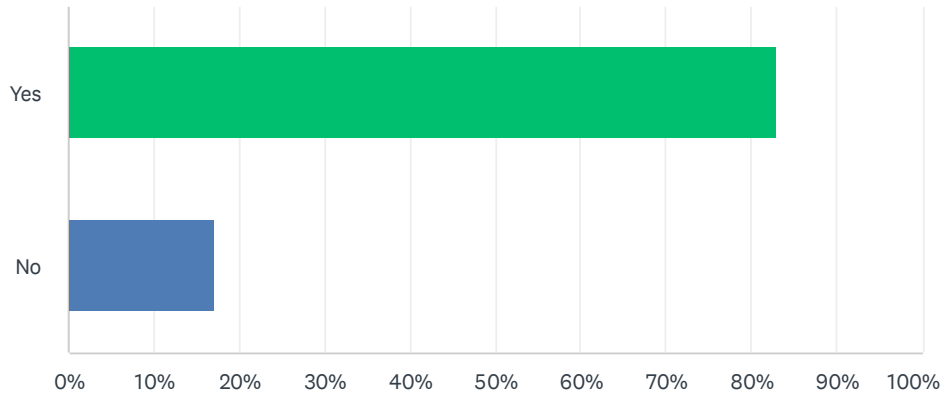


Q1 Does your child have permission to take this survey?

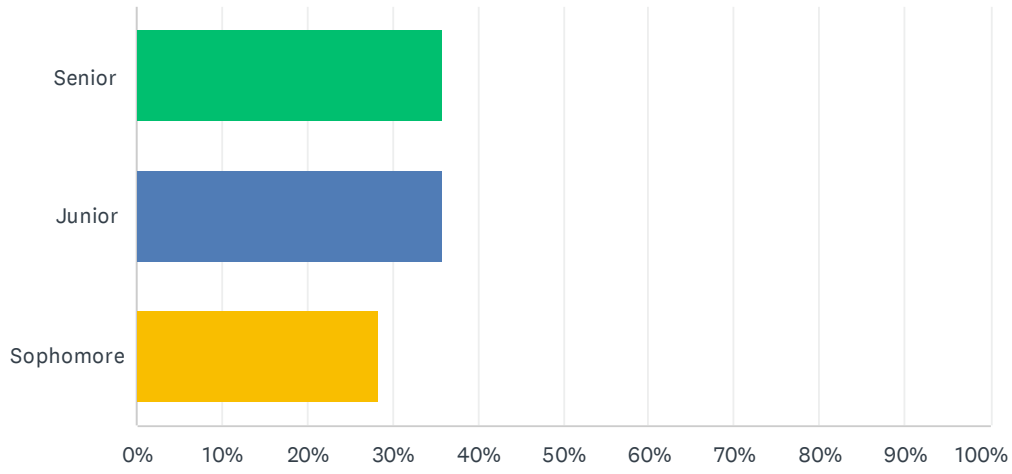

Q2 What year are you in high school?

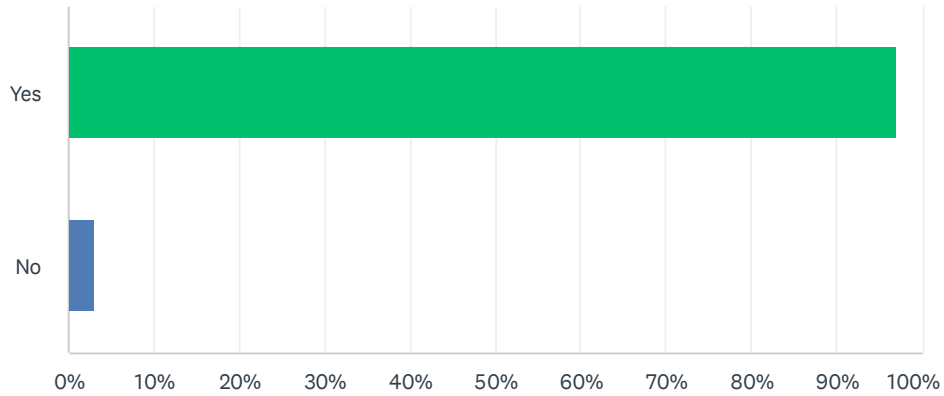

Q3 Did your high school close due to COVID-19?

