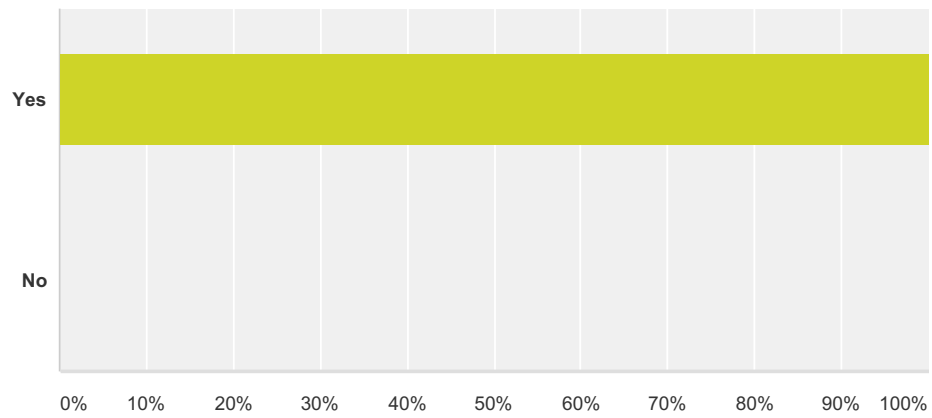

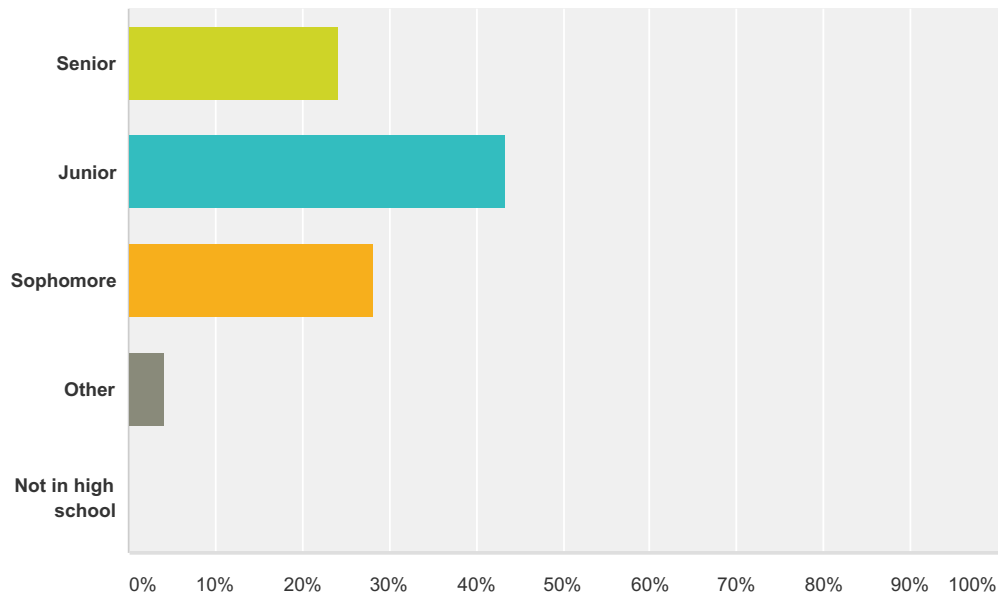

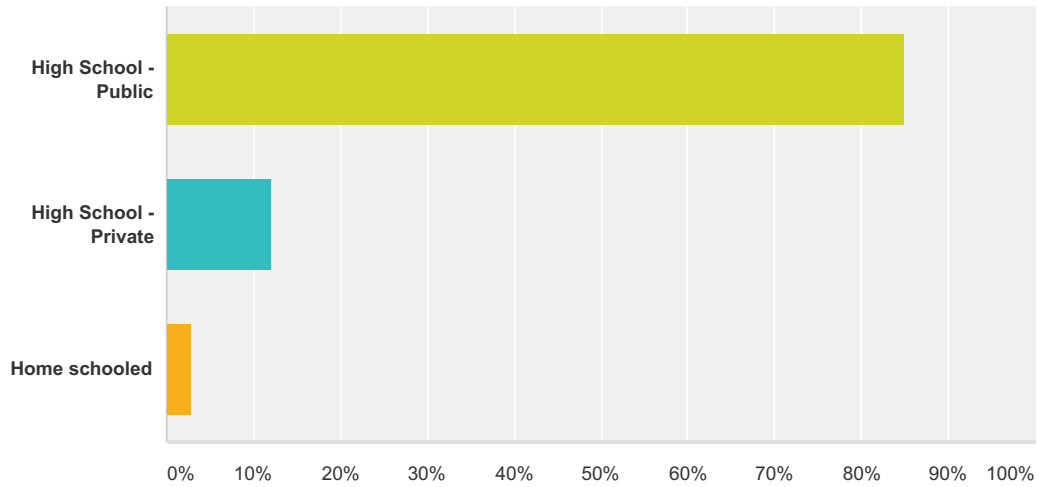

Q3 Where are you going to school now?

