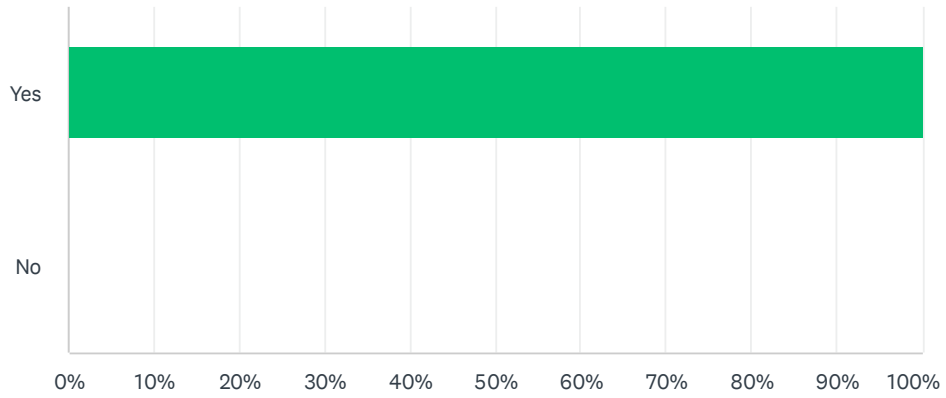


Q1 Do you give permission to your teen (16-17 years) to take this survey?

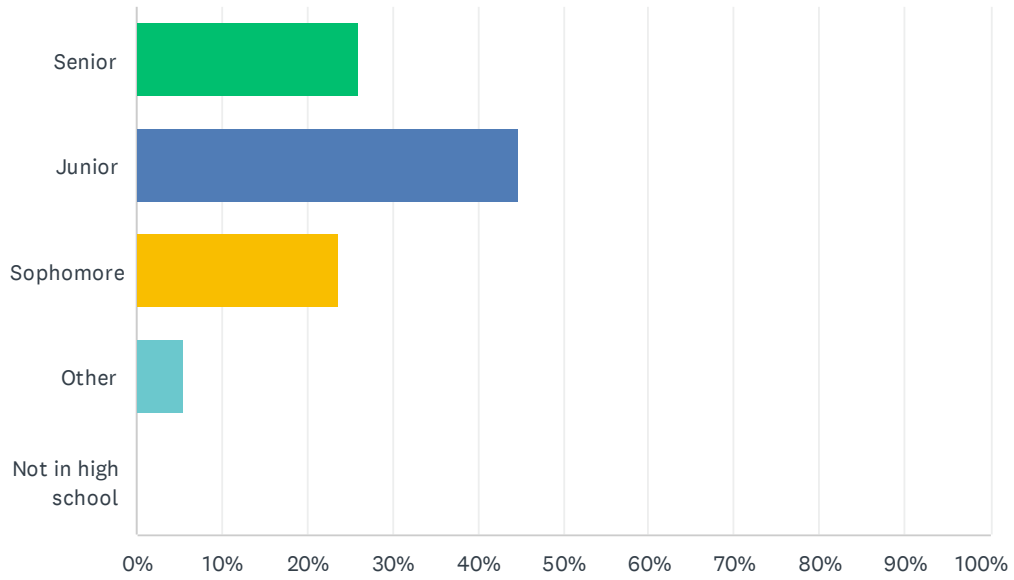

Q2 What year are you in high school?

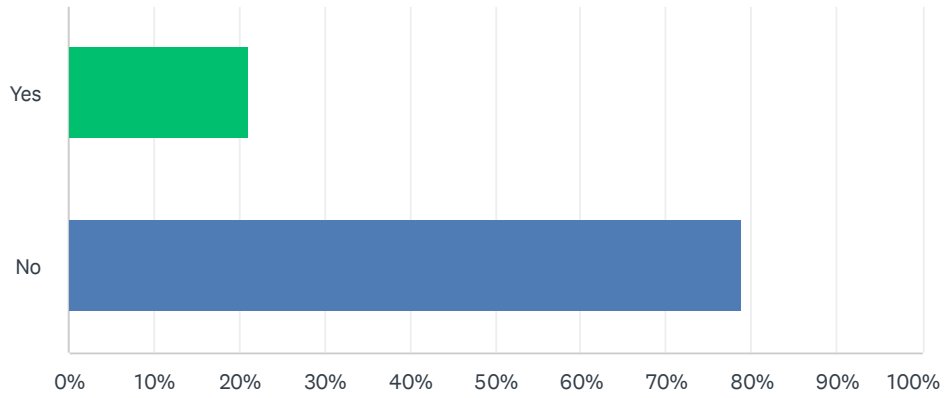

Q3 Are you planning to take a gap year?

