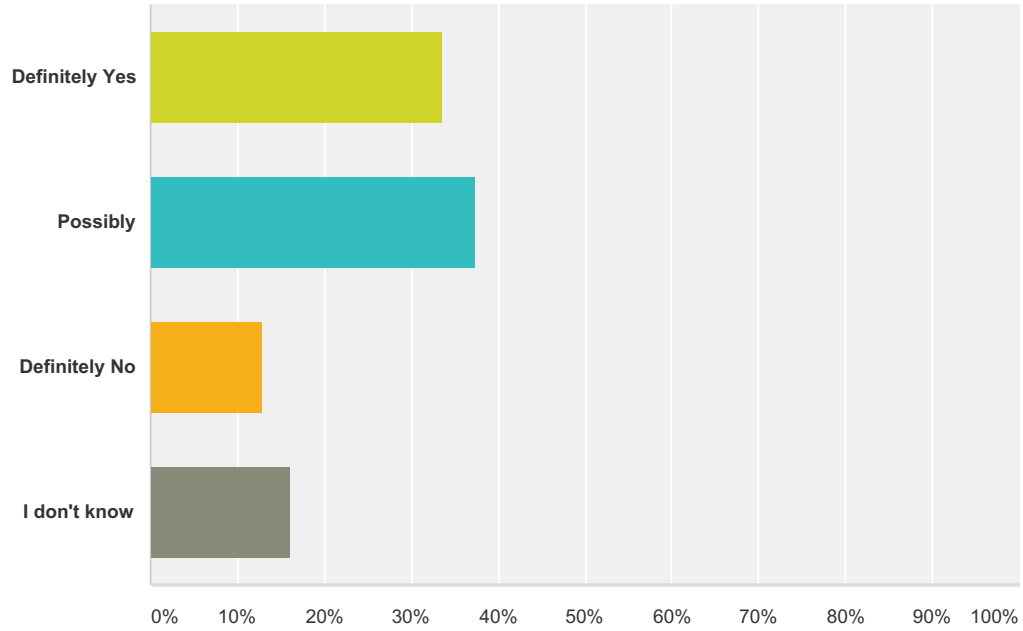

### Q49 Would you rather receive money for education on special occasions rather than tangible gifts?

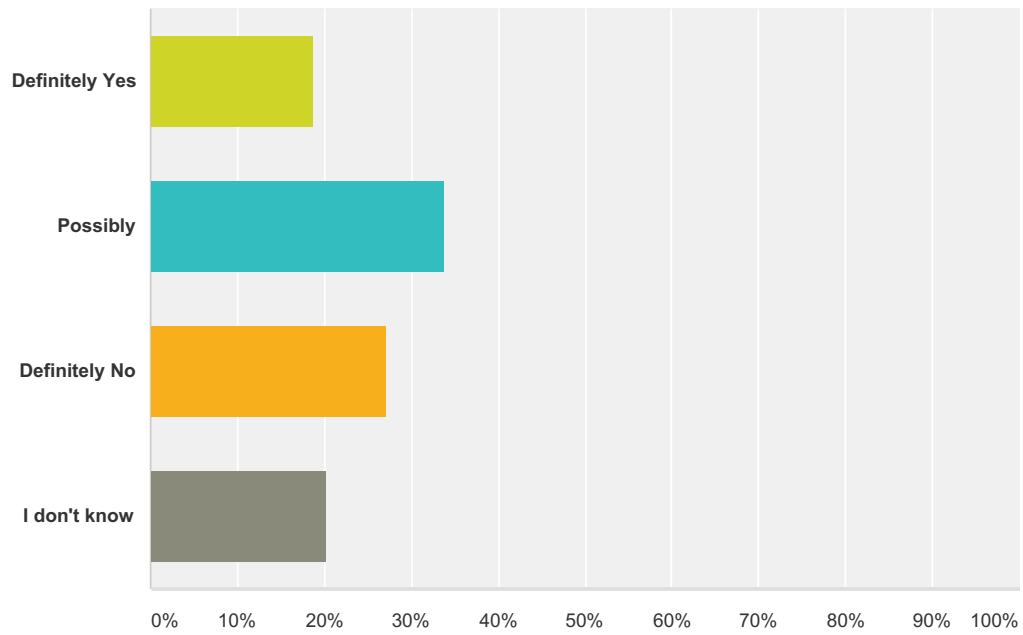