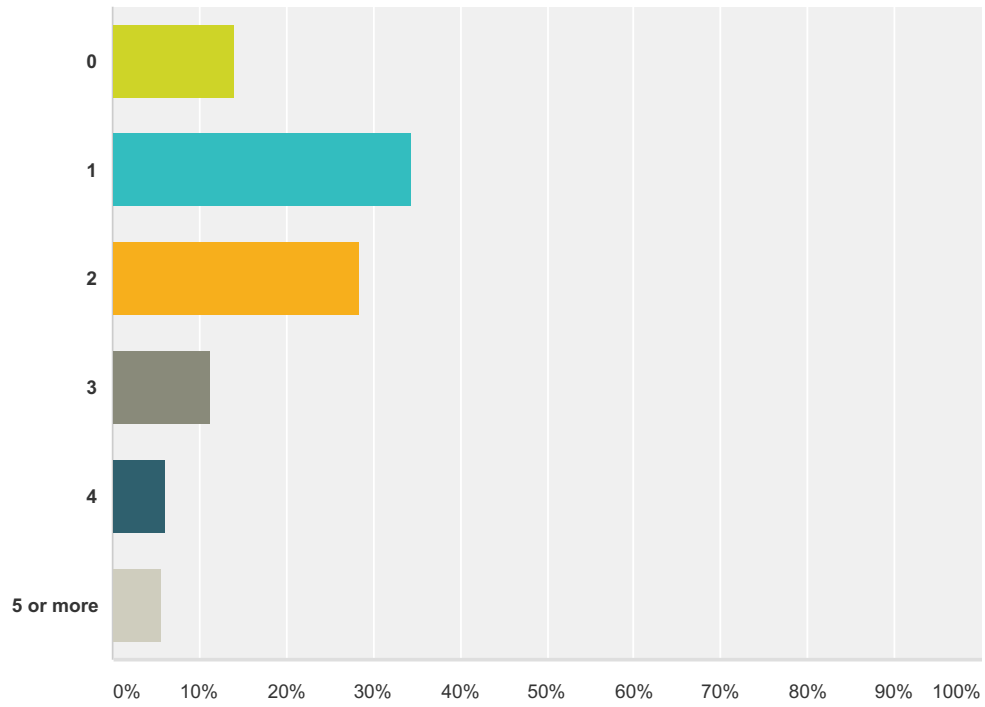

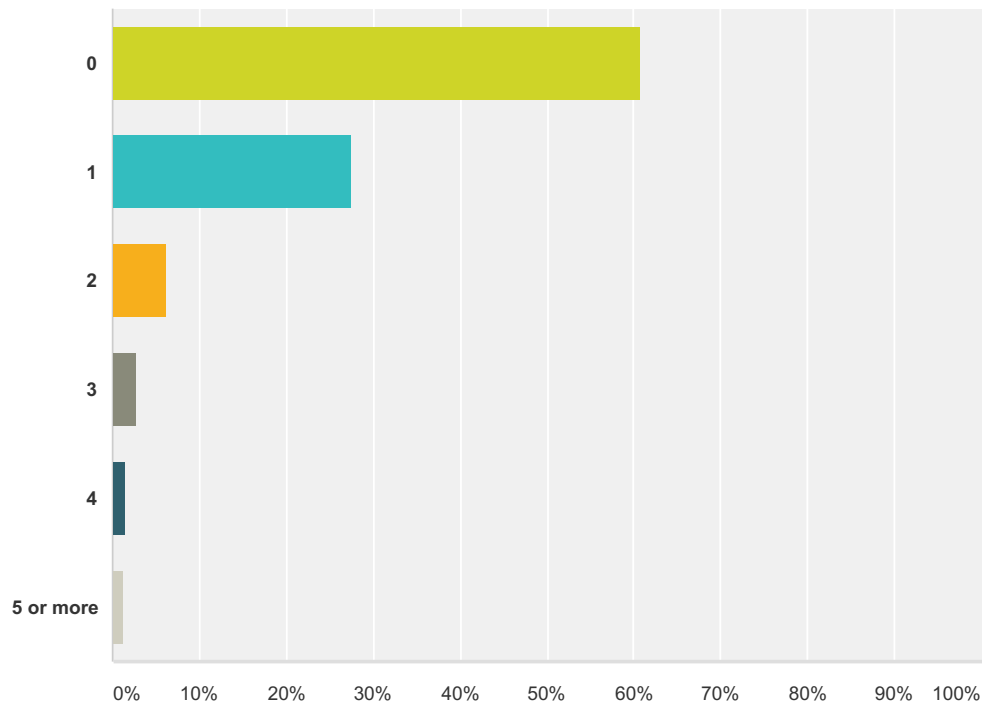

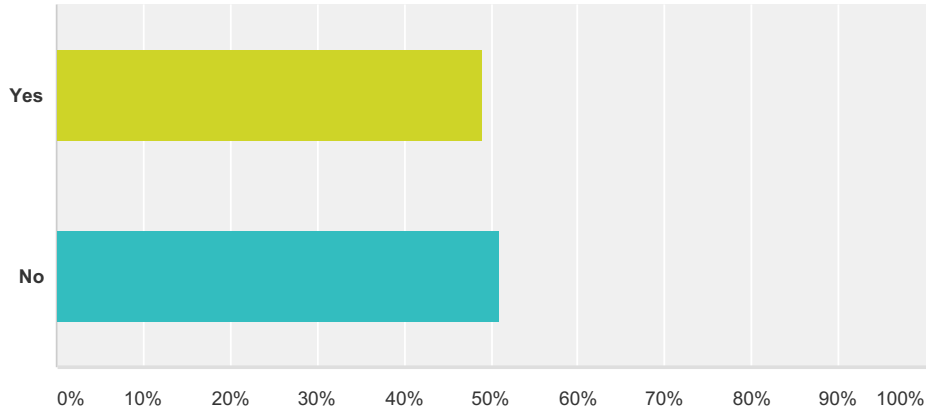

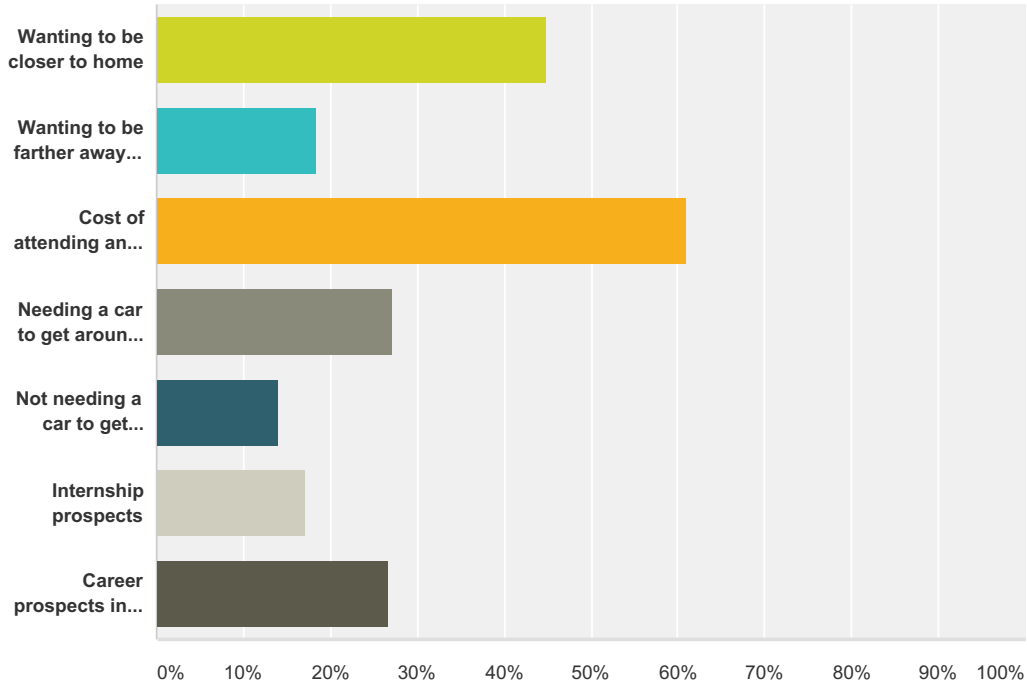

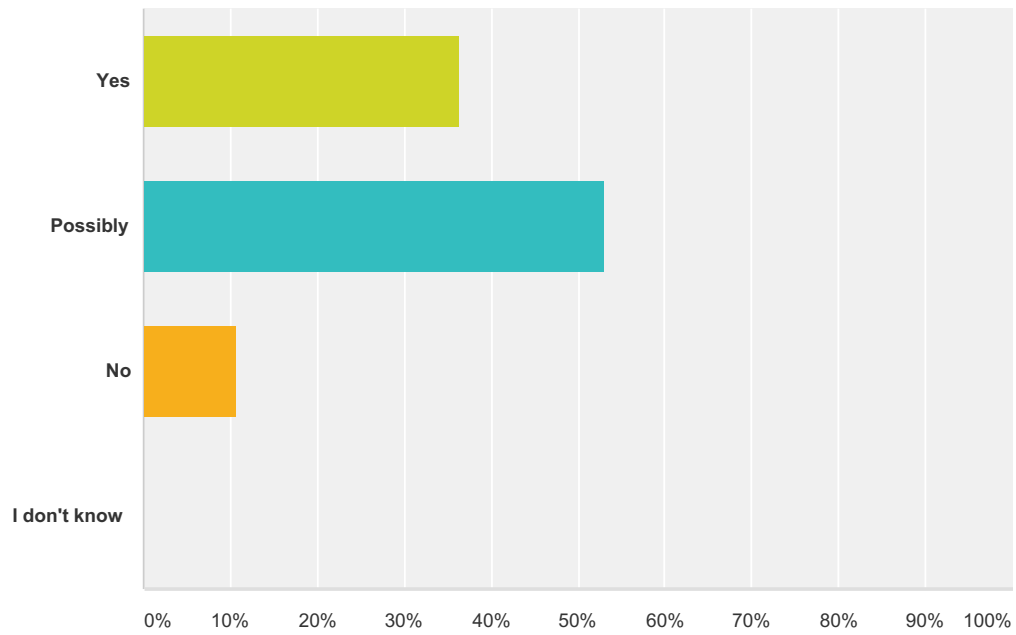

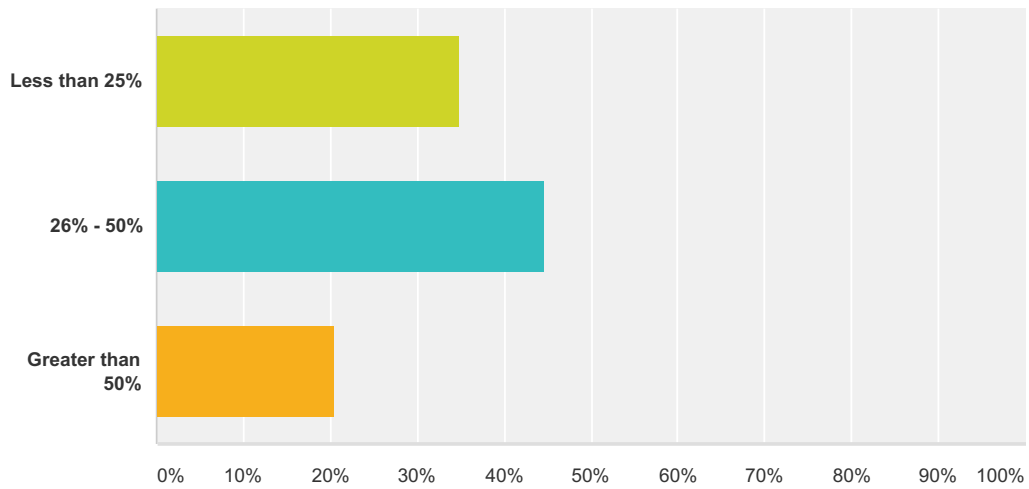