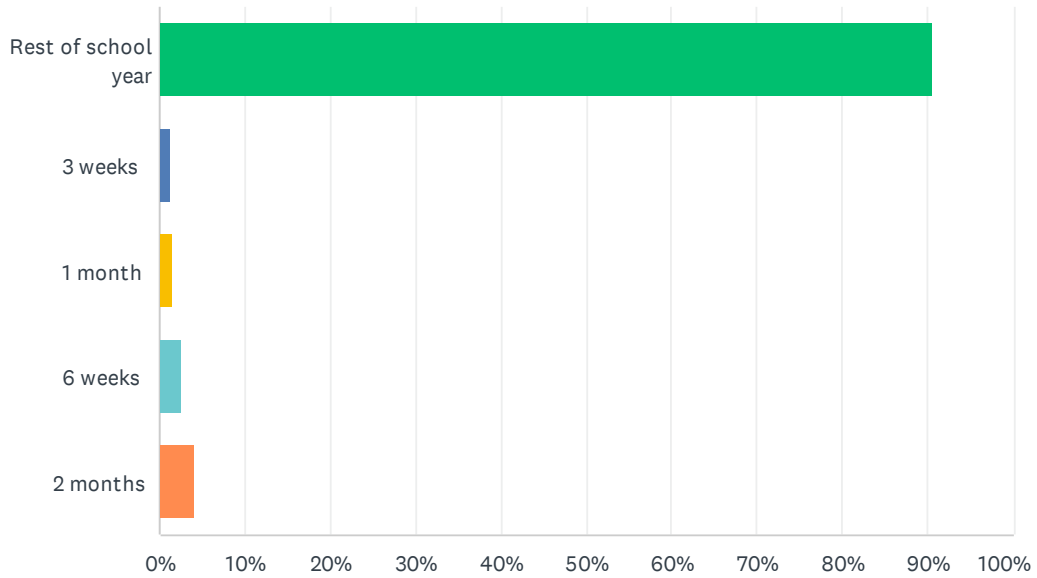

Q4 For how long?

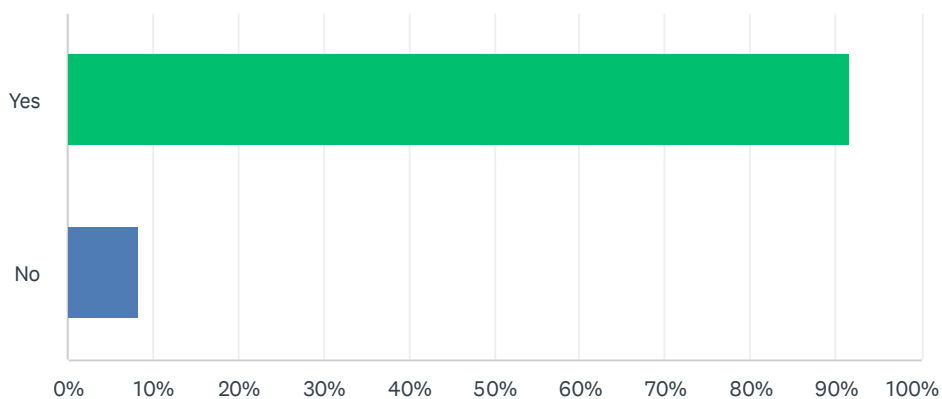

Q5 Did you take/are you taking online classes?