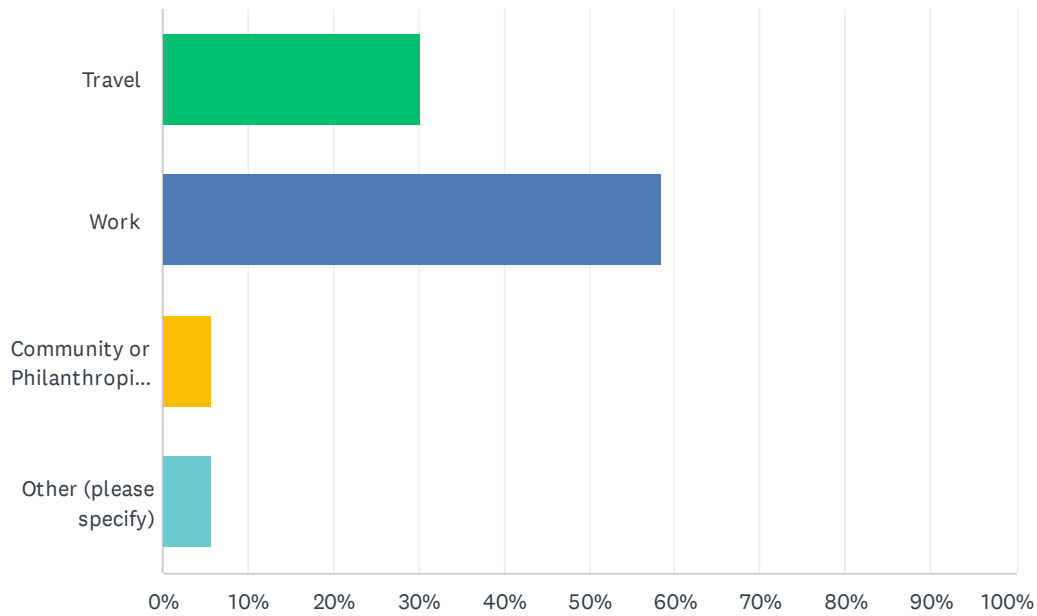

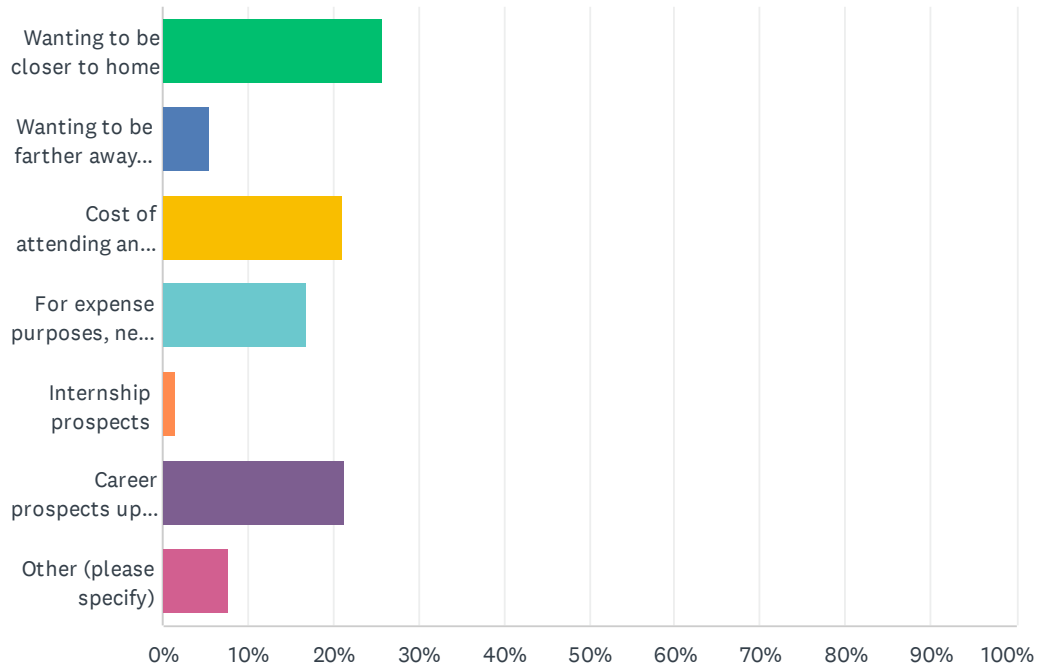

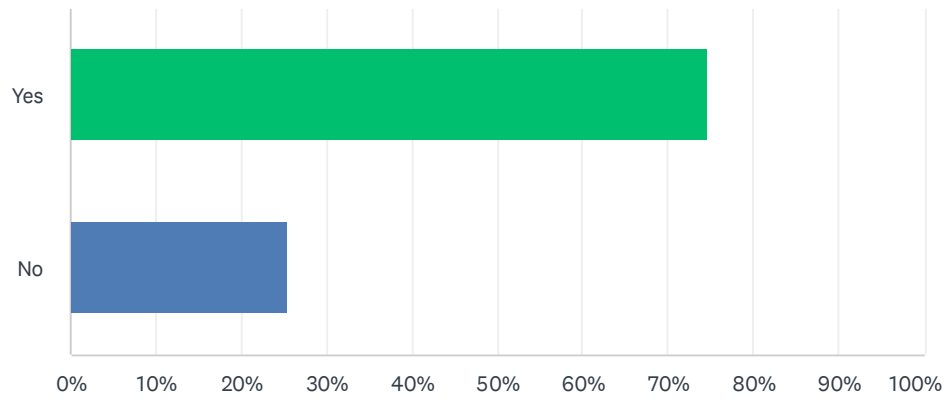

Q10 Have costs been a factor in deciding which college to attend?

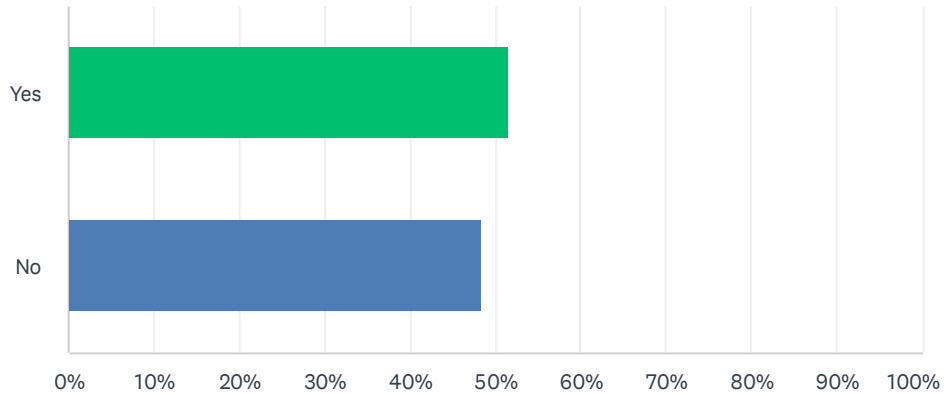

Q11 Have costs been a factor in deciding to attend college part-time or full-time?

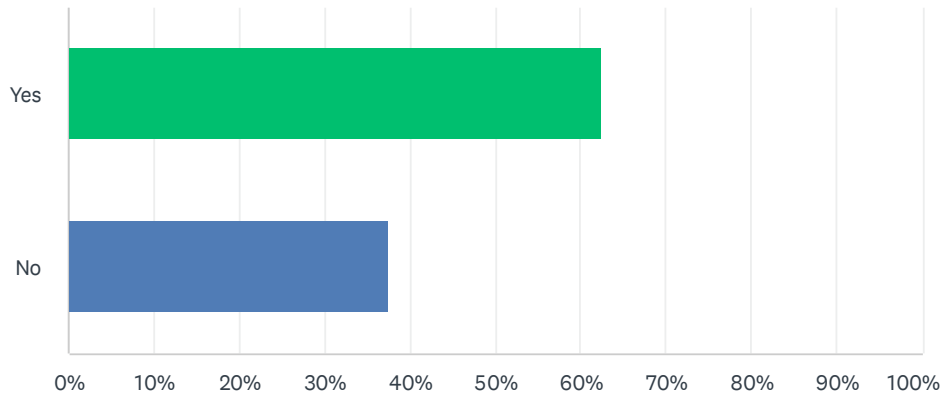

Q12 Will your career plans affect your school choice (i.e., some careers have a higher starting salary, some careers have steady raises throughout the lifetime of a career)?

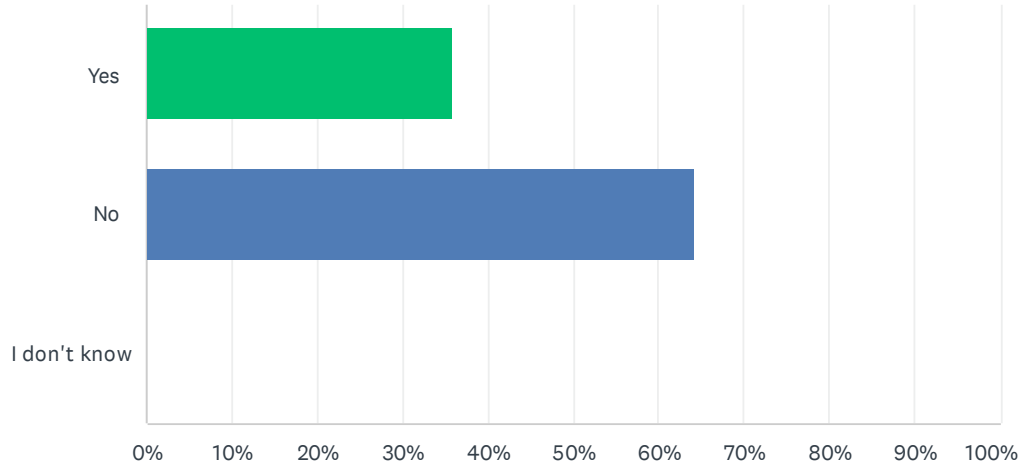

Q13 Have you had to change your higher education choices because of costs?