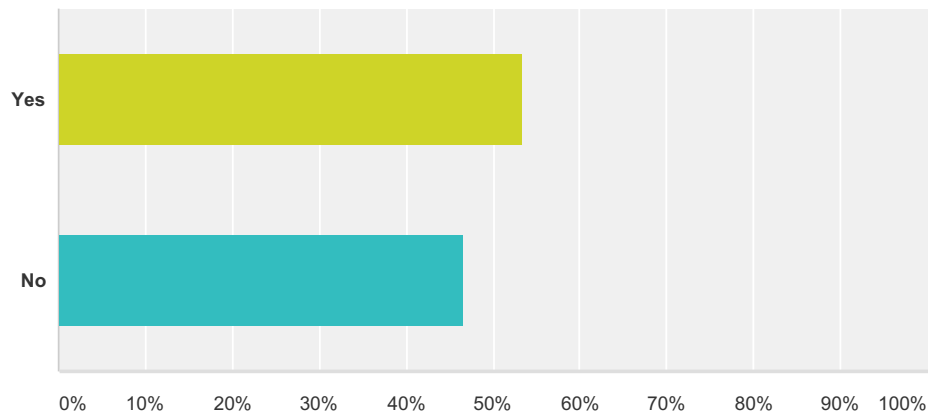

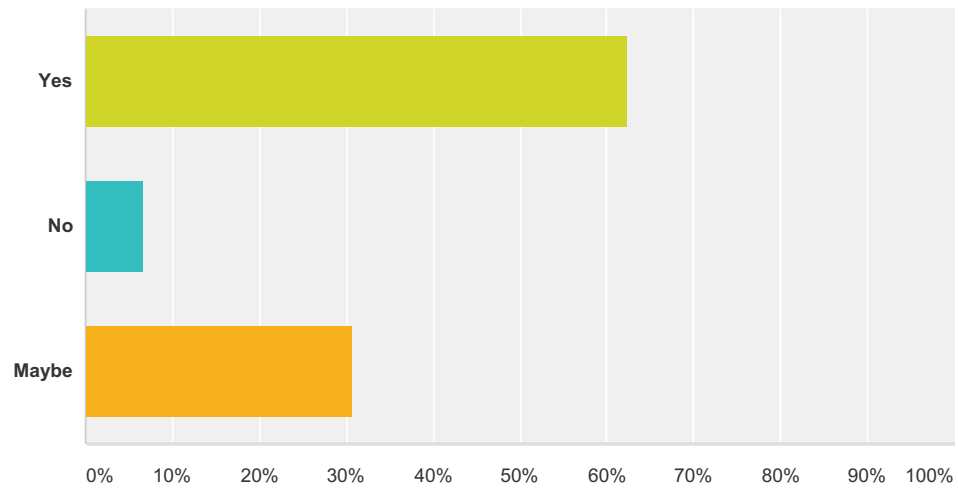

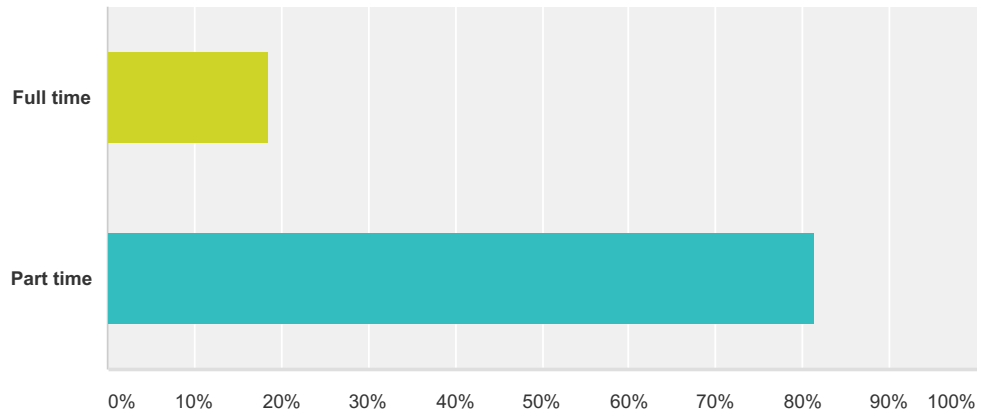

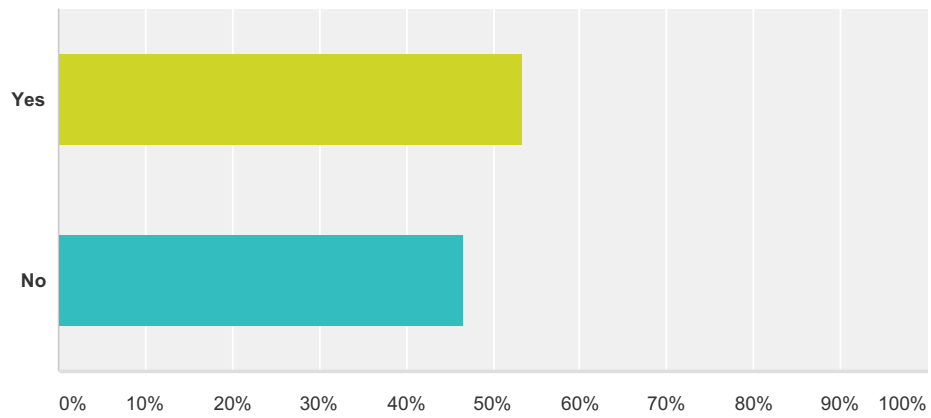

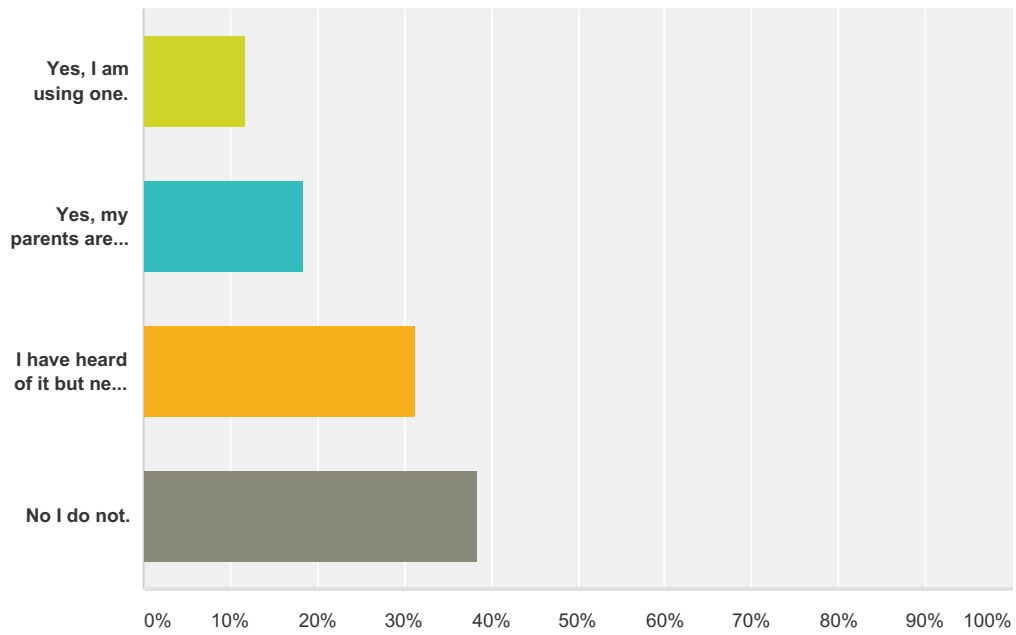

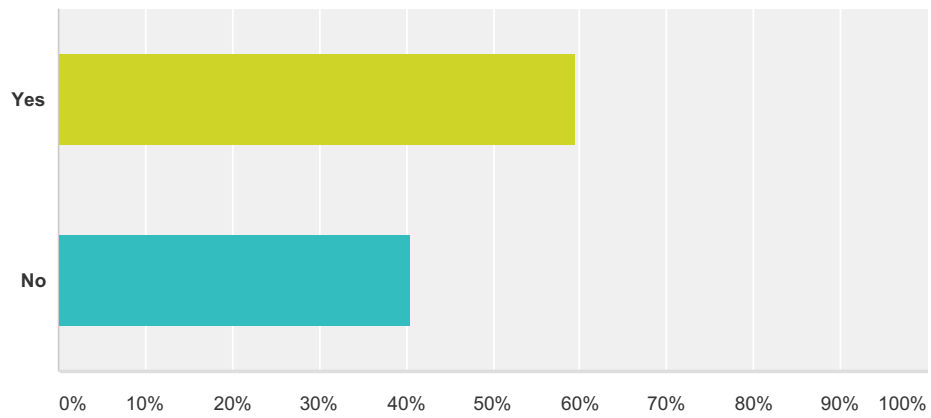