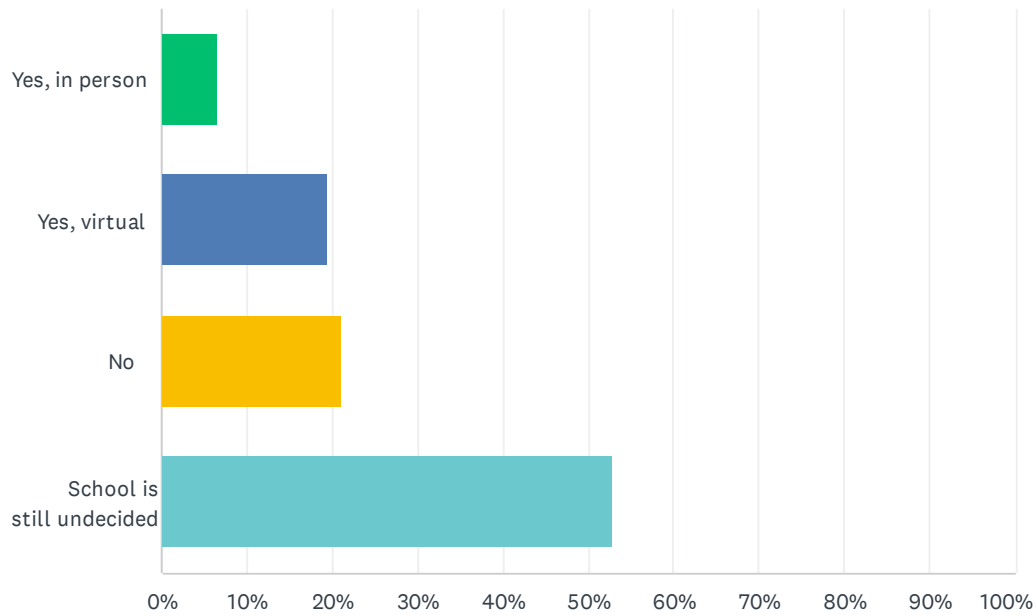

Q6 Will your high school be holding a graduation in 2020?