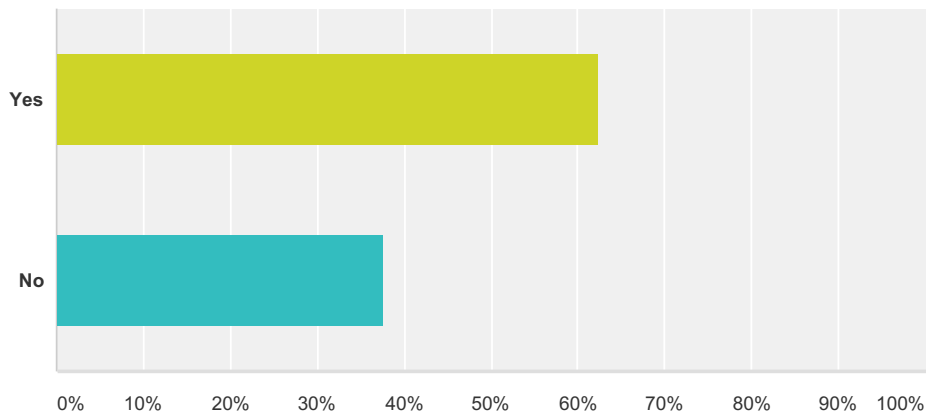

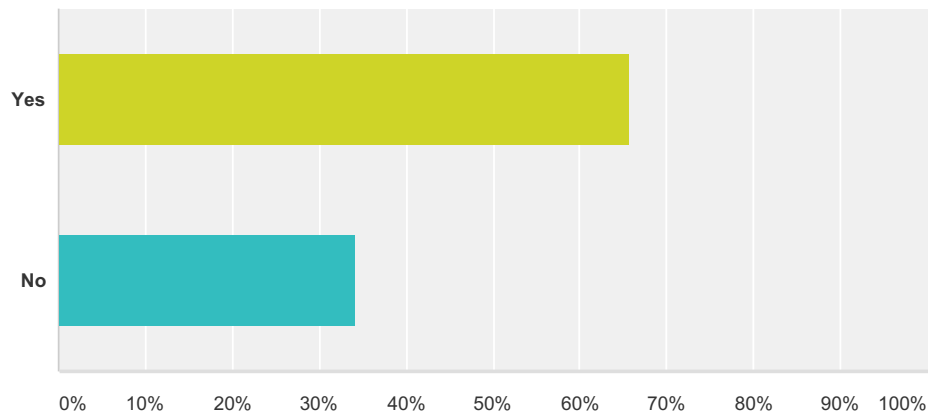

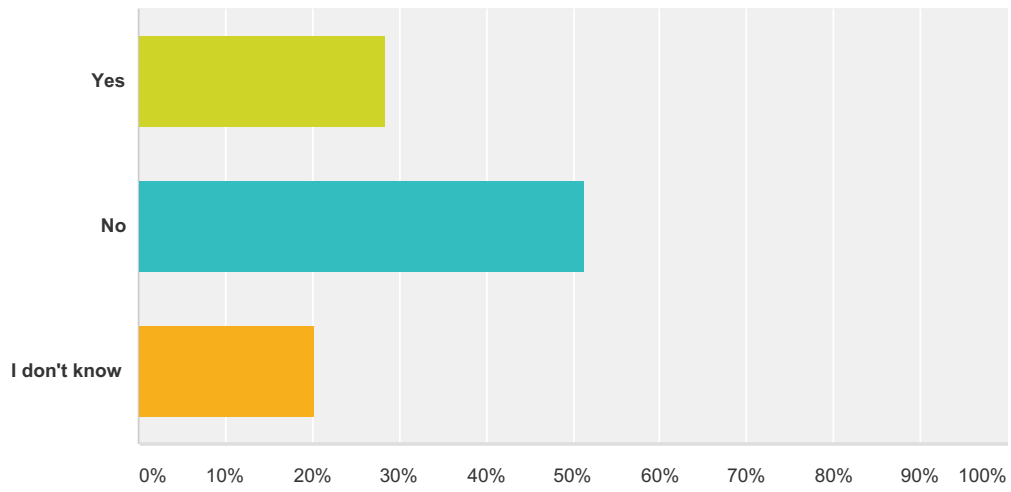

### Q53 Has college funding created anxiety in your household?

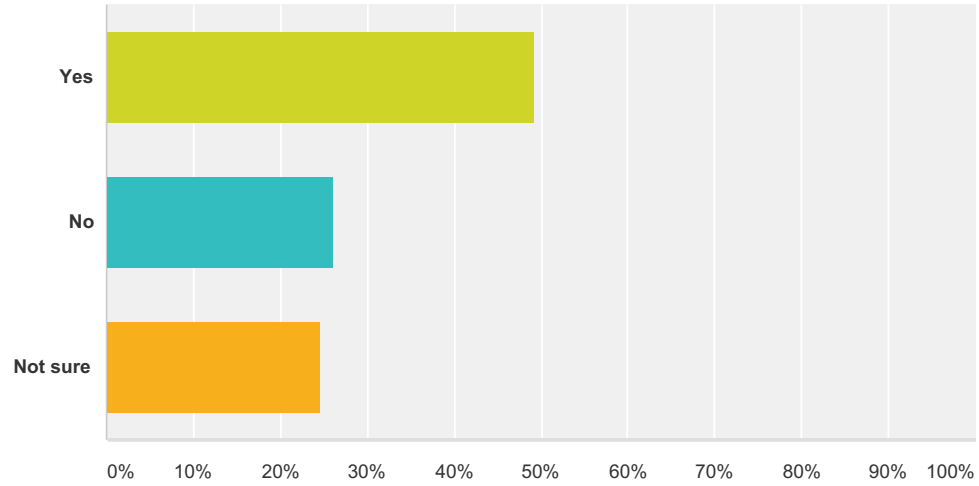