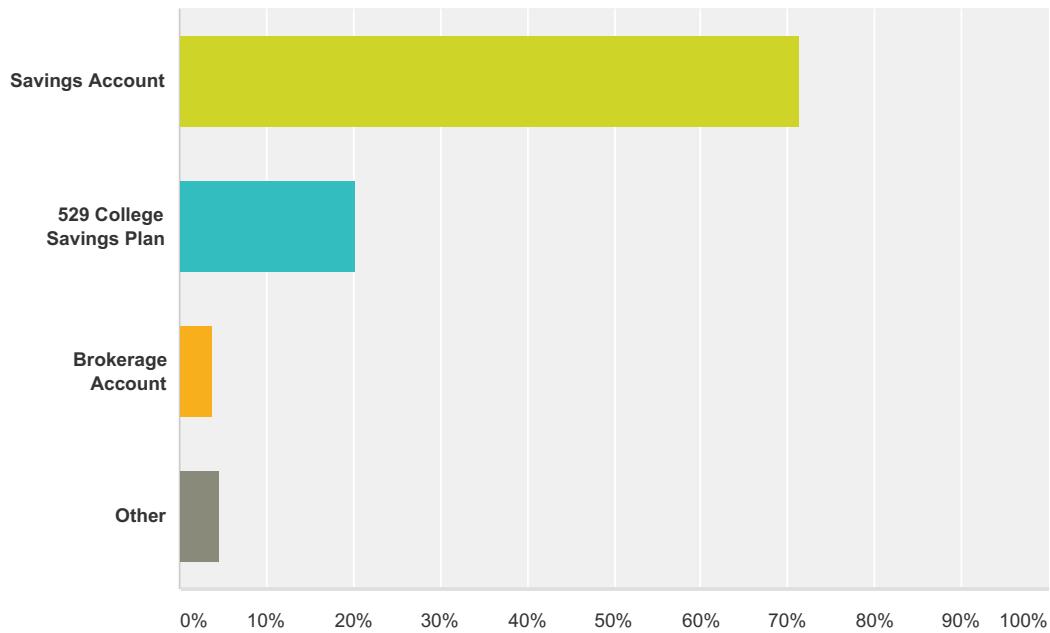

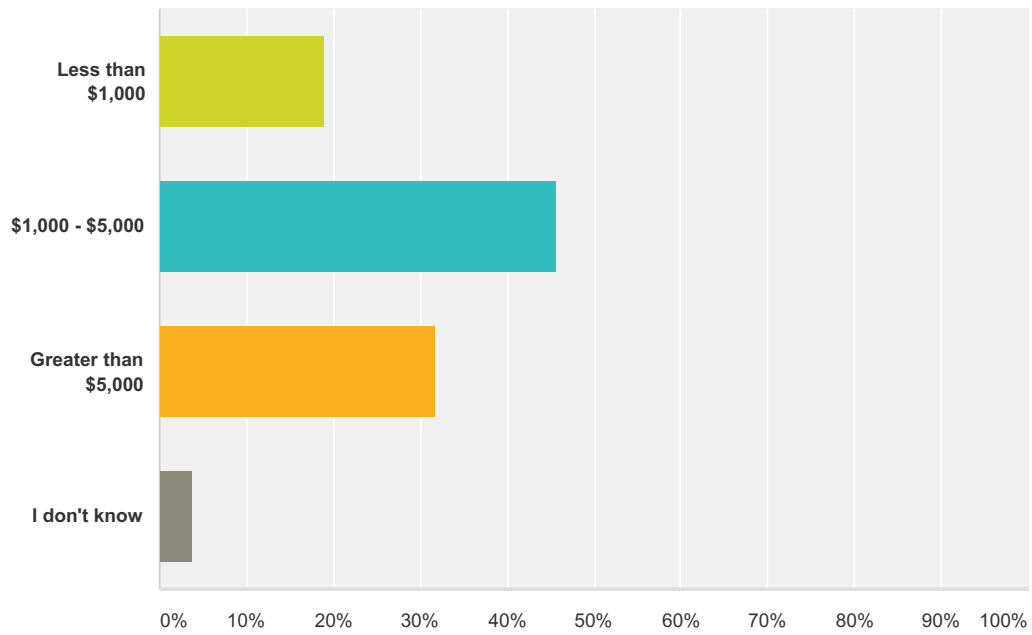

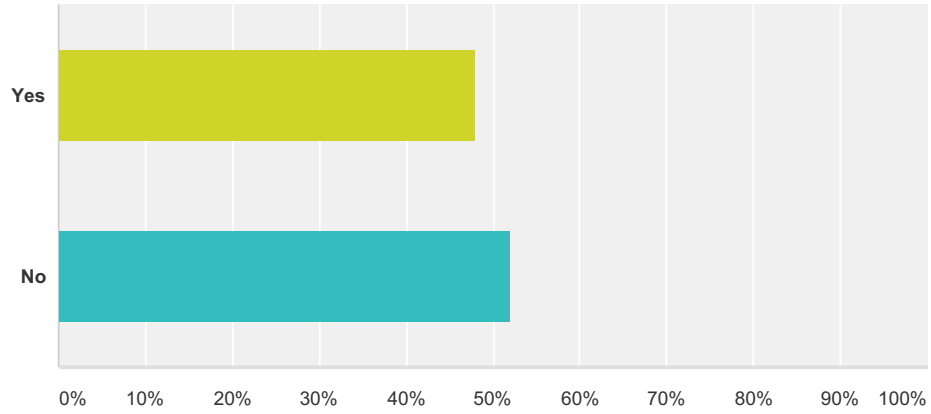

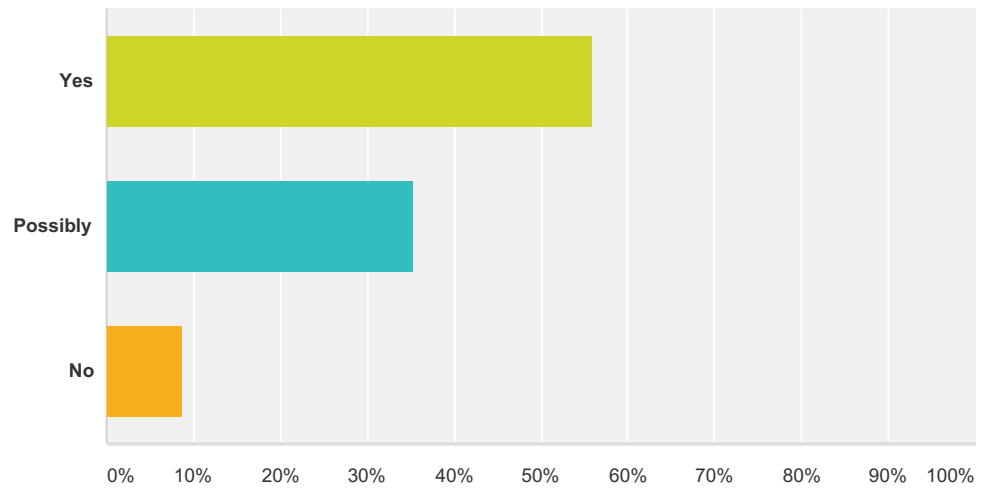

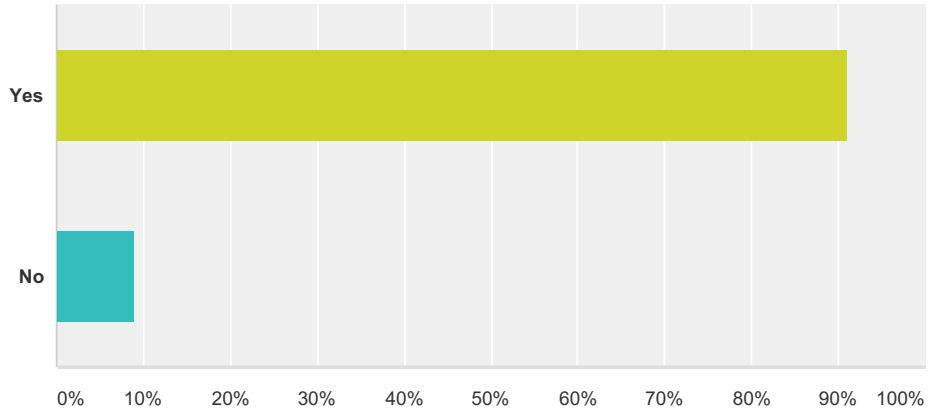

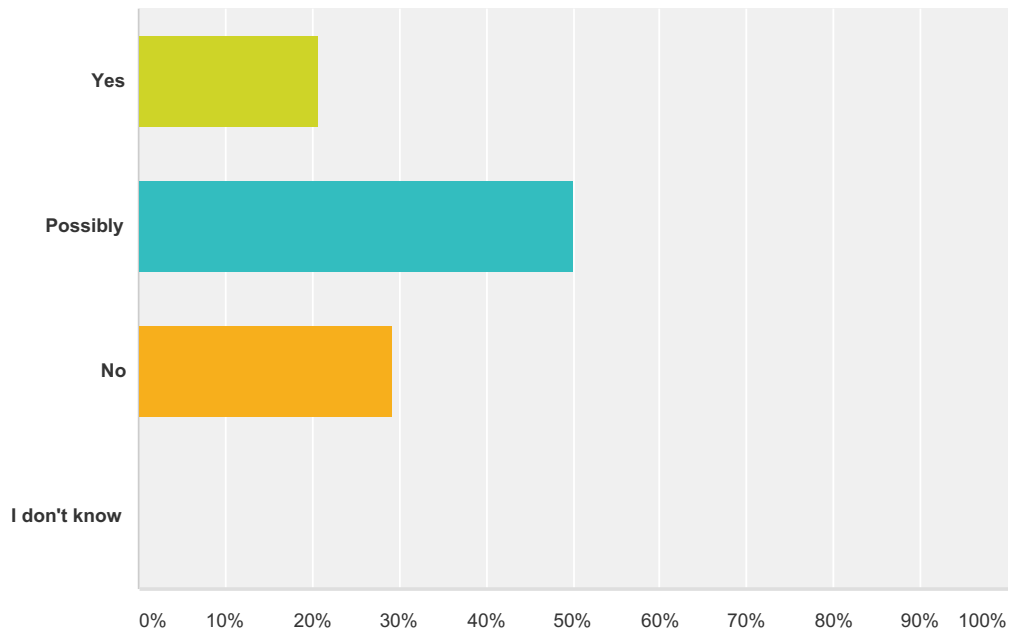