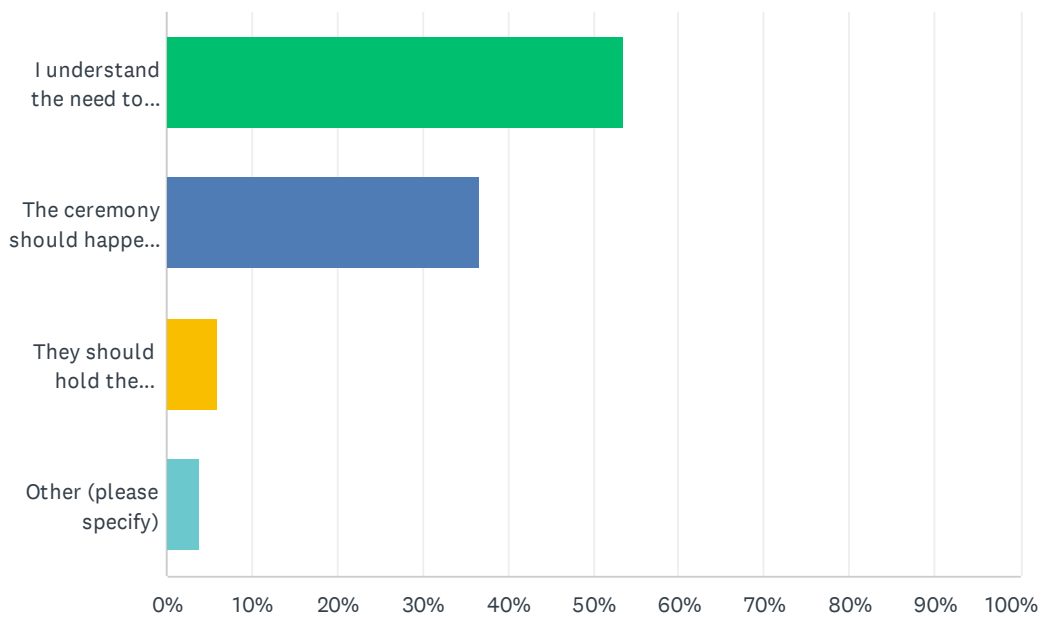

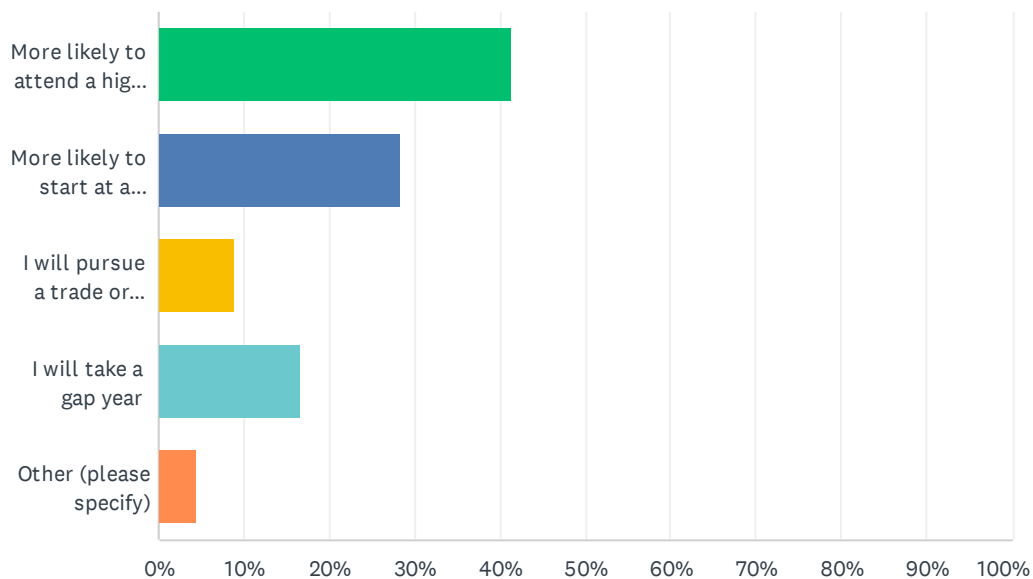

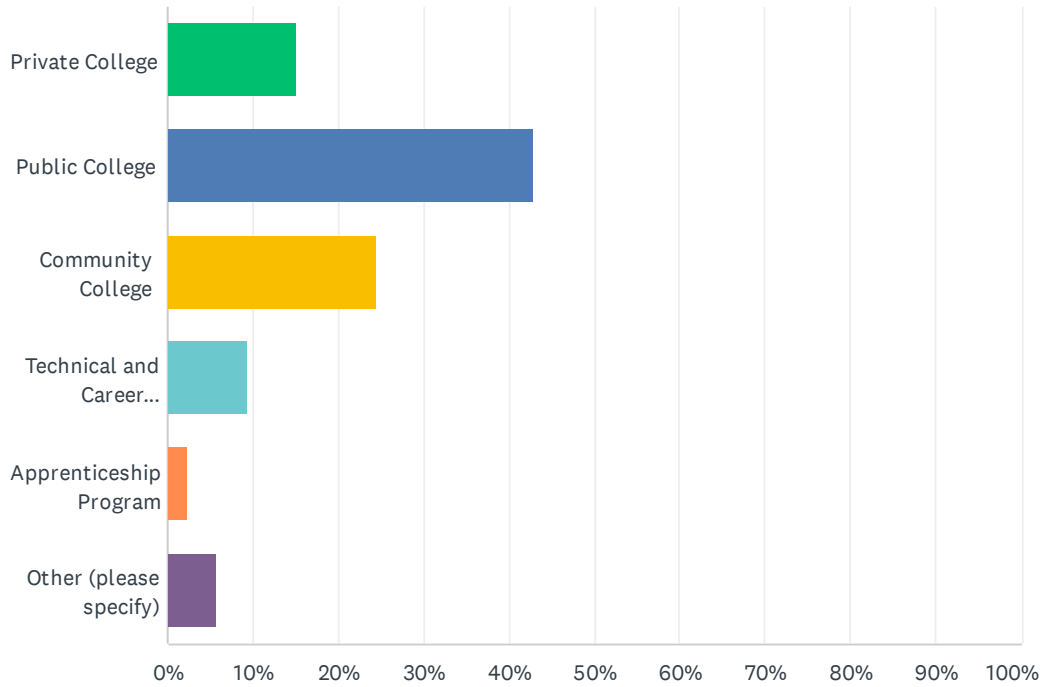

Q11 Has economic uncertainty related to COVID-19 affected your plans?