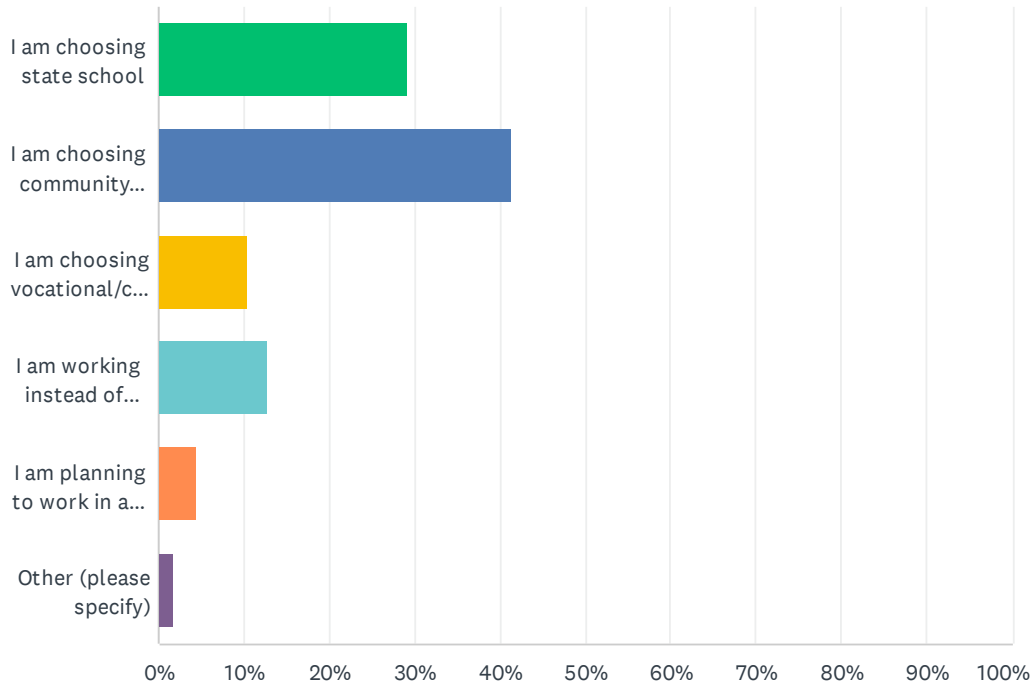

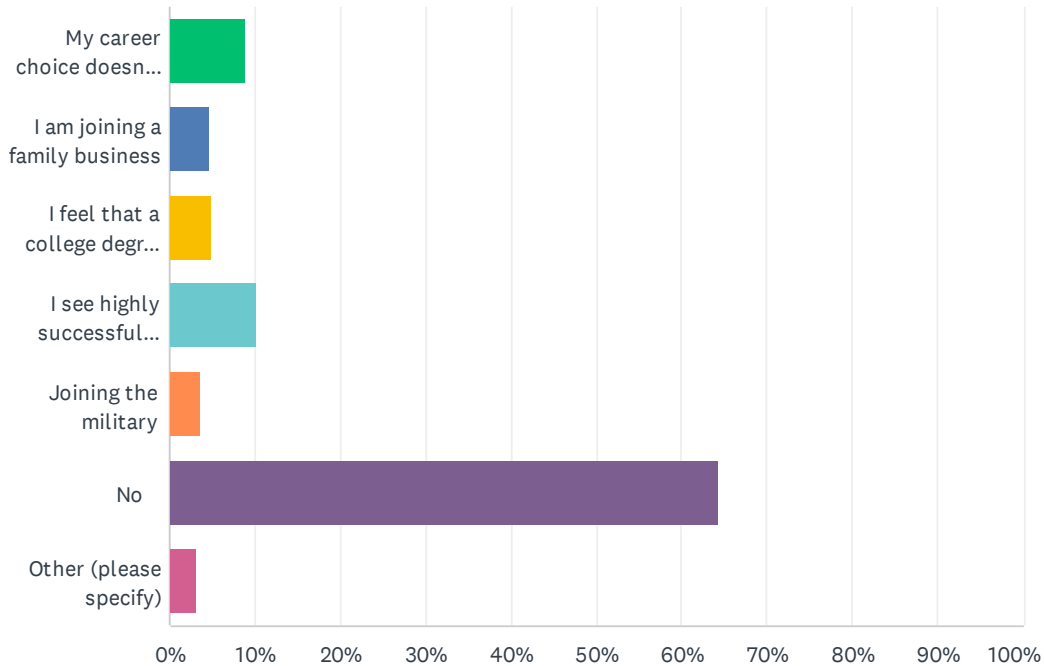

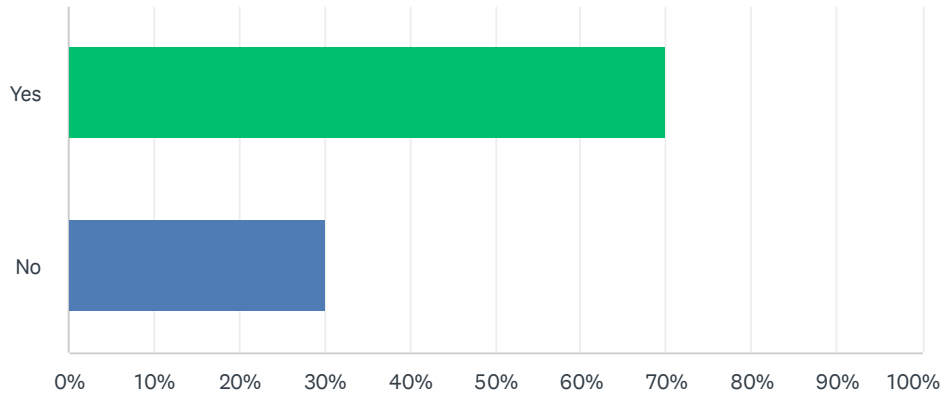

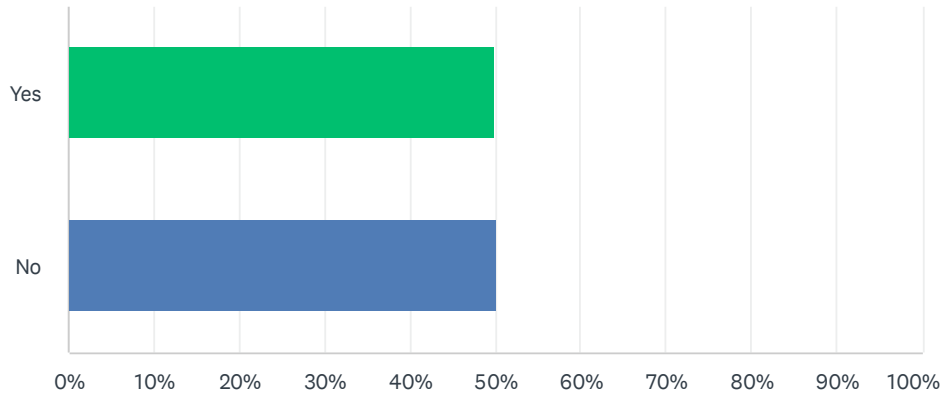

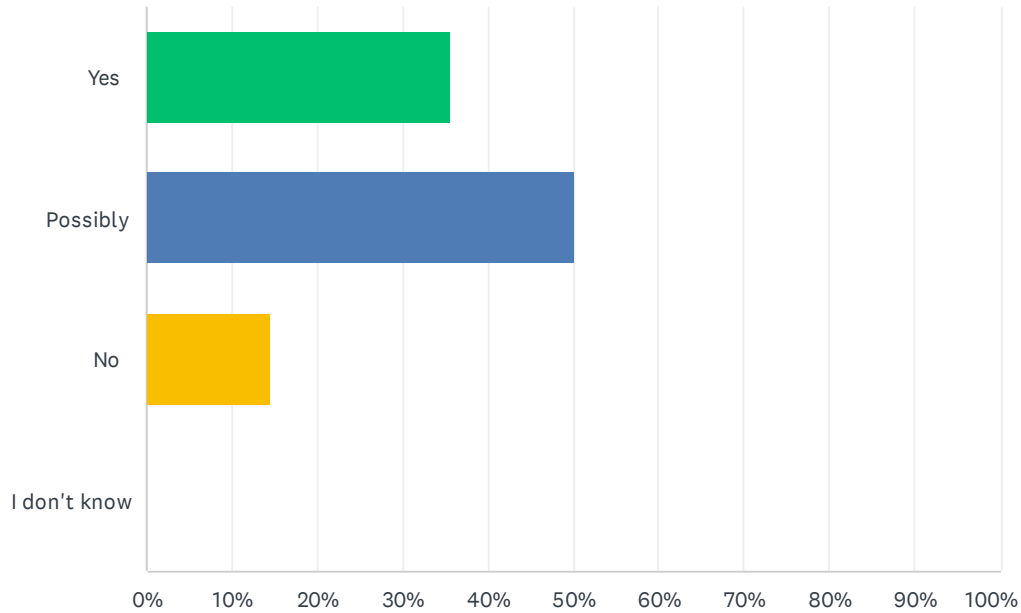

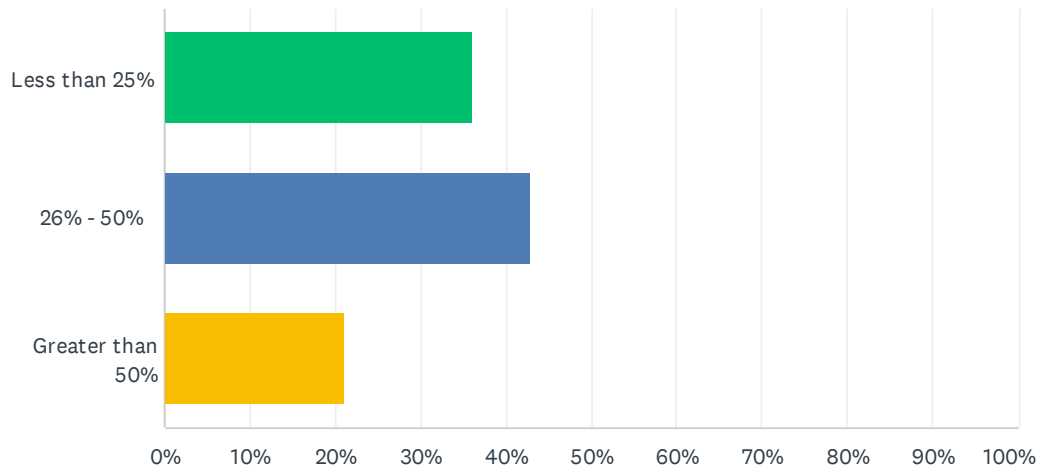

Q20 What percent of your total education costs do you plan to pay for?