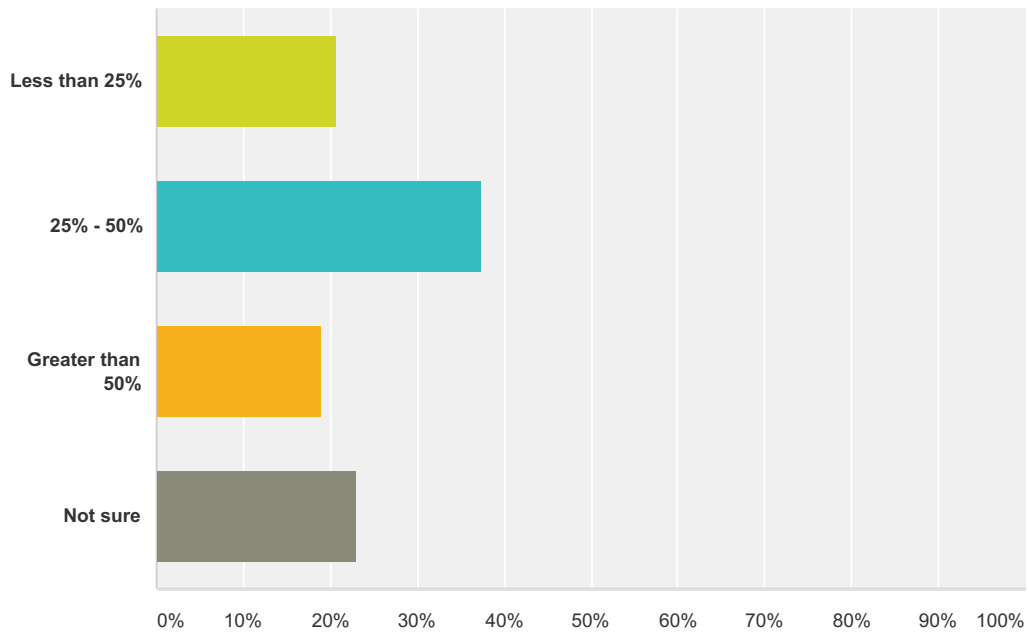

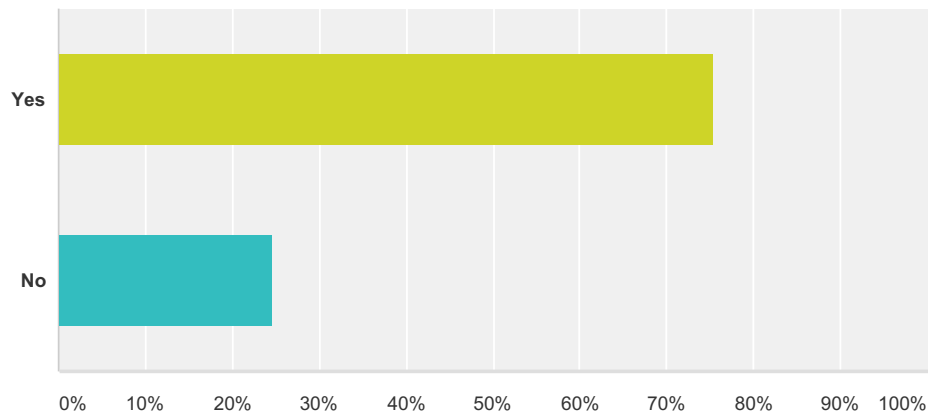

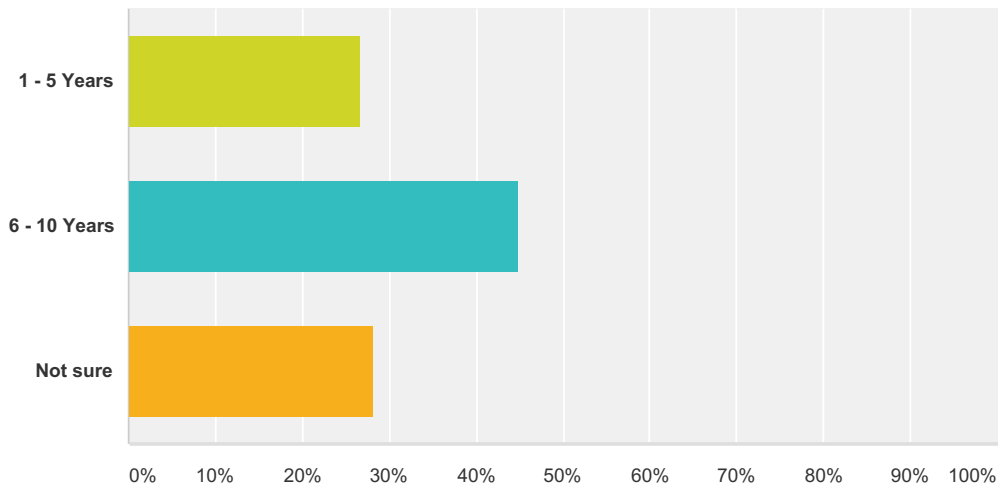

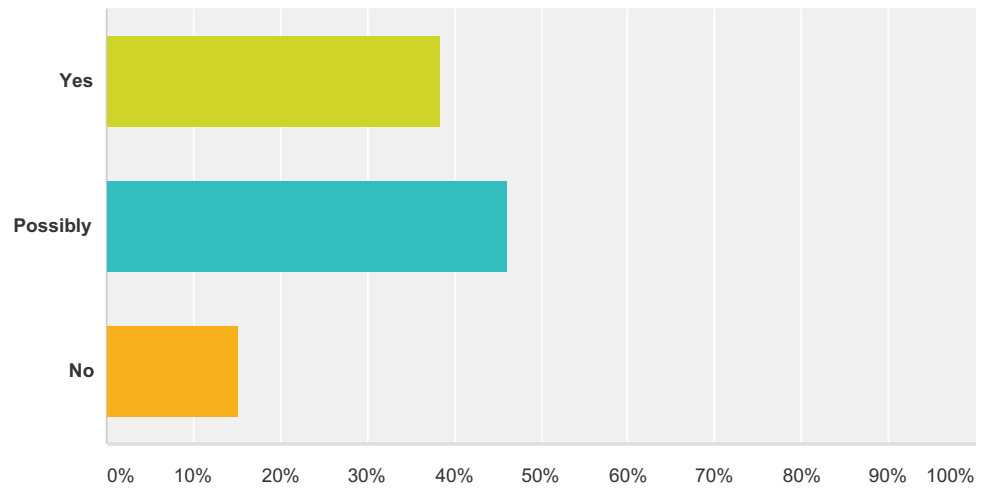

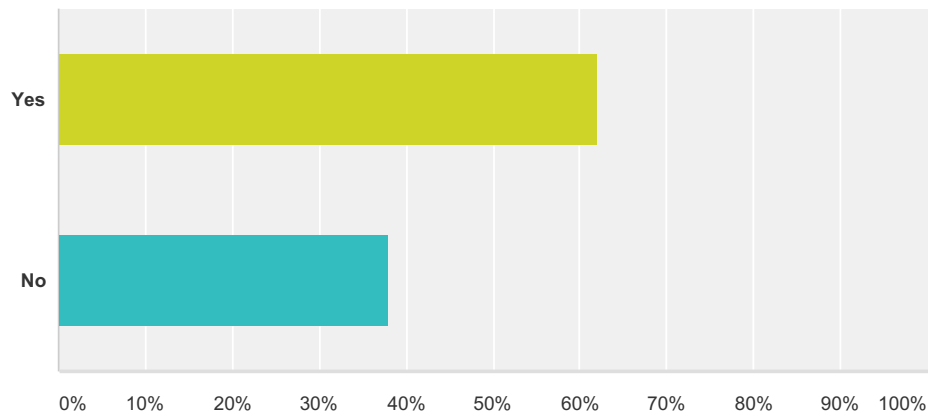

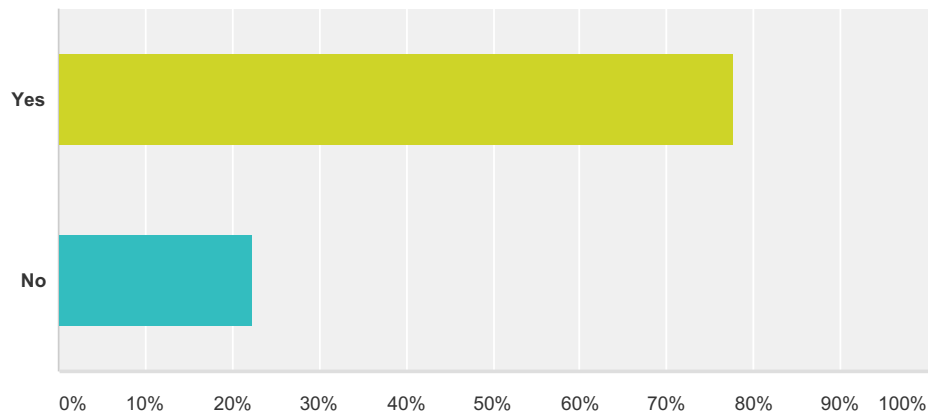