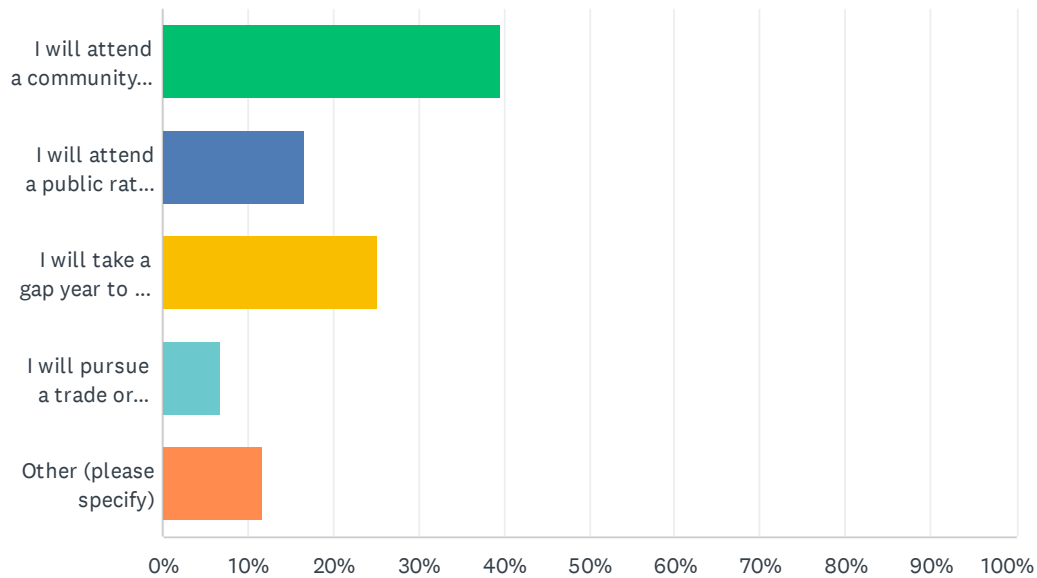

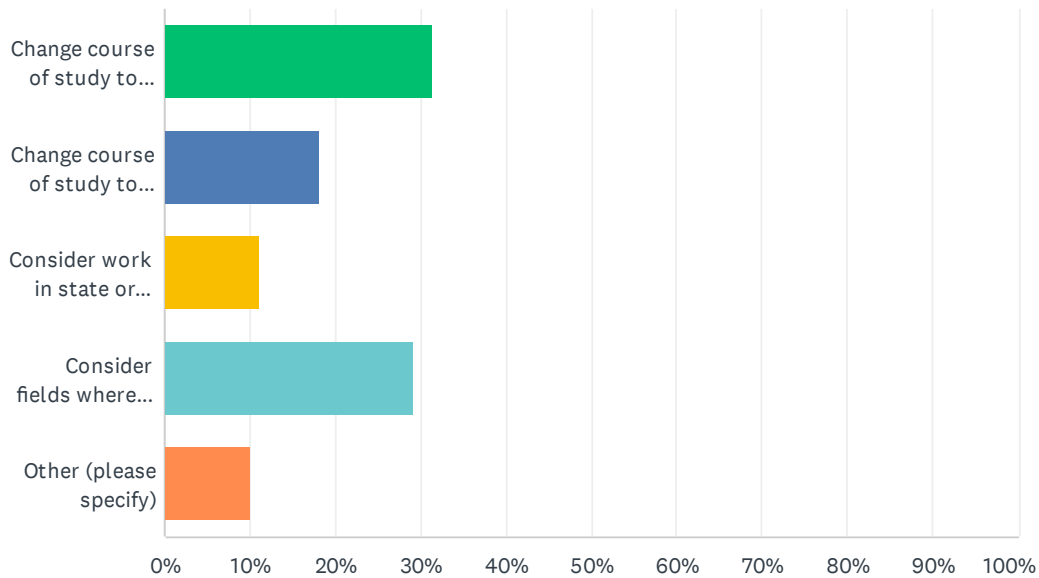

Q16 Do you think your experience with the COVID-19 pandemic will impact the rest of your life?