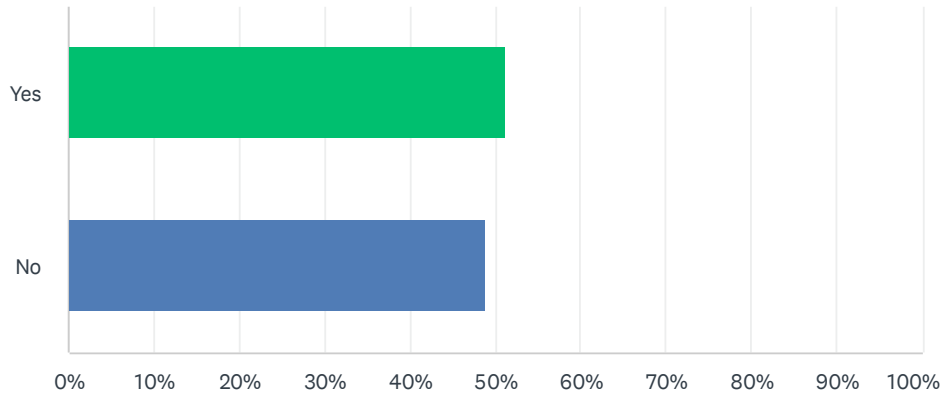

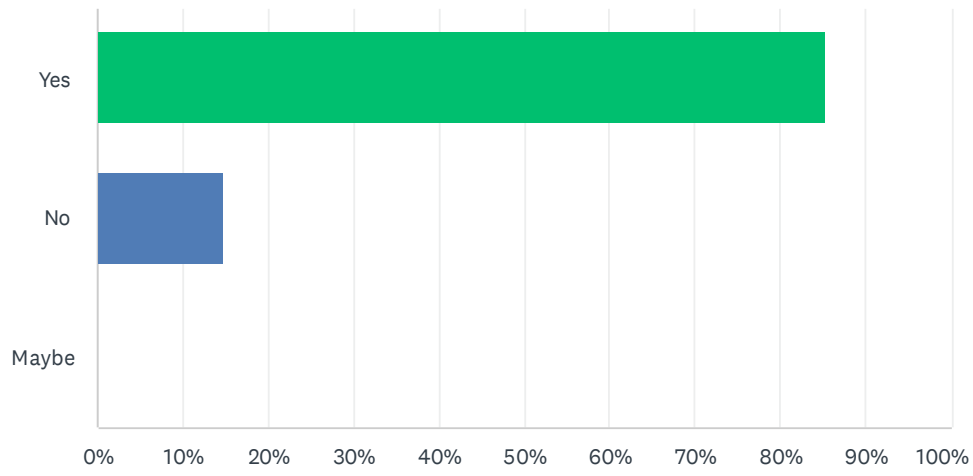

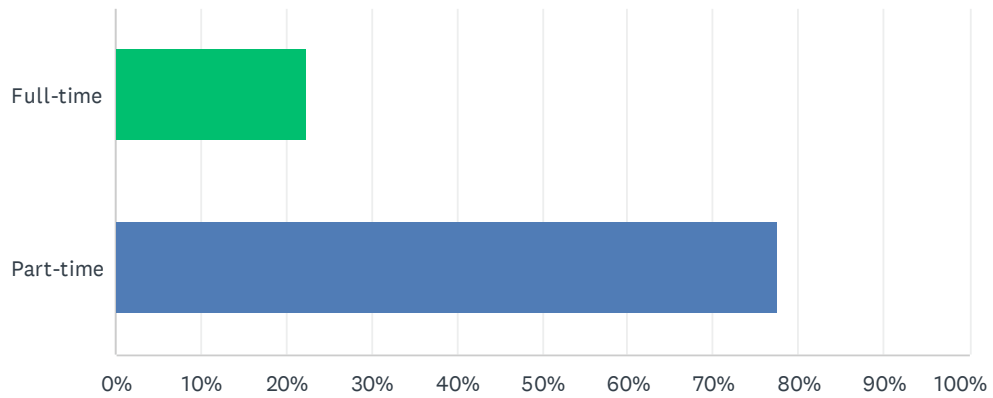

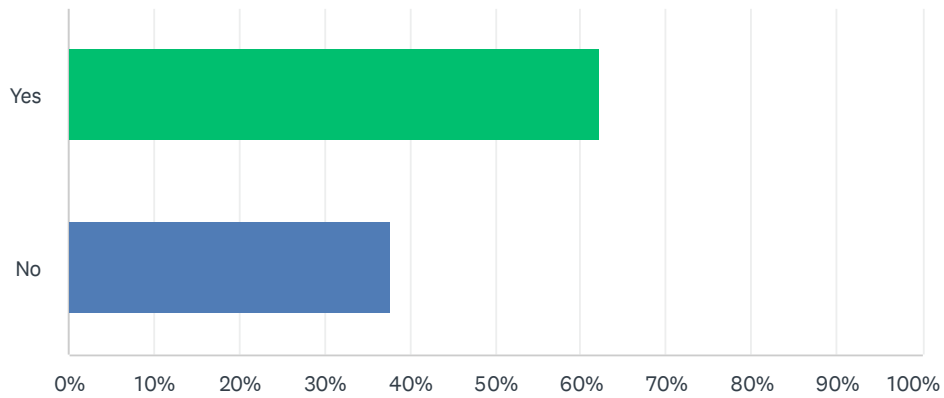

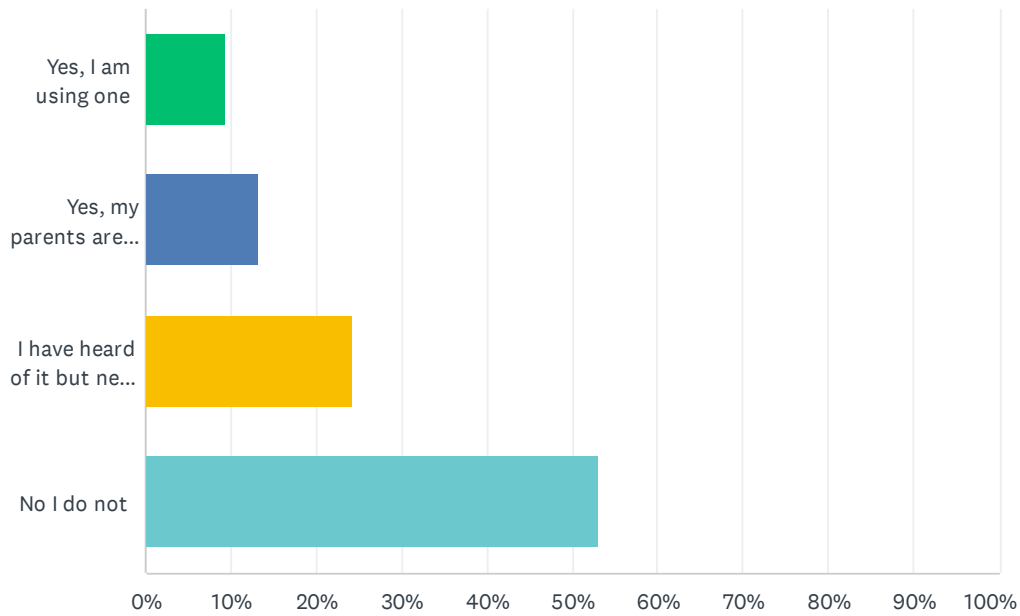

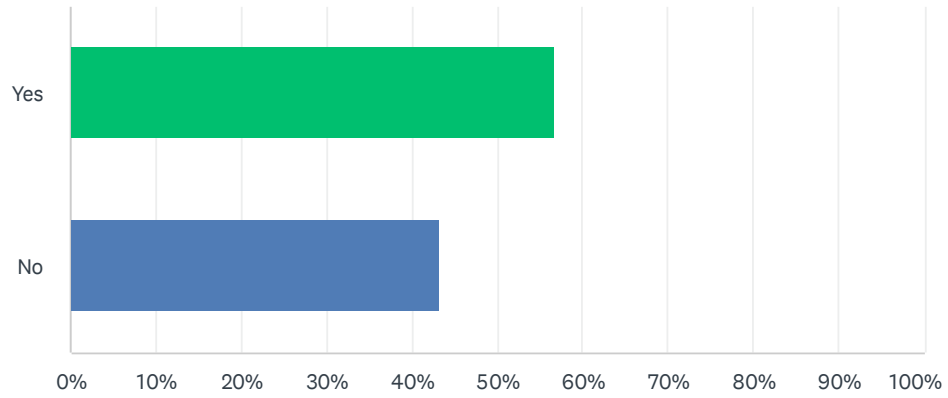

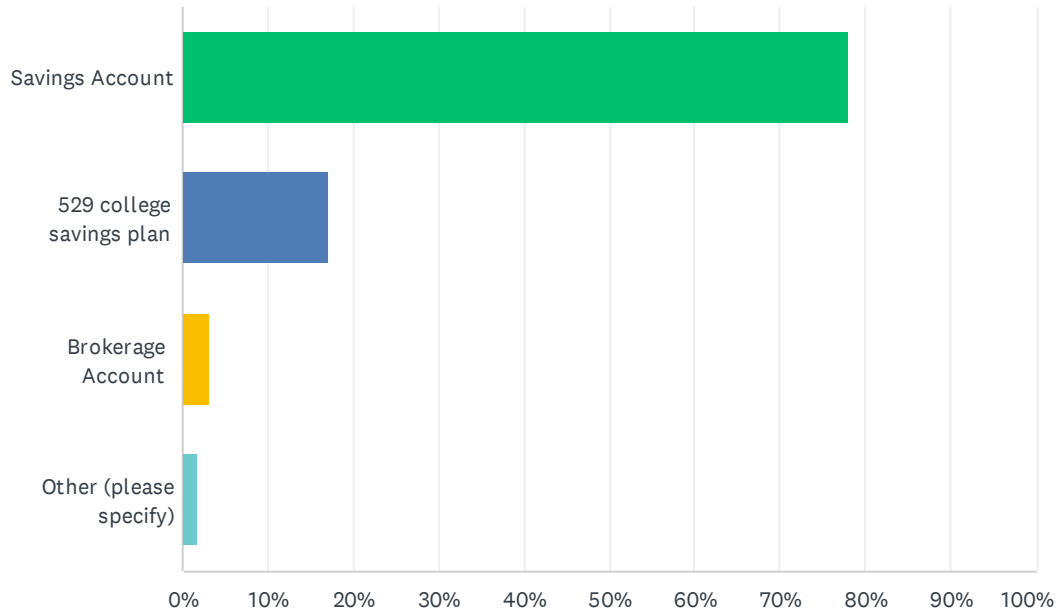