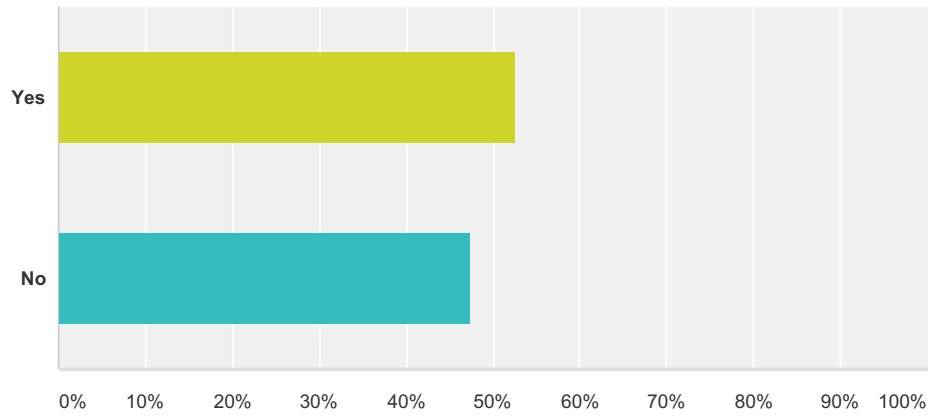

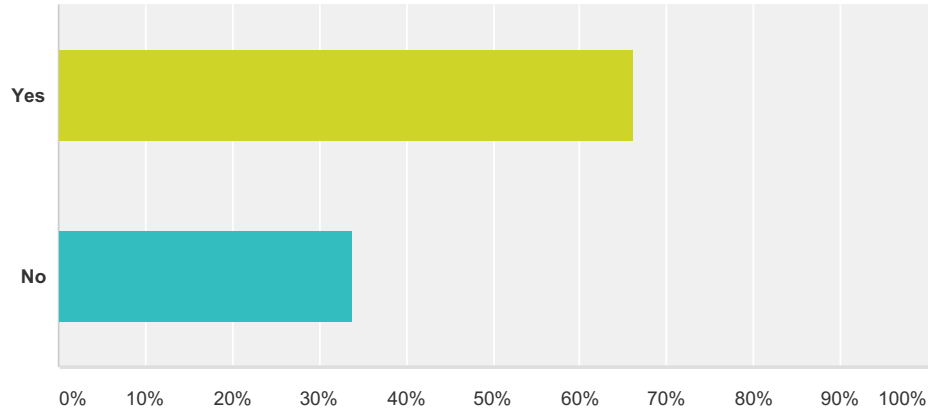

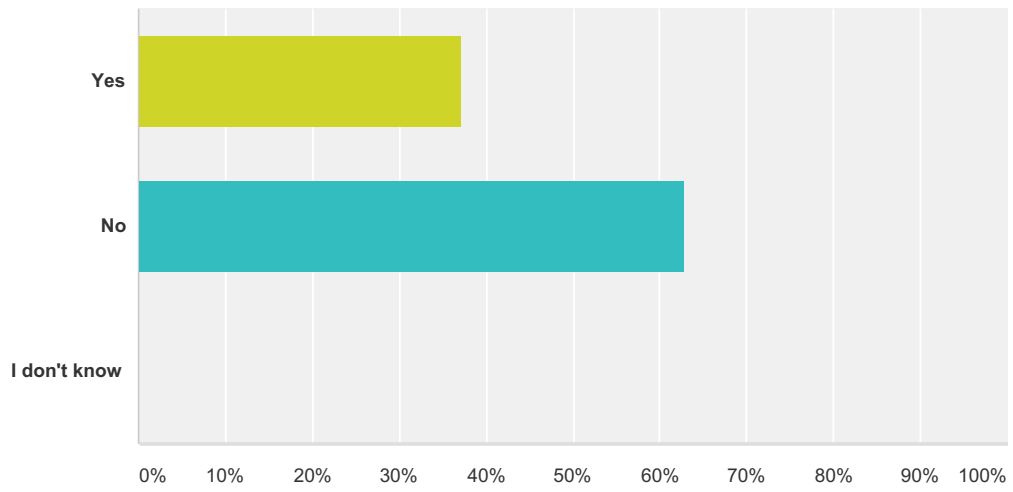

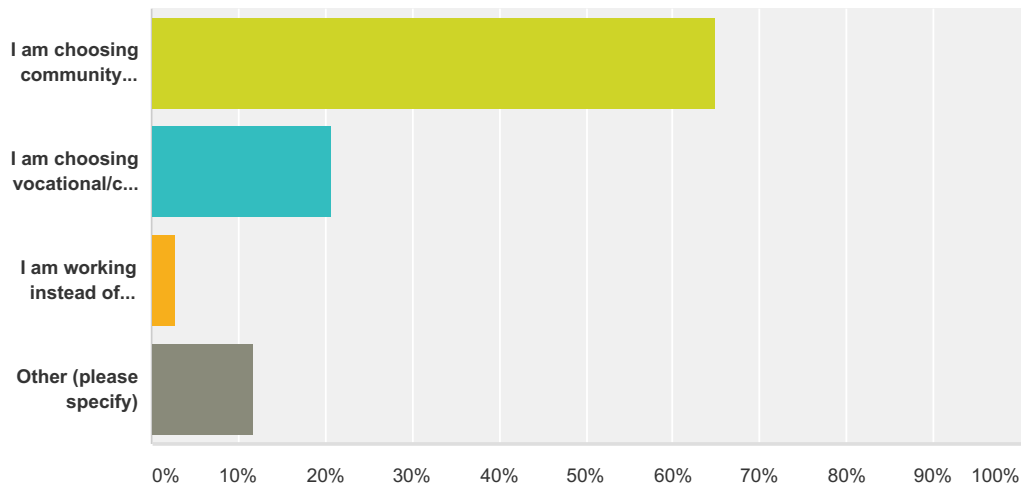

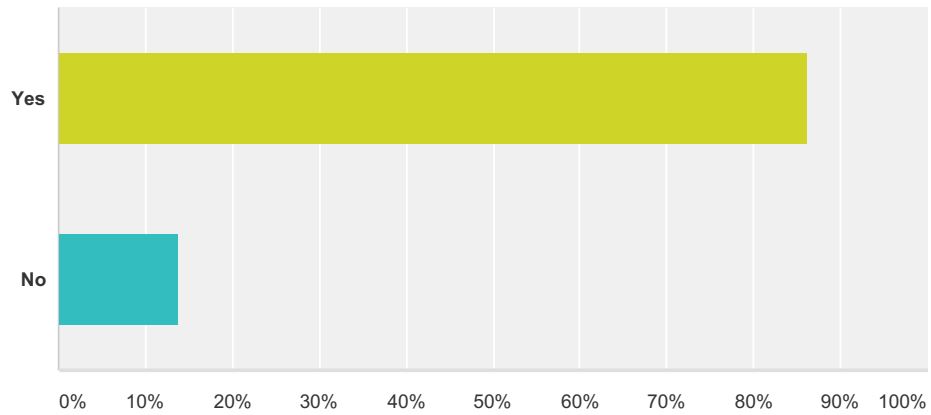

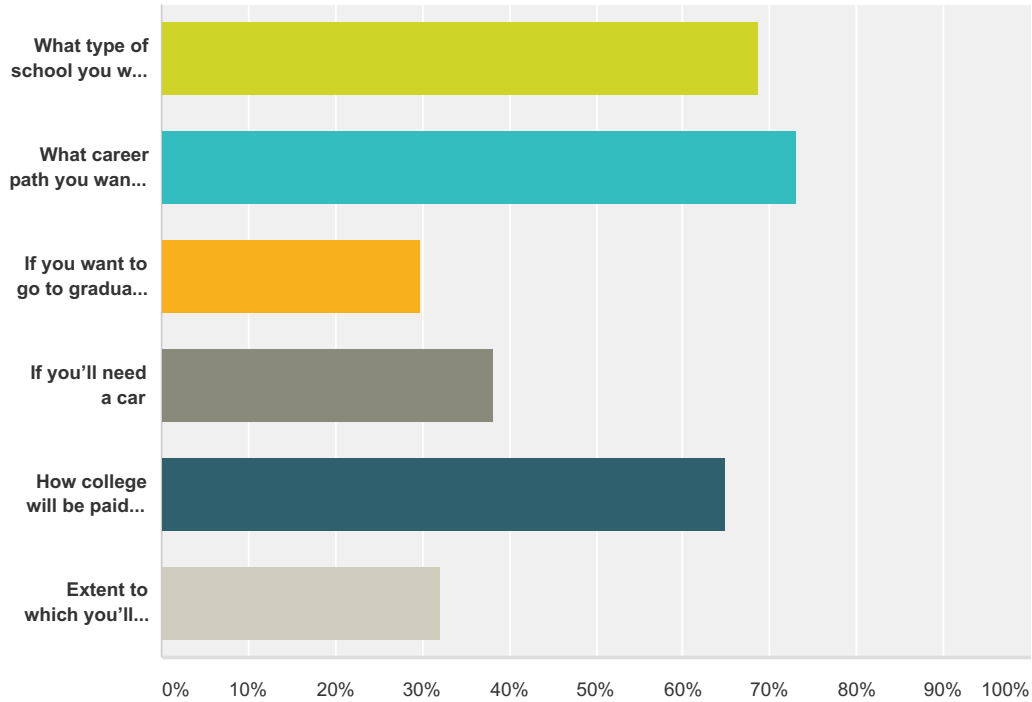