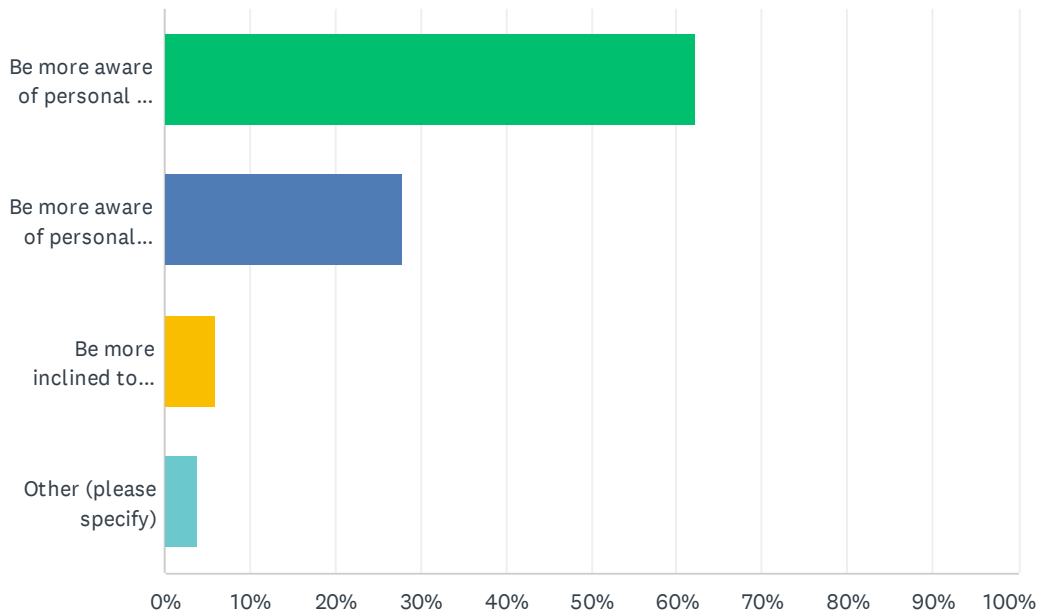

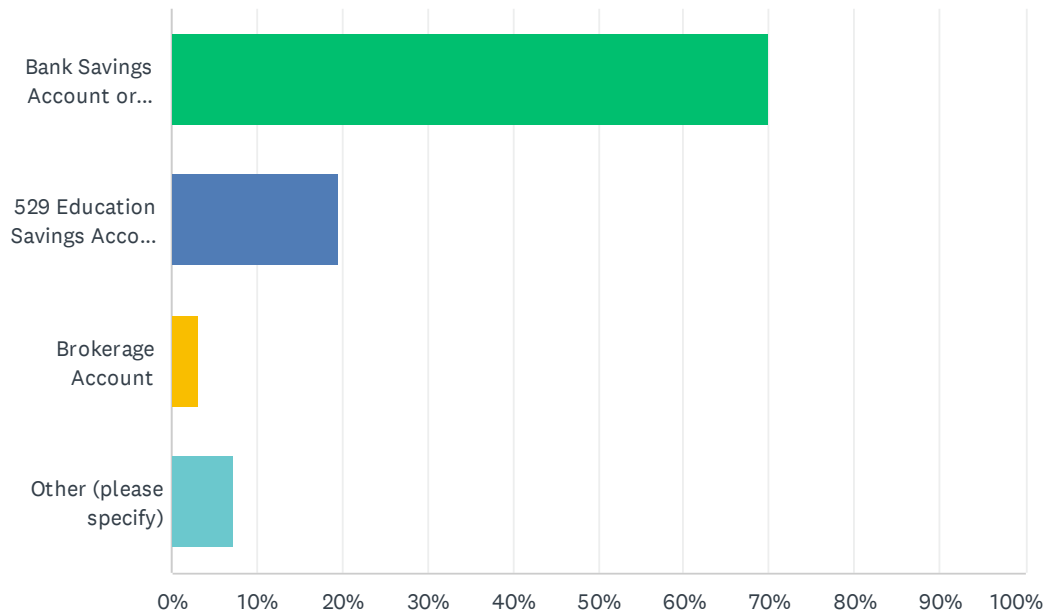

Q20 Are your parents saving for your higher education?