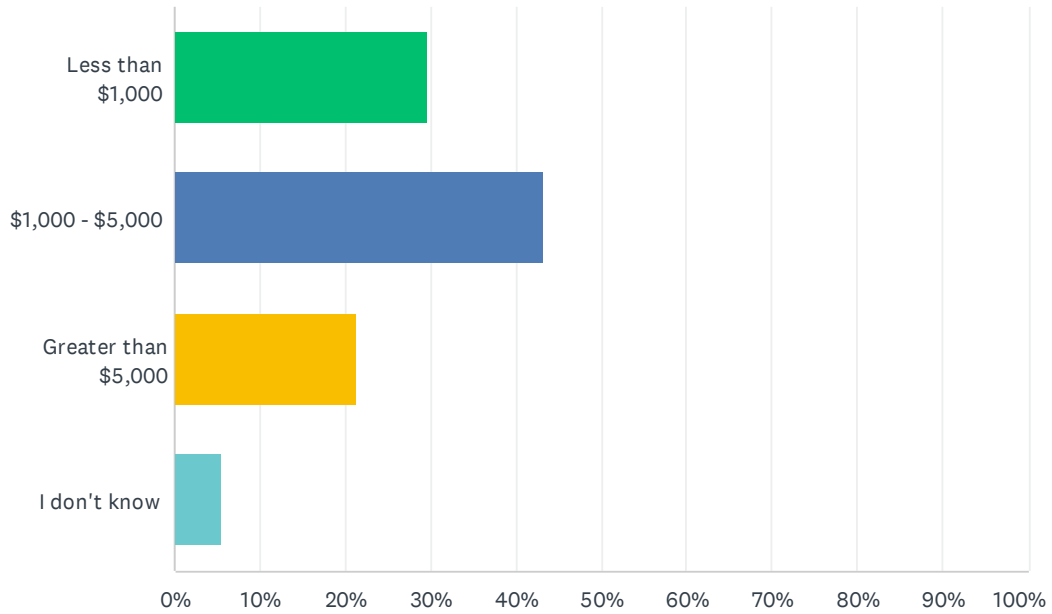

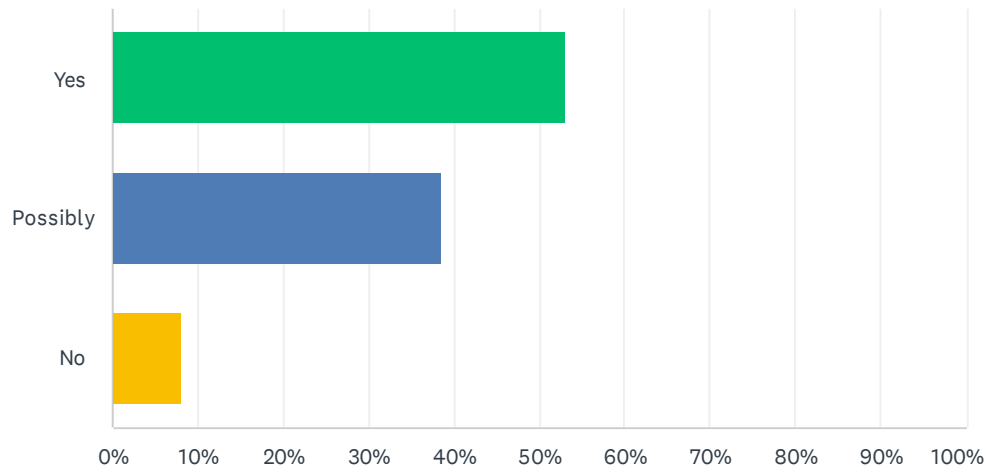

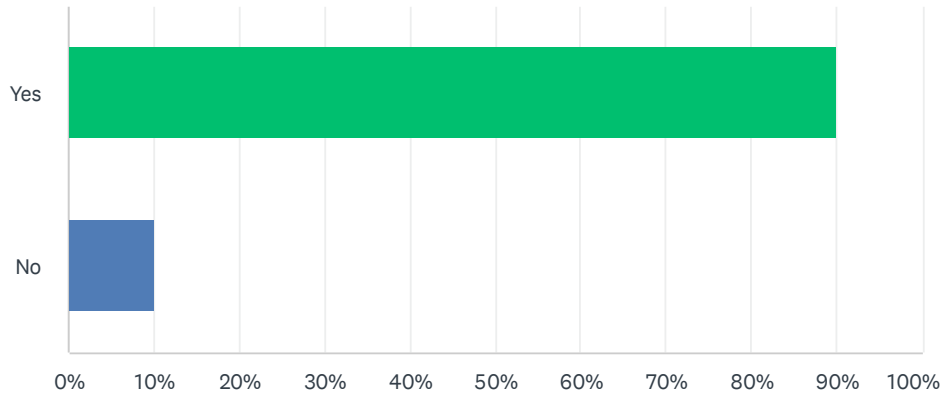

Q30 Financial aid packages often include student loans. Are you aware that this part of financial aid requires repayment over time?