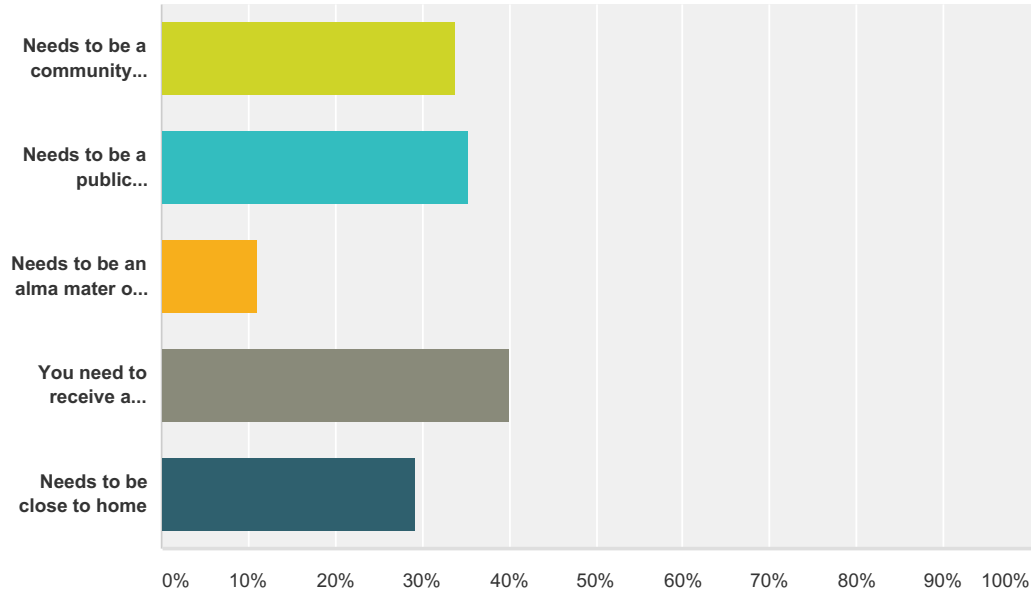

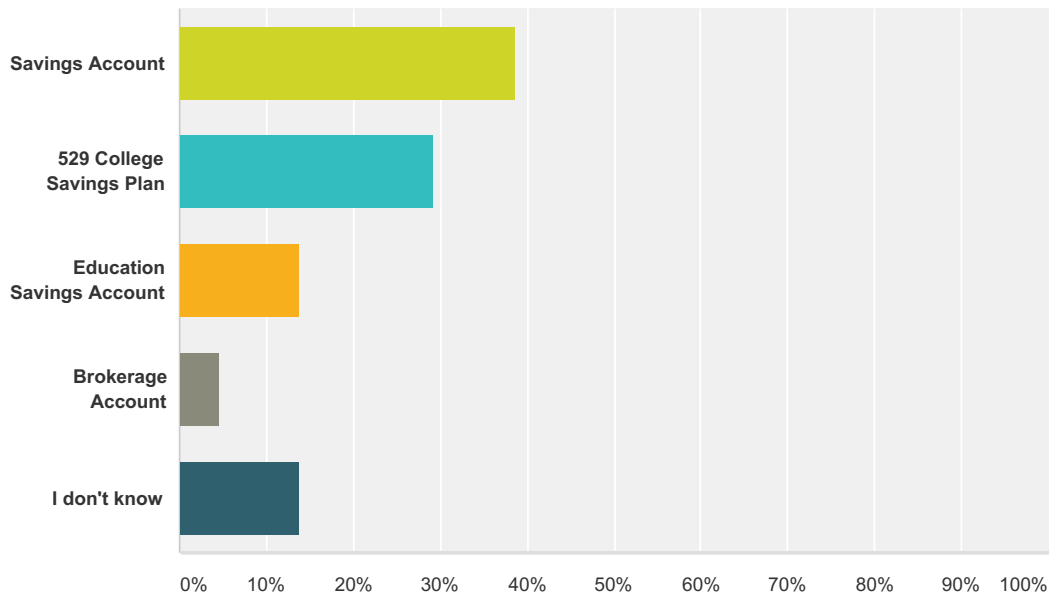

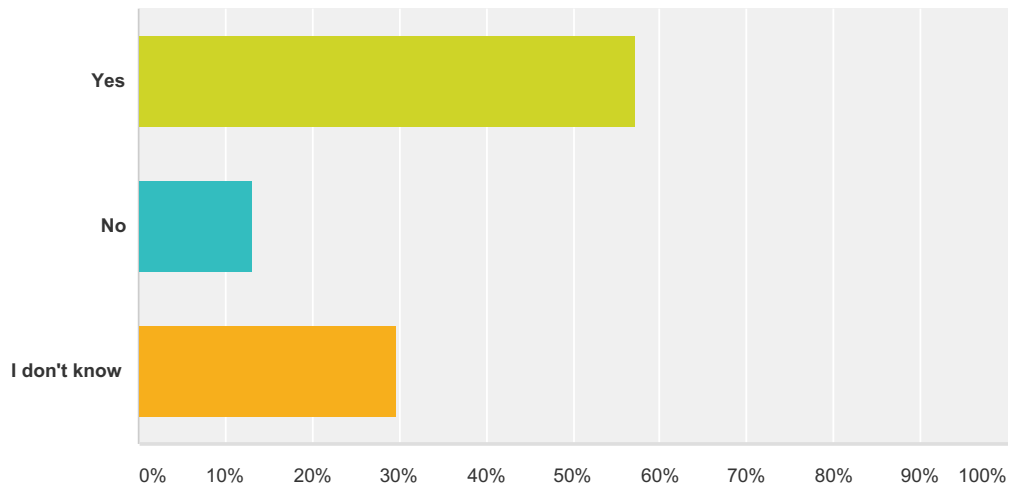

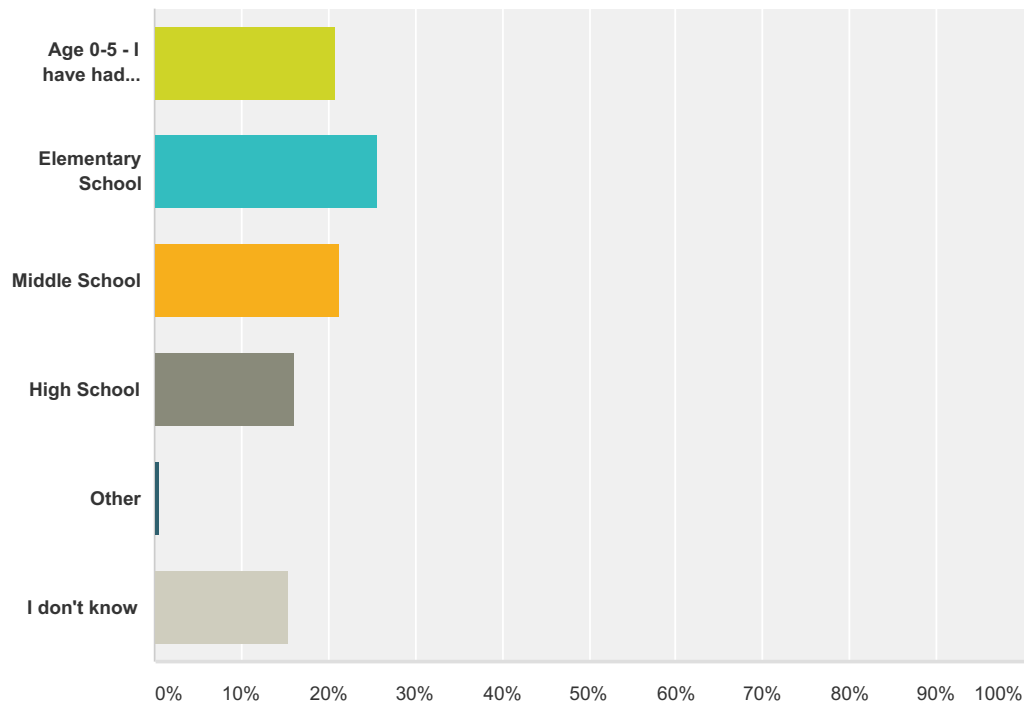

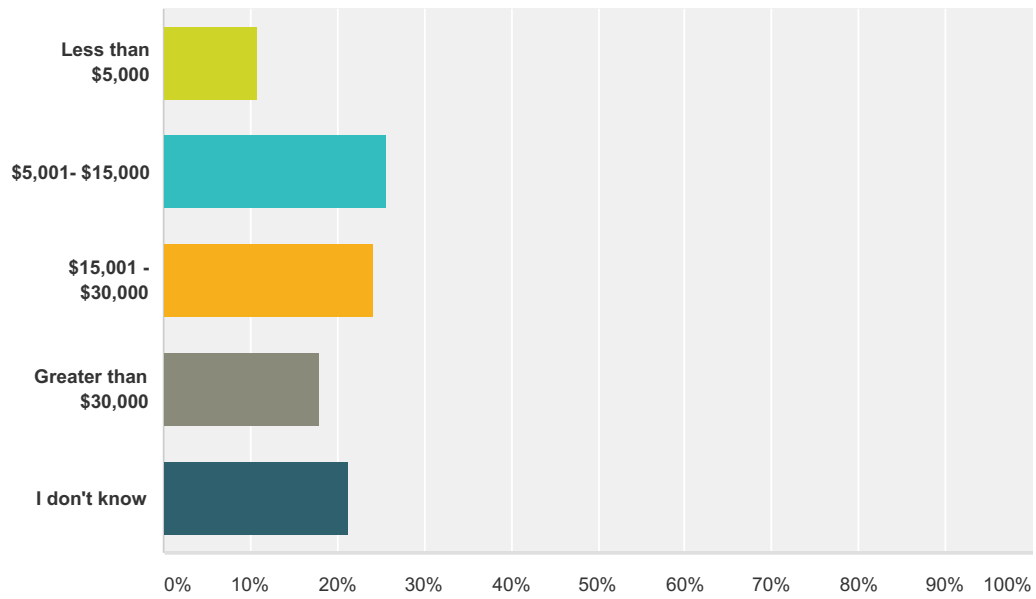

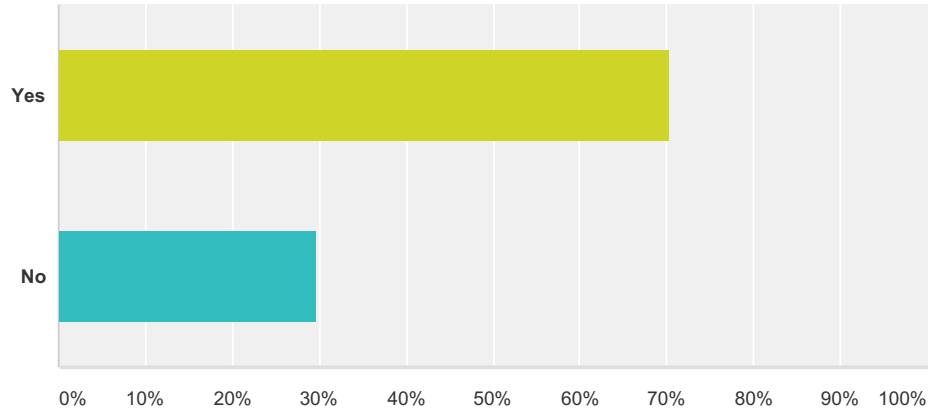