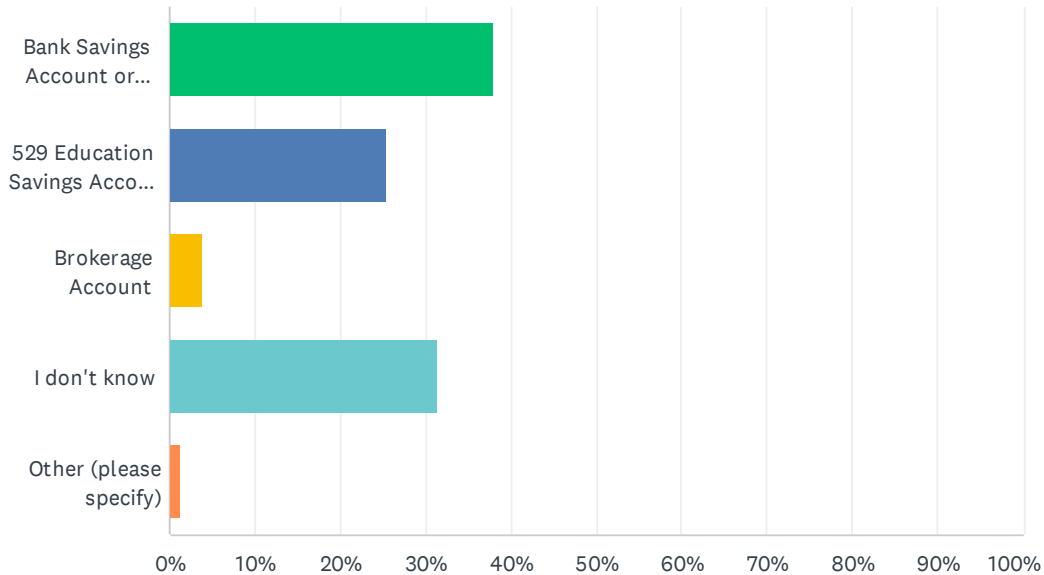

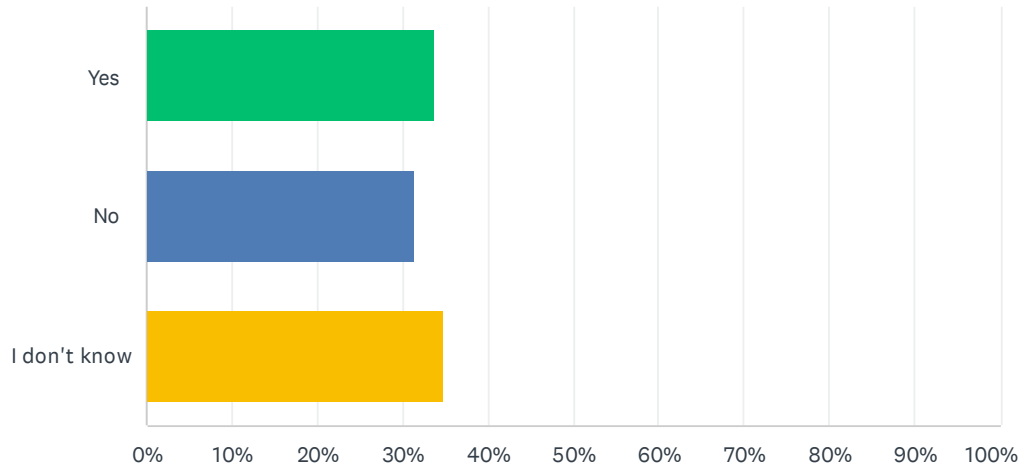