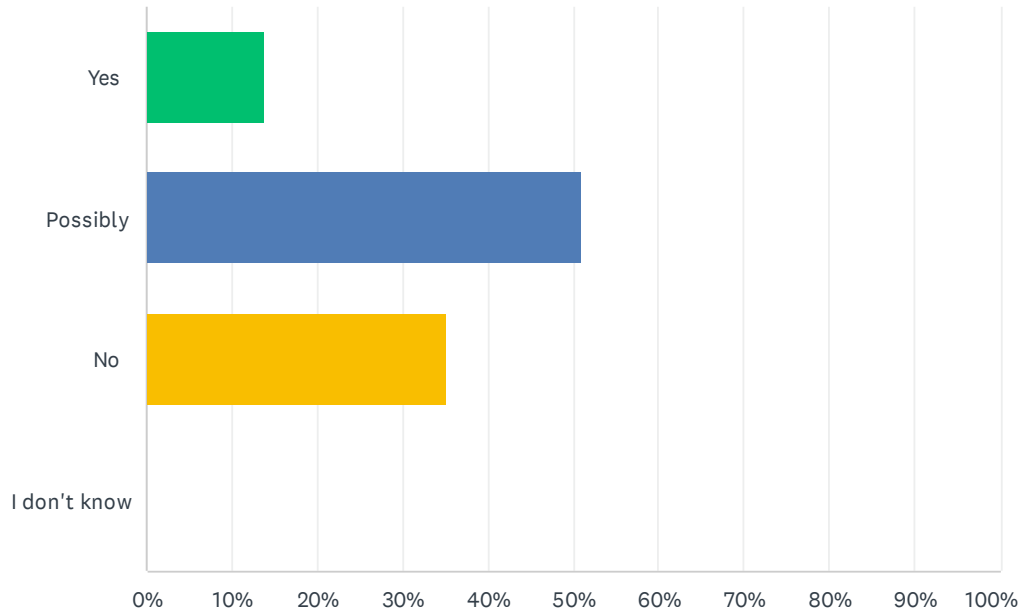

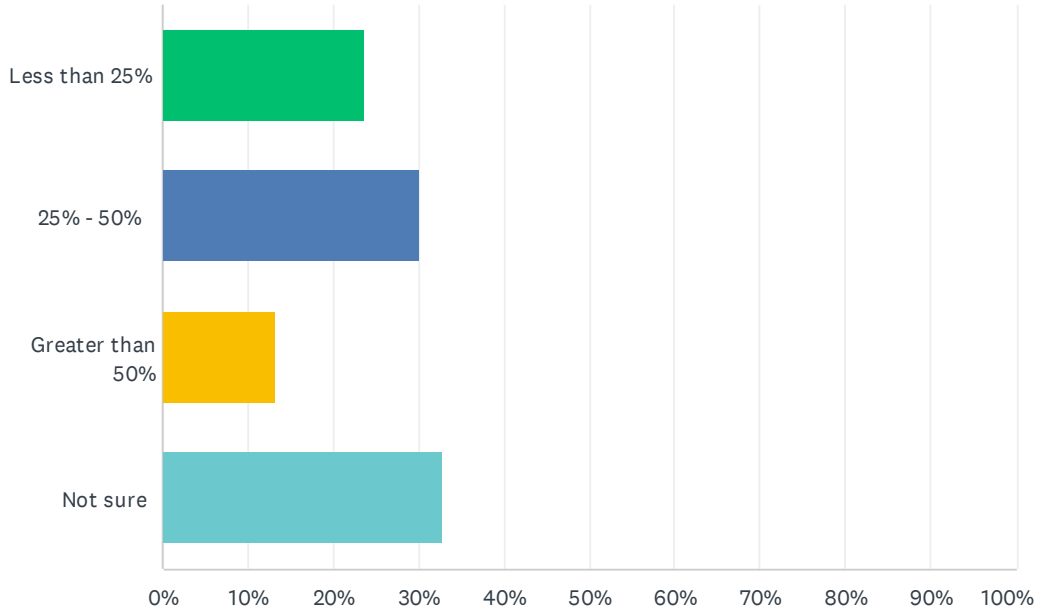

Q32 What percent of your total education costs do you plan on borrowing (please include any loans inside or outside of your financial aid package)?

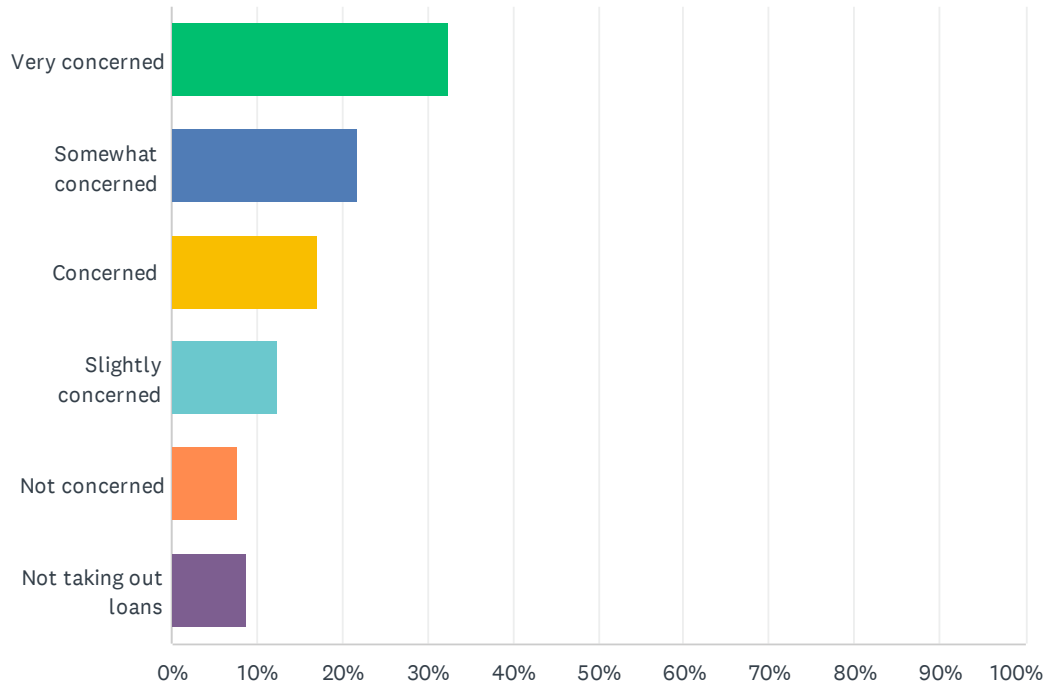

Q33 With \$1.4-Trillion in outstanding student debt in this country, how concerned are you about paying your student loans back?

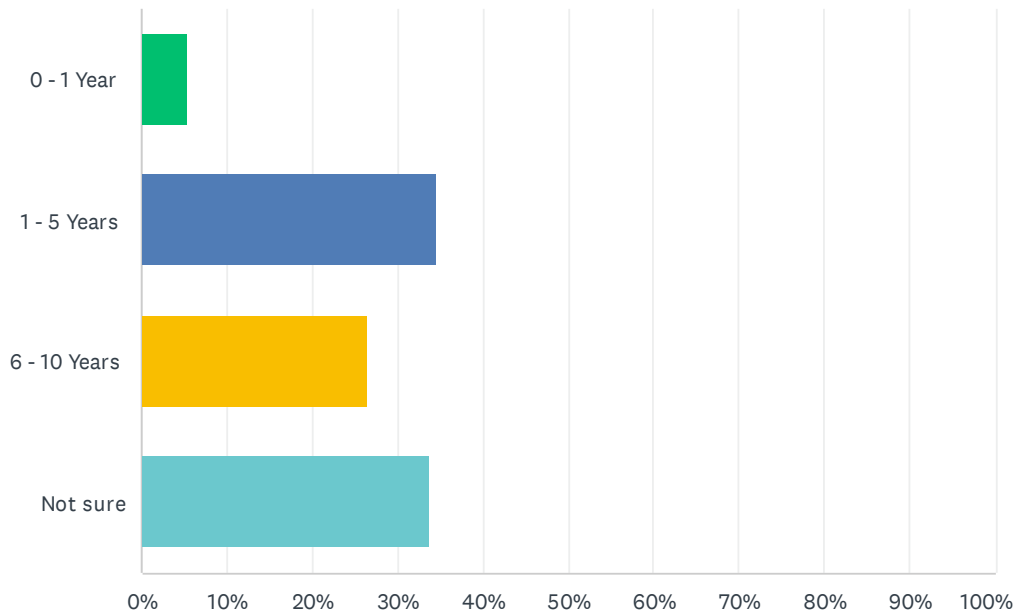

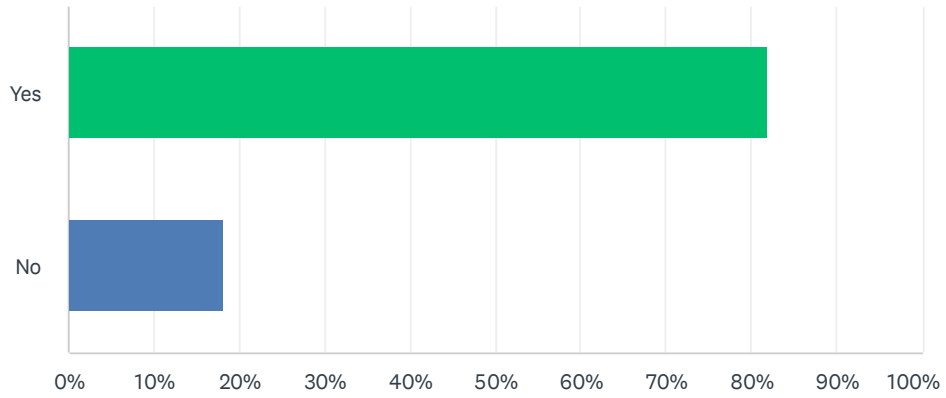

Q35 Have you talked to your parents about their involvement in funding your college education?