**Q54 Do you believe your high school has prepared you adequately for all aspects of higher education - academic and financial?**

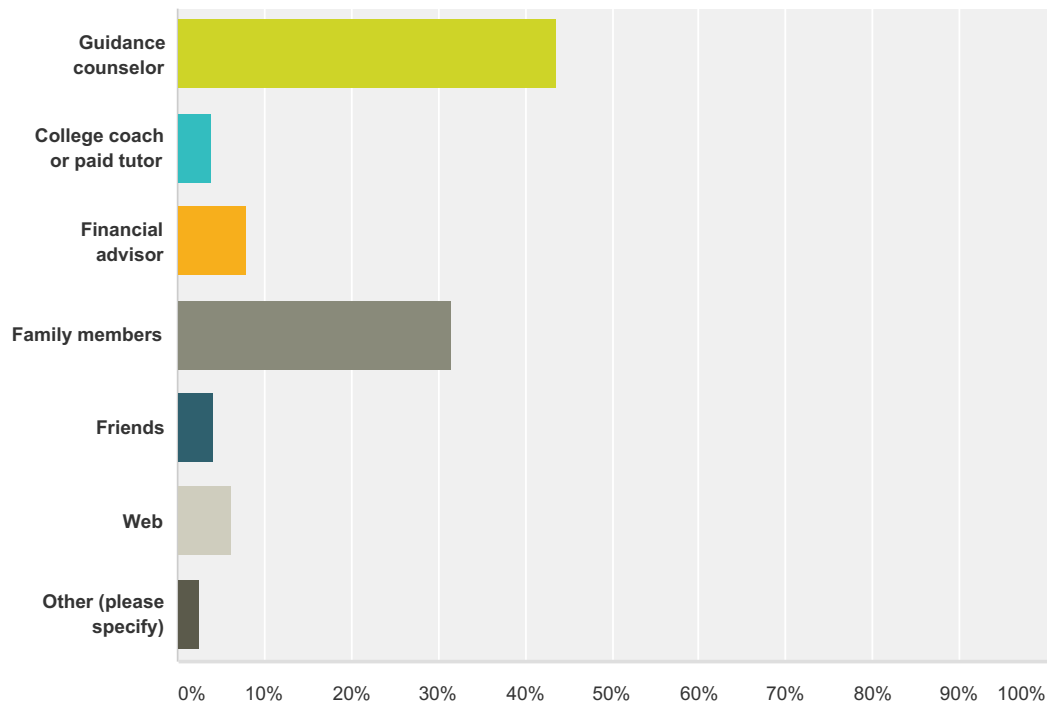