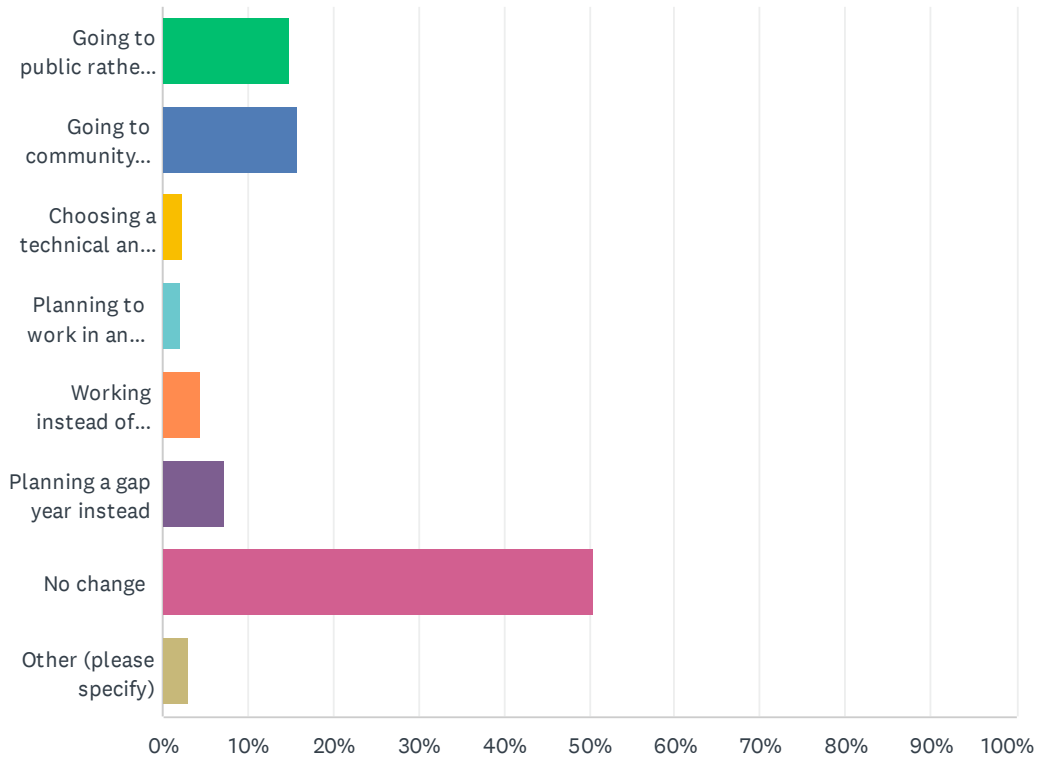

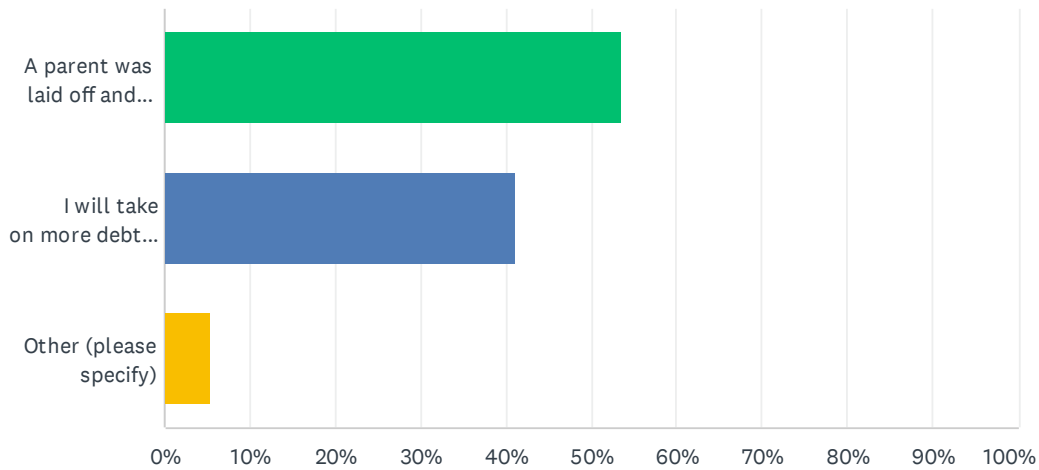