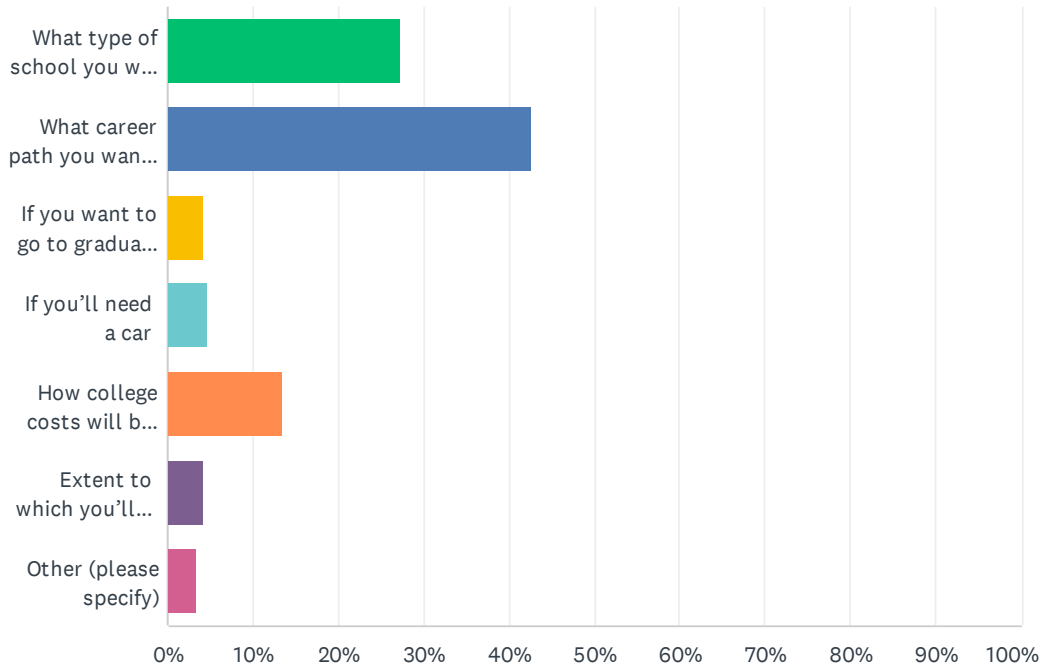

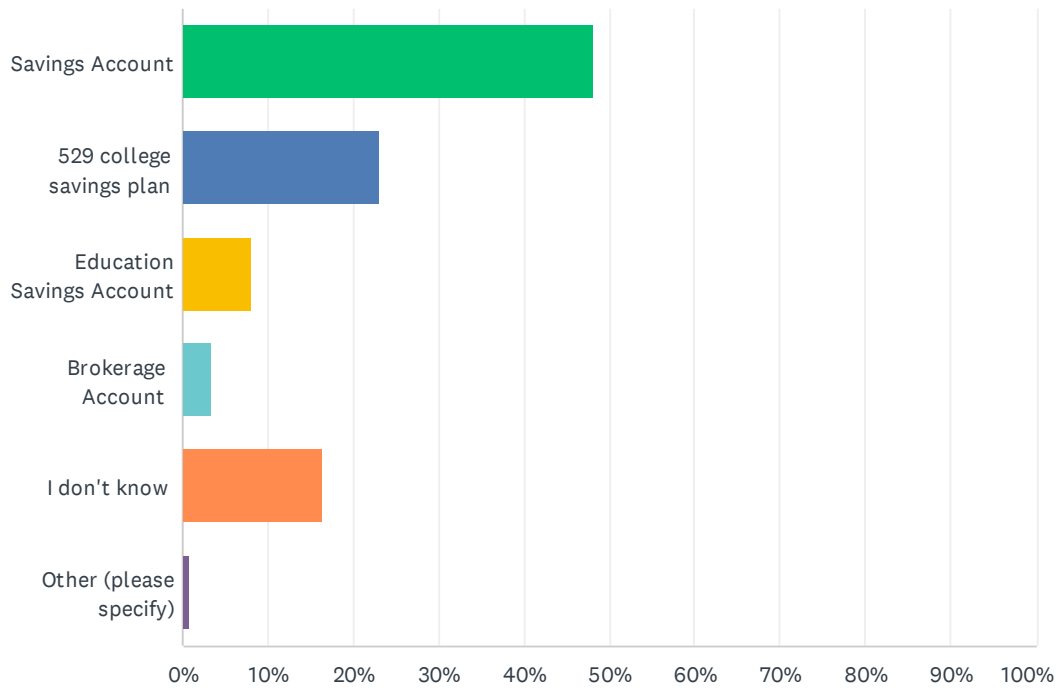

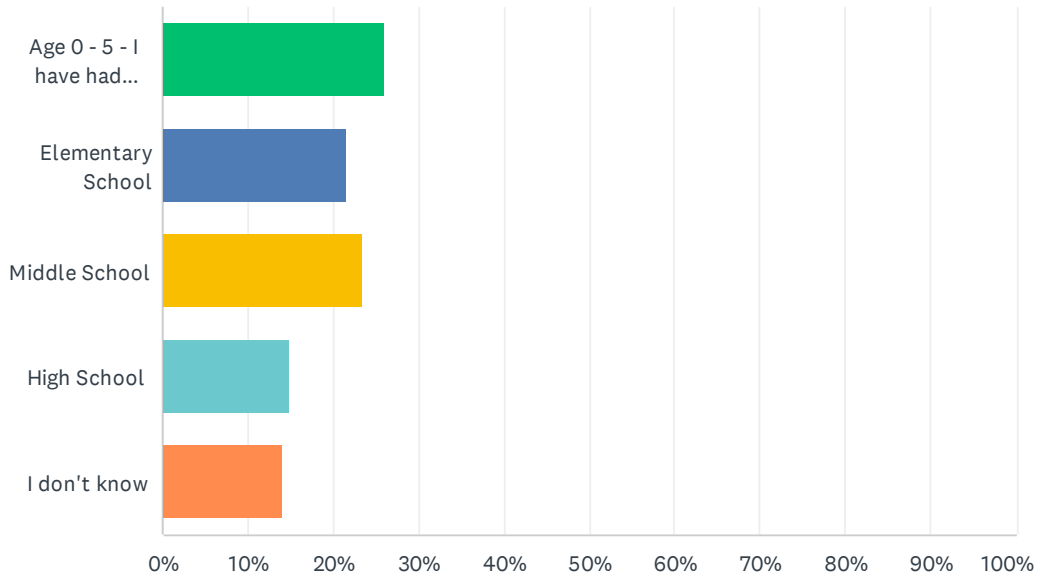

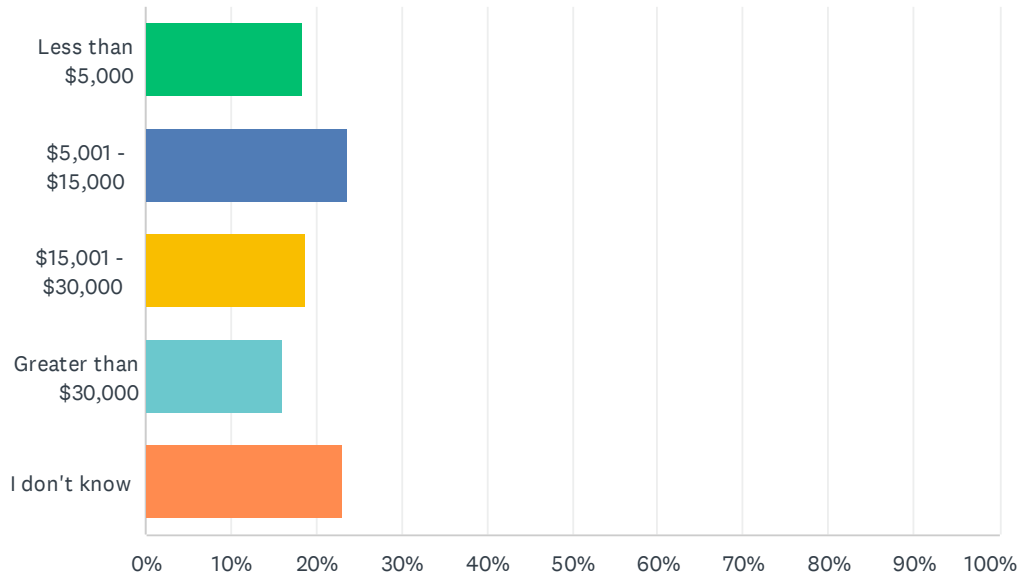