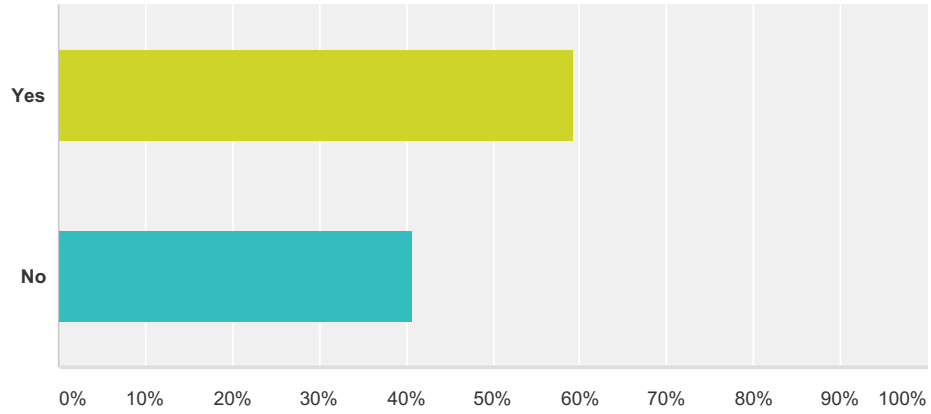

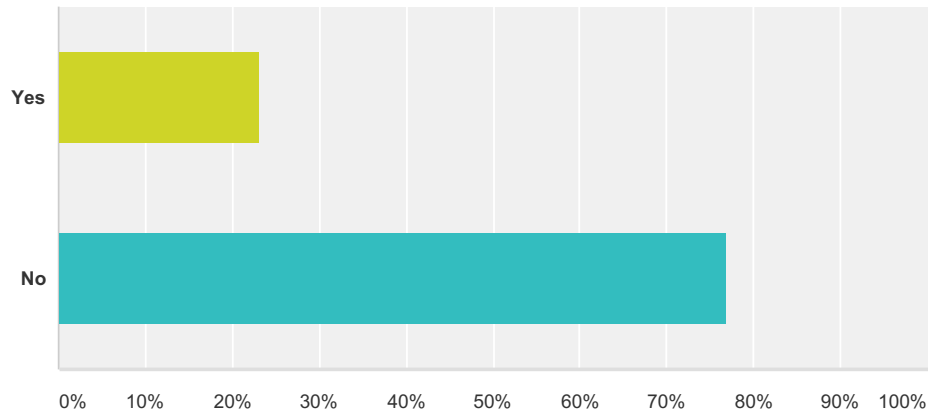

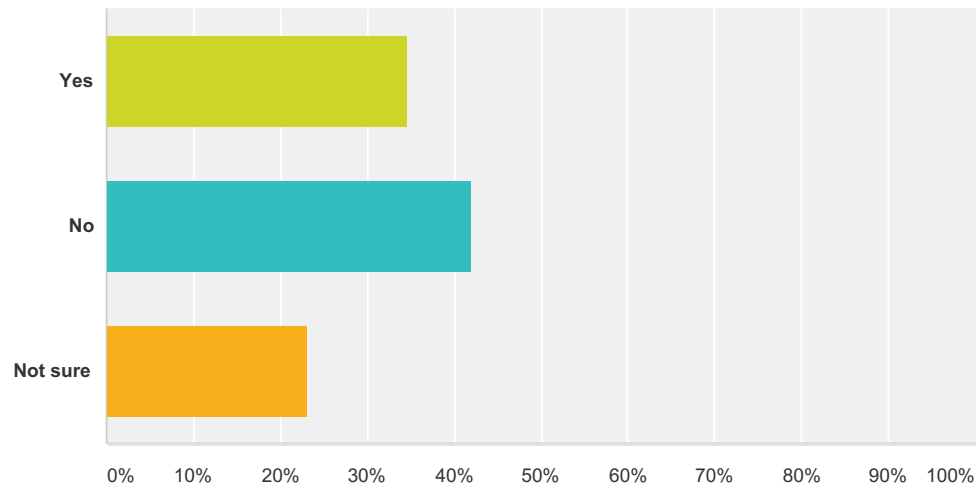

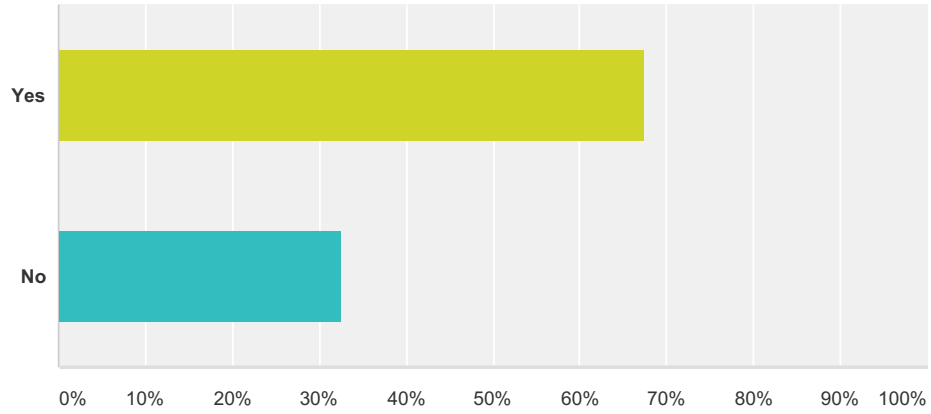

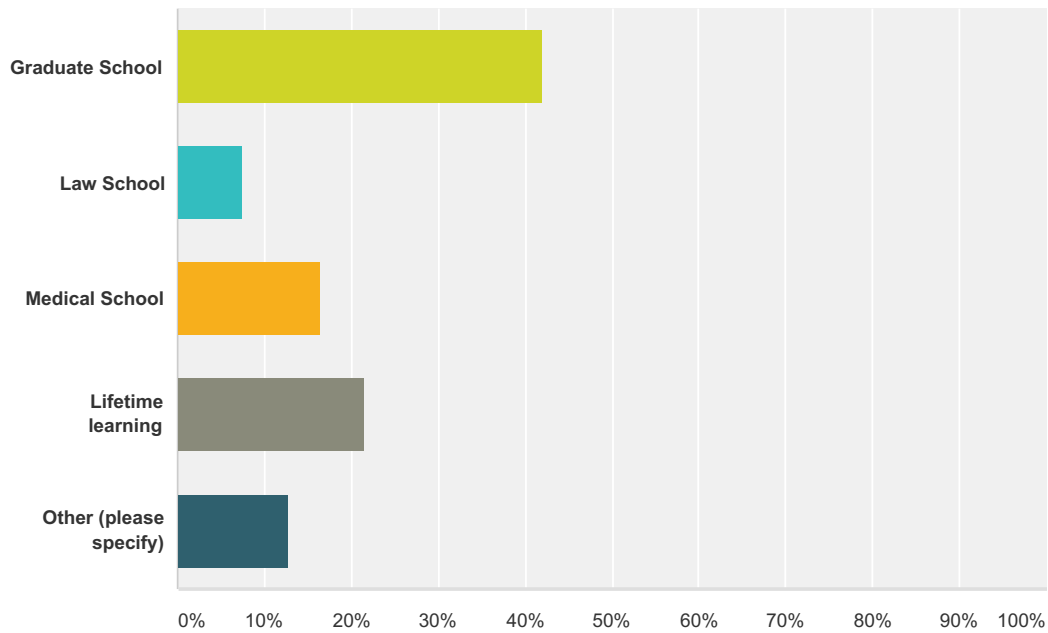

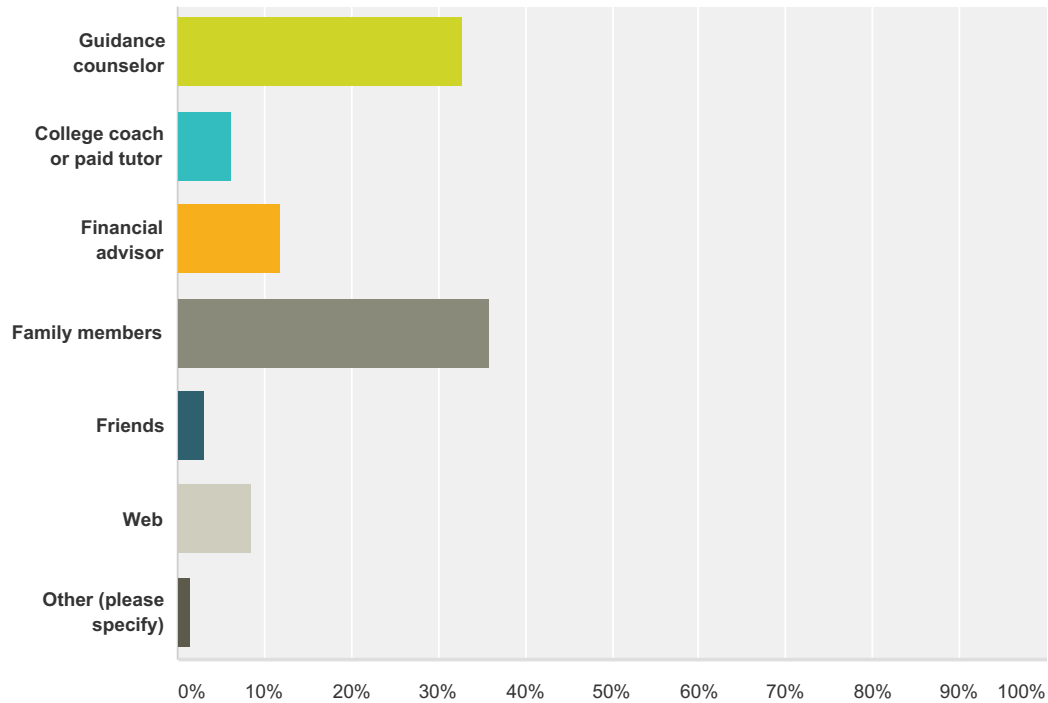