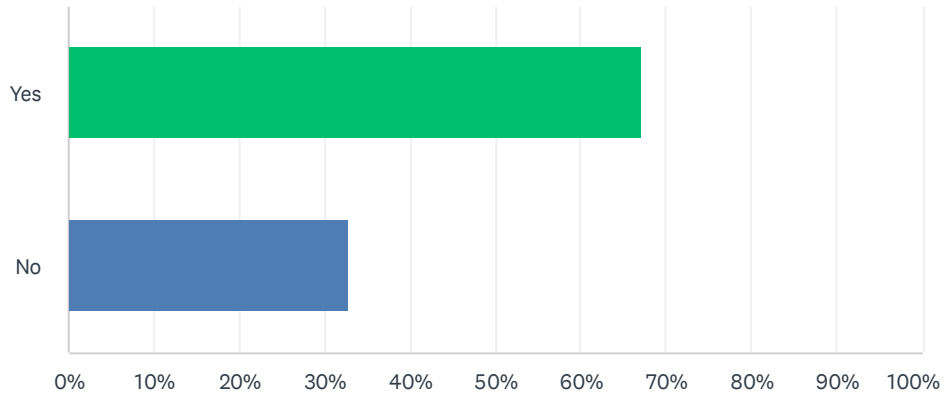

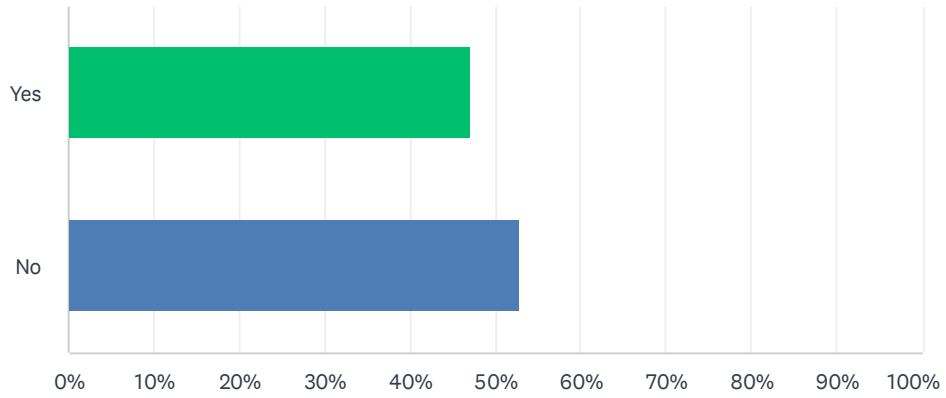

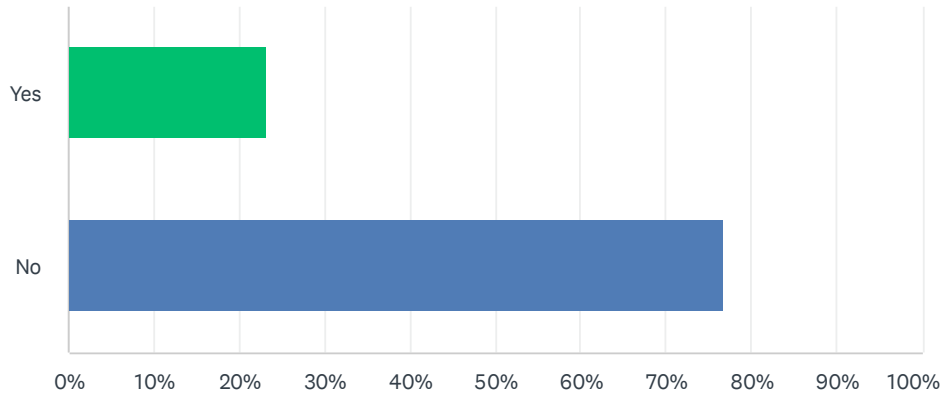

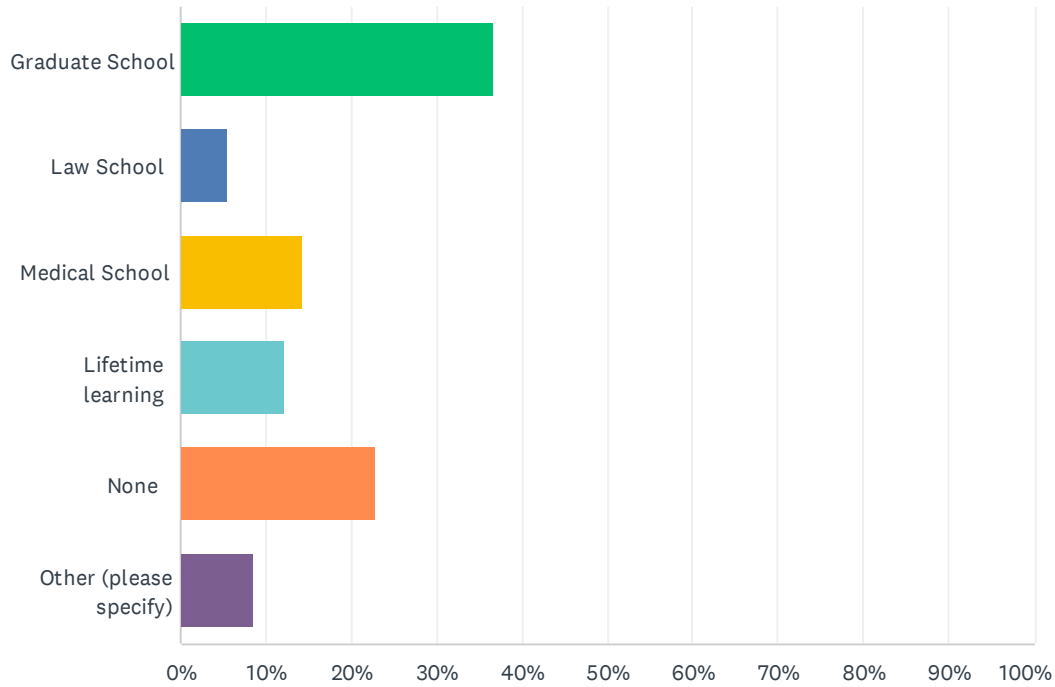

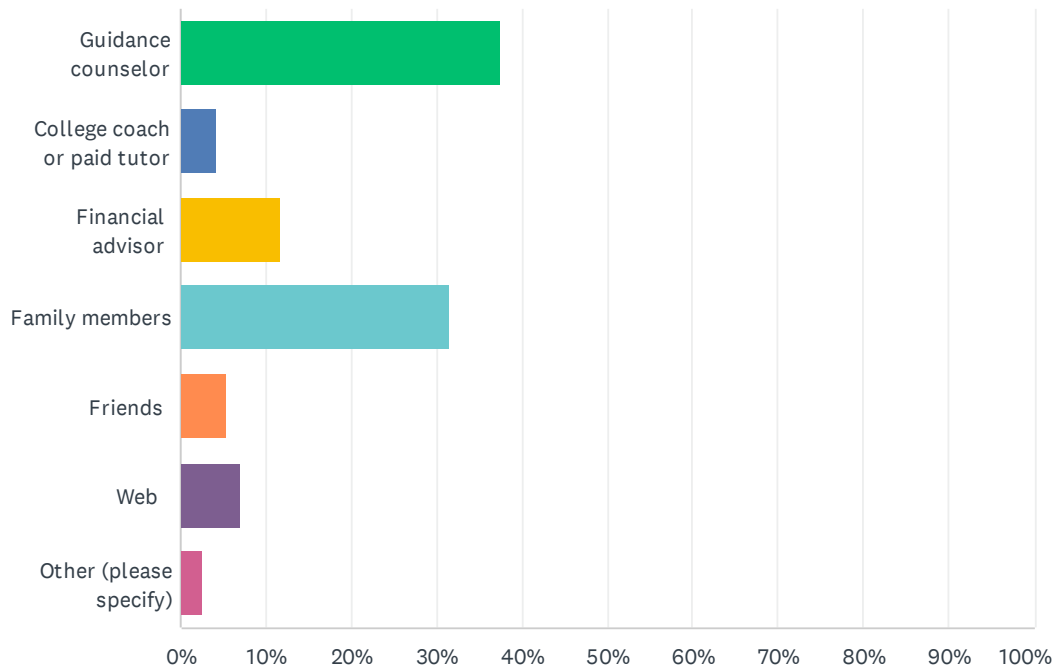
